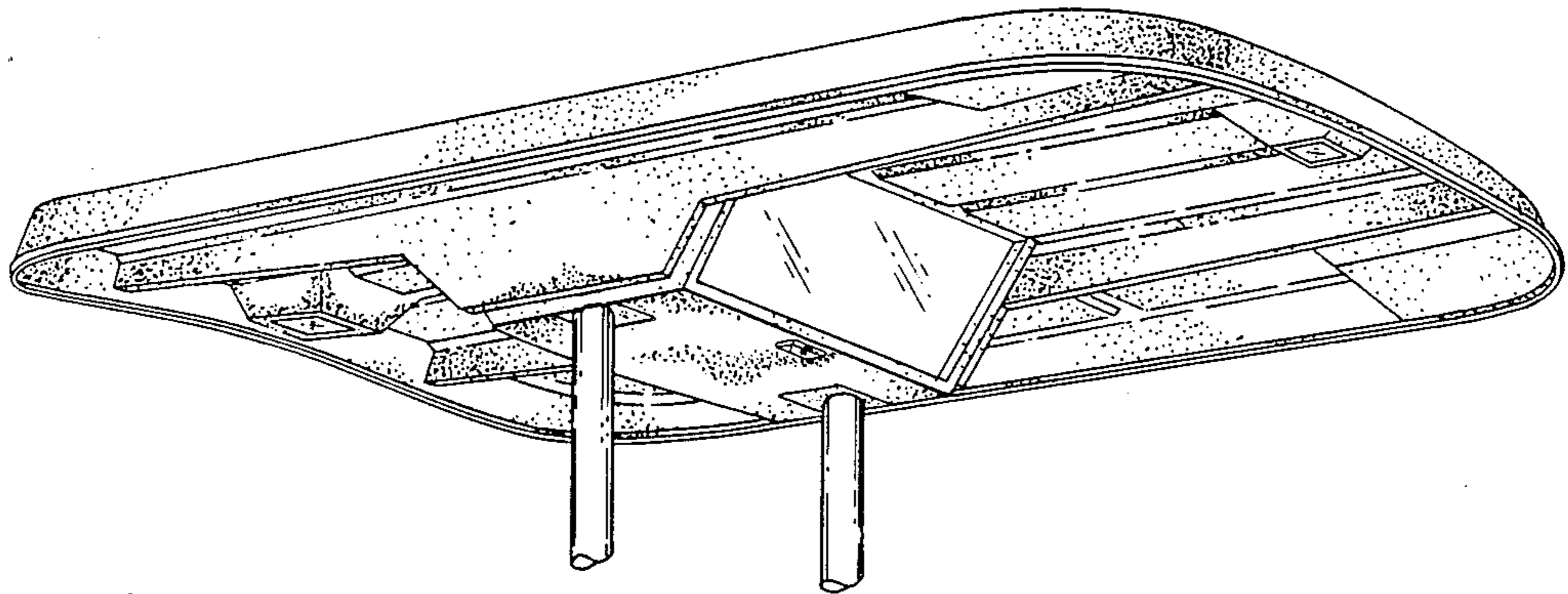

[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a sunshade for boats, as shown and described.

**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a sunshade for boats showing my new design.  
FIG. 2 is a bottom plan view thereof.  
FIG. 3 is a rear elevational view thereof.  
FIG. 4 is a top plan view thereof.  
FIG. 5 is a side elevational view thereof, the opposite side view being a mirror image of that shown;  
FIG. 6 is a front elevational view thereof.  
The portion of the support members shown in FIGS. 1, 3, 5 and 6 are shown broken away for convenience of illustration.



