FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a truck equipped with large screen television receiver, showing my new design;

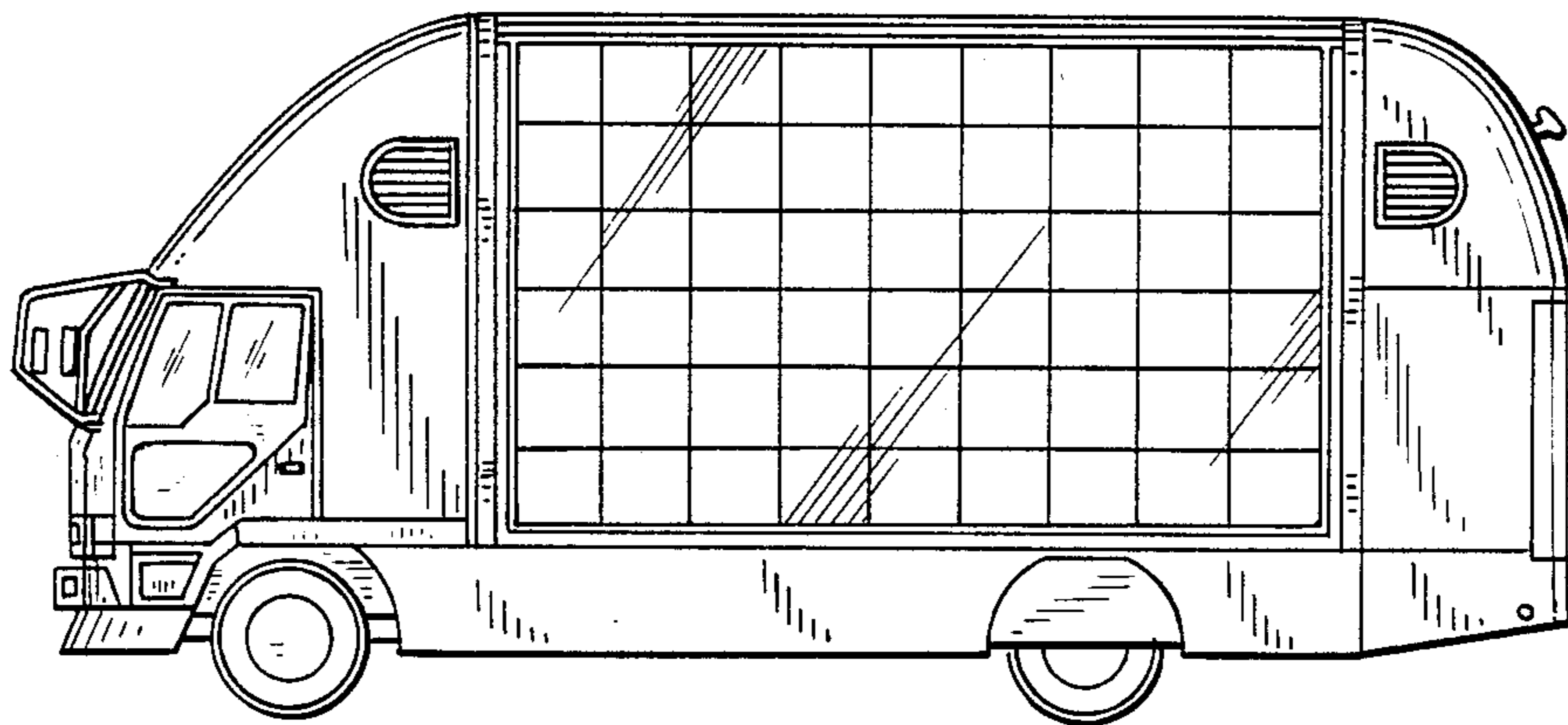
