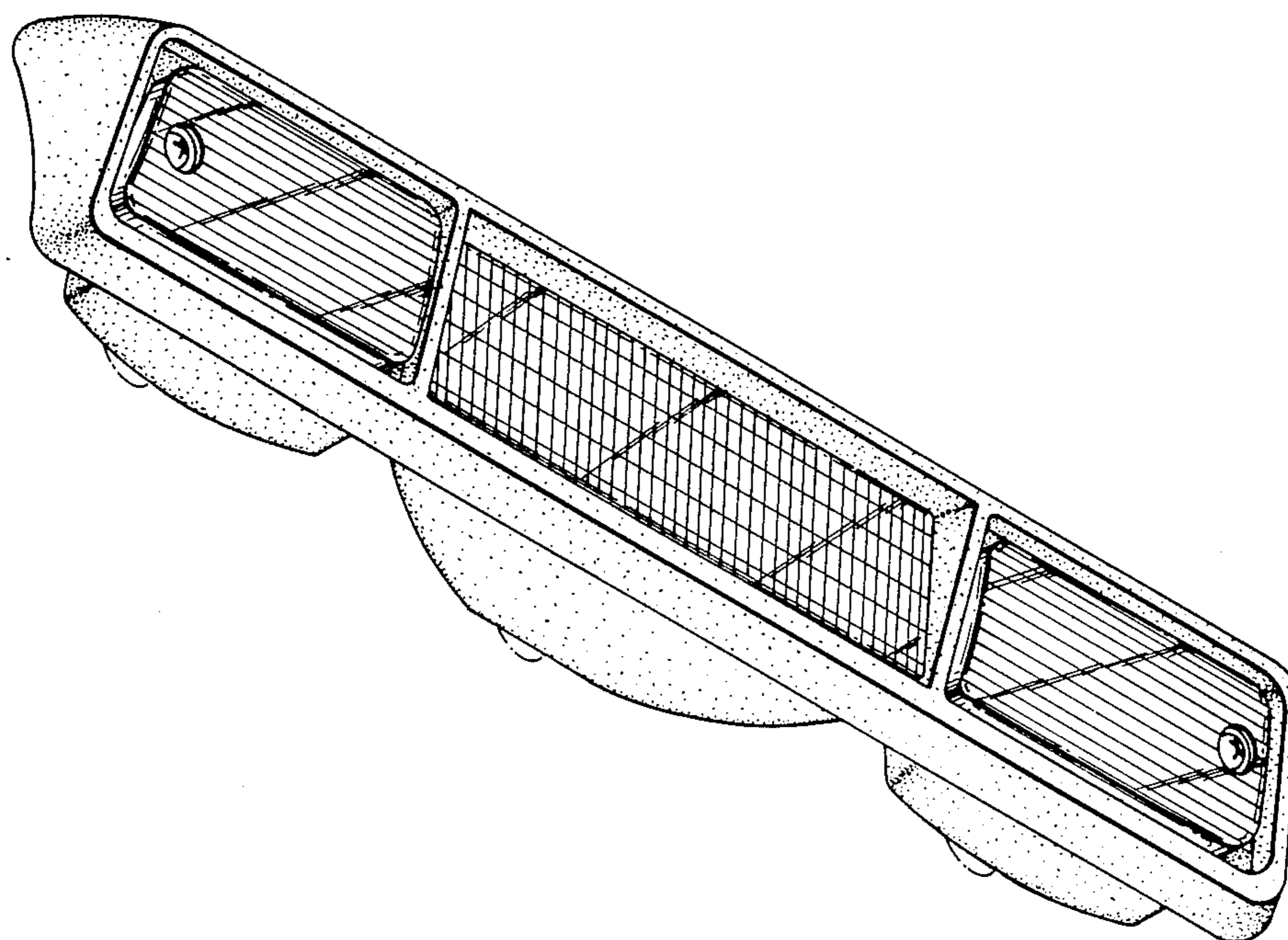

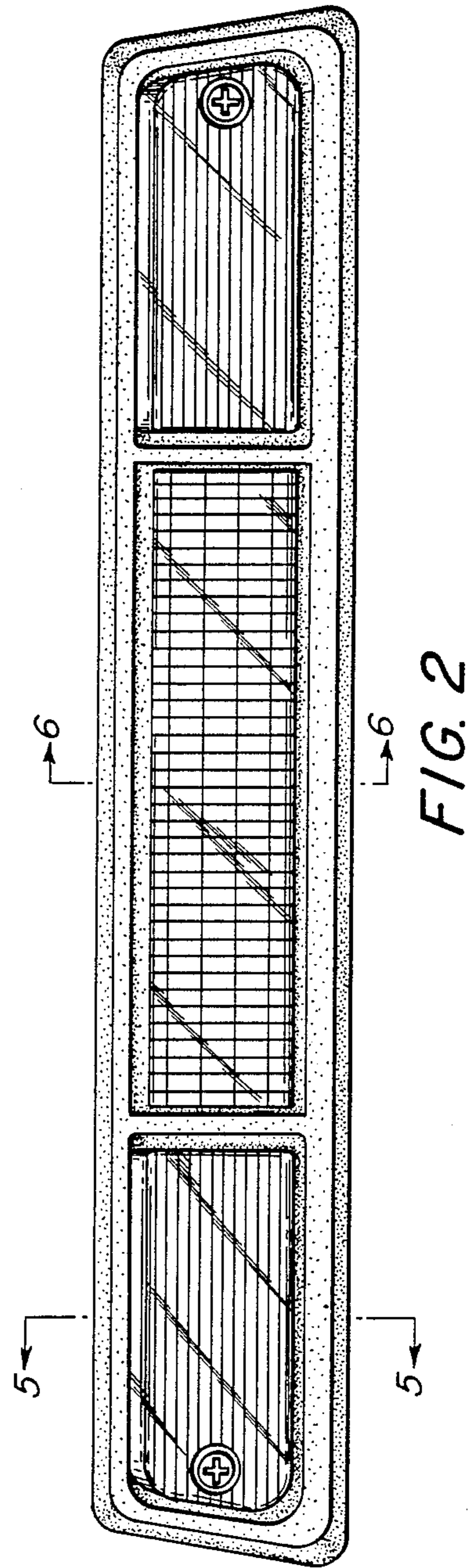
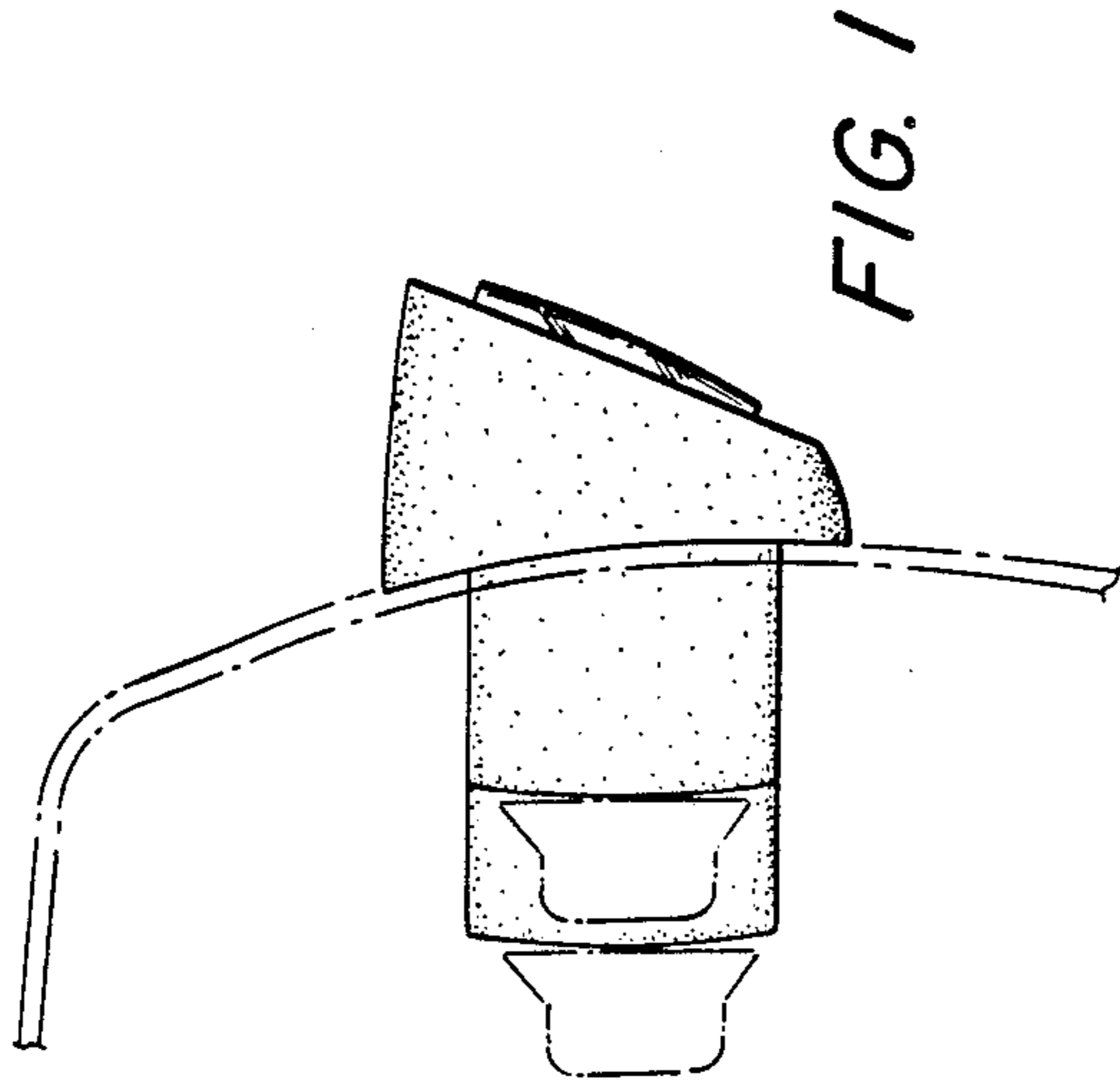
The ornamental design for a combination auxiliary brake light and cargo lamp for vehicles, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a side elevational view of a combination auxiliary brake light and cargo lamp for vehicles showing our new design;
 FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof;
 FIG. 3 is a top plan view thereof;
 FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view thereof;
 FIG. 5 is a vertical section view taken along the line 5—5 of FIG. 3;
 FIG. 6 is a vertical section view taken along the line 6—6 of FIG. 3; and
 FIG. 7 is a rear elevational view thereof.
 FIG. 8 is a bottom, front perspective view thereof on a reduced scale.

A portion of a vehicle roof in FIG. 1 and the end caps on the lamp bases in FIGS. 1 and 3 through 8 are shown in broken lines for illustrative purposes only.