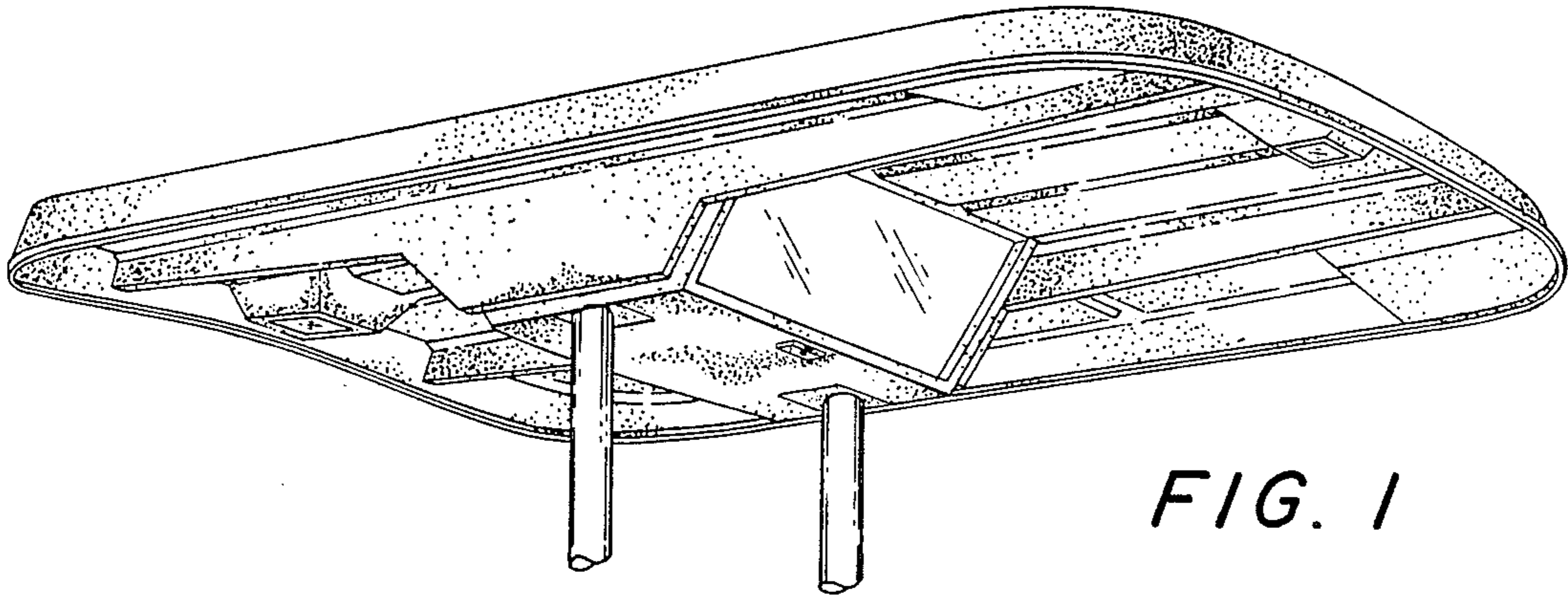

