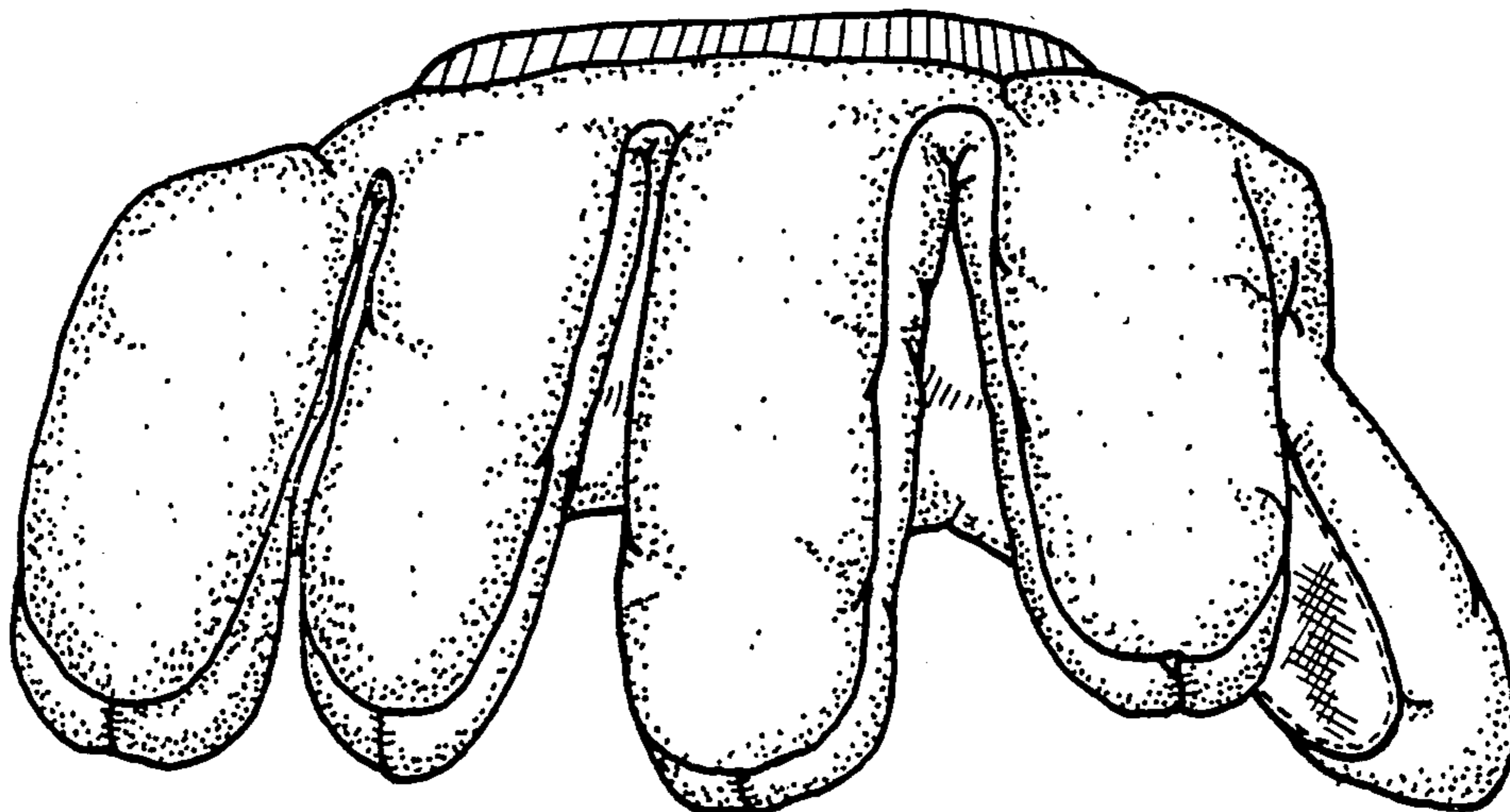