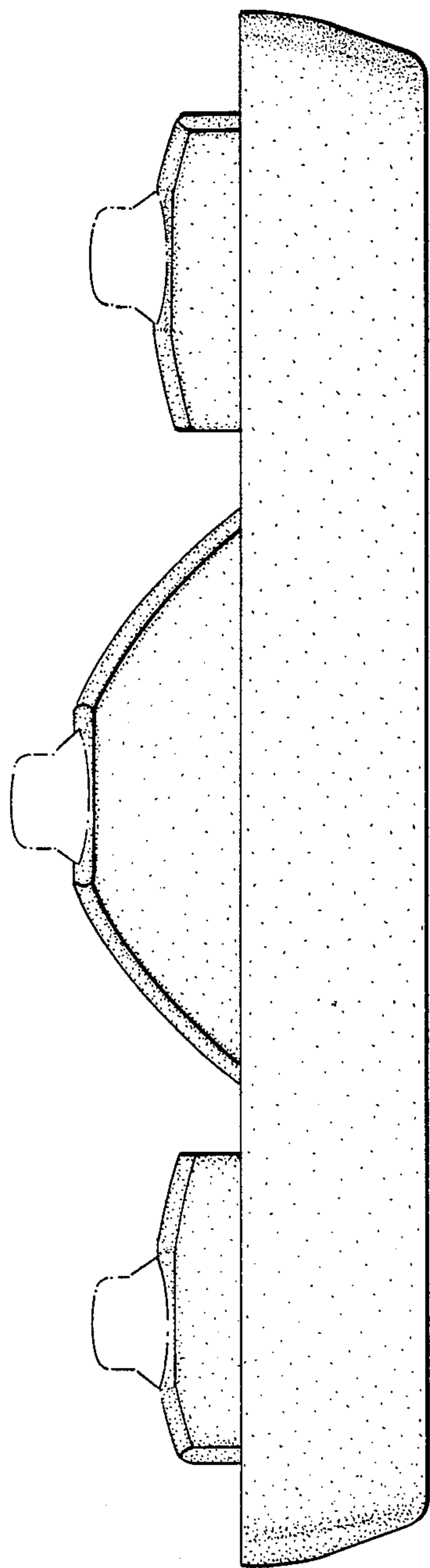
