The ornamental design for a beach blanket, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a side elevational view of the beach blanket showing my new design;
 FIG. 2 is another side elevational view;
 FIG. 3 is a top plan view;
 FIG. 4 is the side elevational view opposite that shown in FIG. 2;
 FIG. 5 is the side elevational view opposite that shown in FIG. 1; and
 FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view thereof;
 FIG. 7 is a side elevational view of a second embodiment of the beach blanket showing my new design;
 FIG. 8 is another side elevational view;
 FIG. 9 is a top plan view;
 FIG. 10 is the side elevational view opposite that shown in FIG. 8;
 FIG. 11 is the side elevational view opposite that shown in FIG. 7; and
 FIG. 12 is a bottom plan view thereof;
 FIG. 13 is a perspective view of the first embodiment; and
 FIG. 14 is a perspective view of the second embodiment.

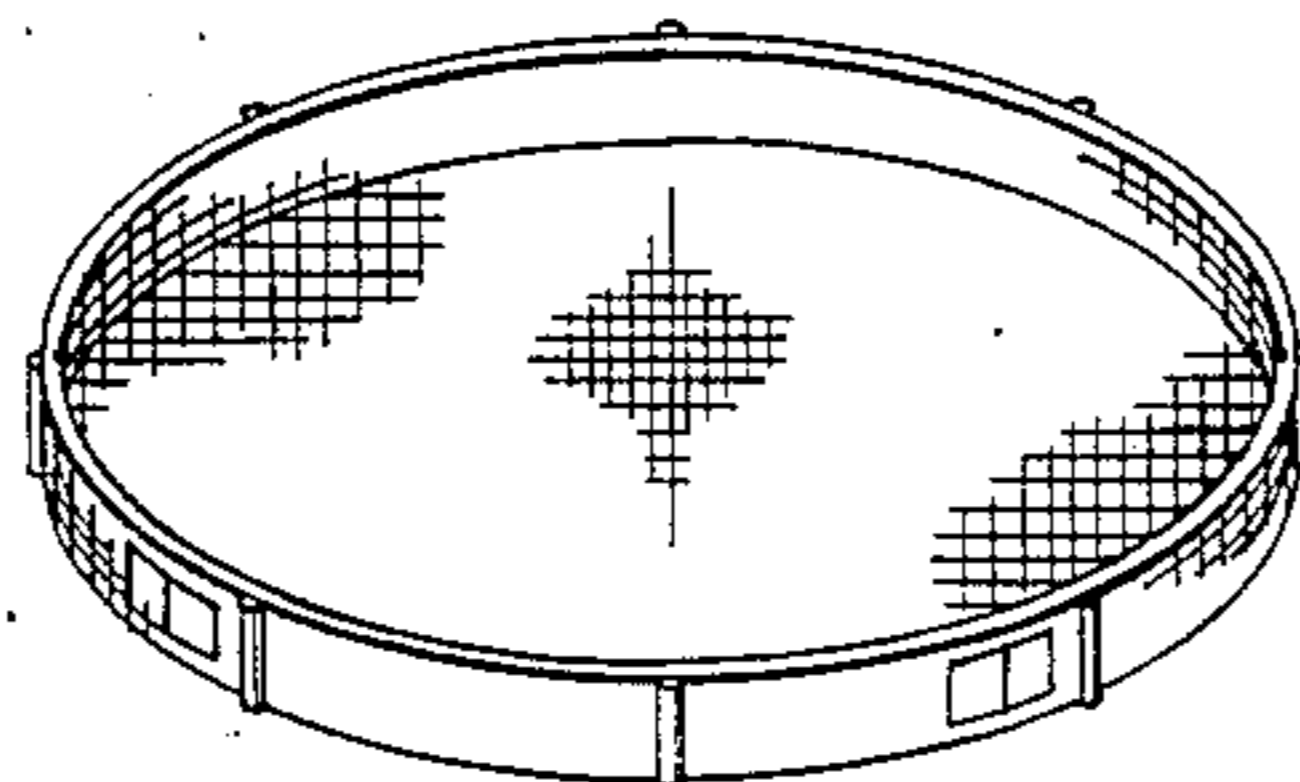
