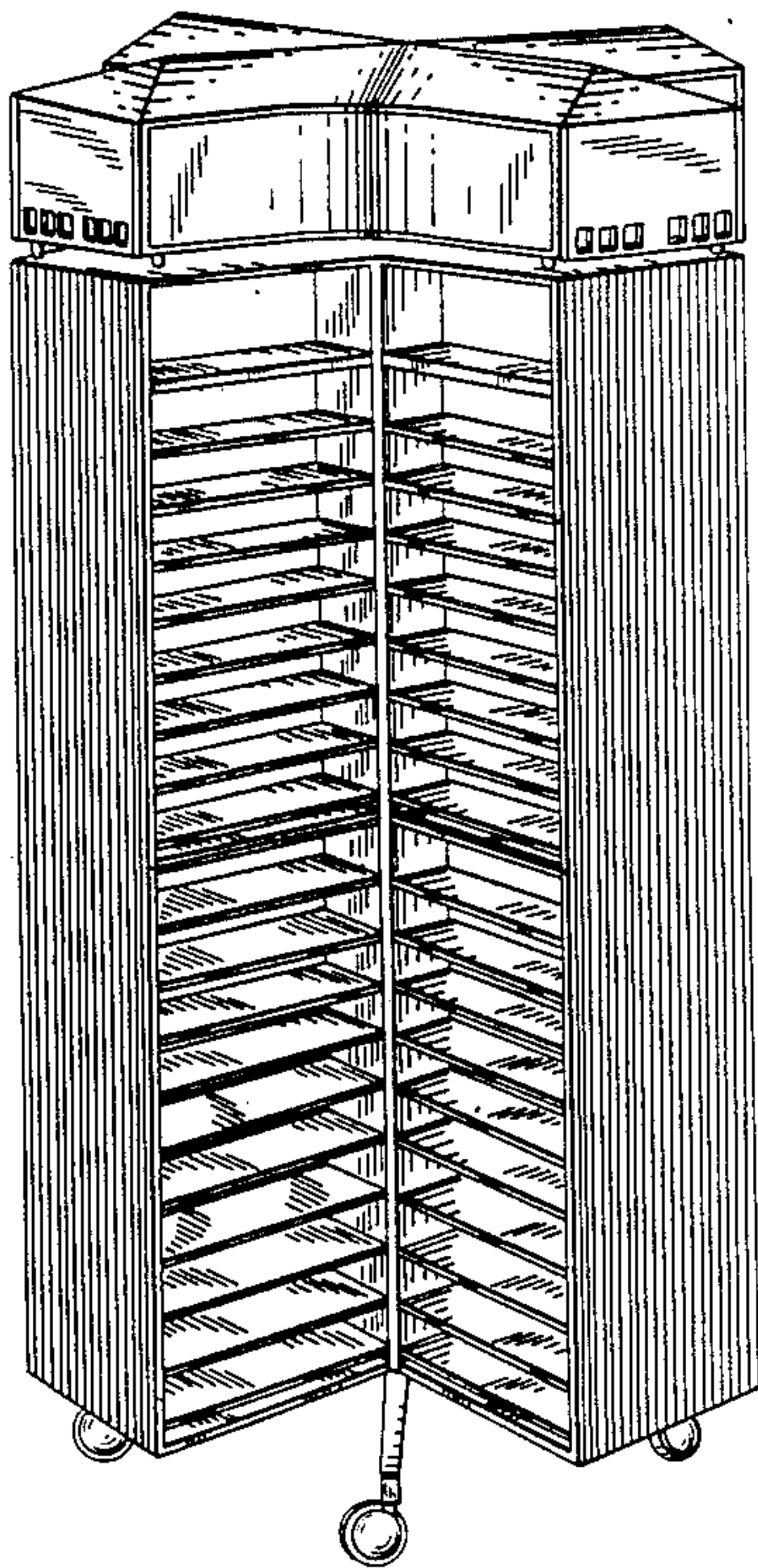

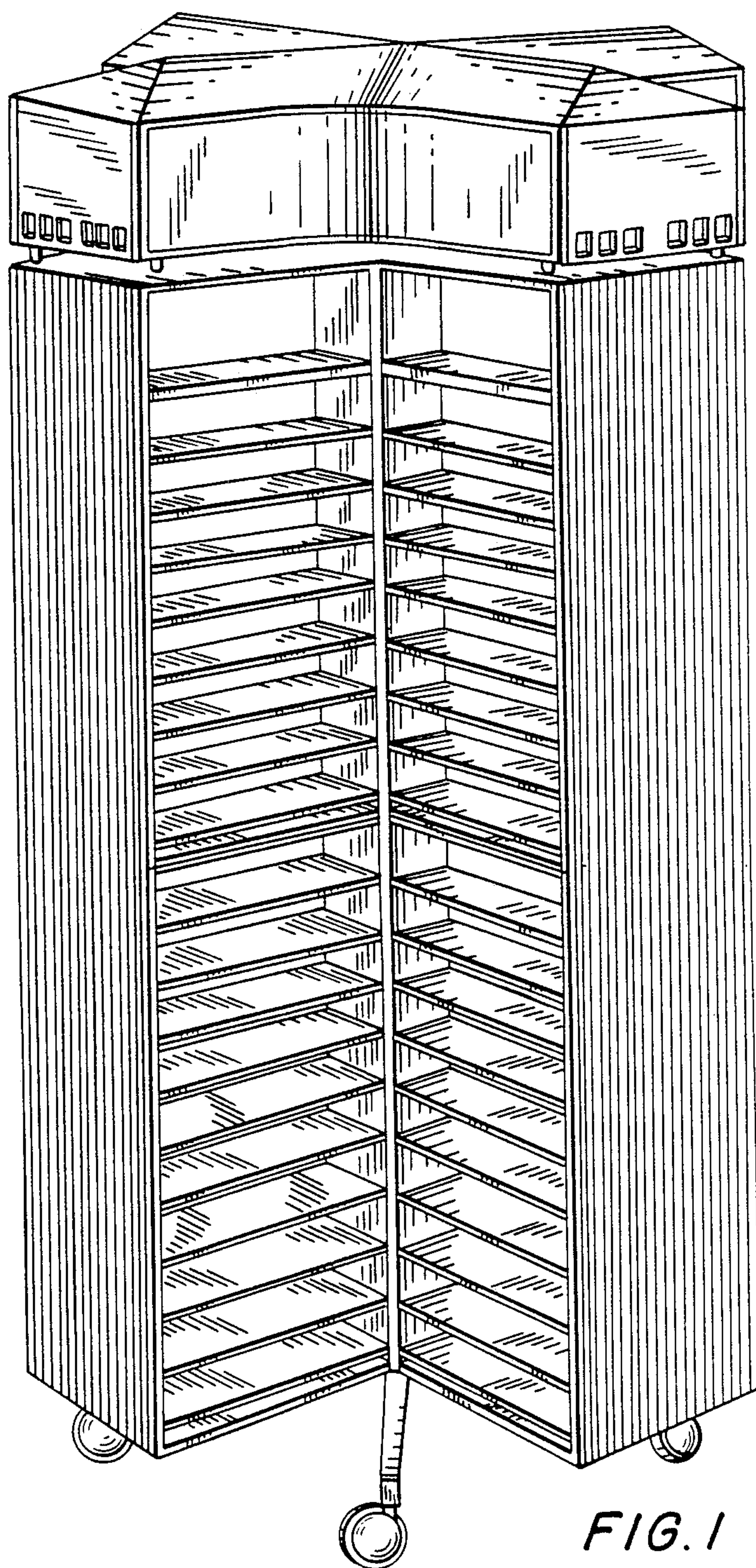
[57] **CLAIM**

FIG. 3 is a bottom plan view thereof.





