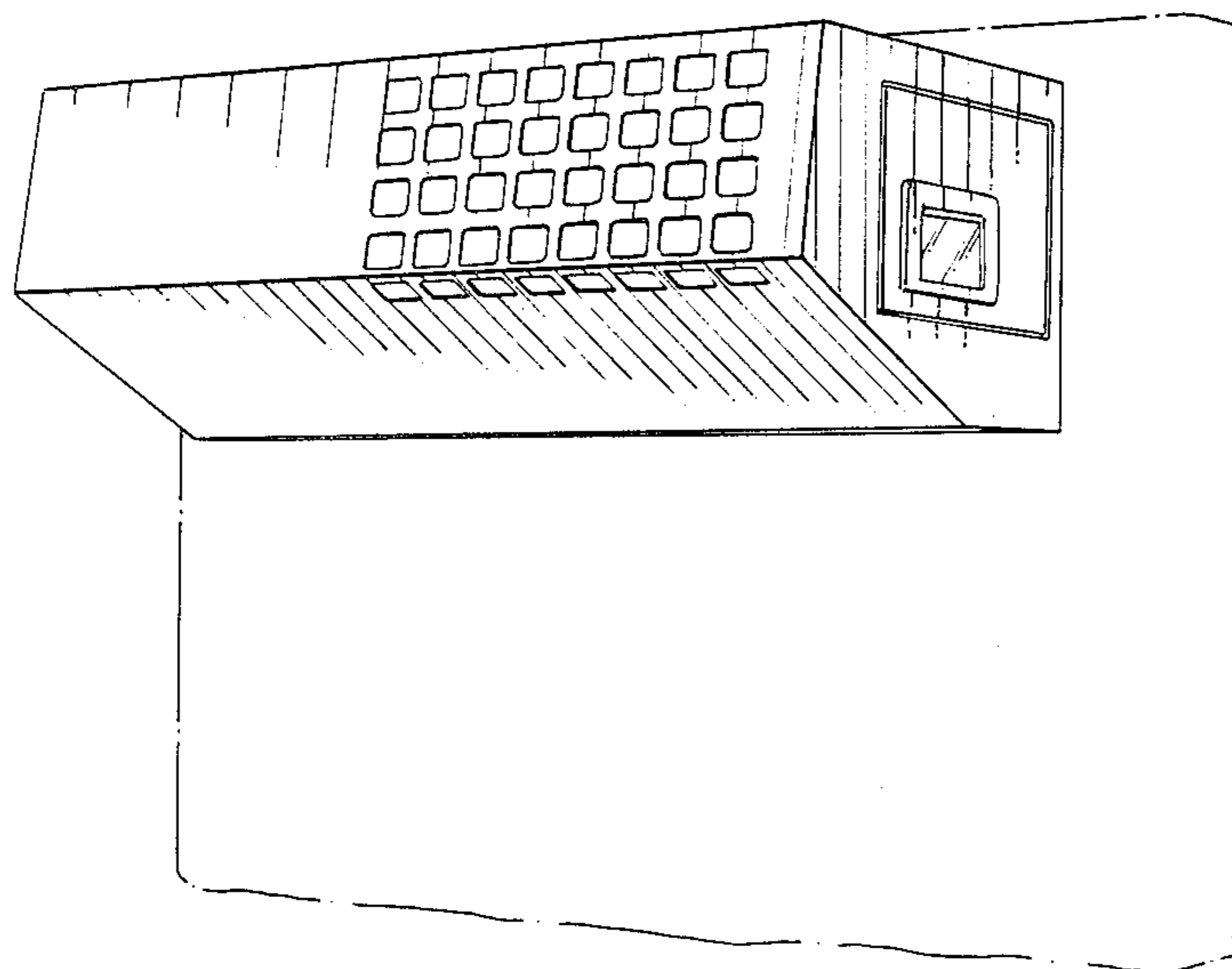

[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design of a cover for a transport refrigeration unit, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a cover for a transport refrigeration unit showing our new design; FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof; FIG. 3 is a top plan view thereof; FIG. 4 is a left side elevational view thereof; FIG. 5 is a right side elevational view thereof. The fragmentary broken line representation of the front of a trailer in FIG. 1 is for purposes of illustration only, and forms no part of the claimed design. The bottom is plain and unornamented.