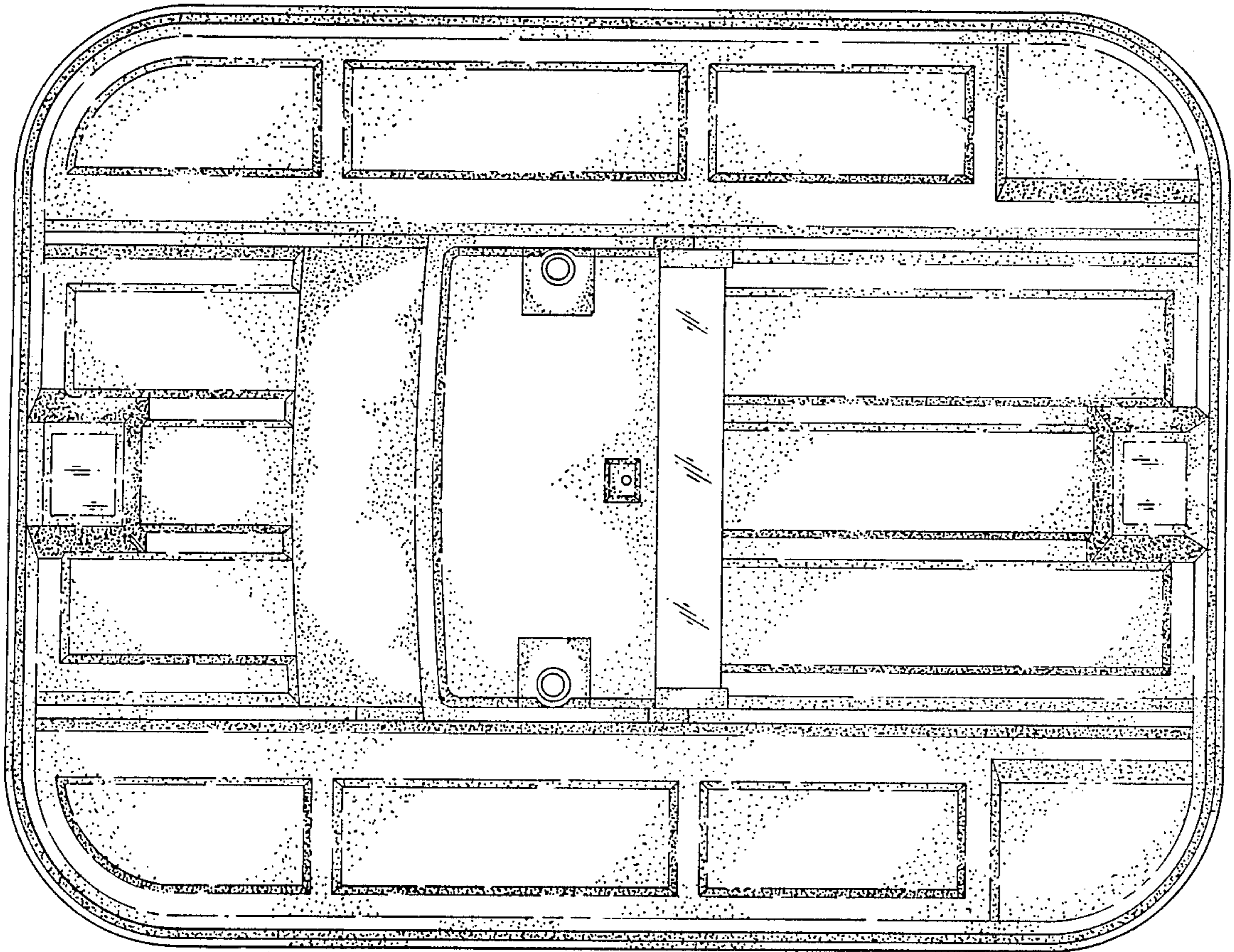

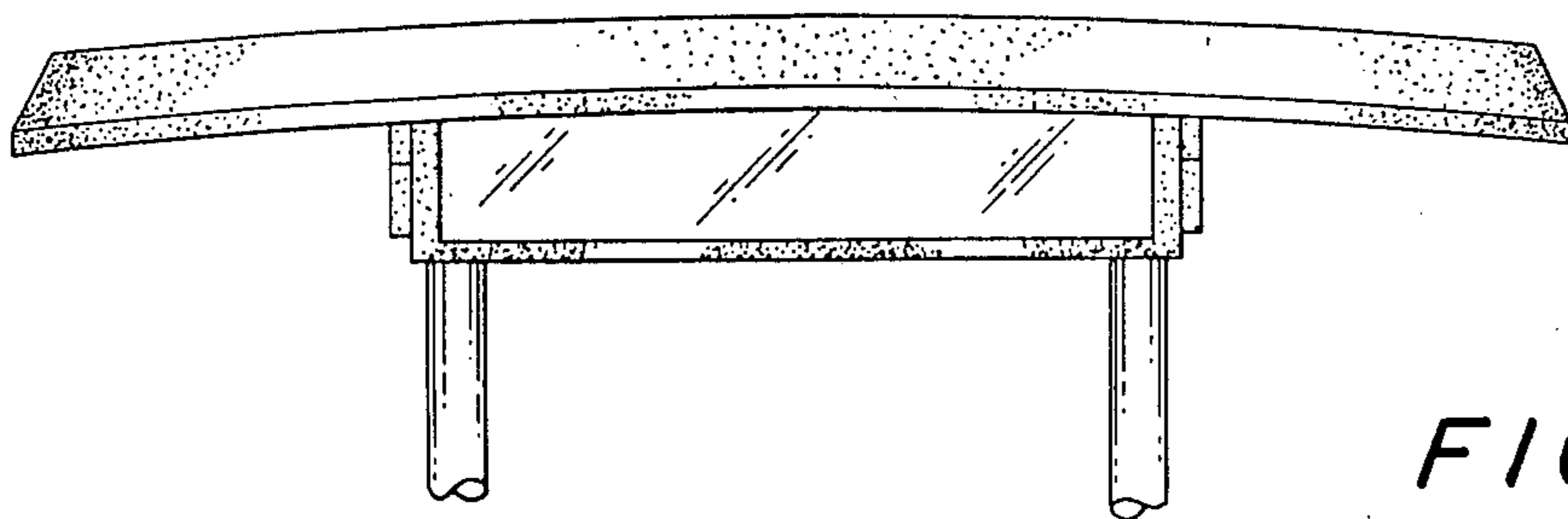