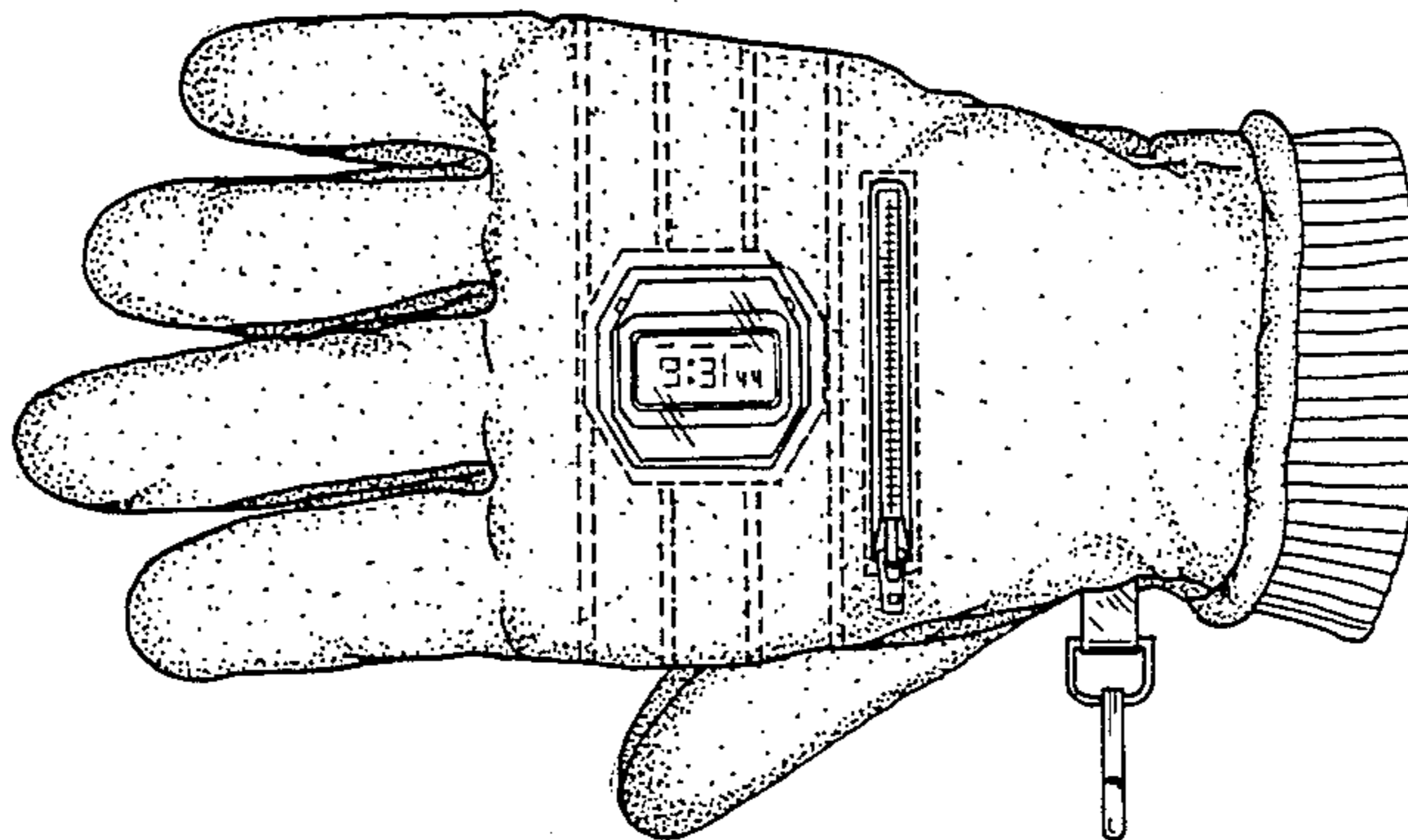
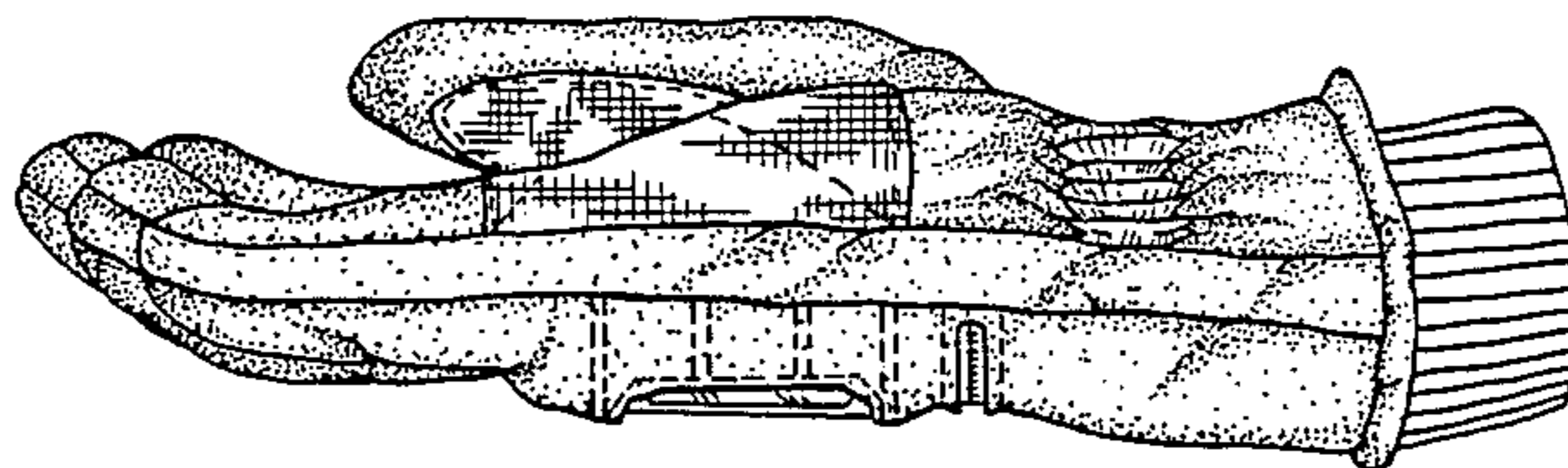