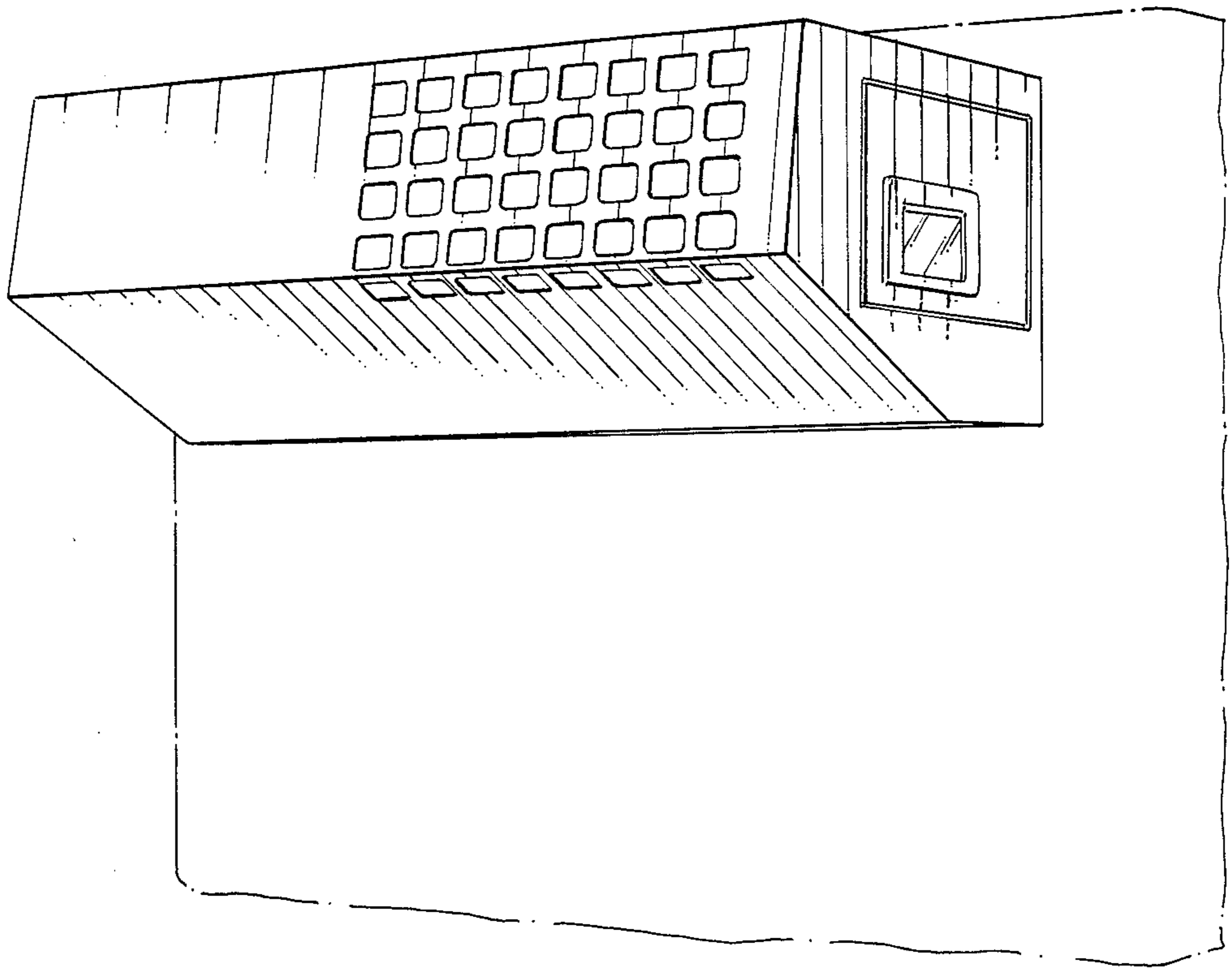