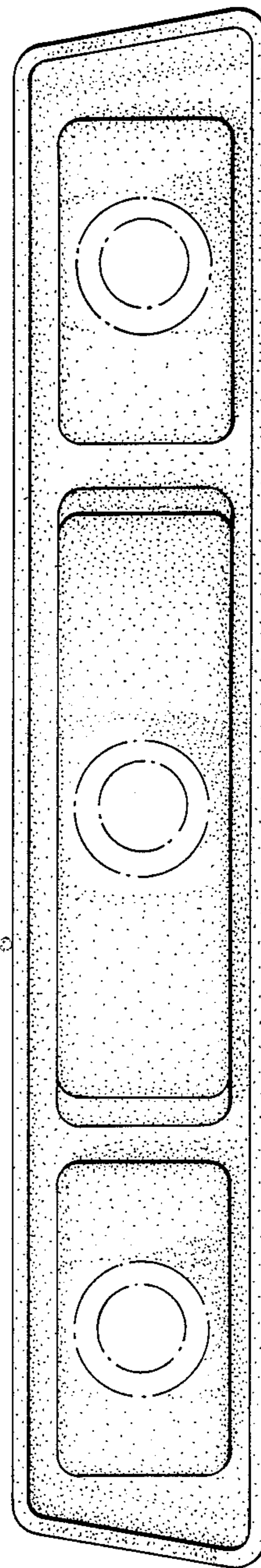

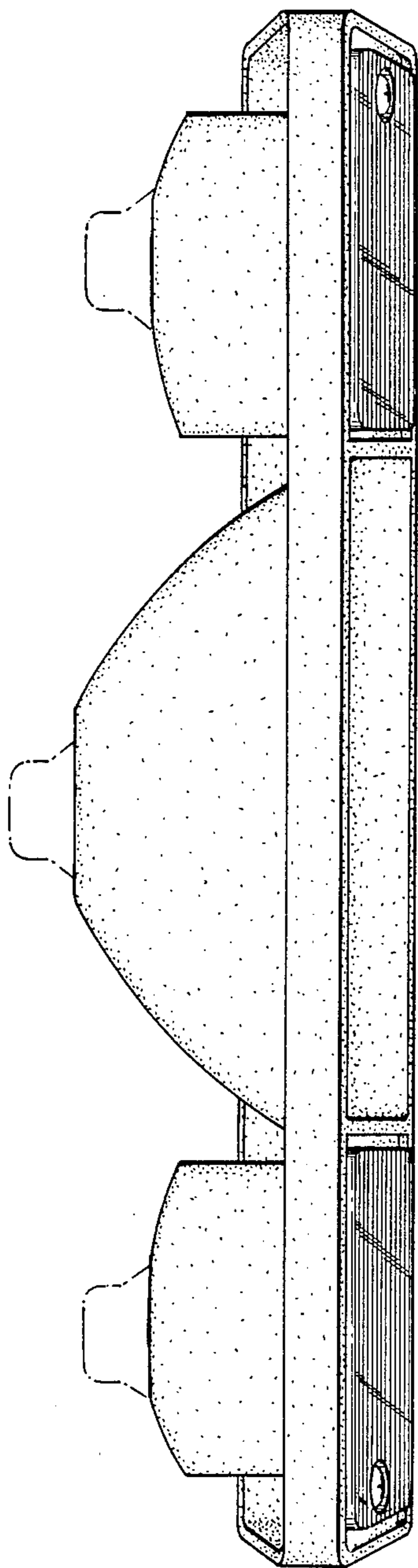

