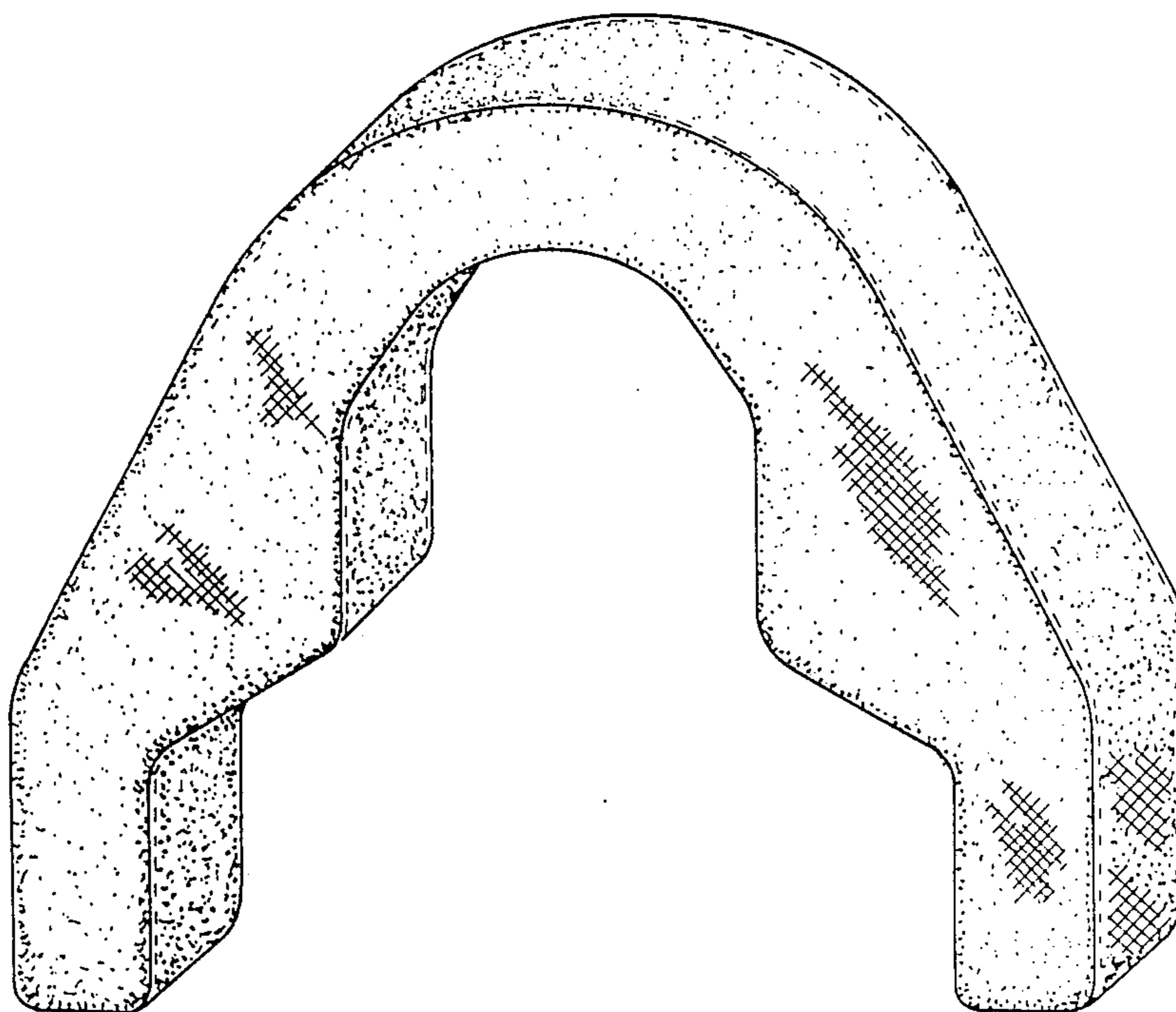

[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for an infant head support for use with infant retaining devices, as shown.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of an infant head support showing my new design;
 FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof, the rear view being identical;
 FIG. 3 is a top plan view thereof;
 FIG. 4 is an end elevational view thereof, the opposite end being identical; and
 FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view thereof.
 The cross hatch pattern shown in FIGS. 1, 2, 4 and 5 is understood to repeat throughout the indicated area.