FIG. 2 is a rear elevational view thereof;

FIG. 3 is a right-side elevational view thereof;

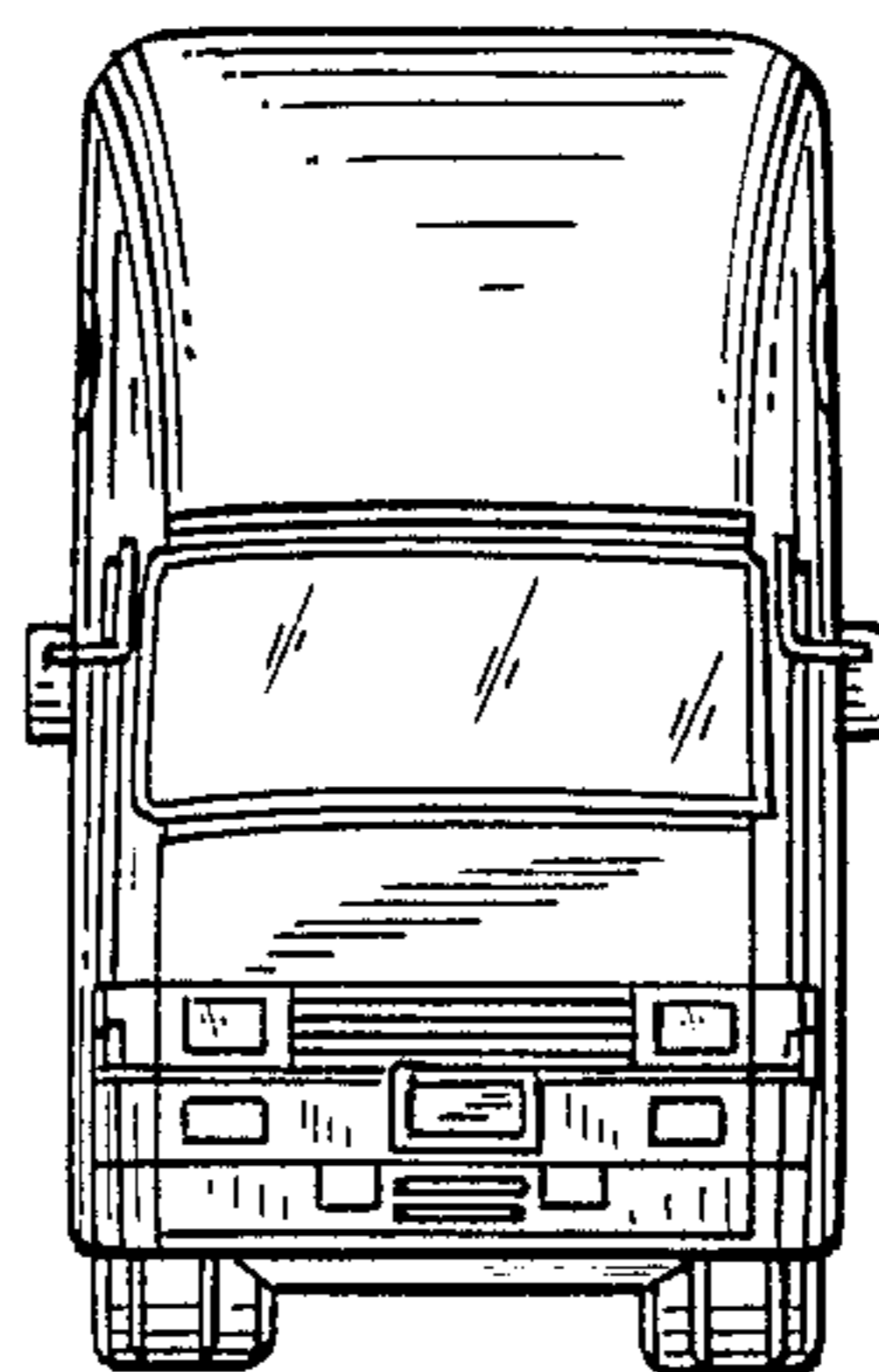
FIG. 4 is a left-side elevational view thereof;