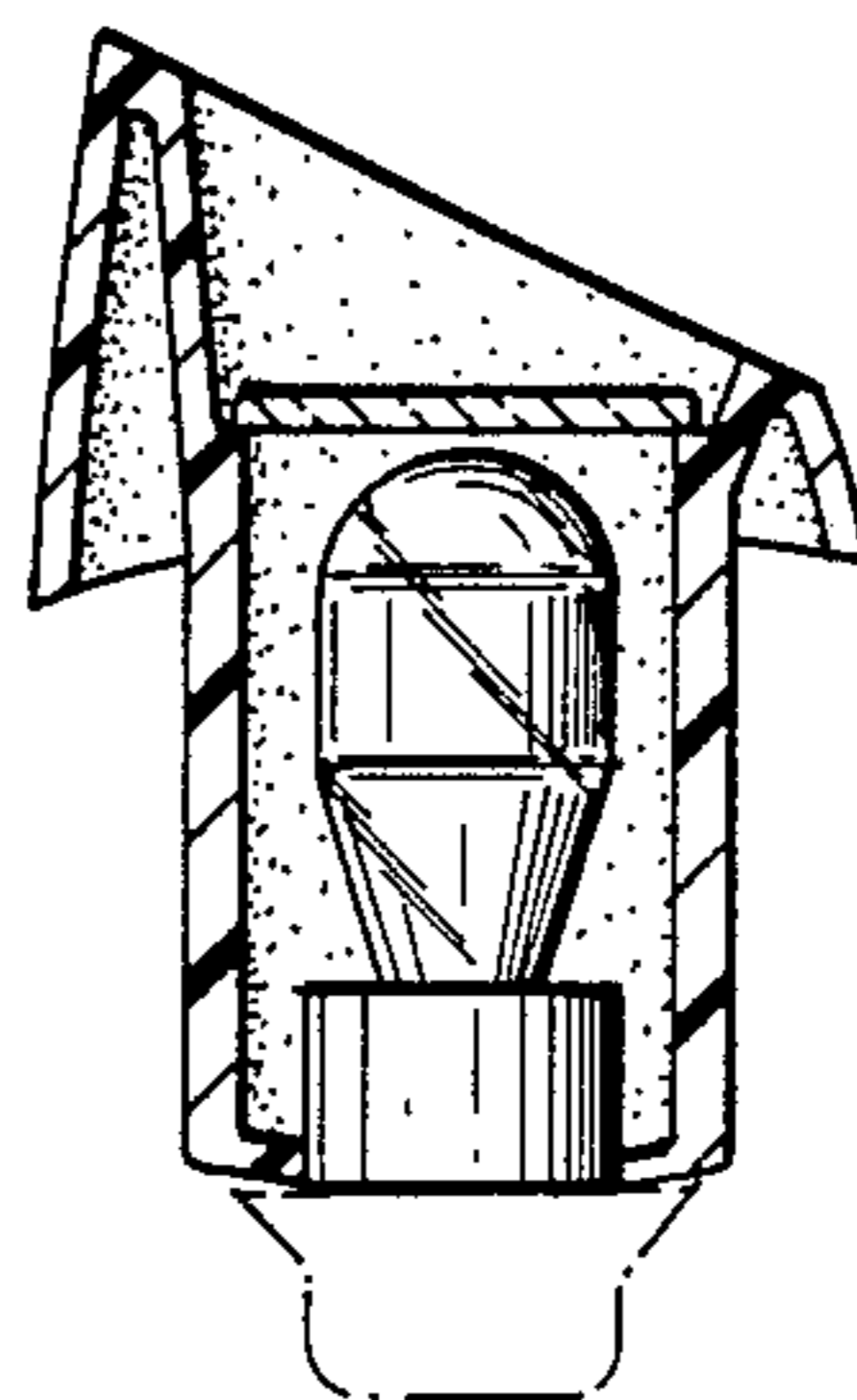

