DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top perspective view of the eyeglass earstem showing my new design, the eyeglass frame being shown in broken-lines for illustrative purposes only; FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof; FIG. 3 is a top plan view thereof; FIG. 4 is an end elevational view thereof; FIG. 5 is an opposite end elevational view thereof; FIG. 6 is a rear elevational view thereof.

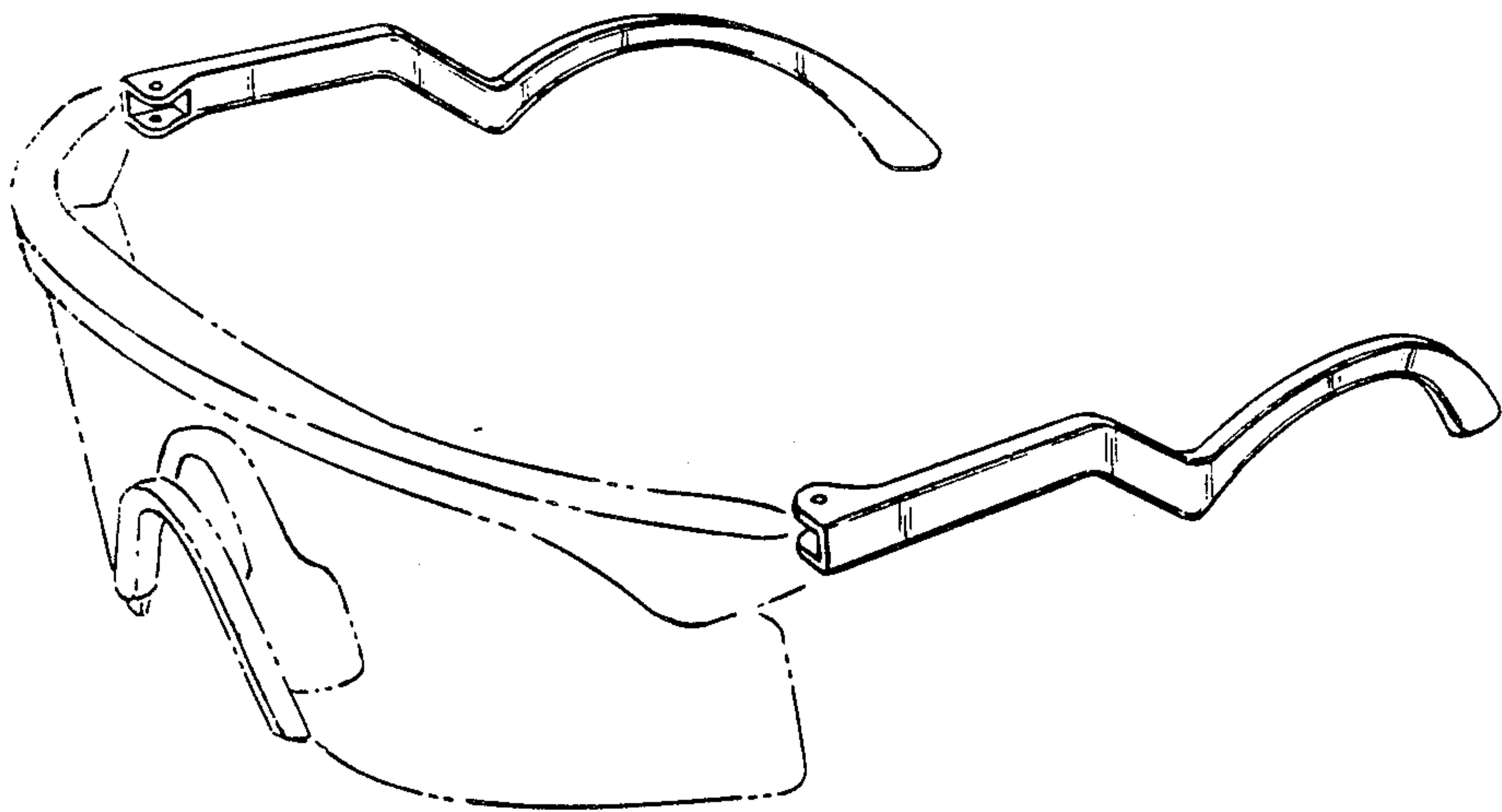

