 FIG. 3 is a top plan view, on an enlarged scale thereof.

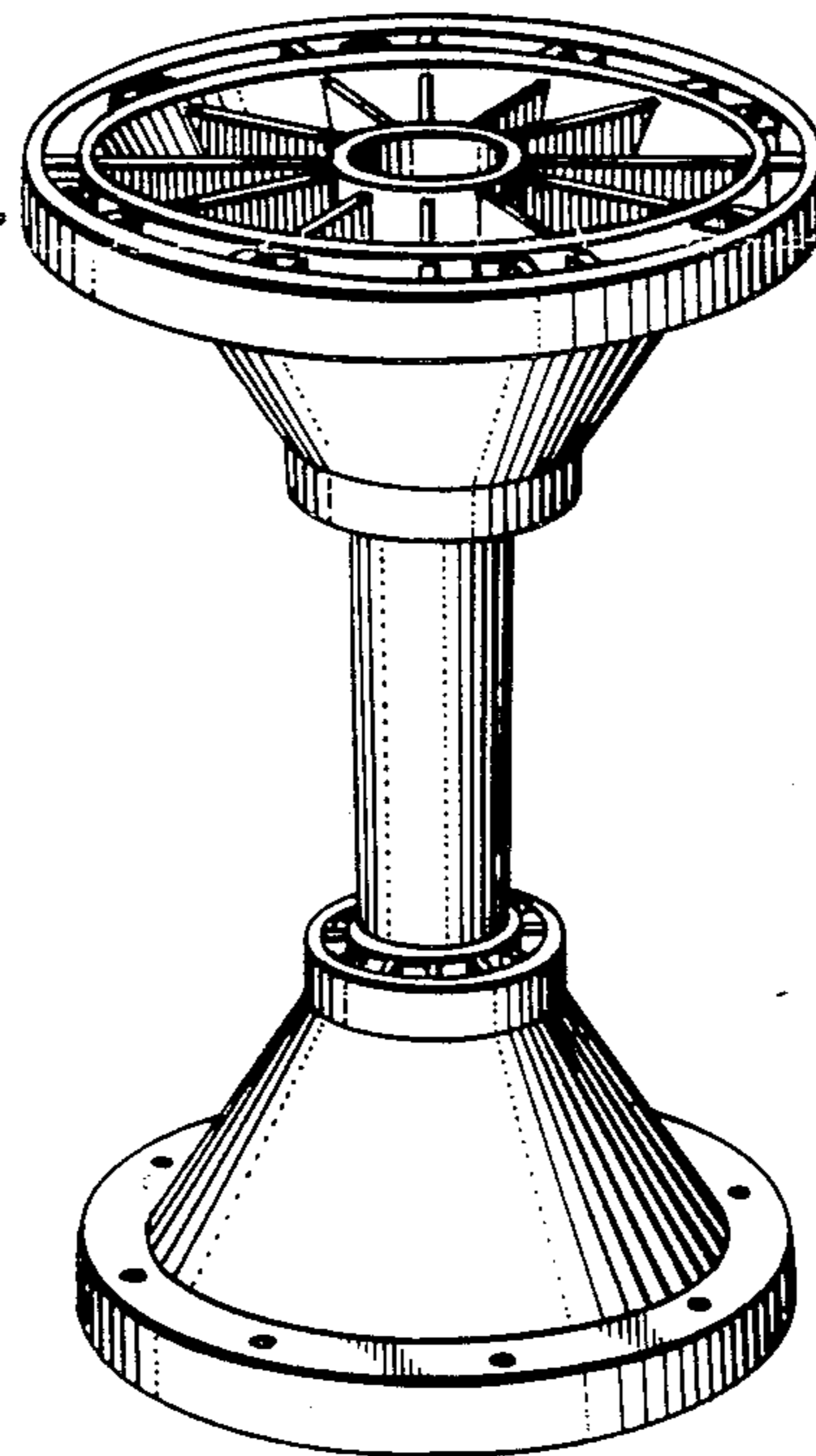