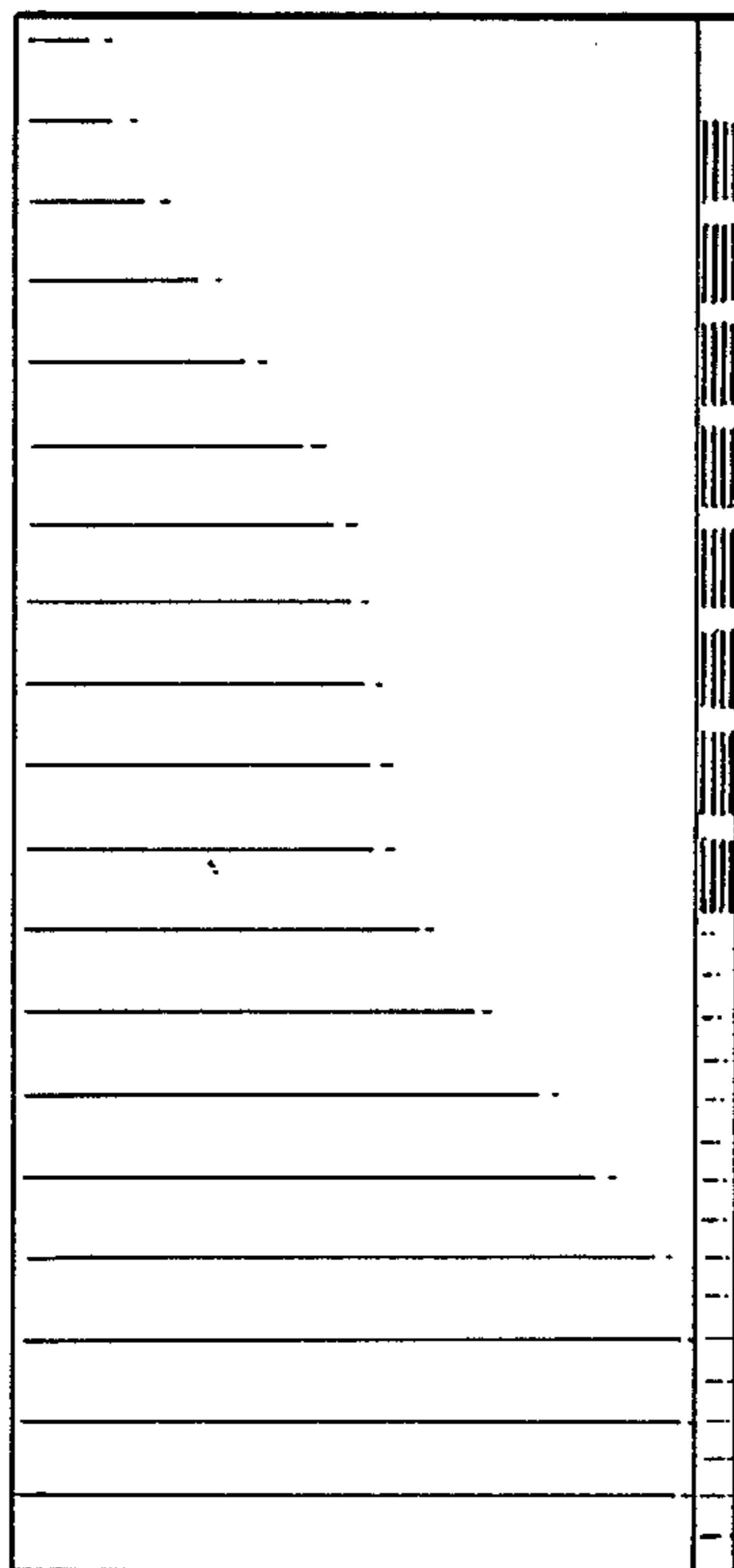