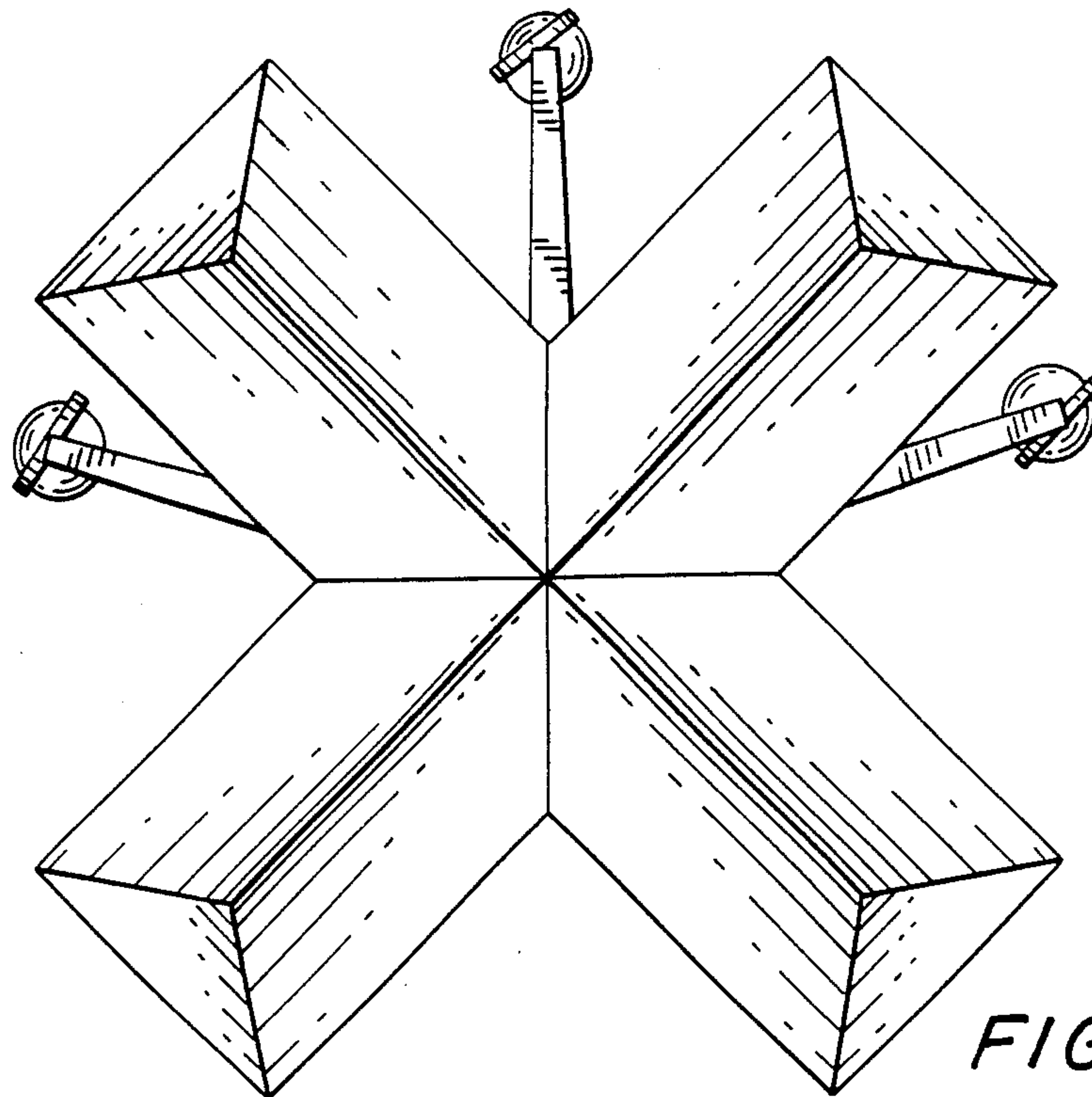