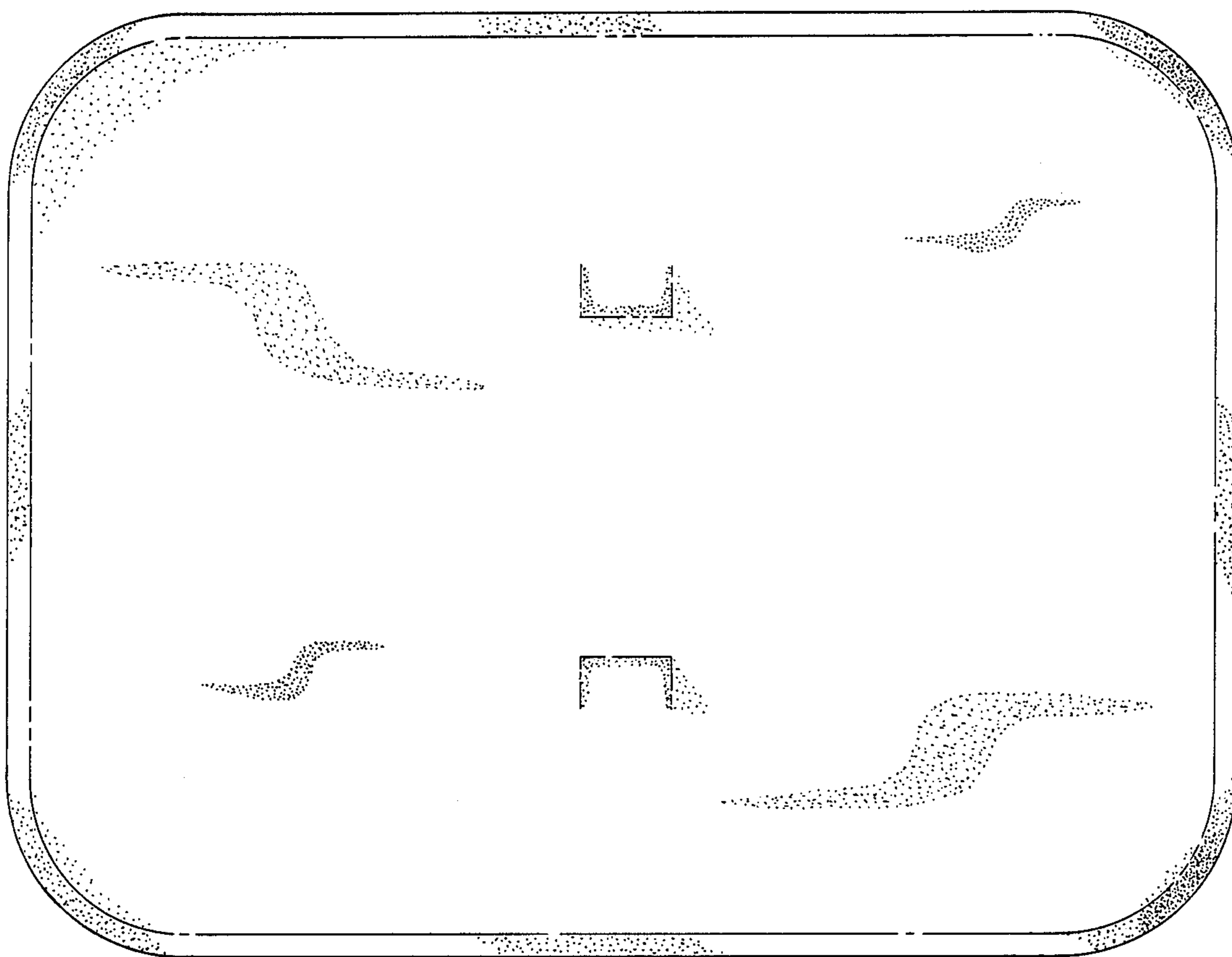
