FIG. 6 is a right side elevation thereof.



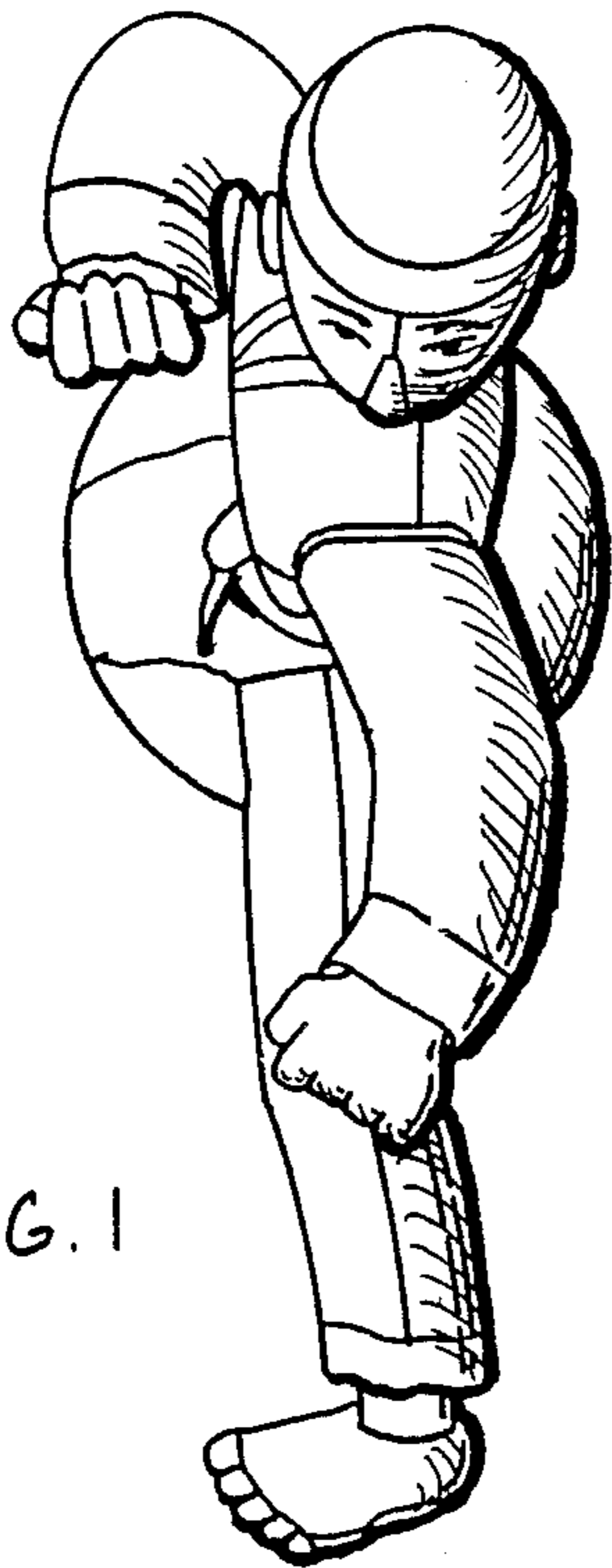

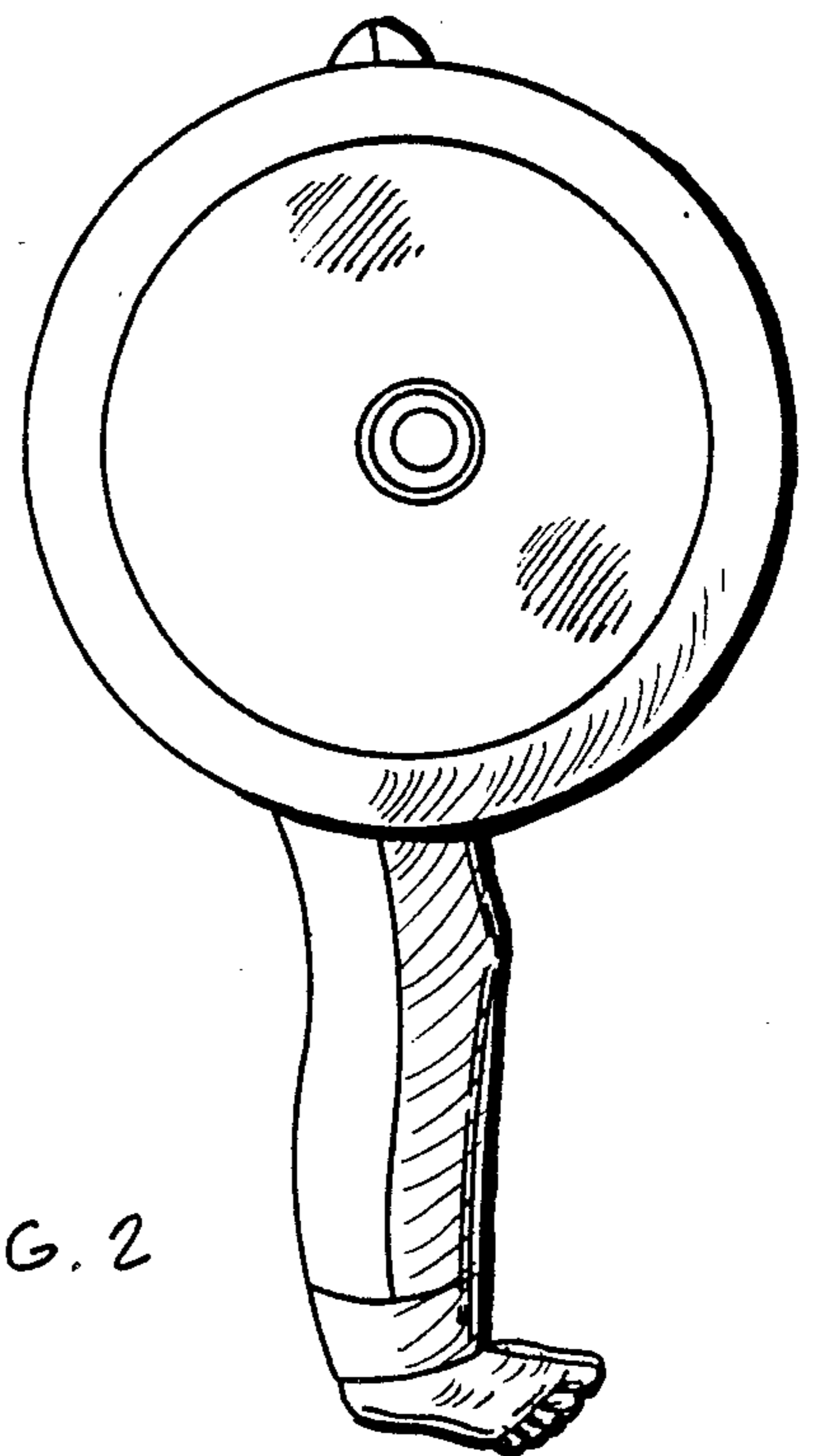