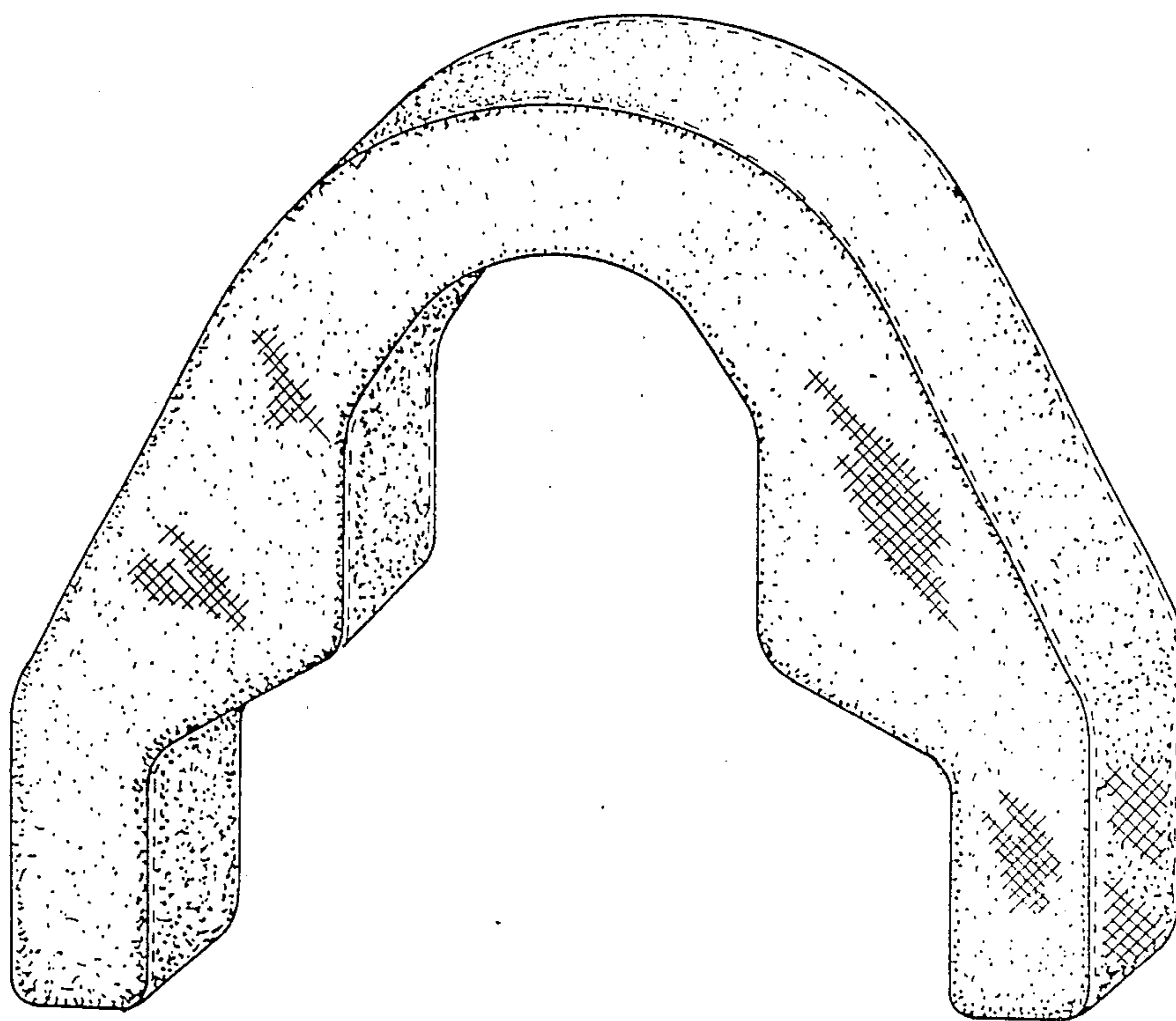

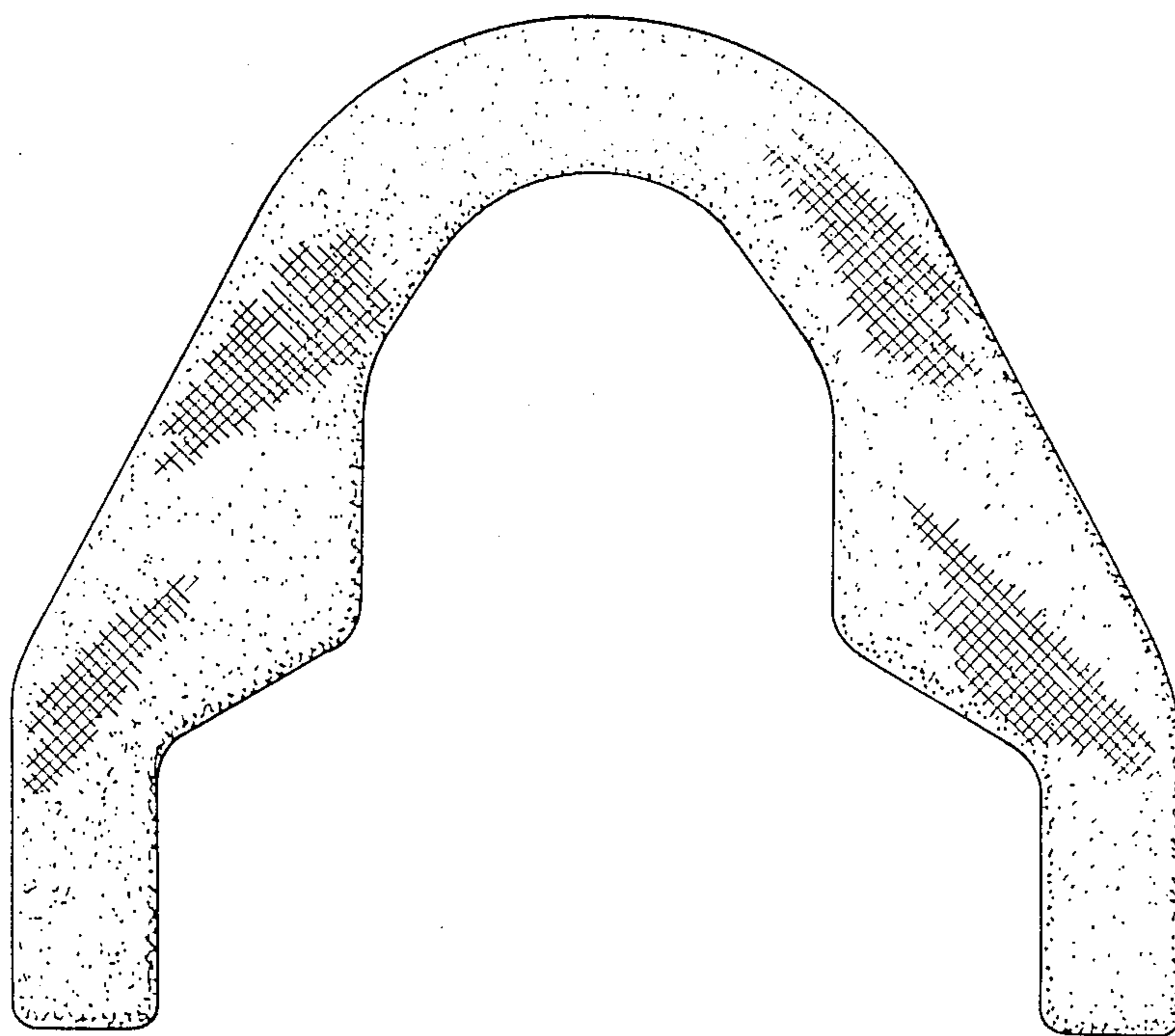