FIG. 5 is a top plan view thereof; and

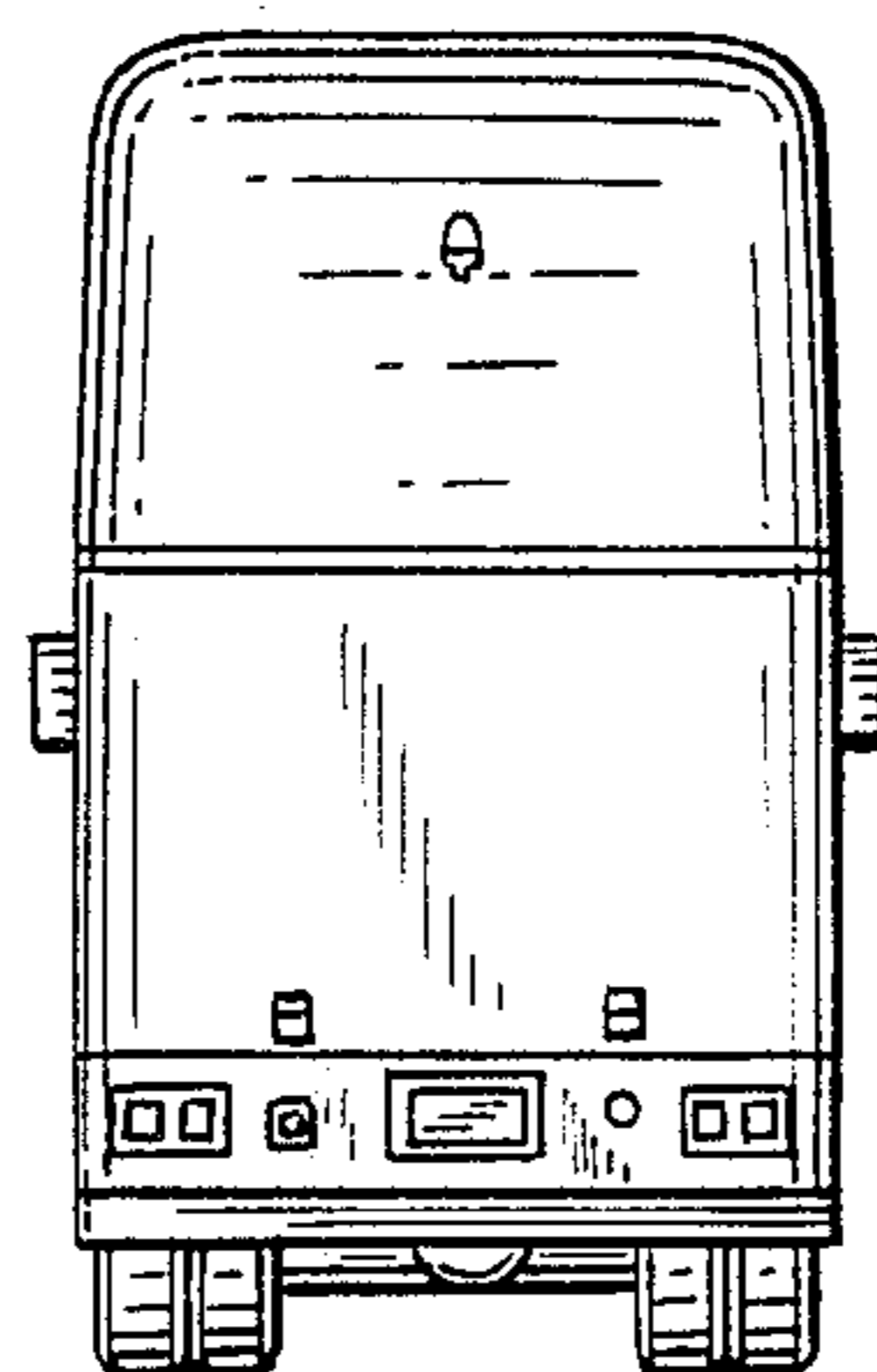
FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view thereof.