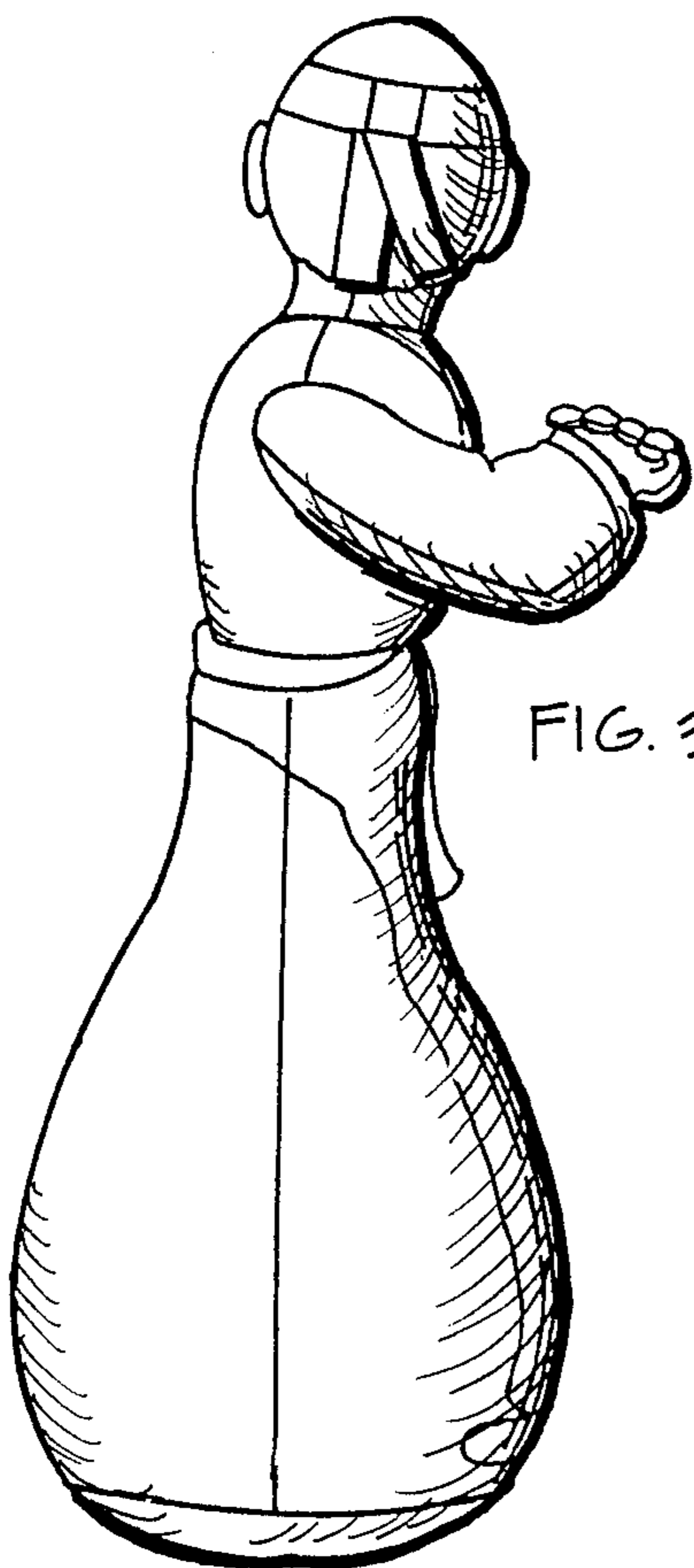

