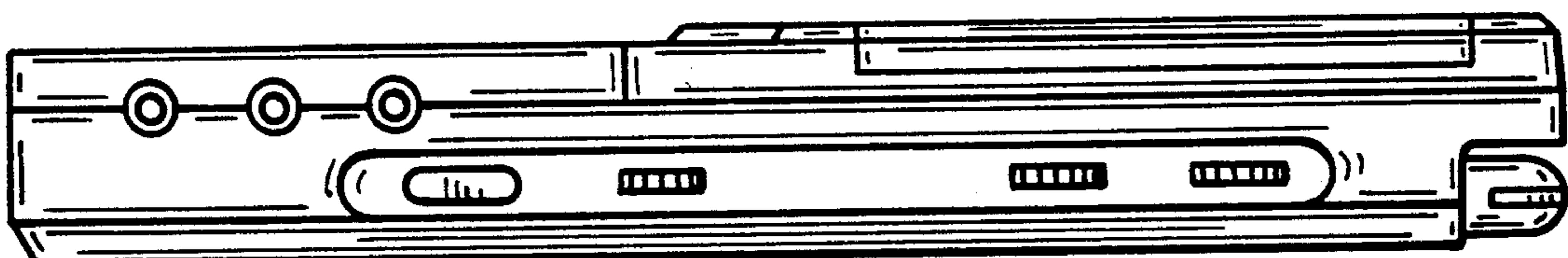
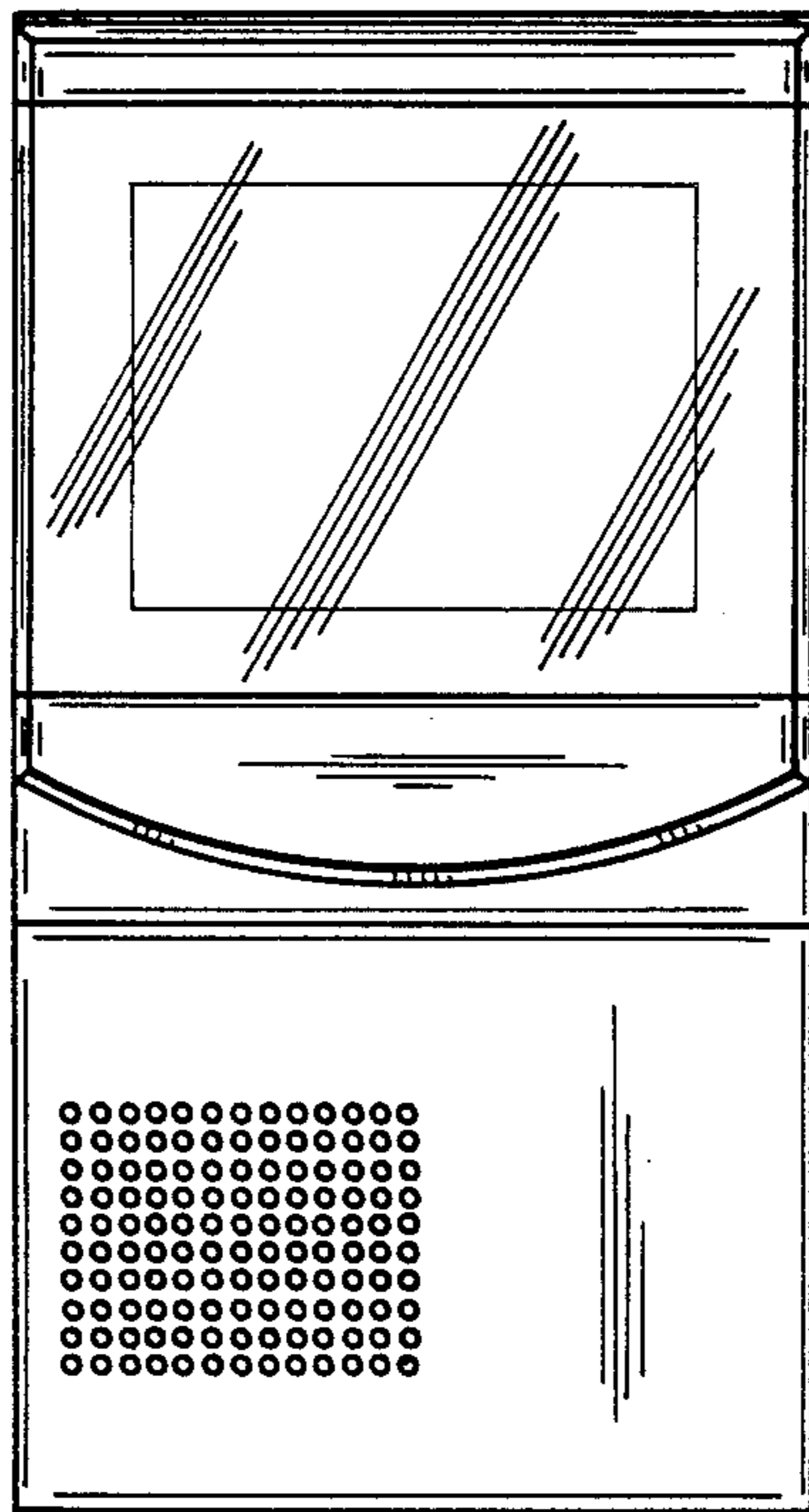

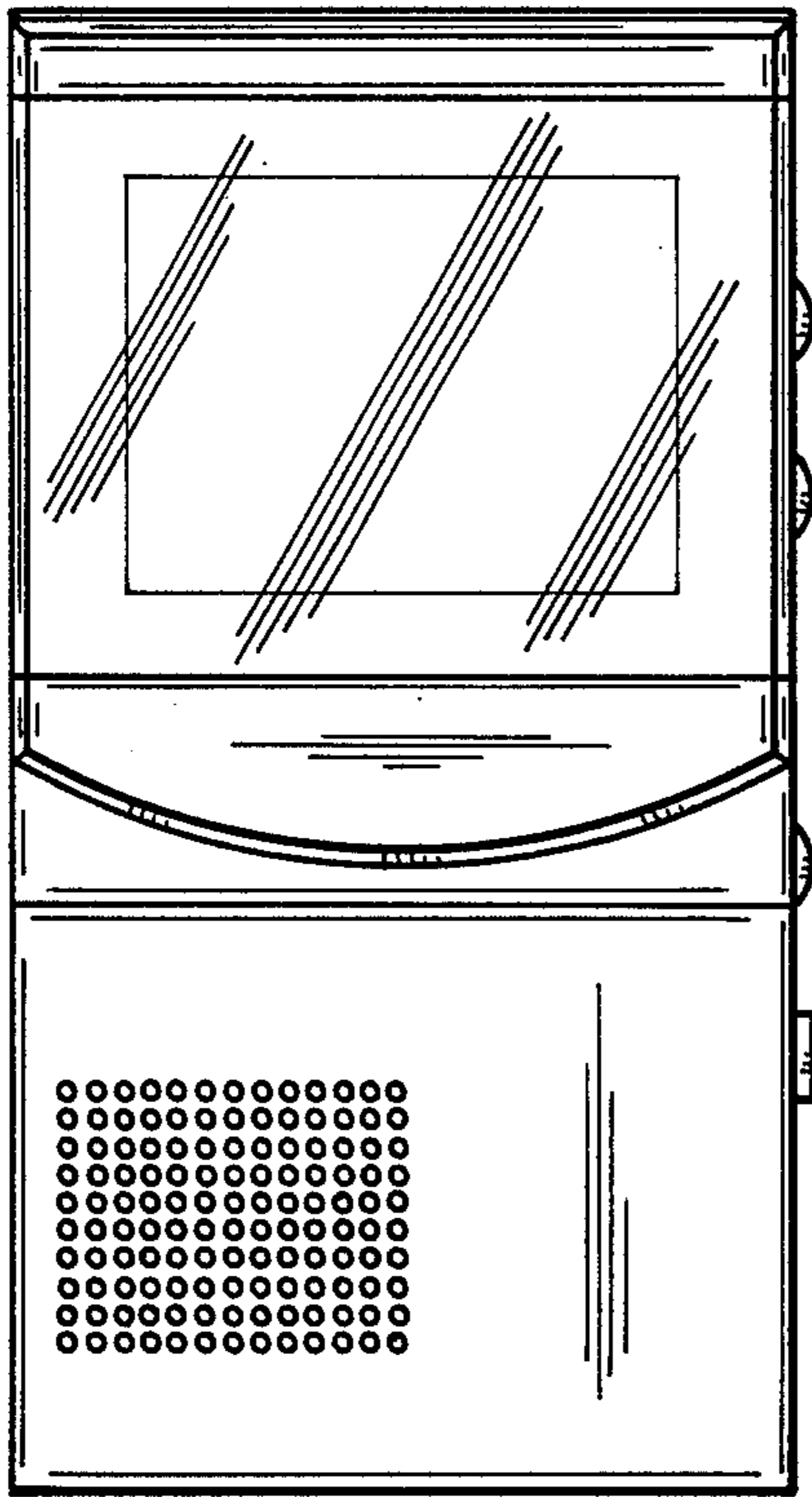
[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a television set, as shown and described.