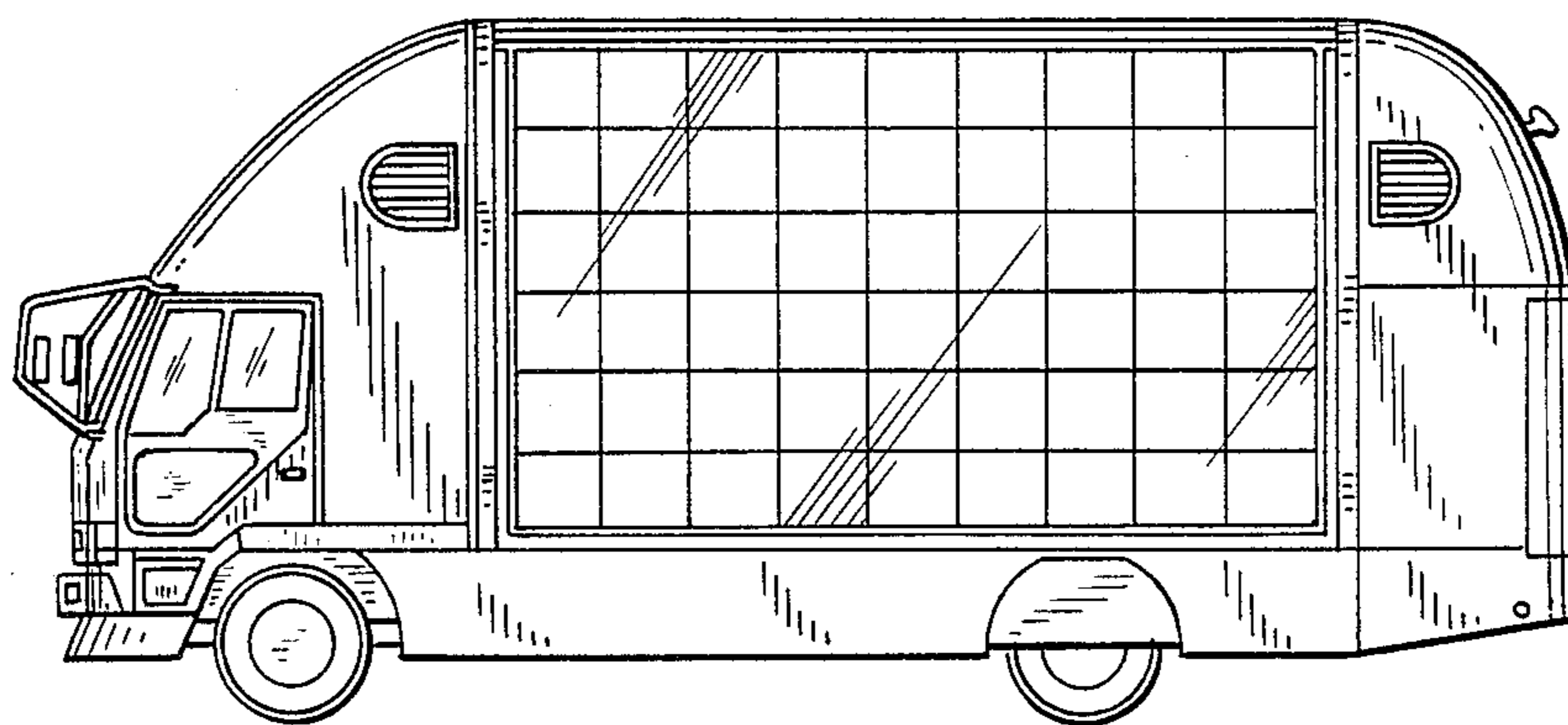