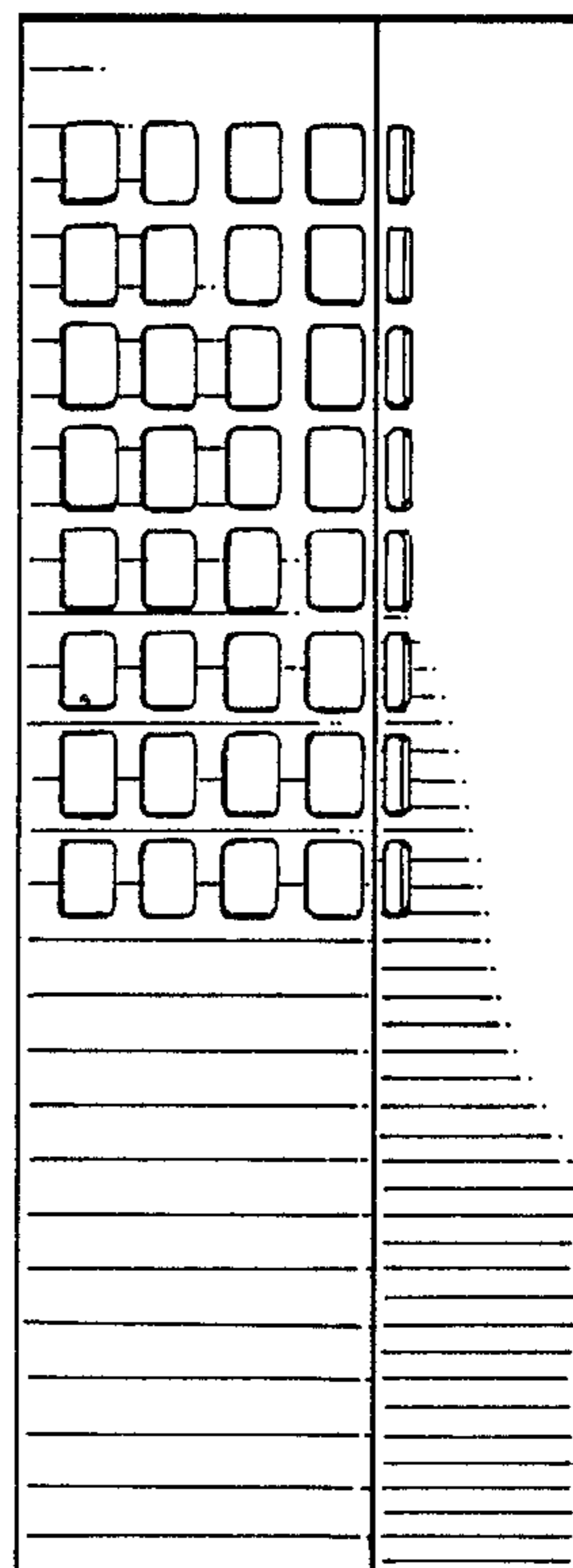

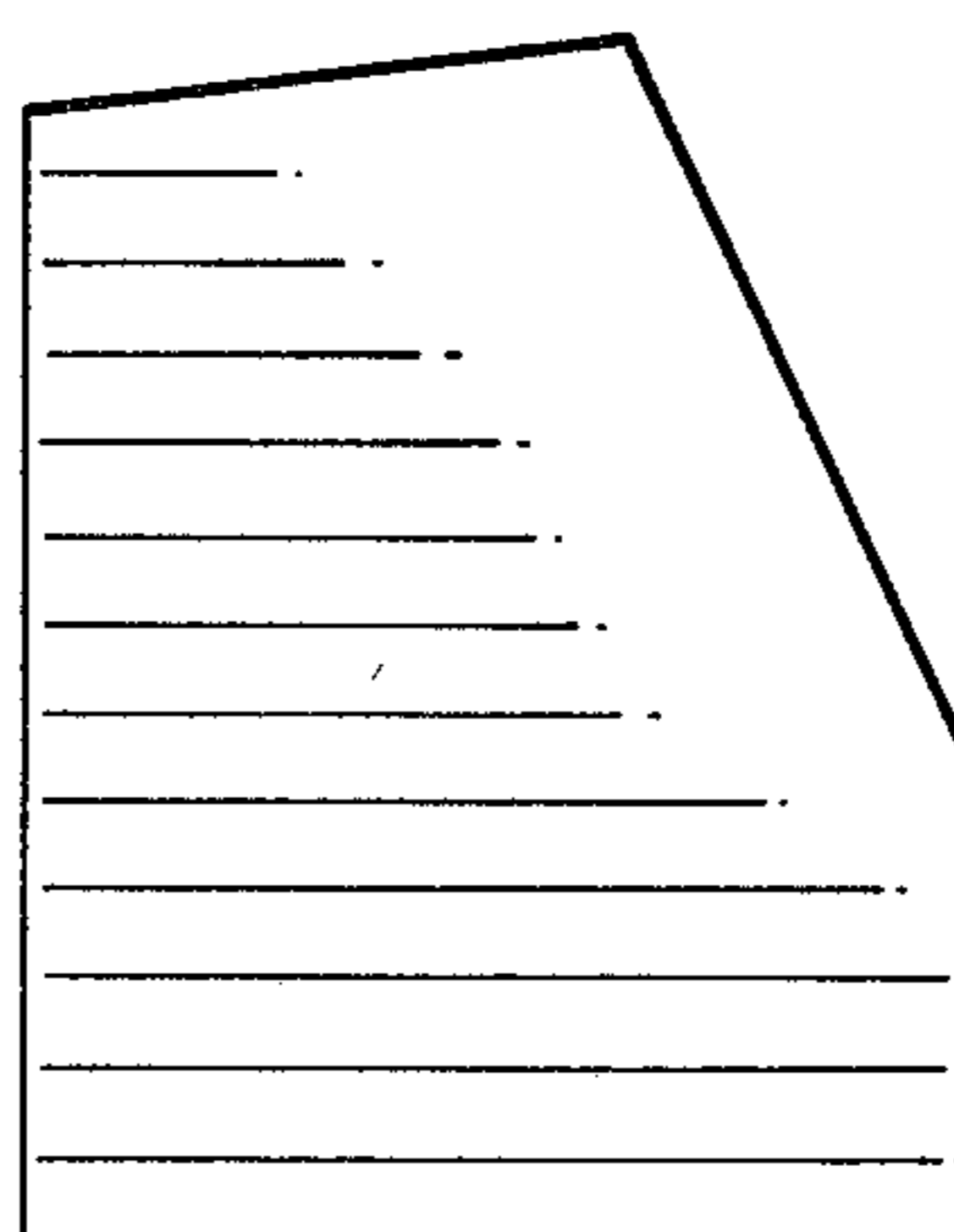