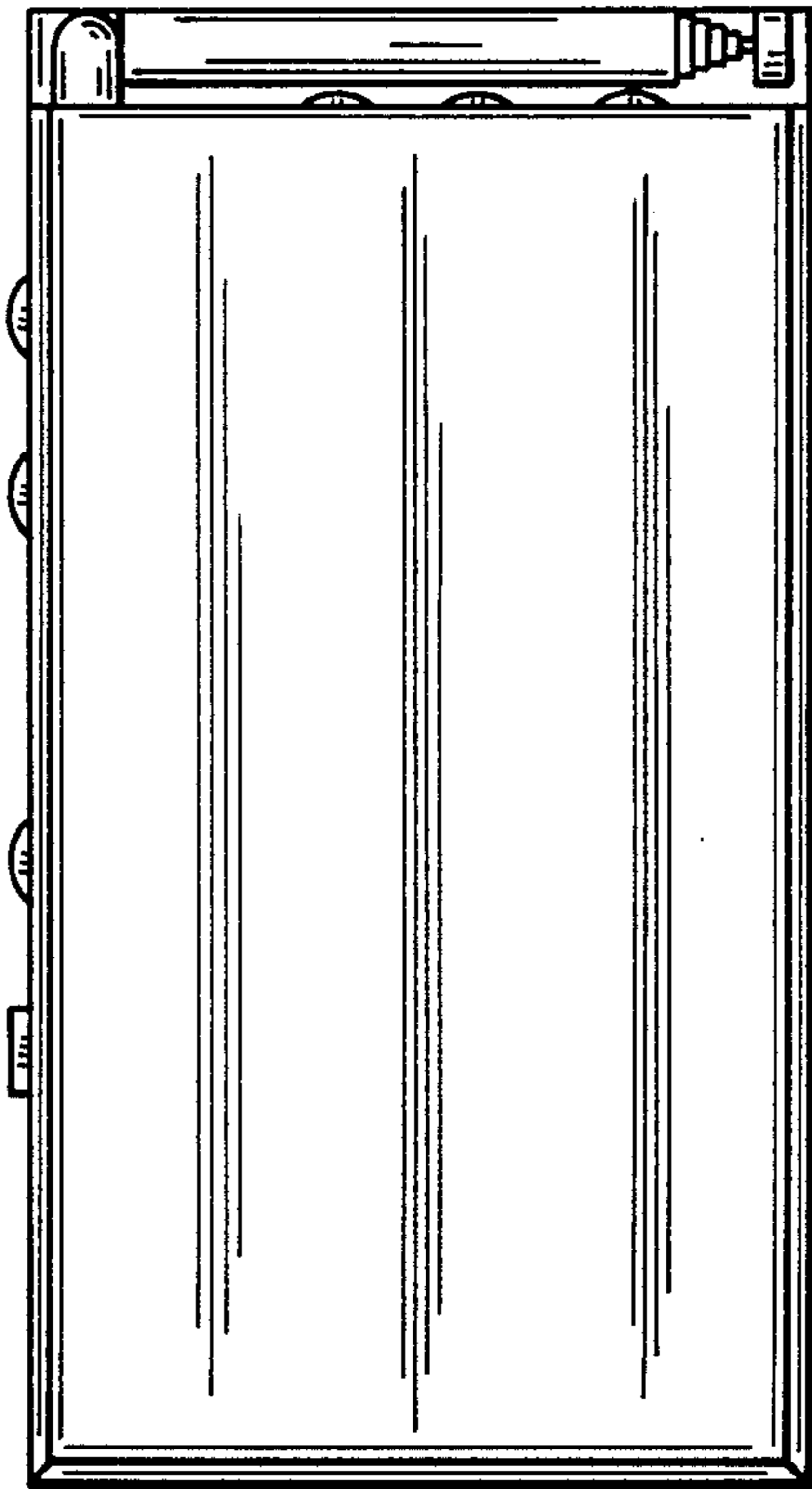
DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a television set showing our new design;
FIG. 2 is a rear elevational view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a top plan view thereof;
FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view thereof;
FIG. 5 is a right side elevational view thereof rotated 90 degrees from FIG. 1; and
FIG. 6 is a left side elevational view thereof rotated 90 degrees from FIG. 1.