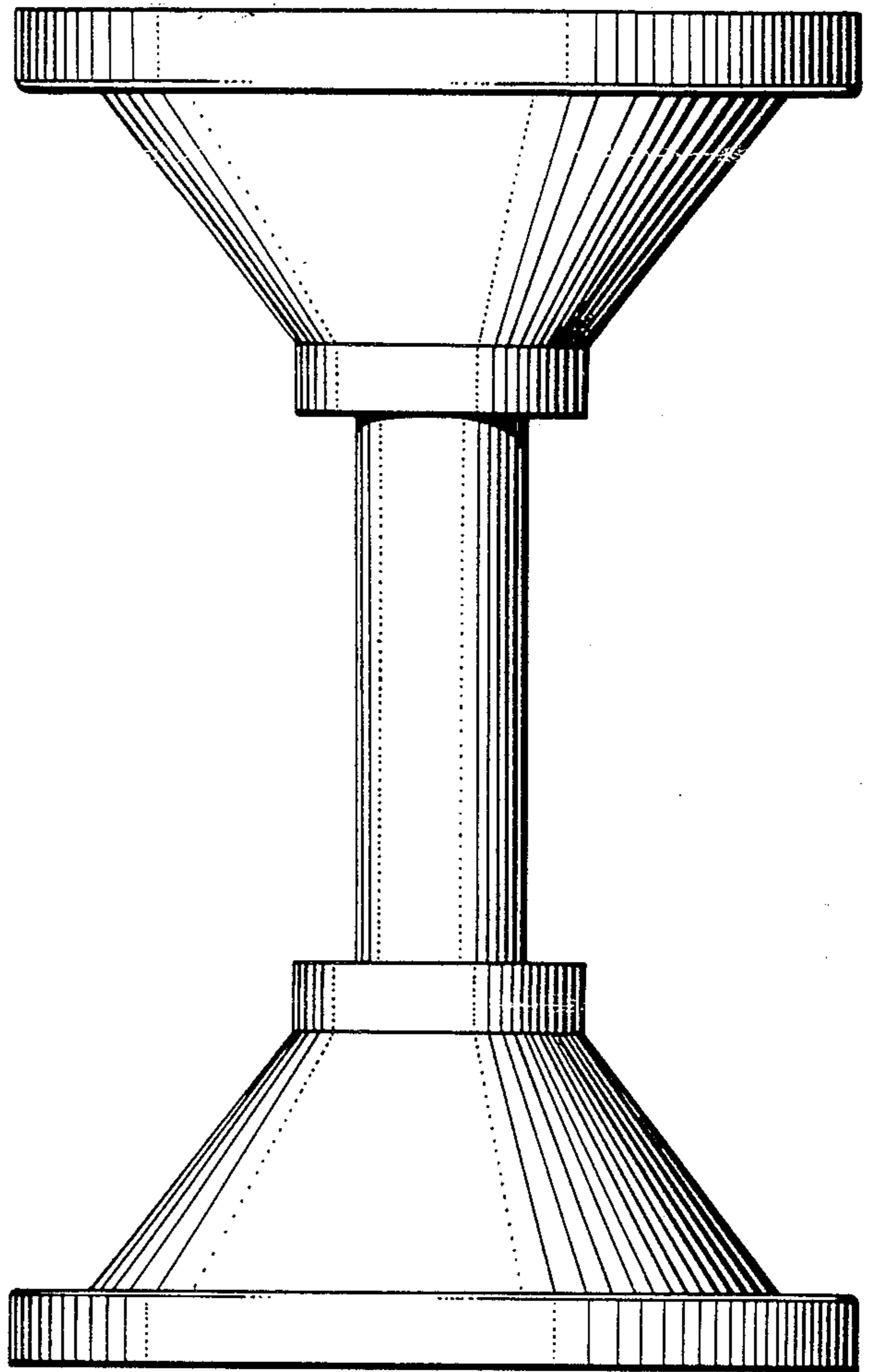
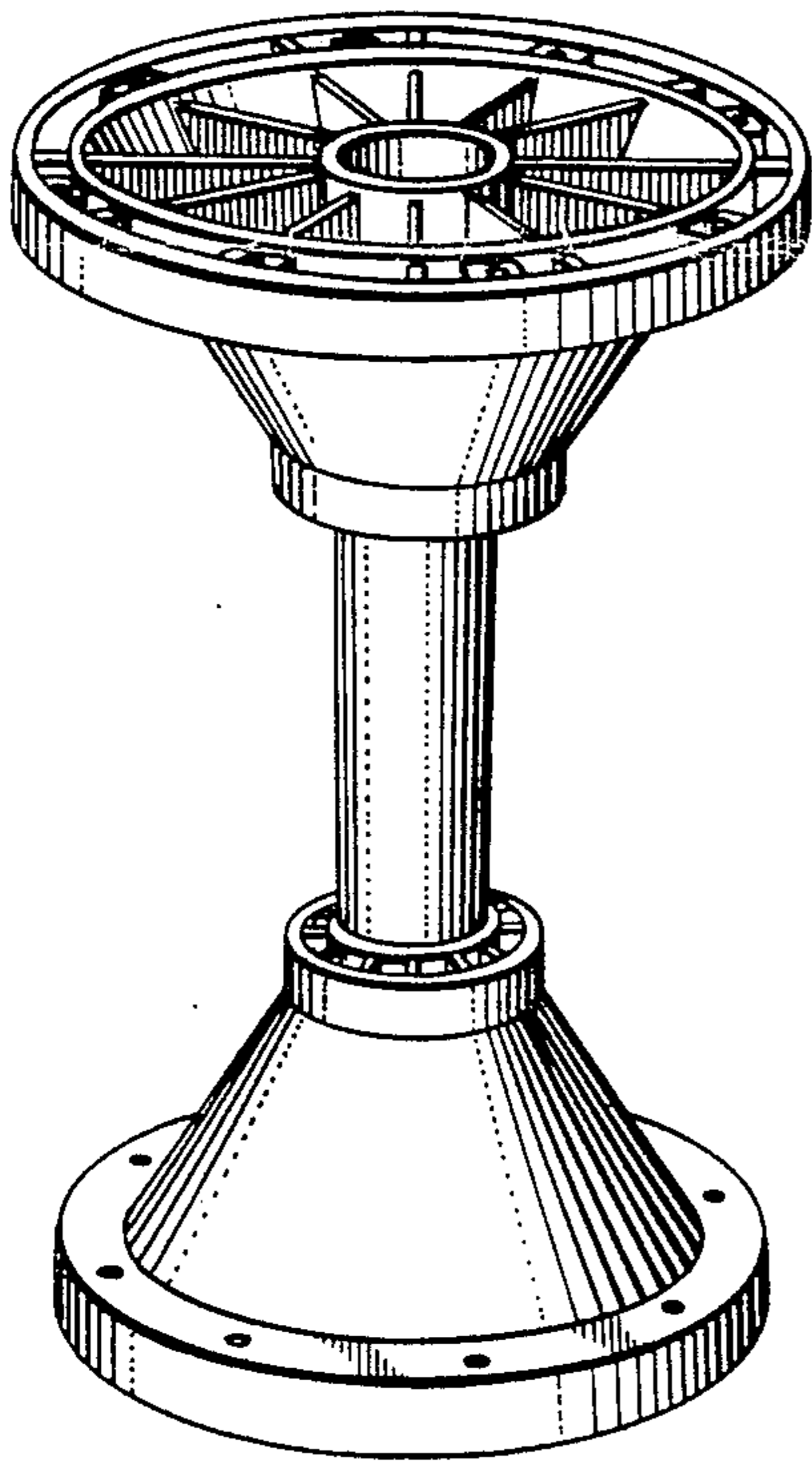

