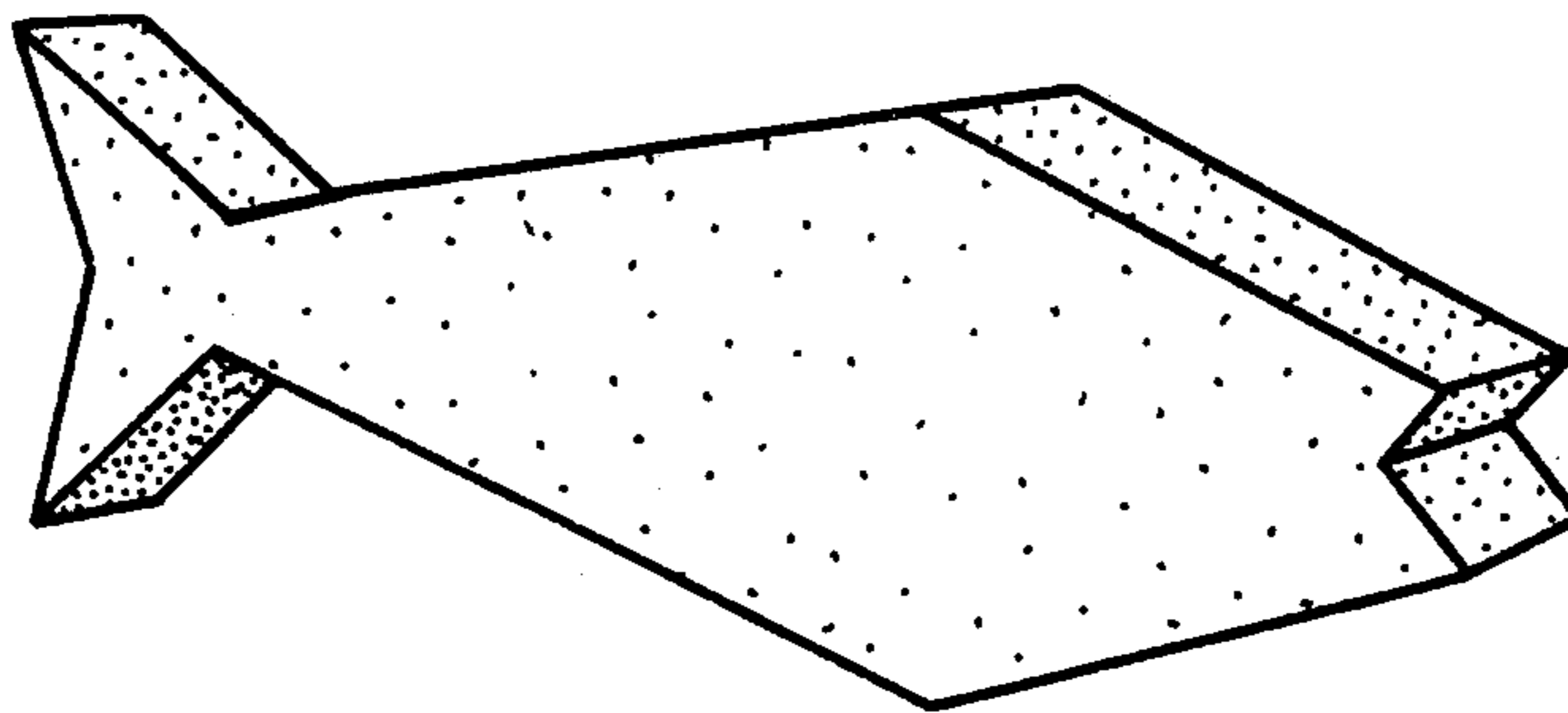

FIG. 1 is a top perspective view of a french fry showing my new design;

FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof, the undisclosed bottom being the same;

FIG. 3 is a front end elevational view thereof, the undisclosed rear end being unadorned and having the shape as indicated in FIG. 2.