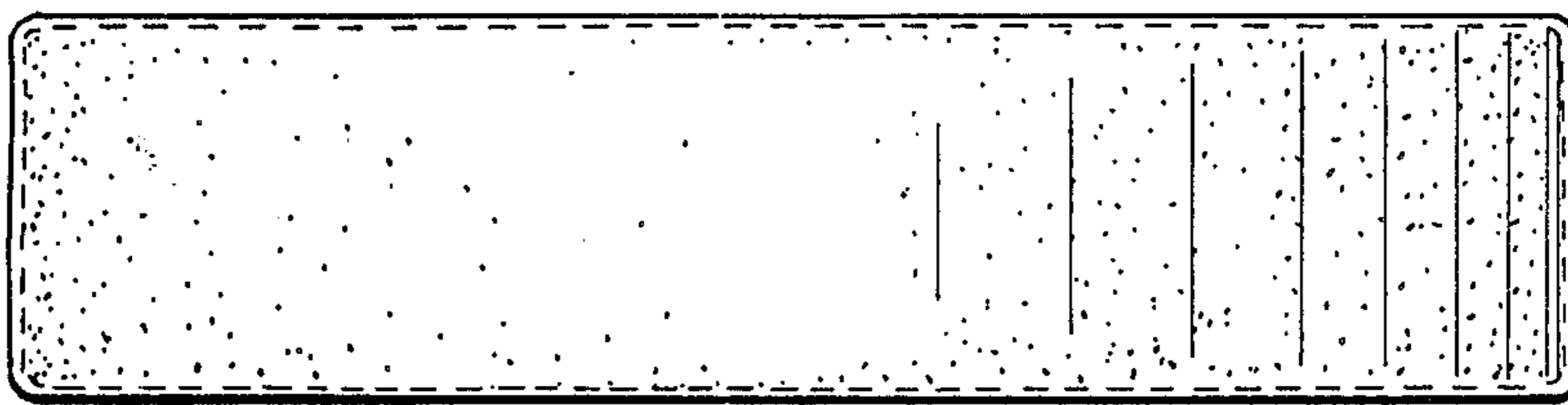