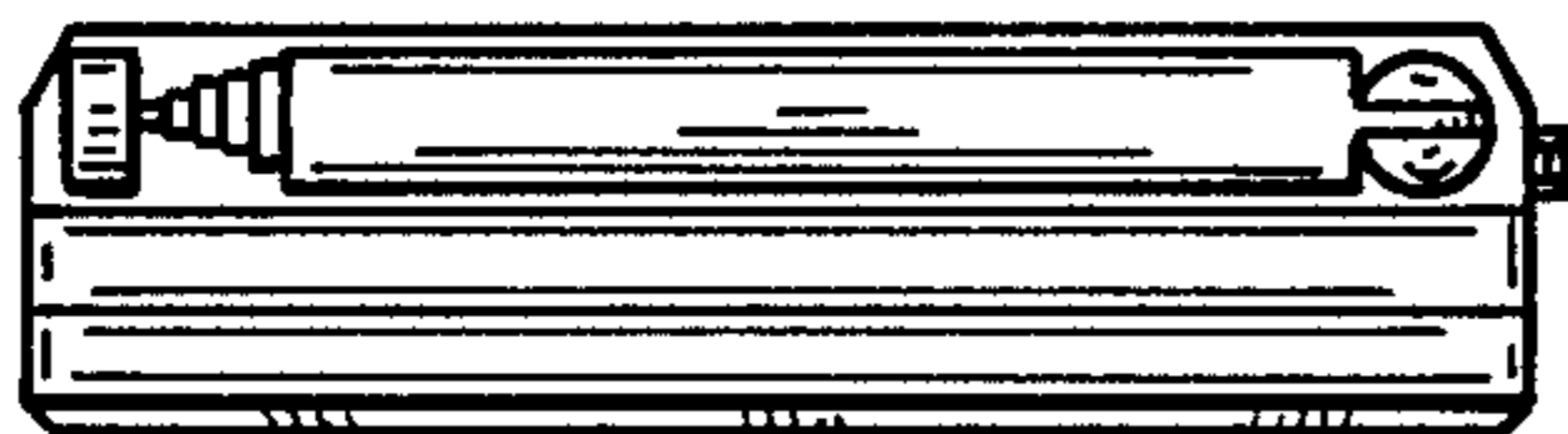




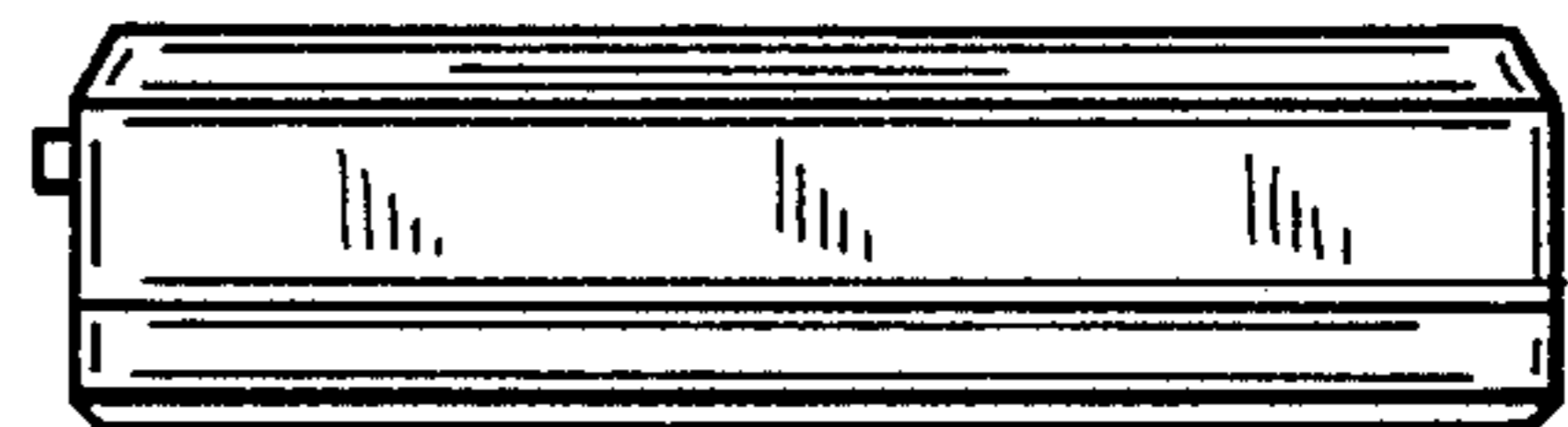