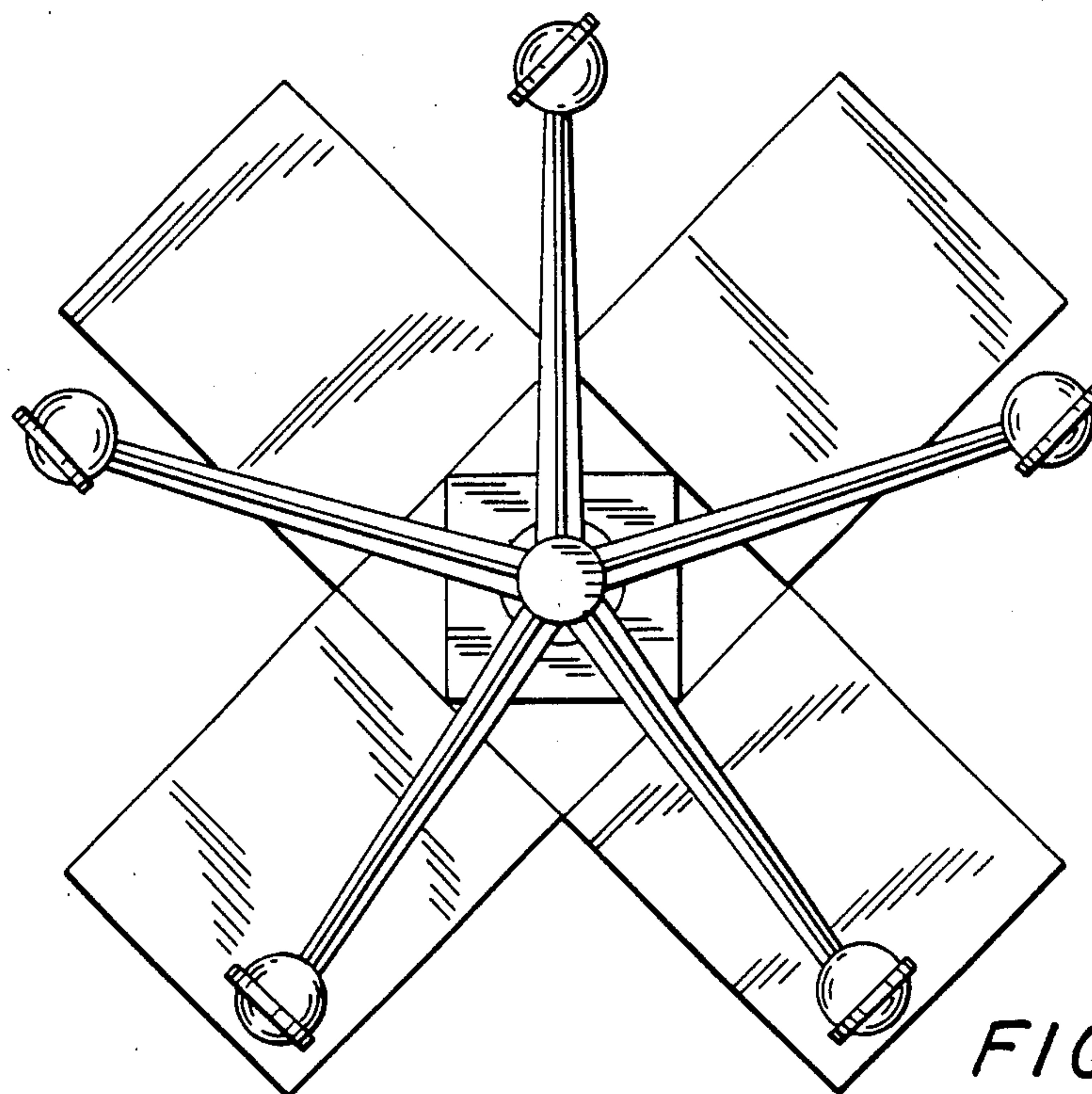