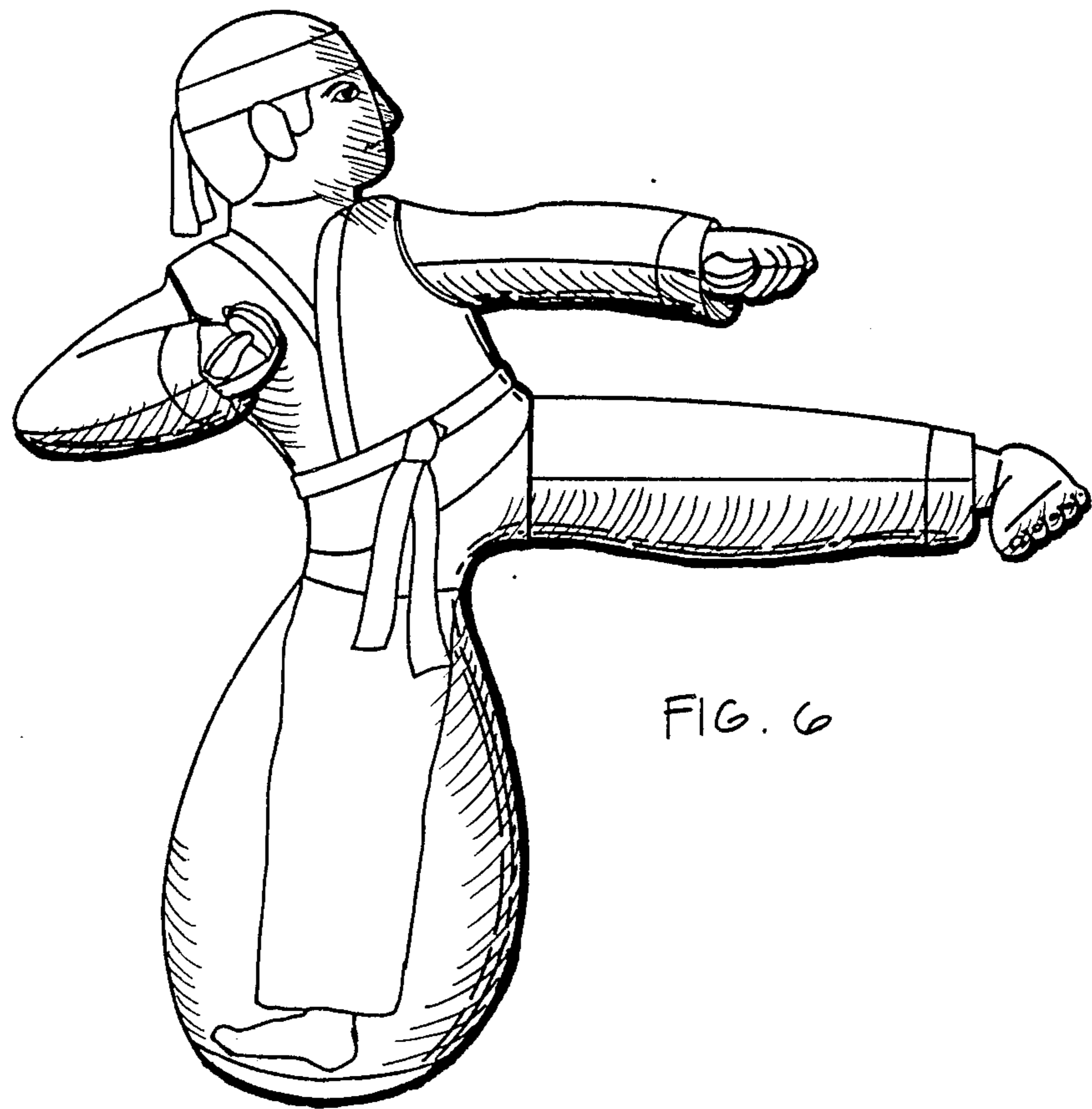

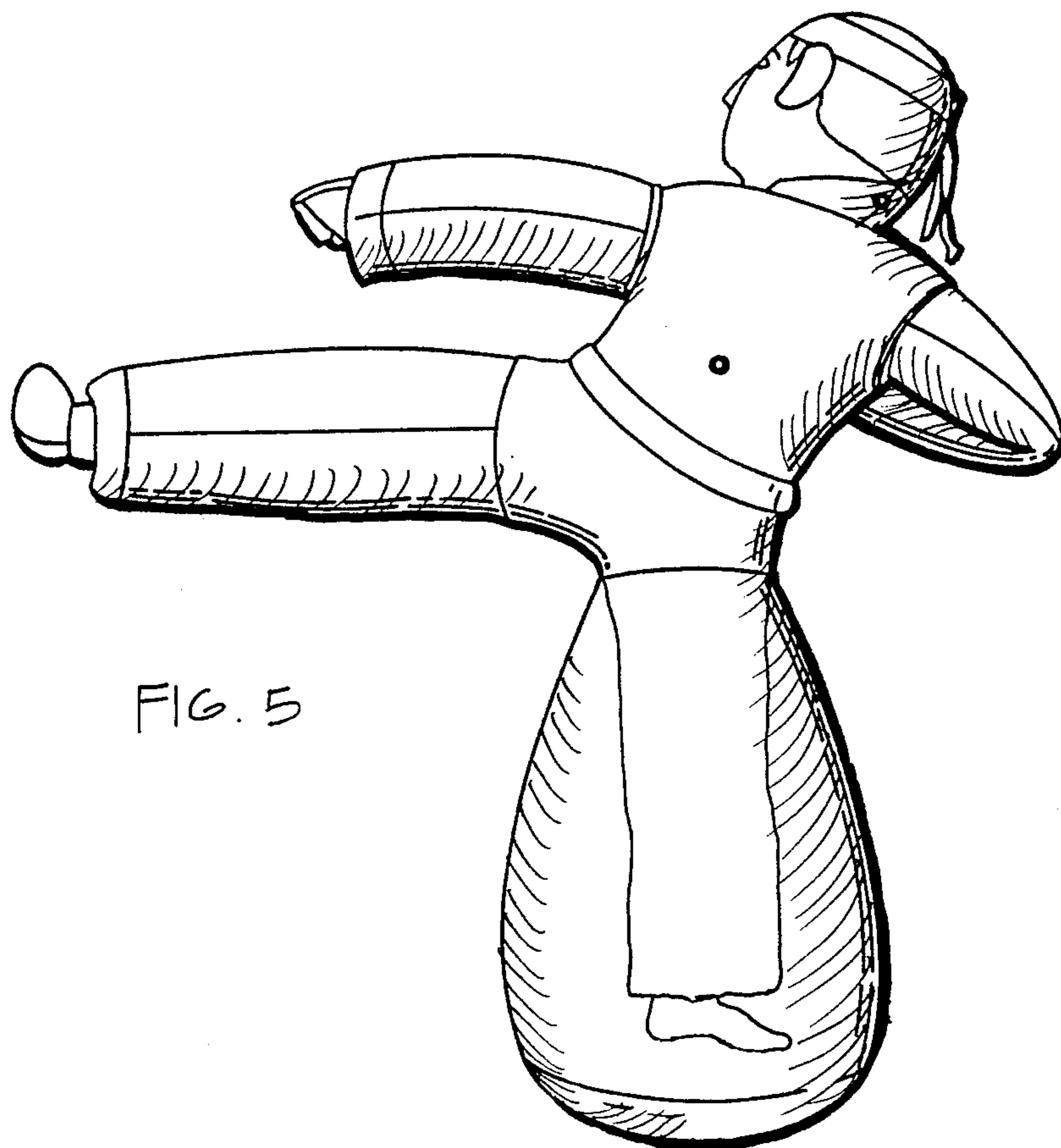