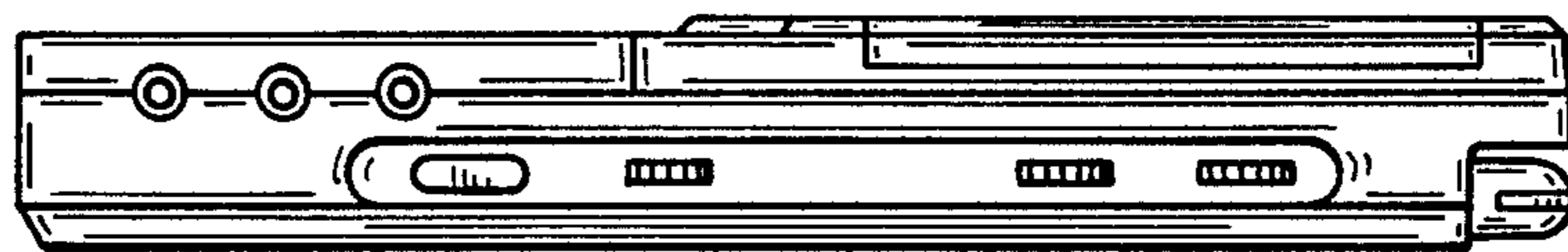

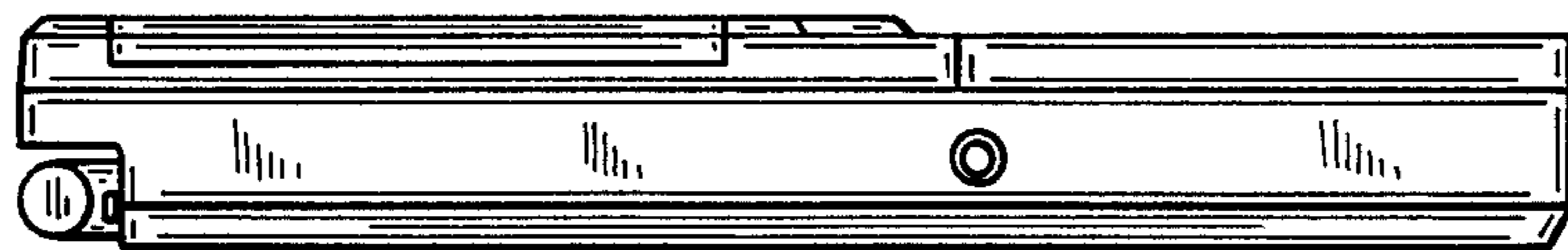