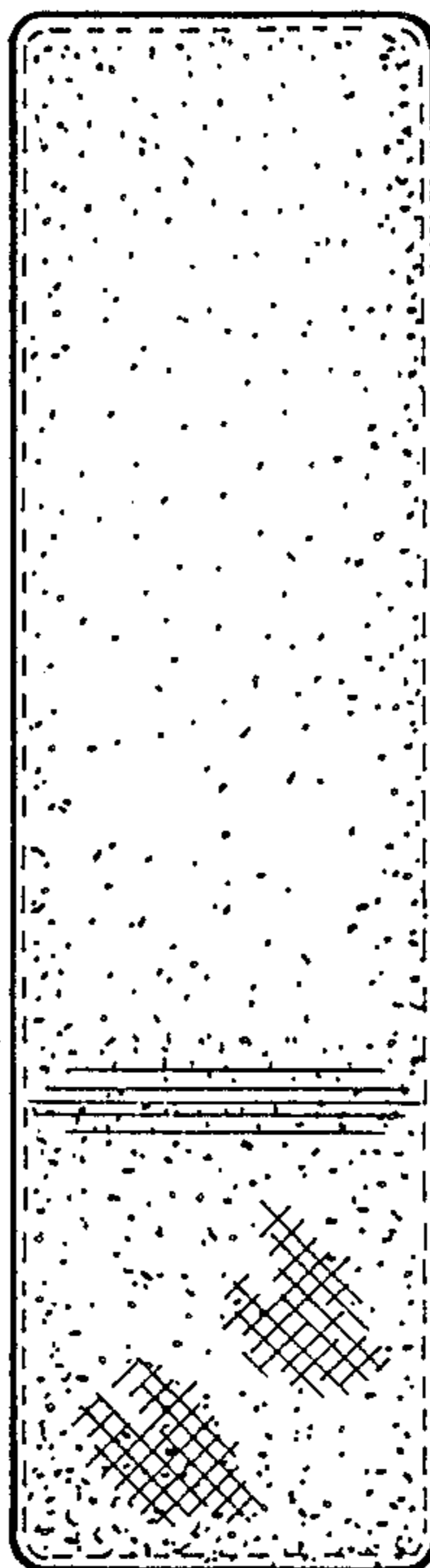

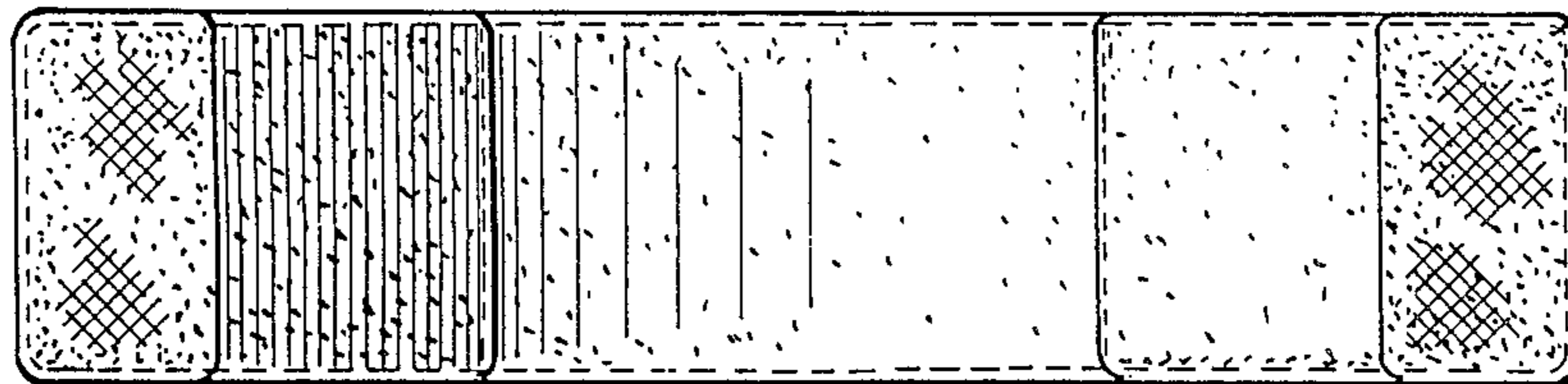