The broken lines in FIGS. 1, 2 and 3 represent conventional stitching.



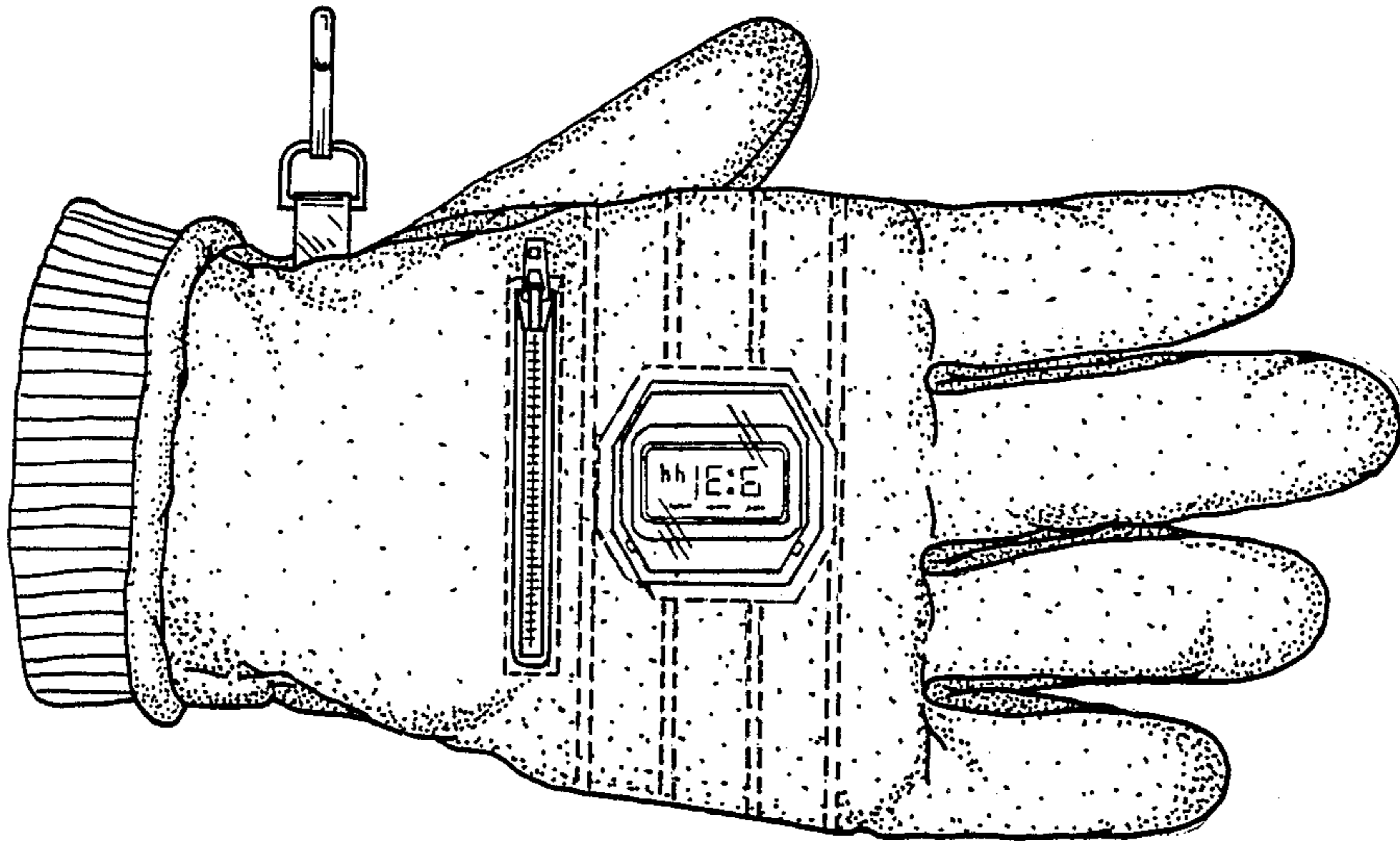