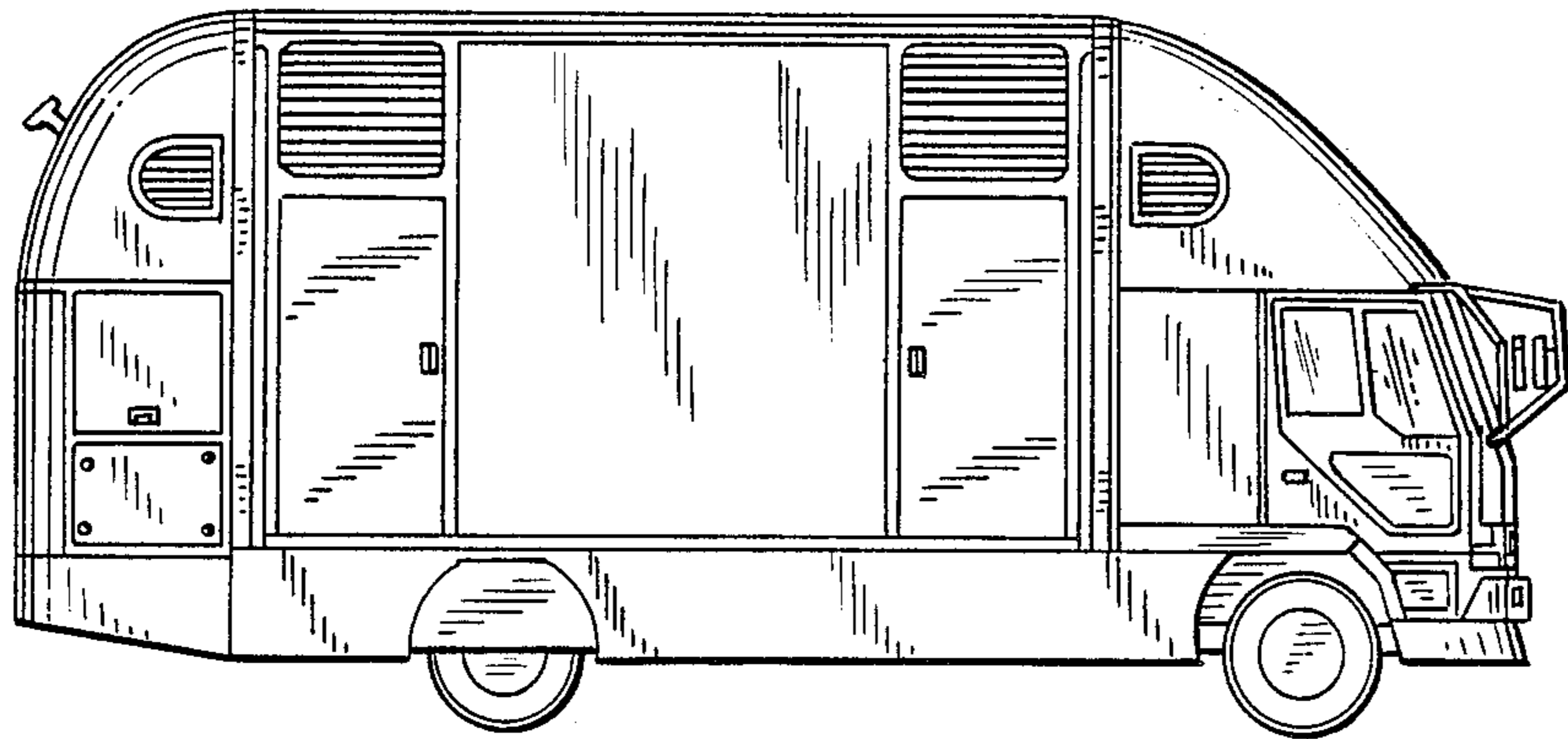

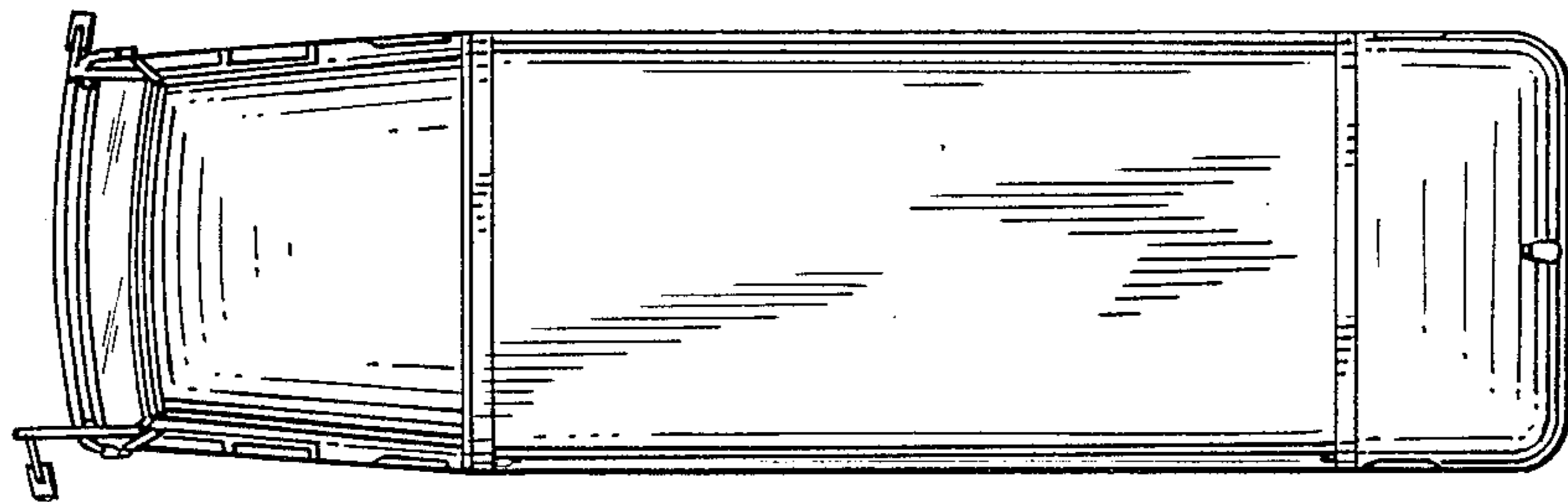
