[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a sternal incision protector, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a bottom, front and left side perspective view of a sternal incision protector showing my new design; FIG. 2 is a bottom, rear and right side perspective view thereof; FIG. 3 is a side elevational view thereof; FIG. 4 is a top and rear perspective view thereof; and FIG. 5 is a bottom and rear perspective view thereof. The body shown in broken lines in FIGS. 1 and 3 is for illustrative purposes only and forms no part of the claimed design. The strap in FIGS. 2, 4 and 5 is shown broken away for ease of illustration.

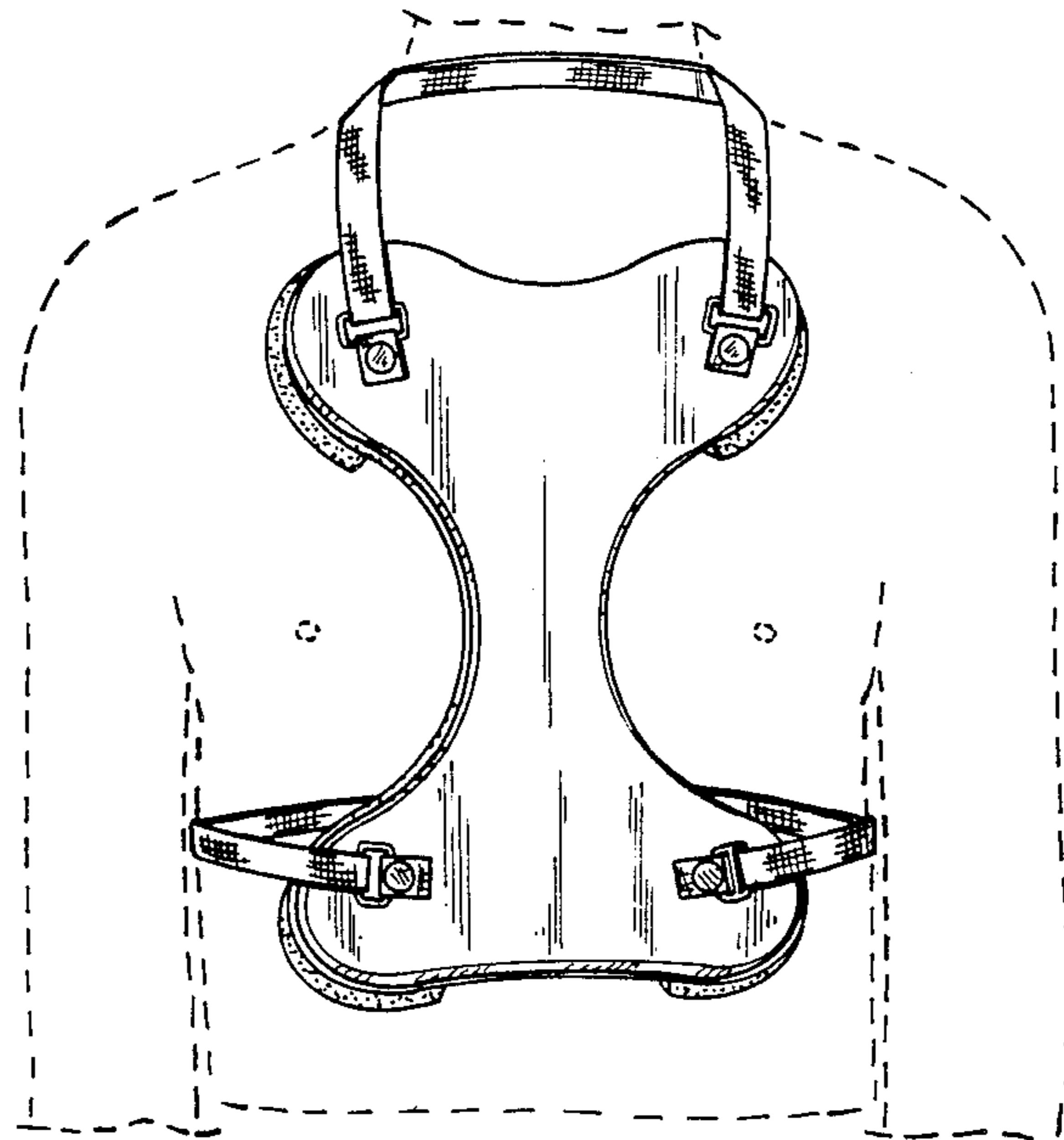

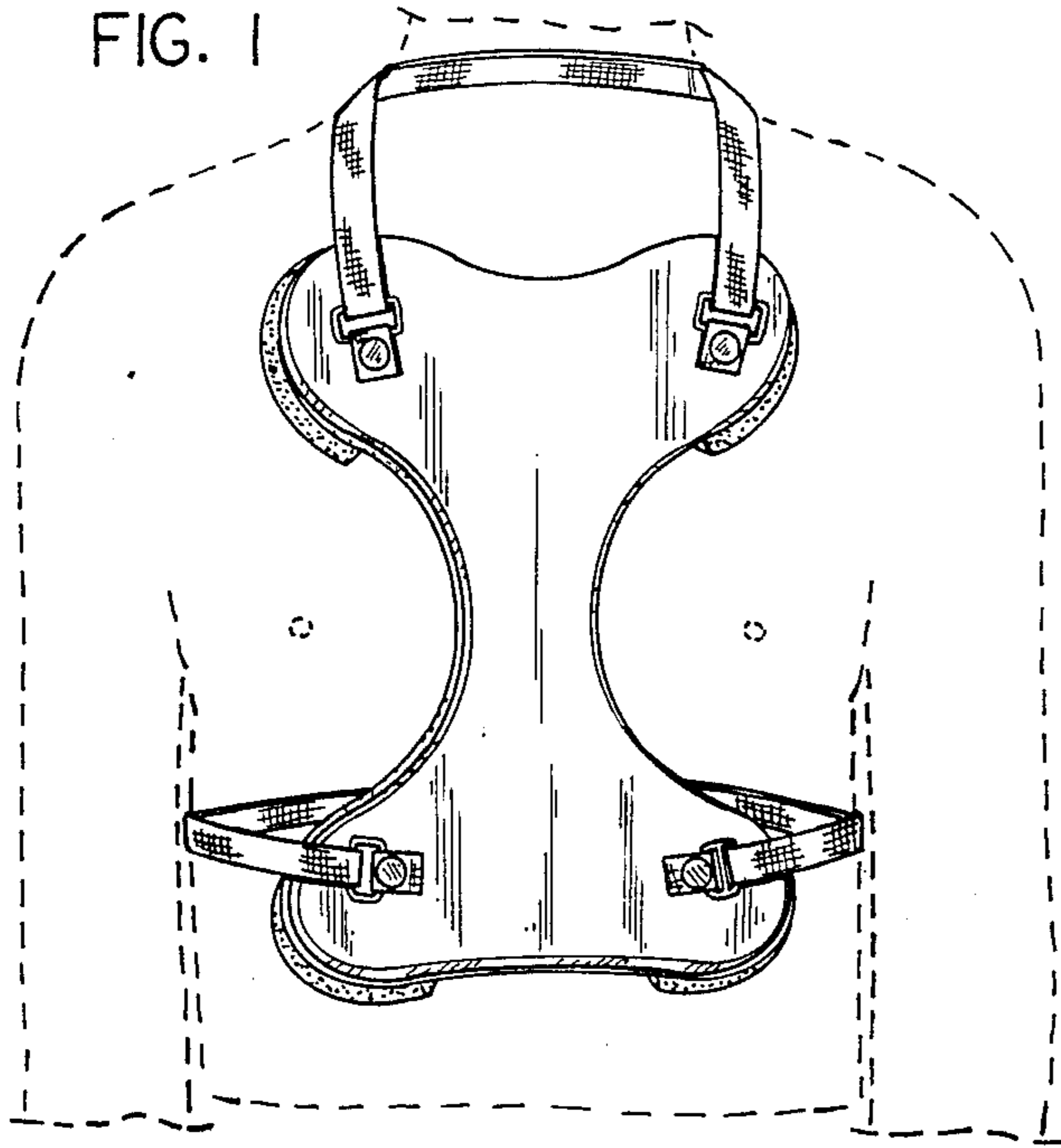