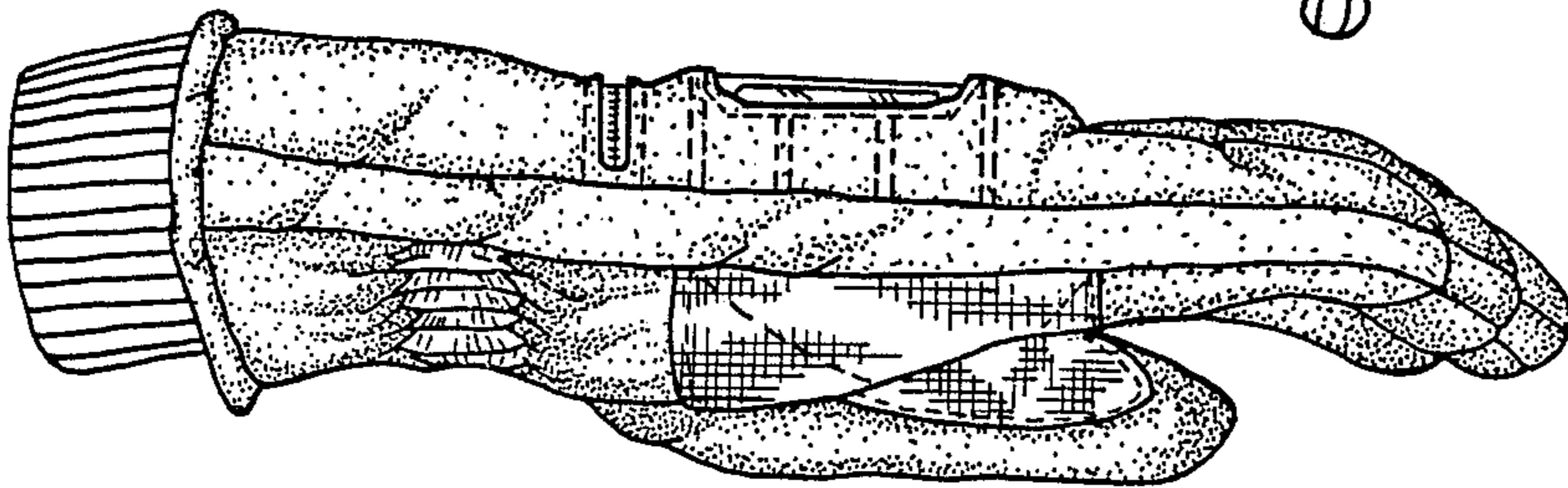