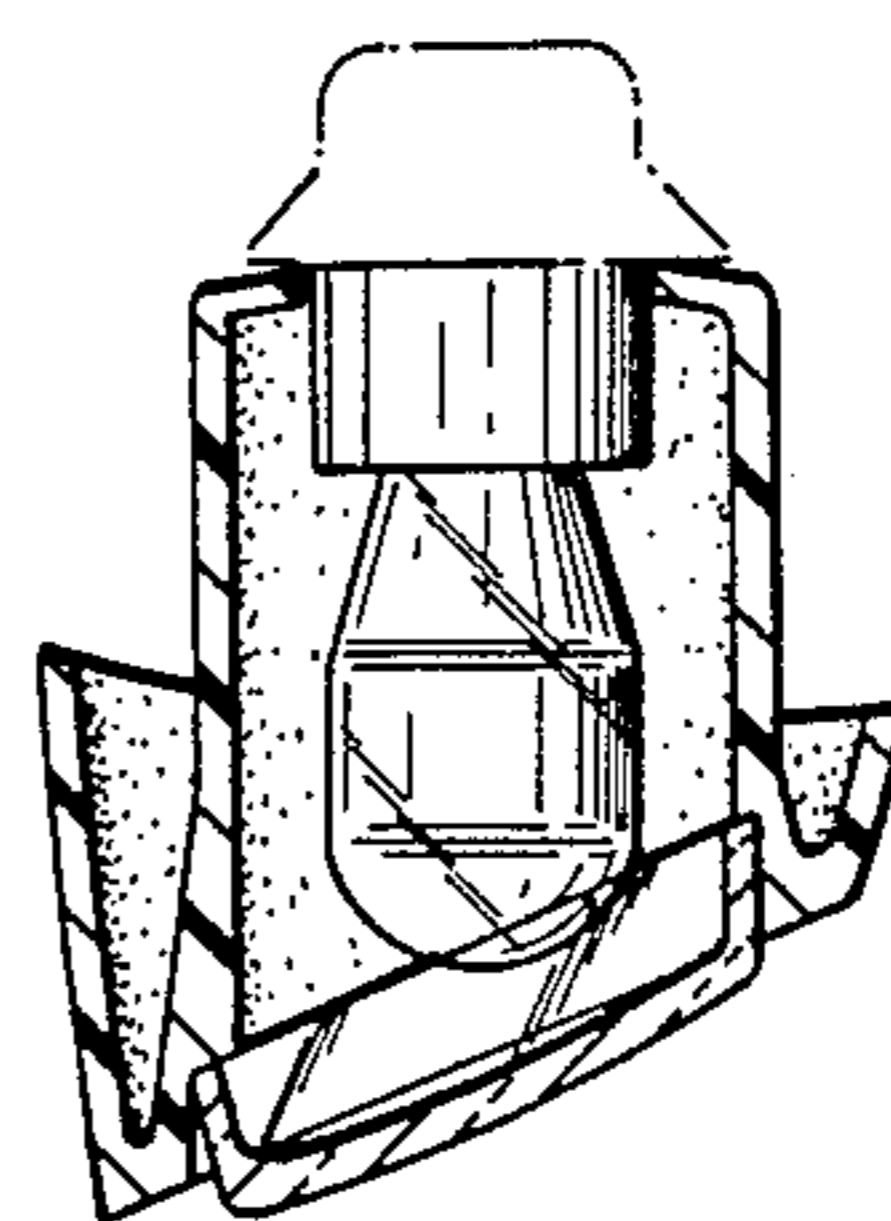

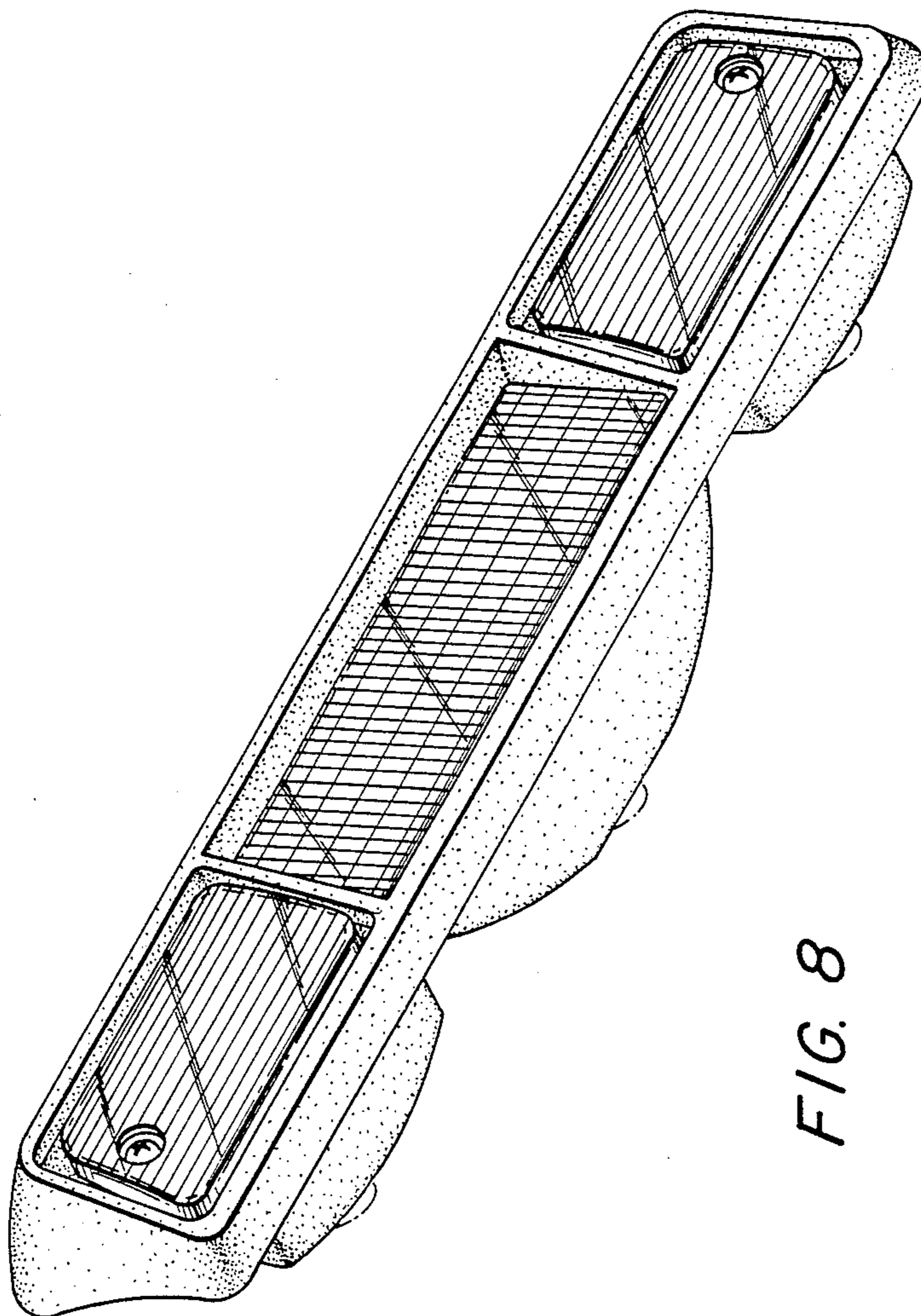