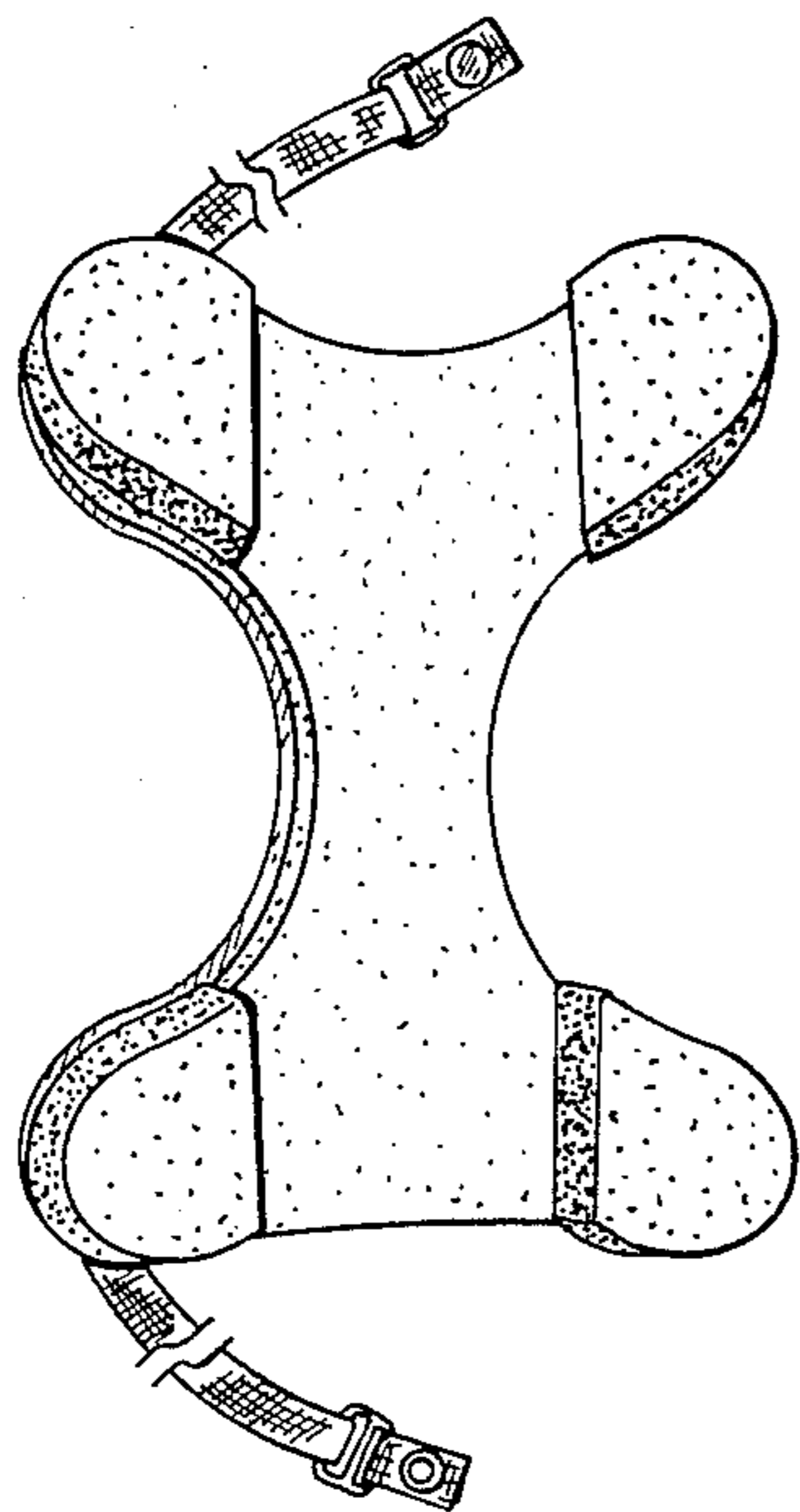
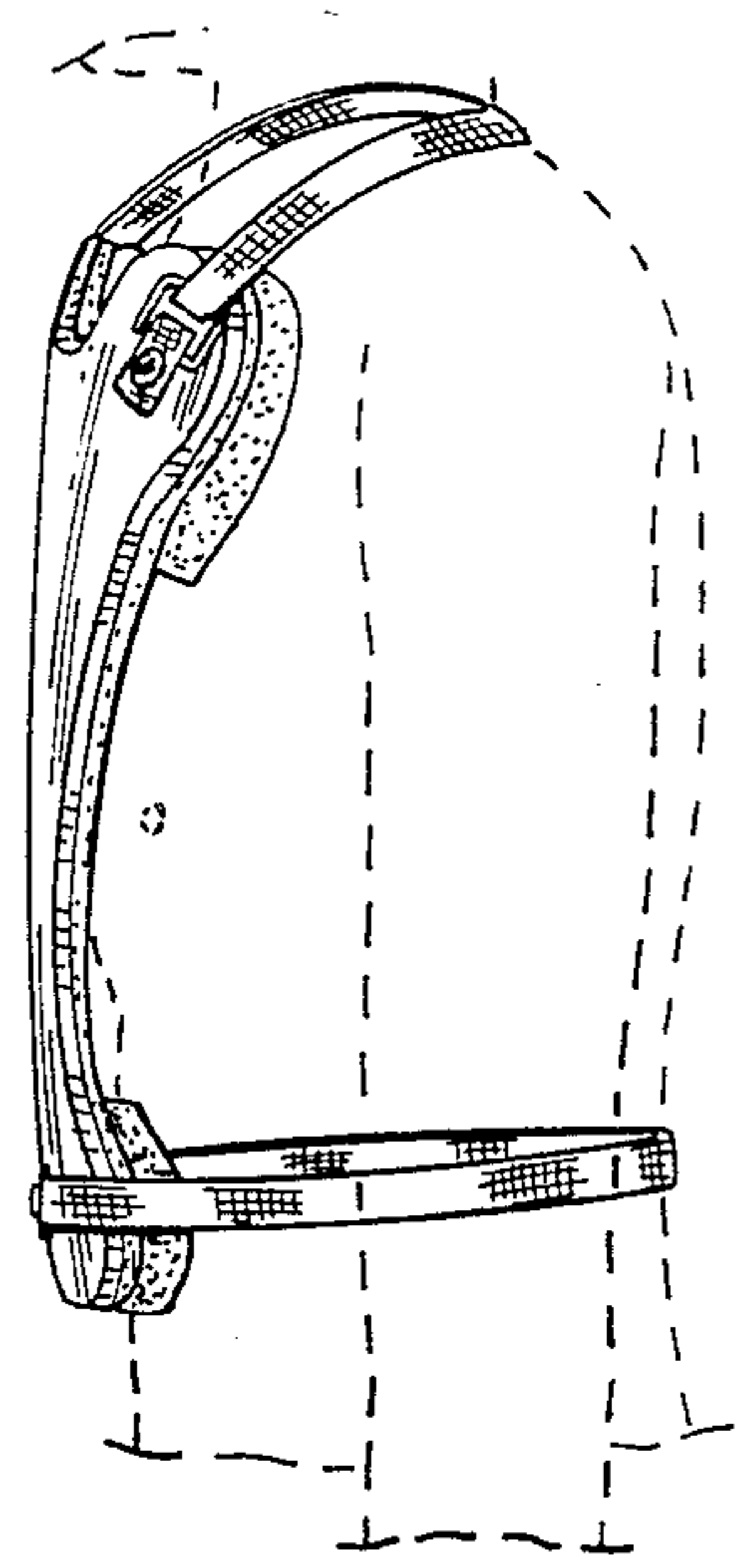

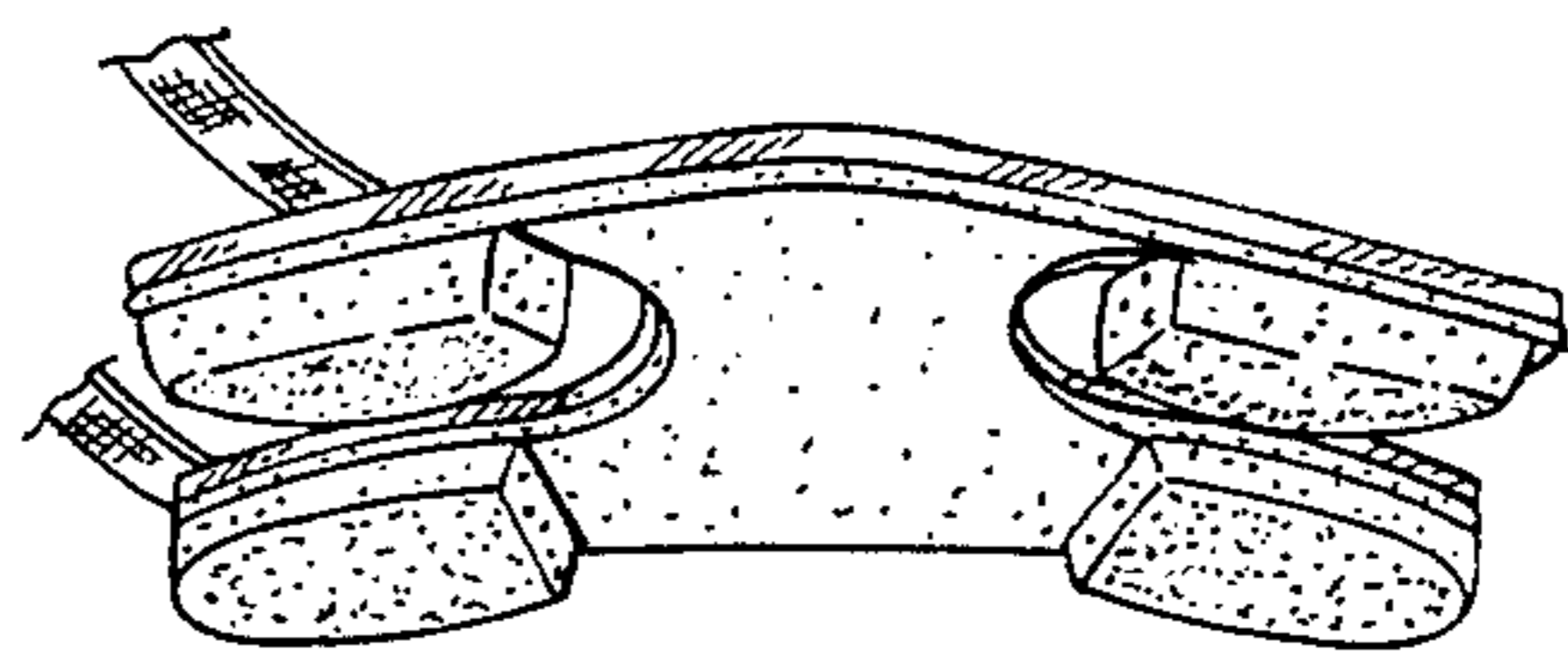

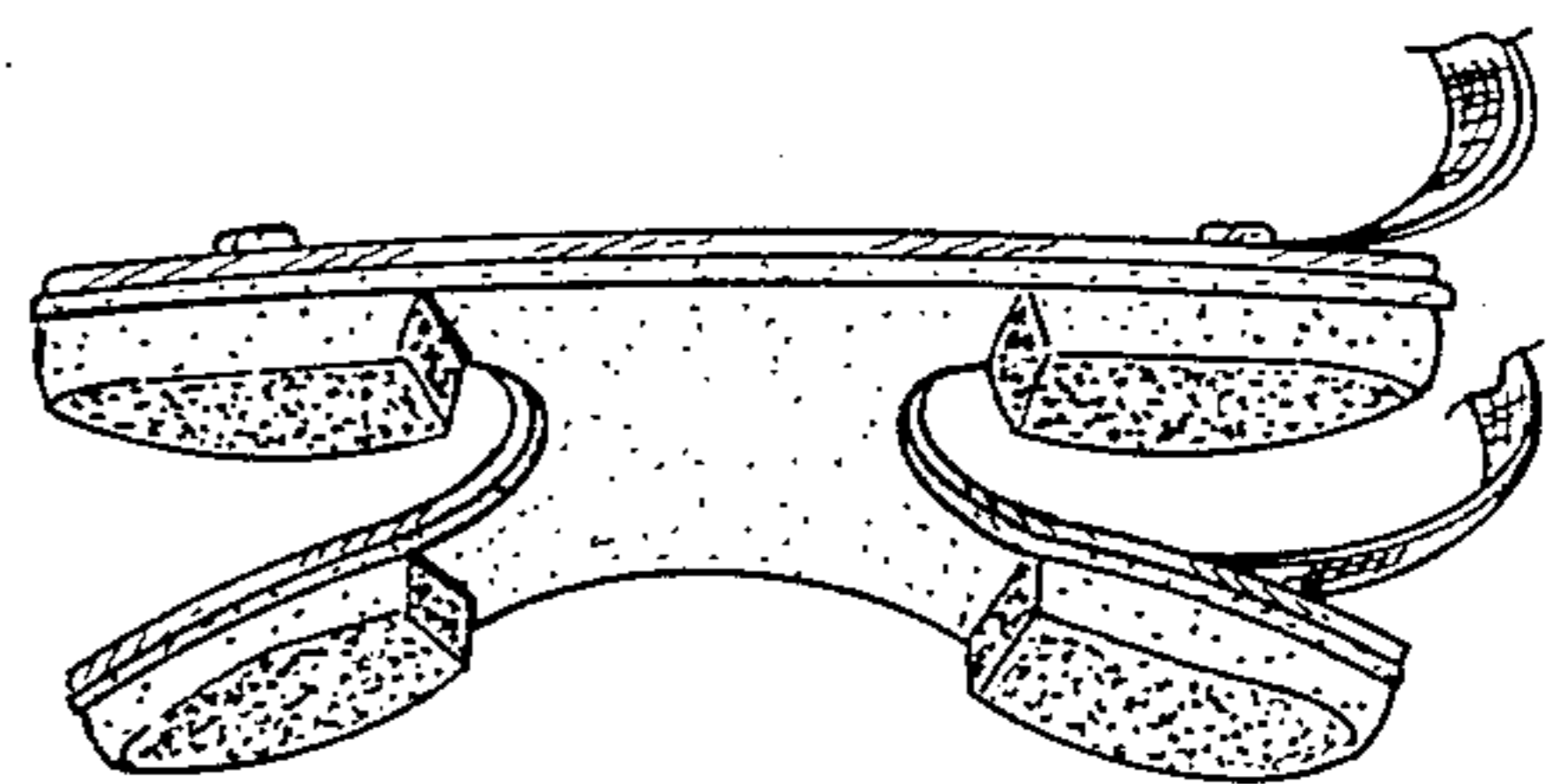