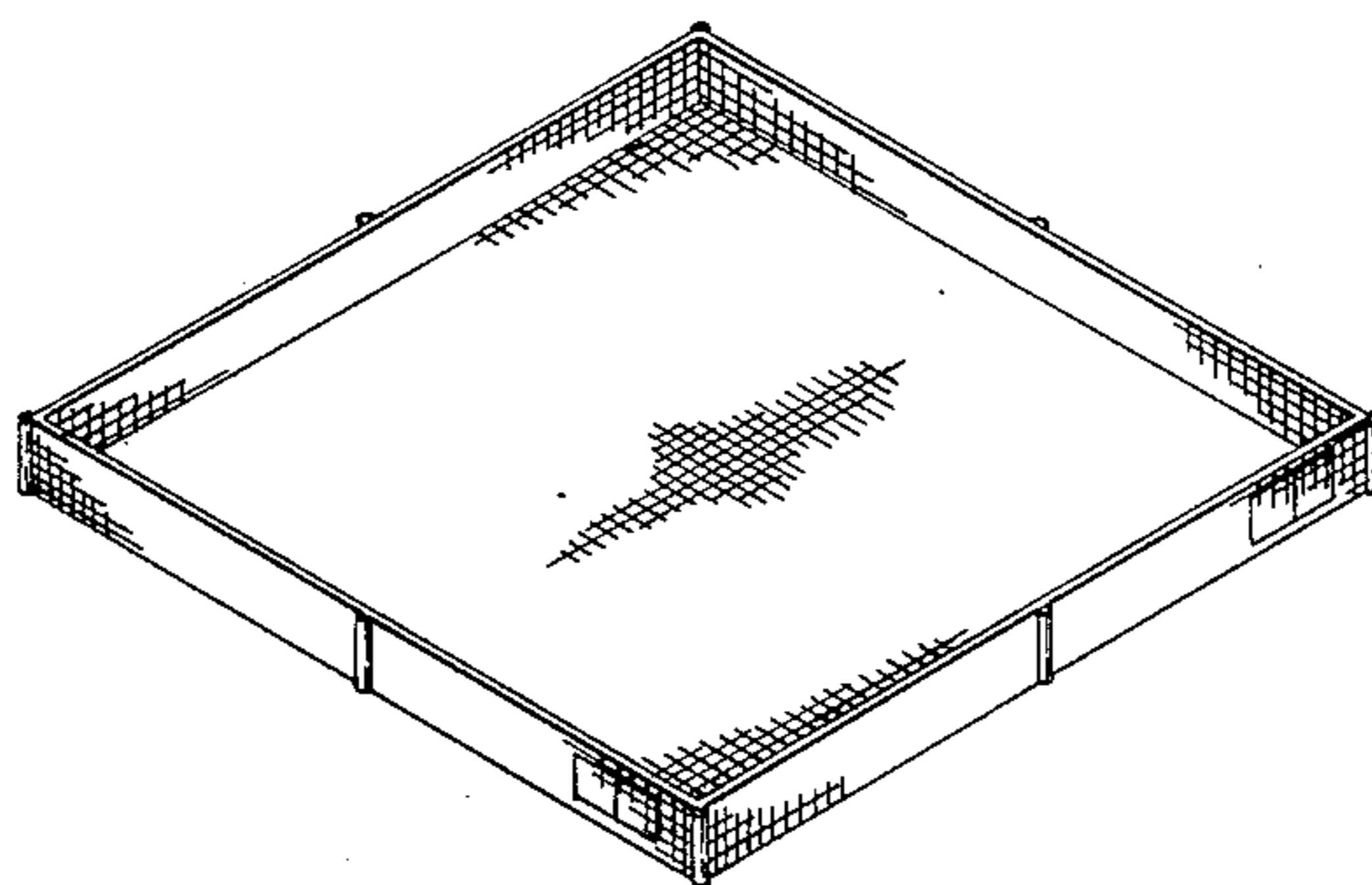

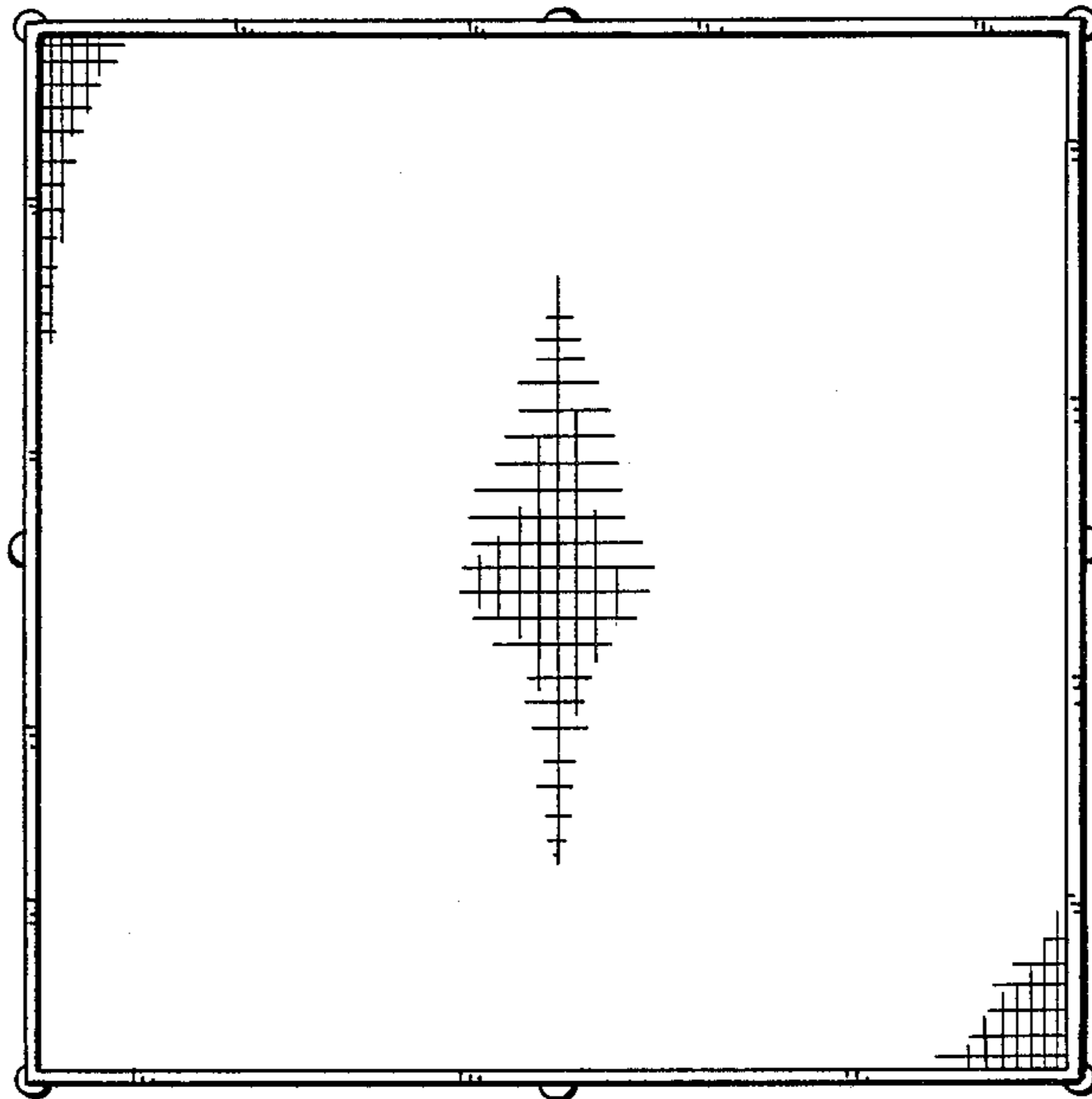

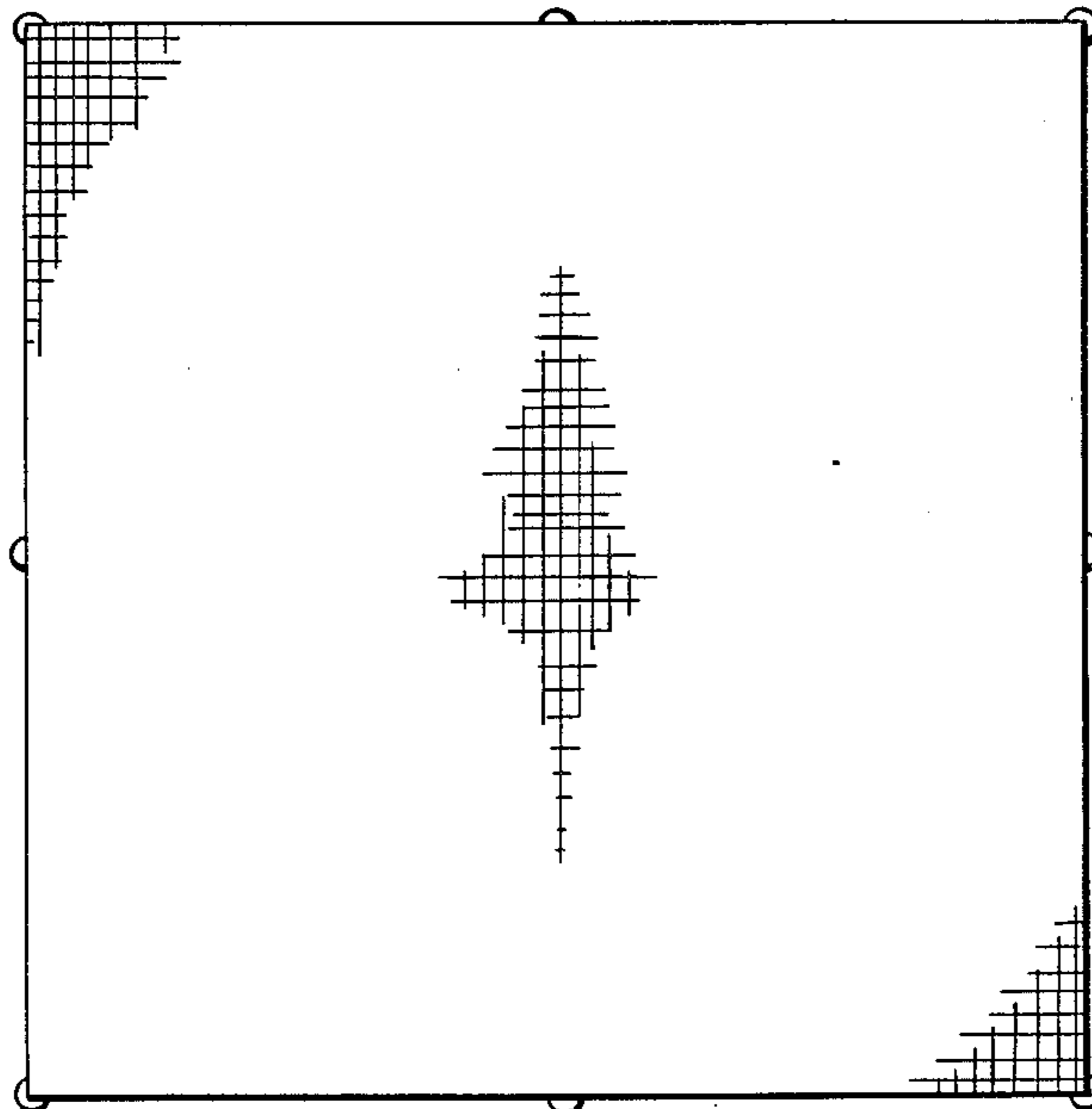