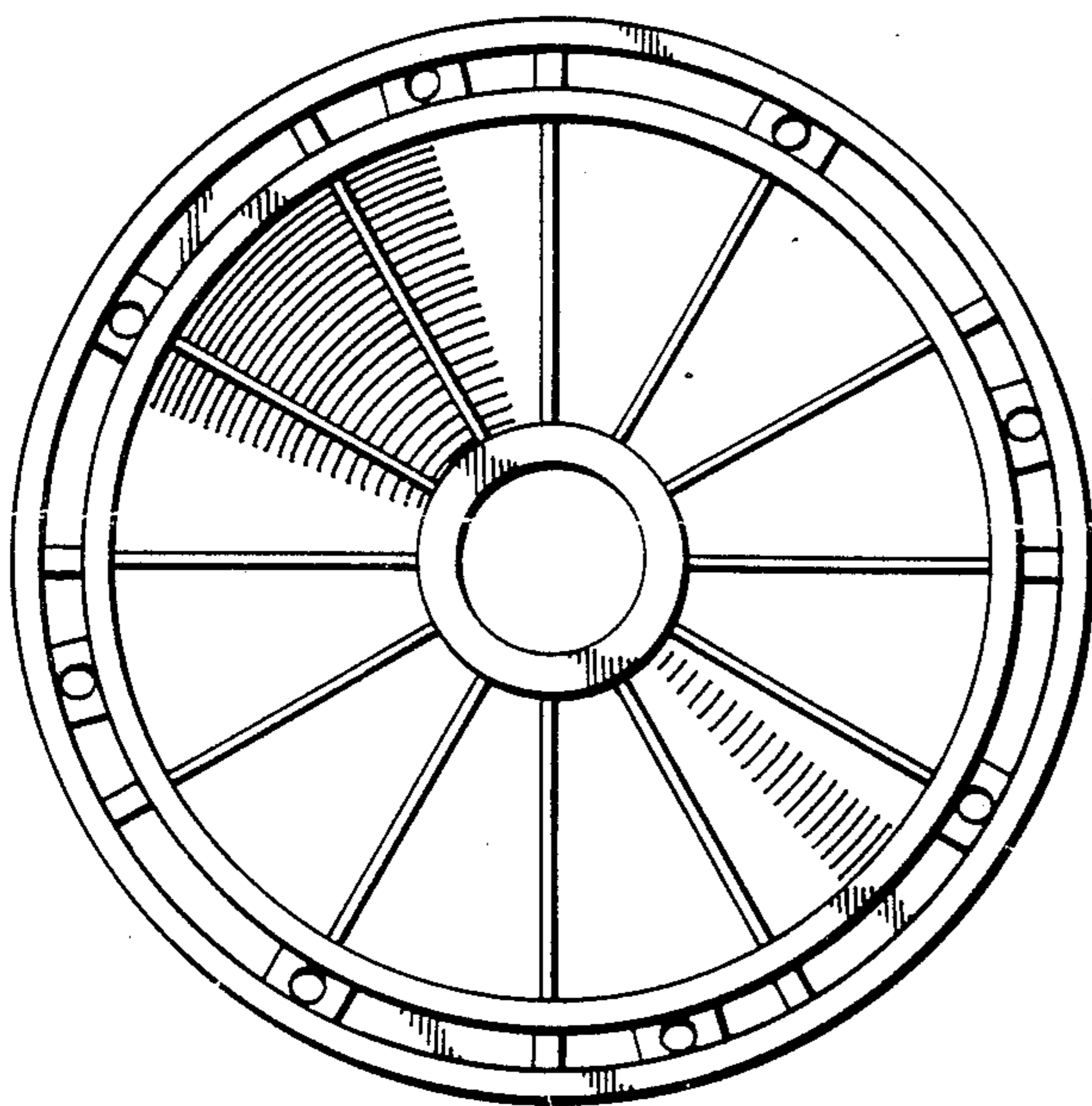