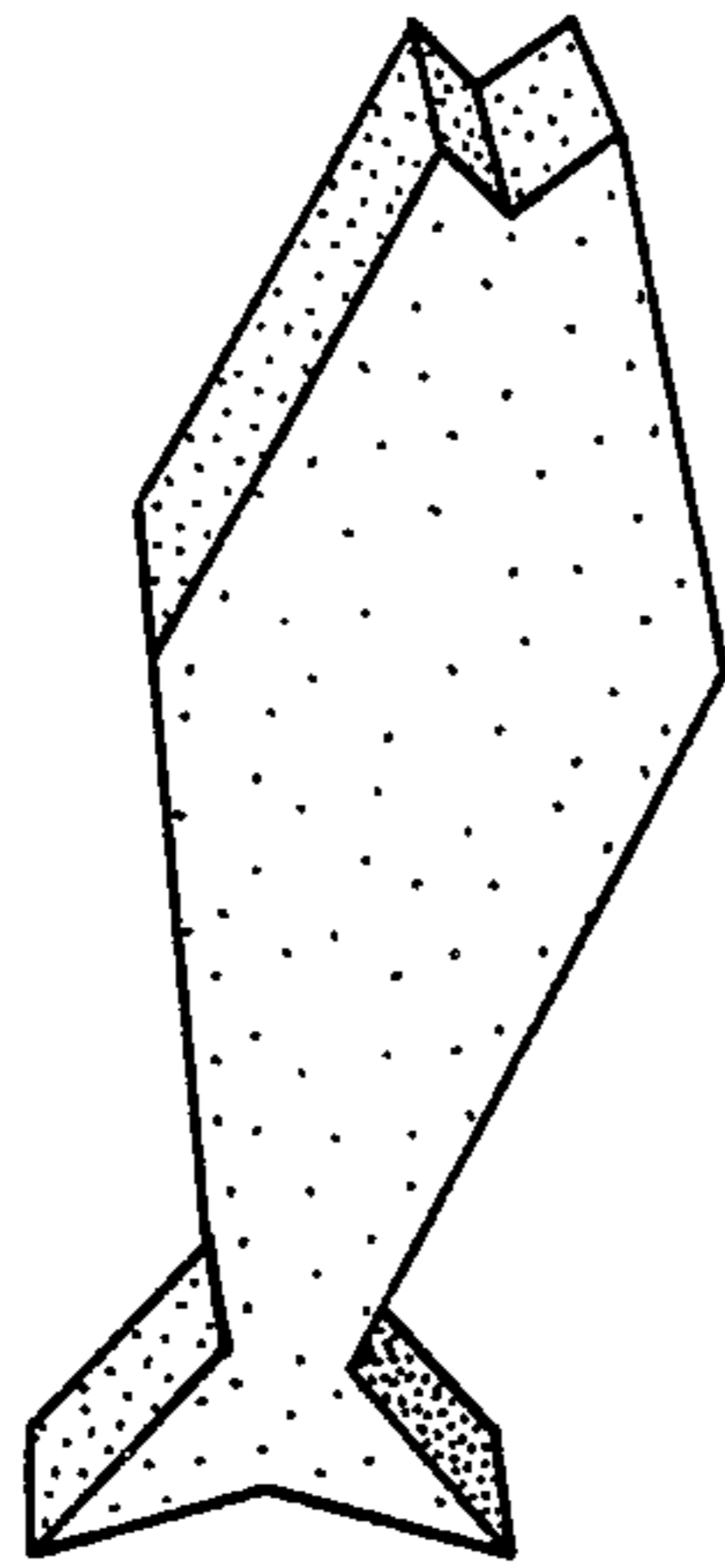

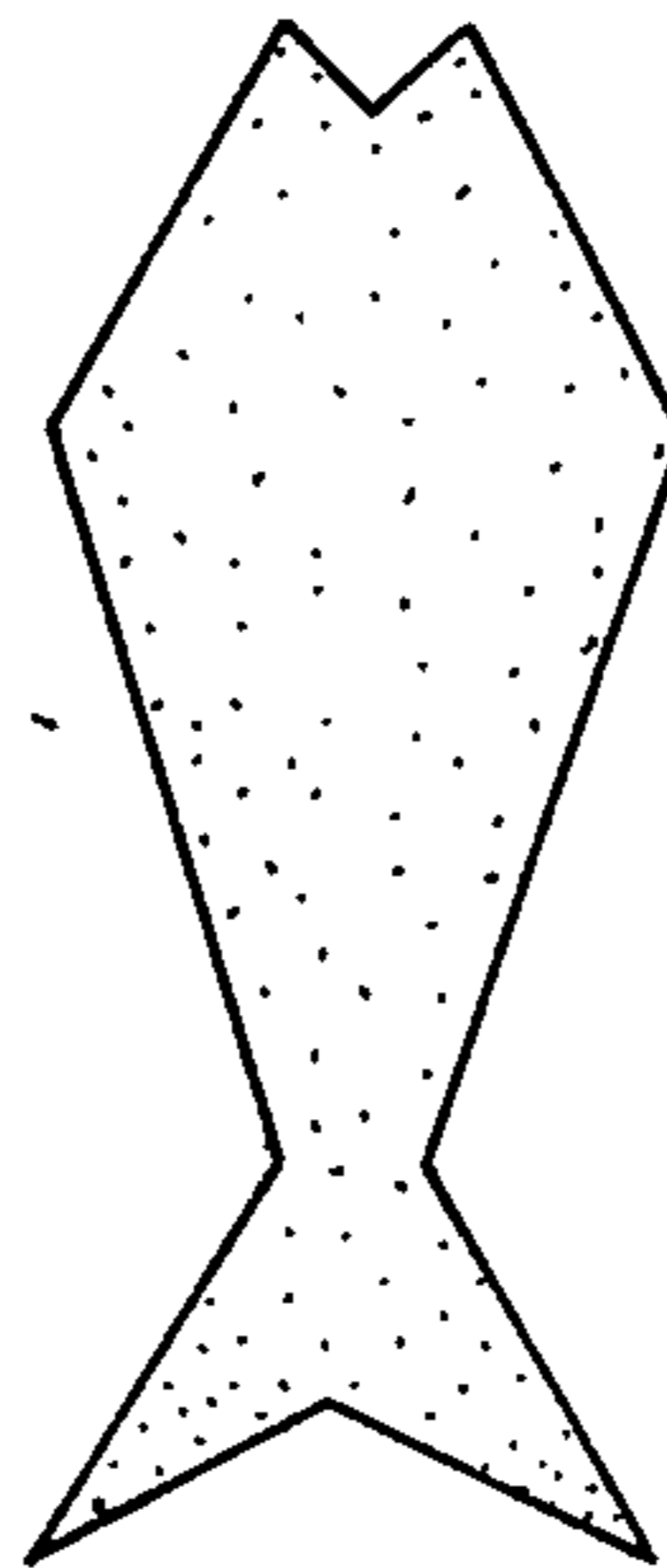