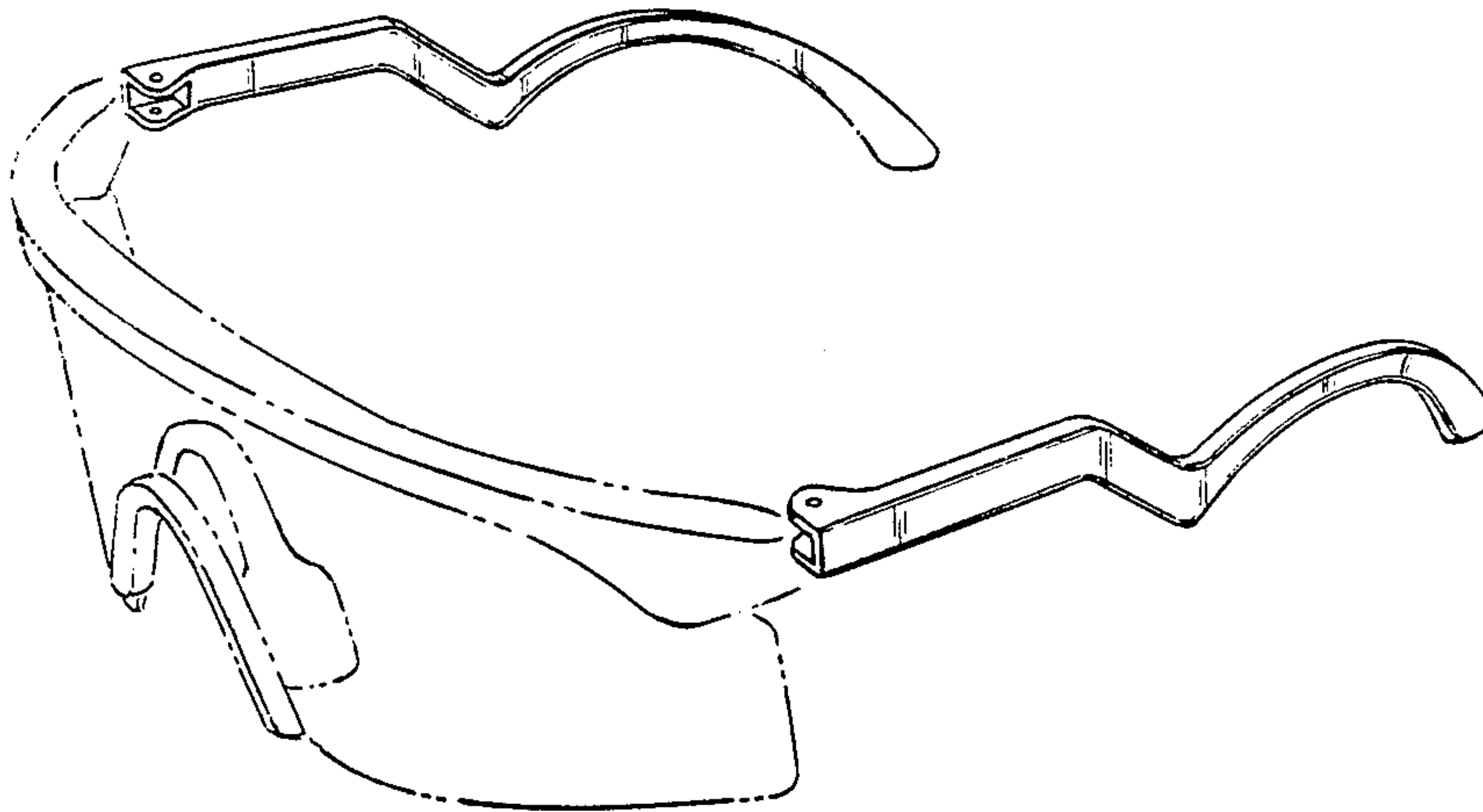

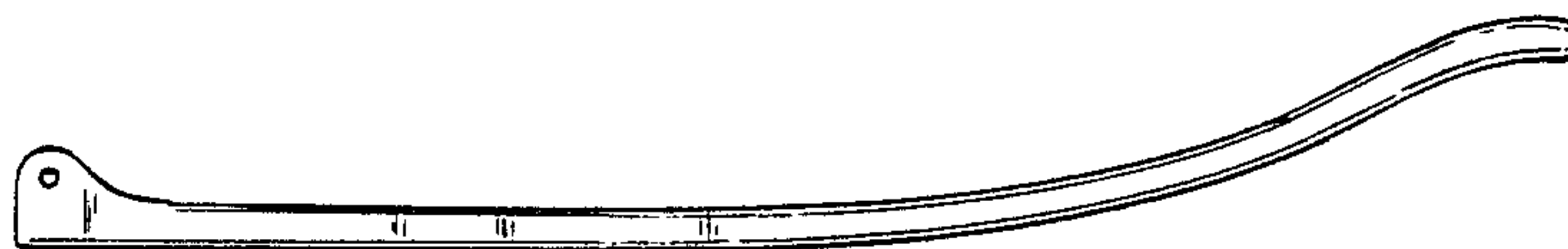

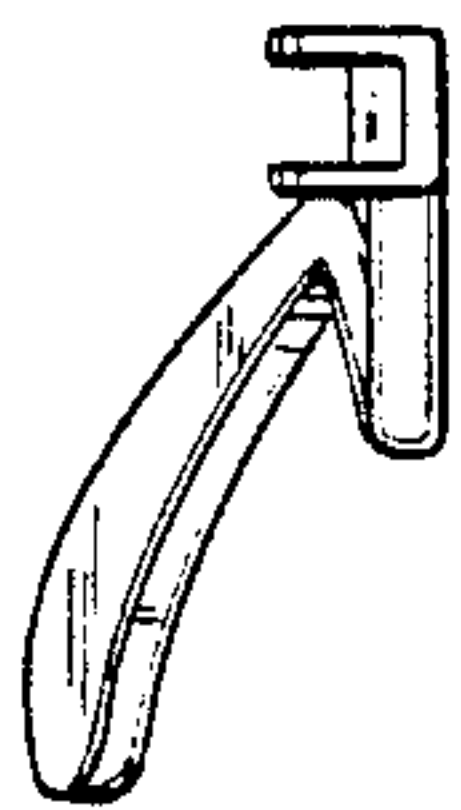

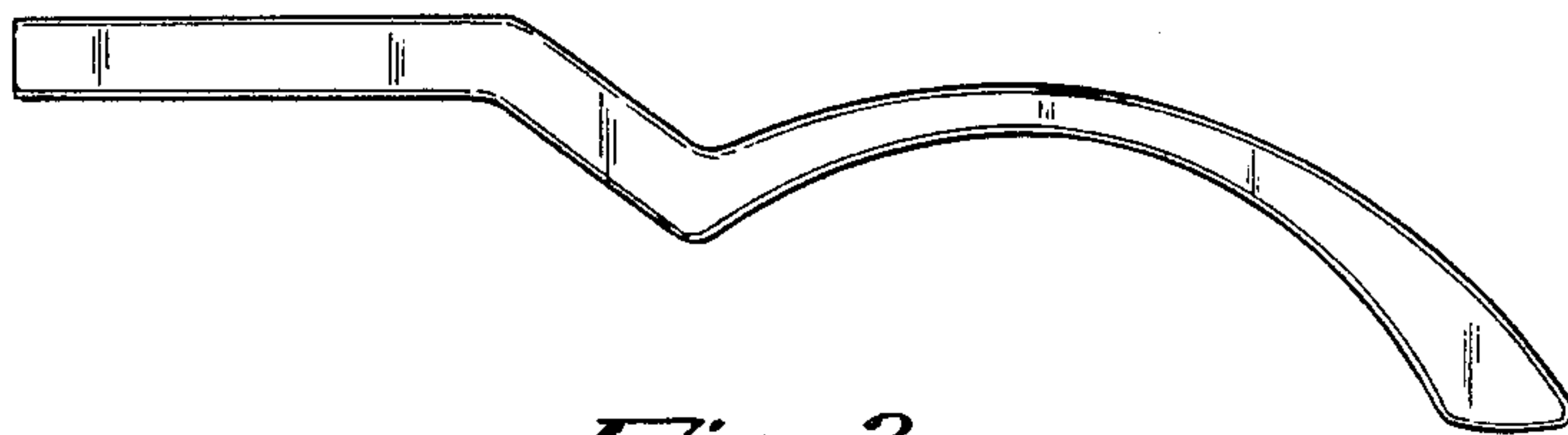

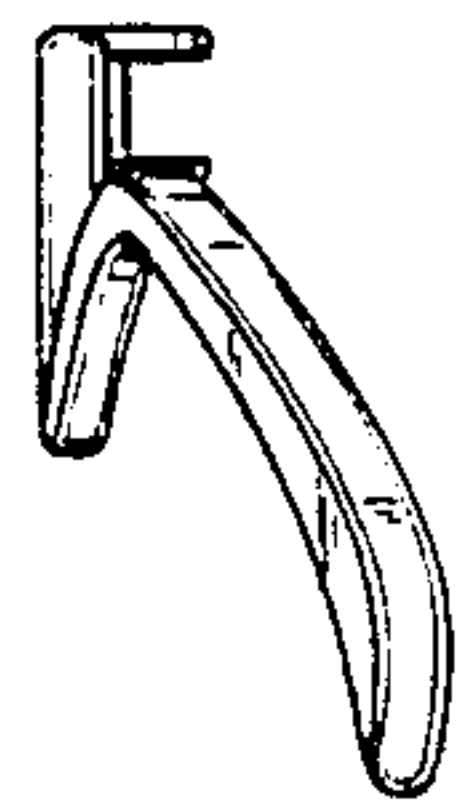