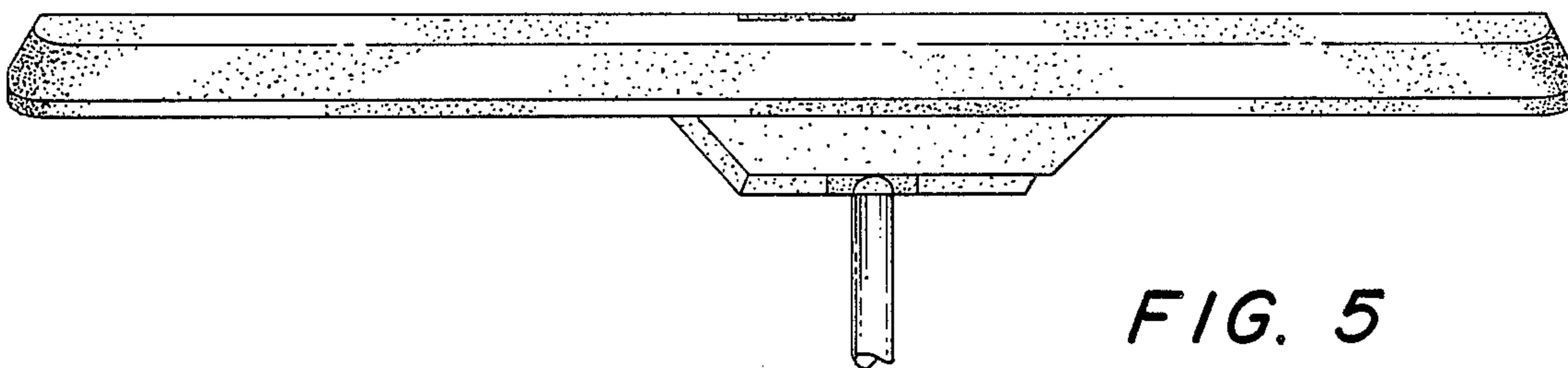

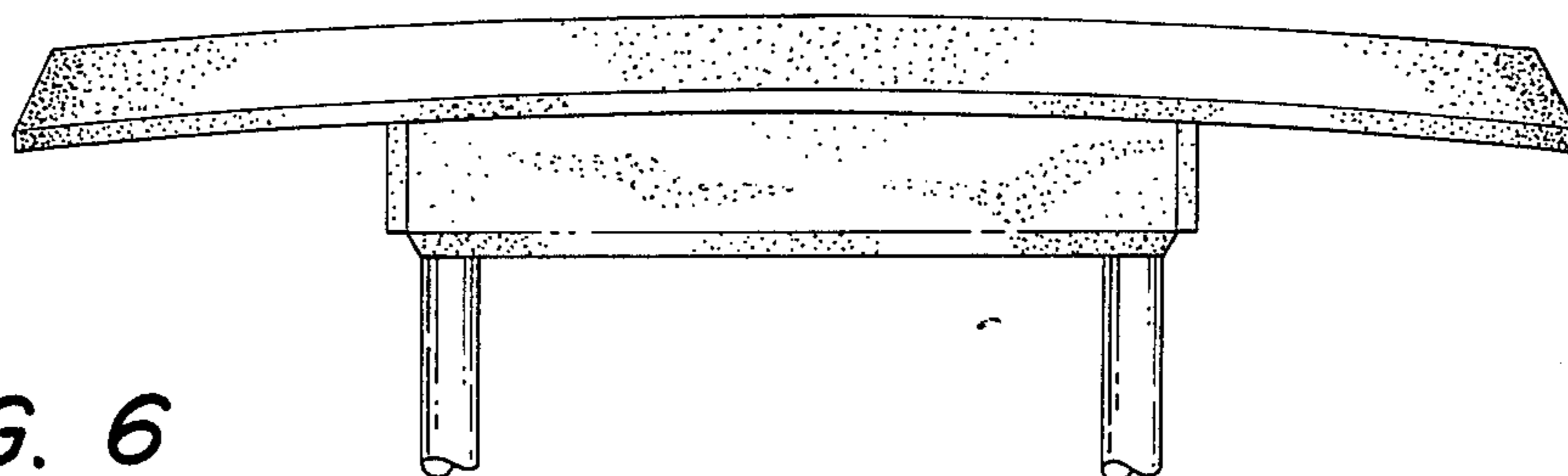