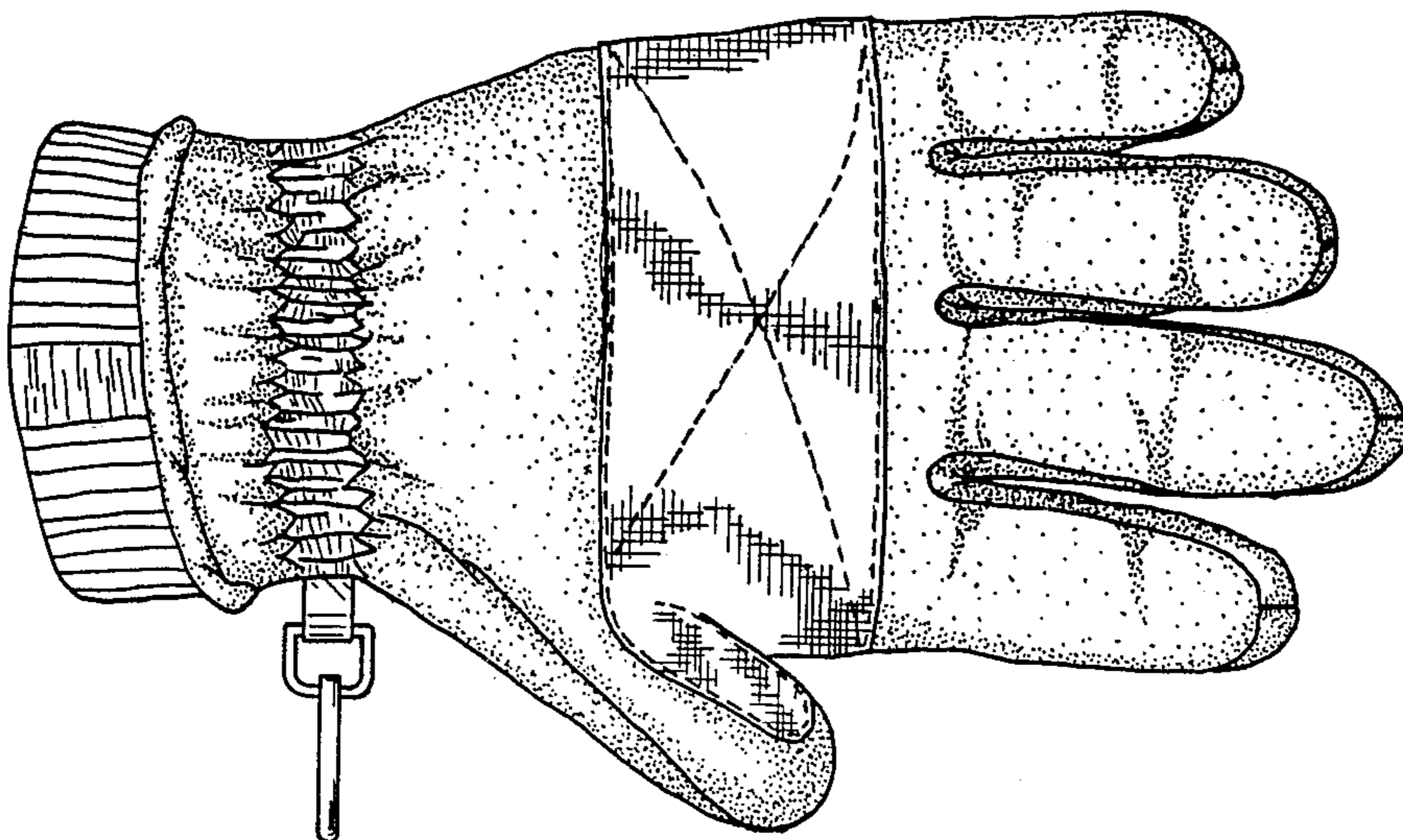

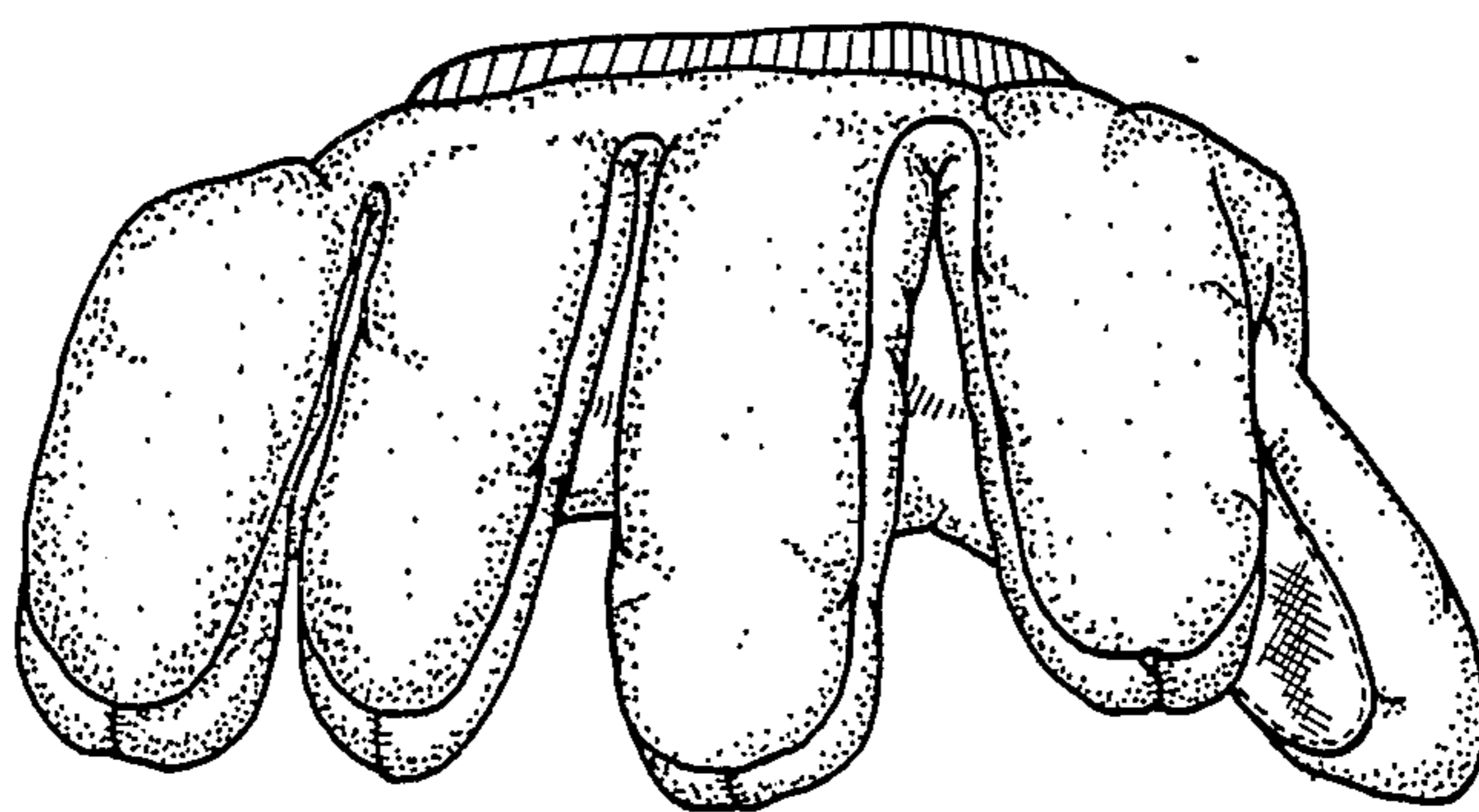