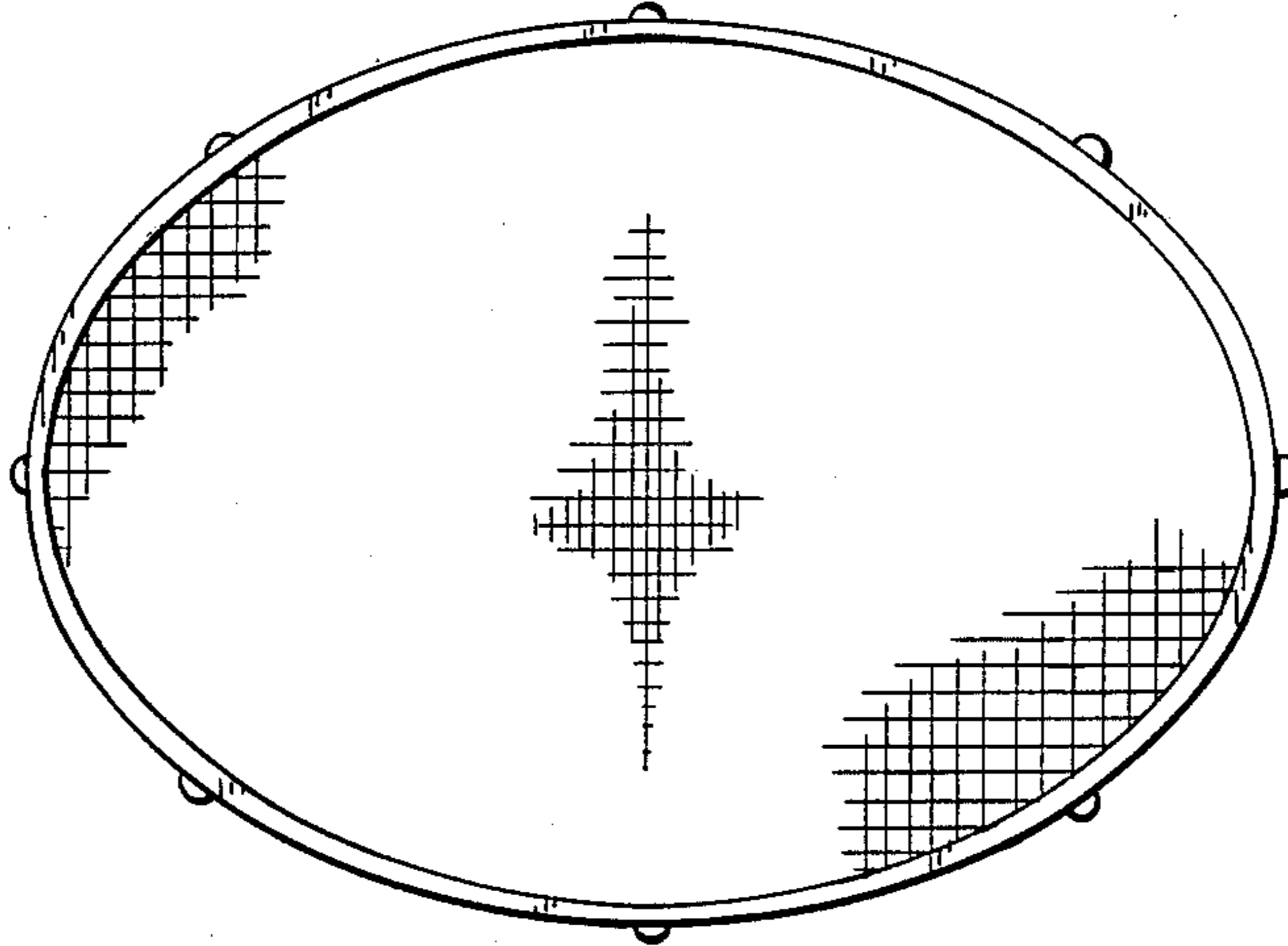

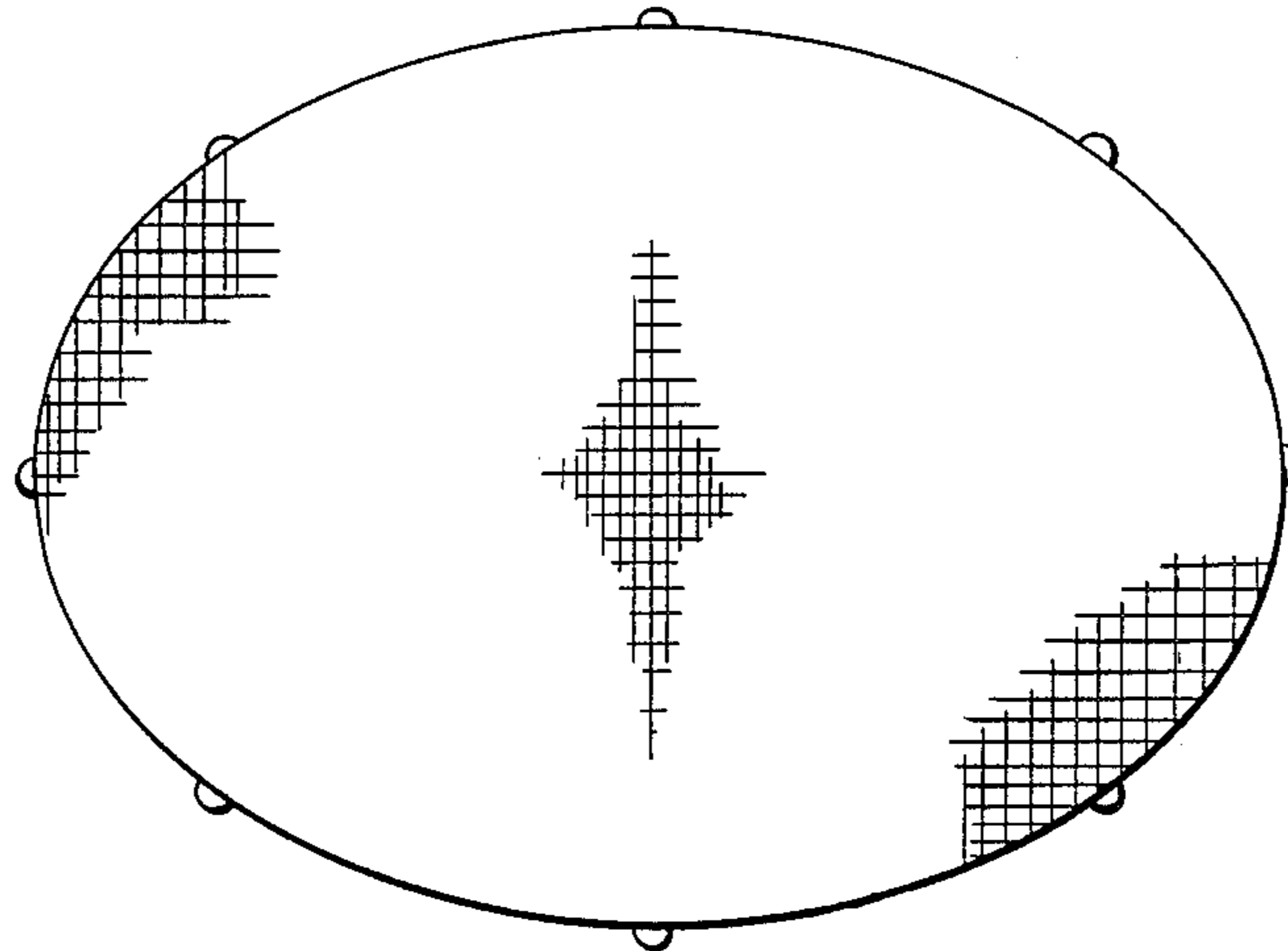

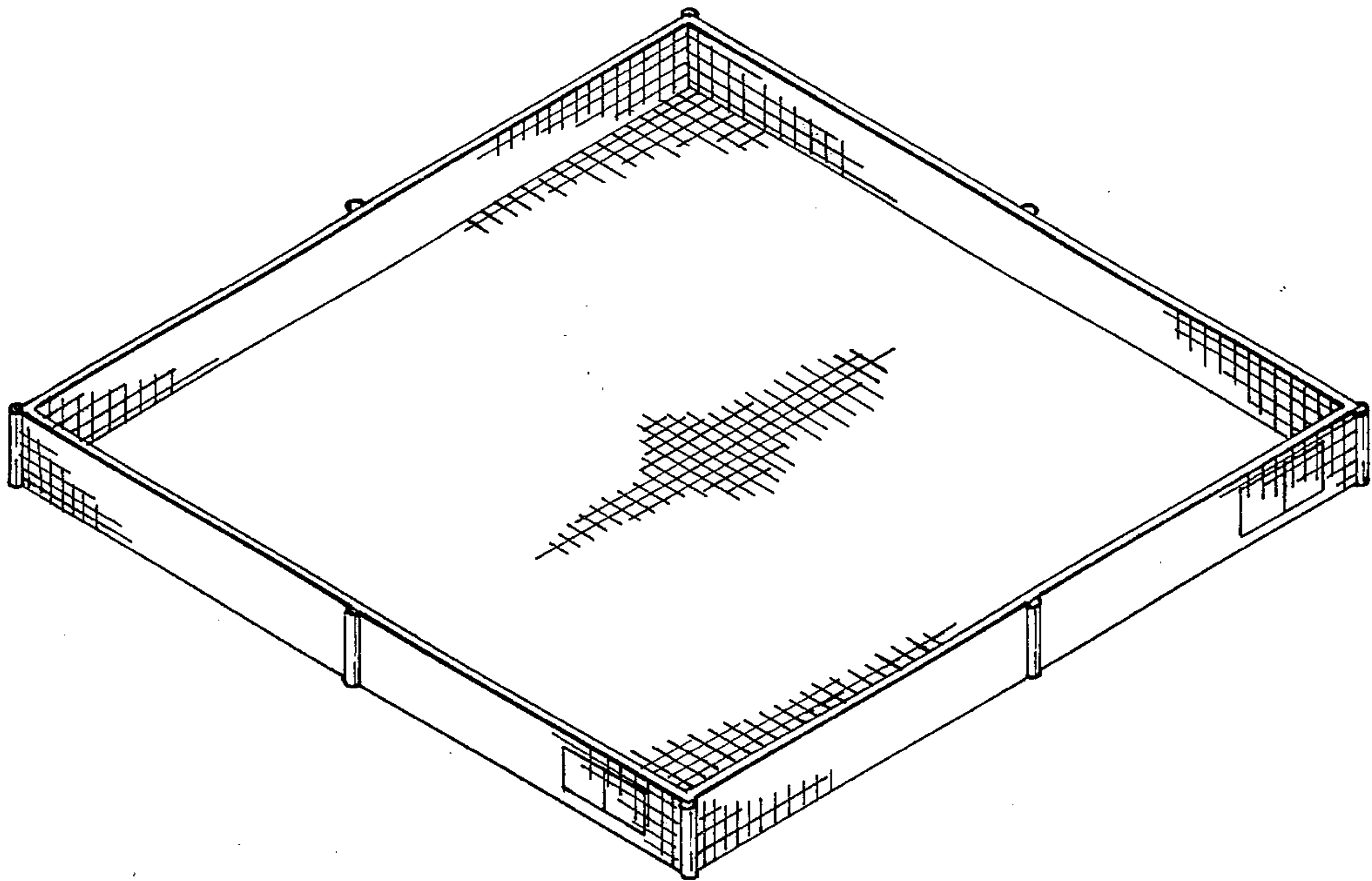

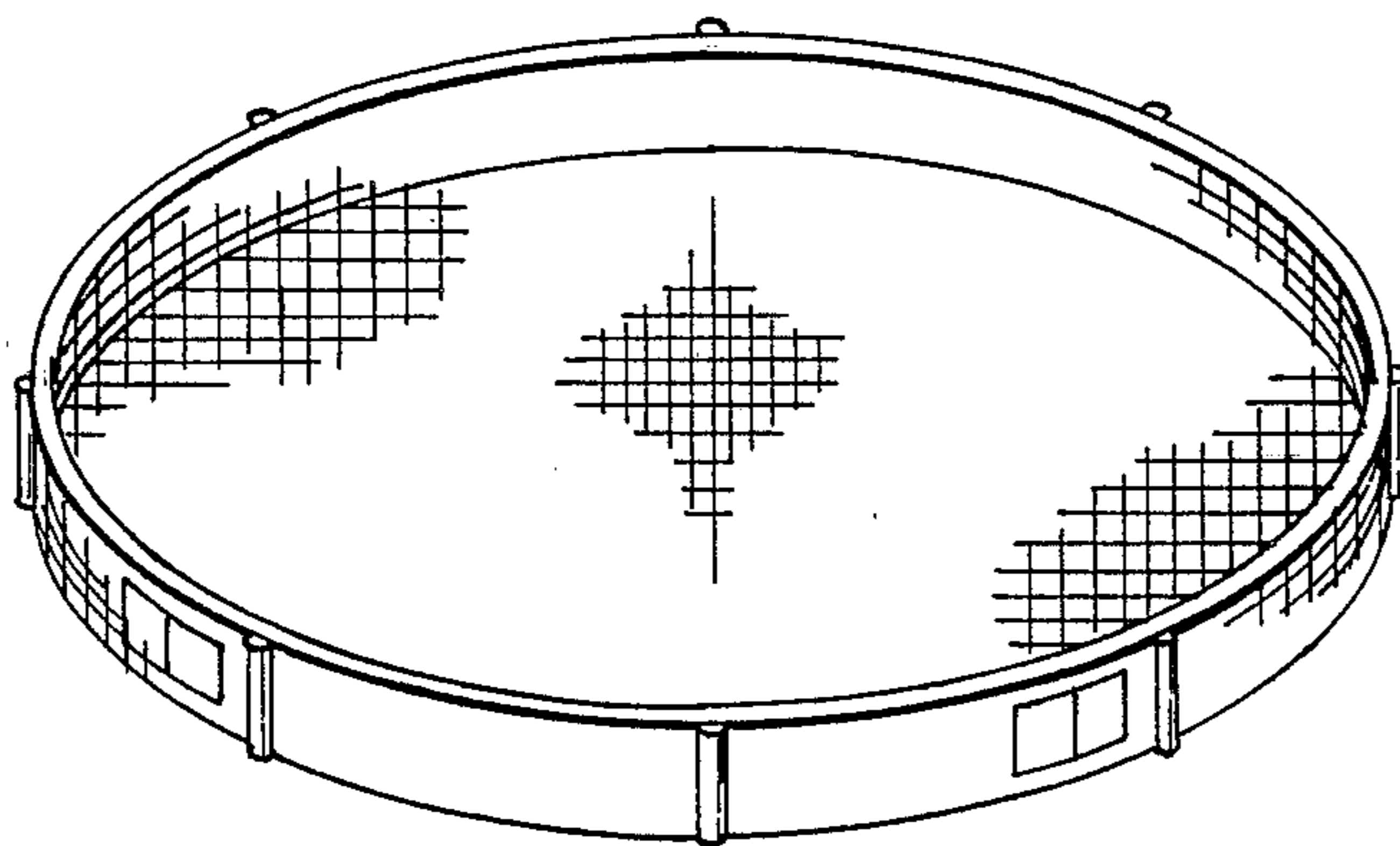