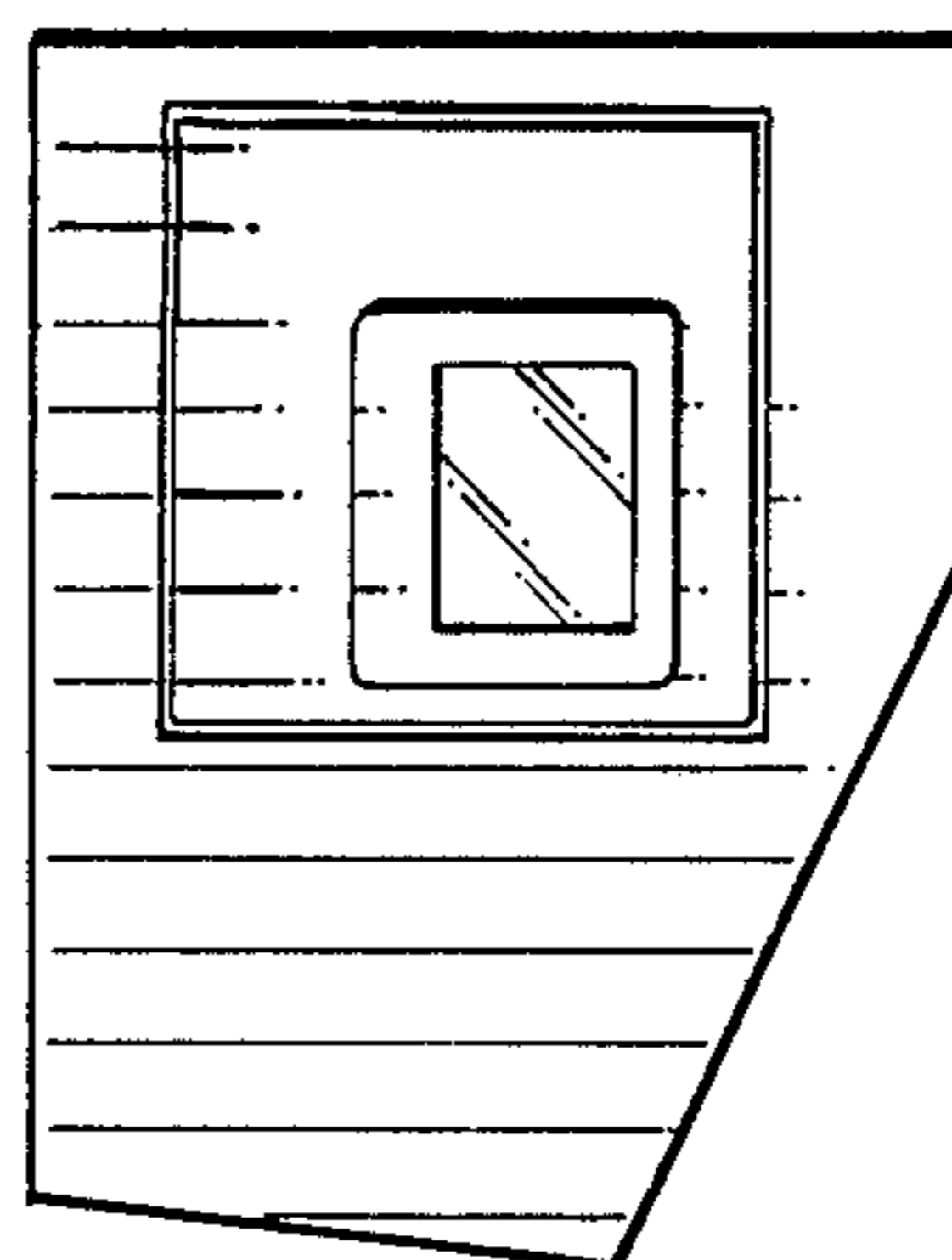