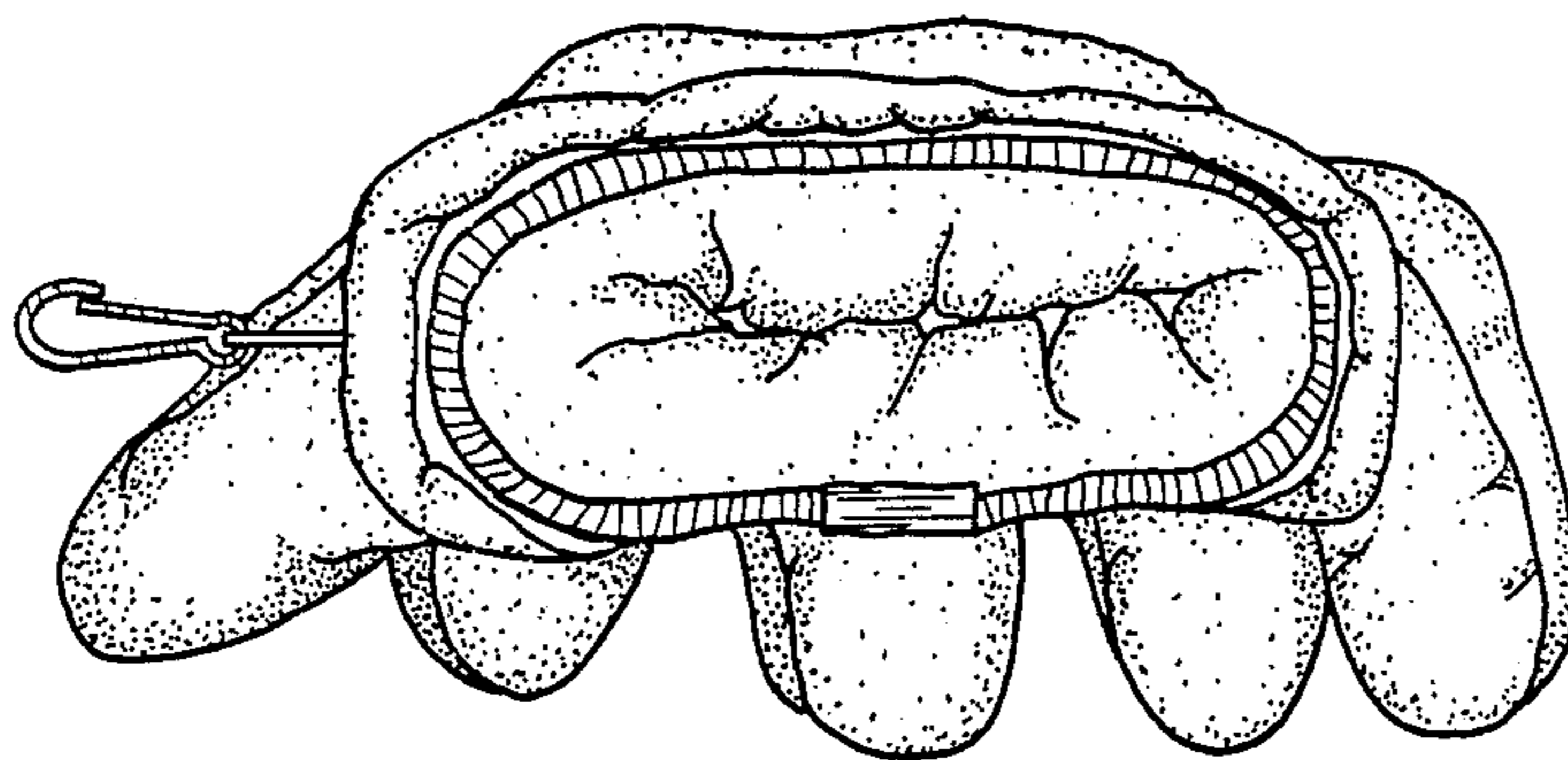
