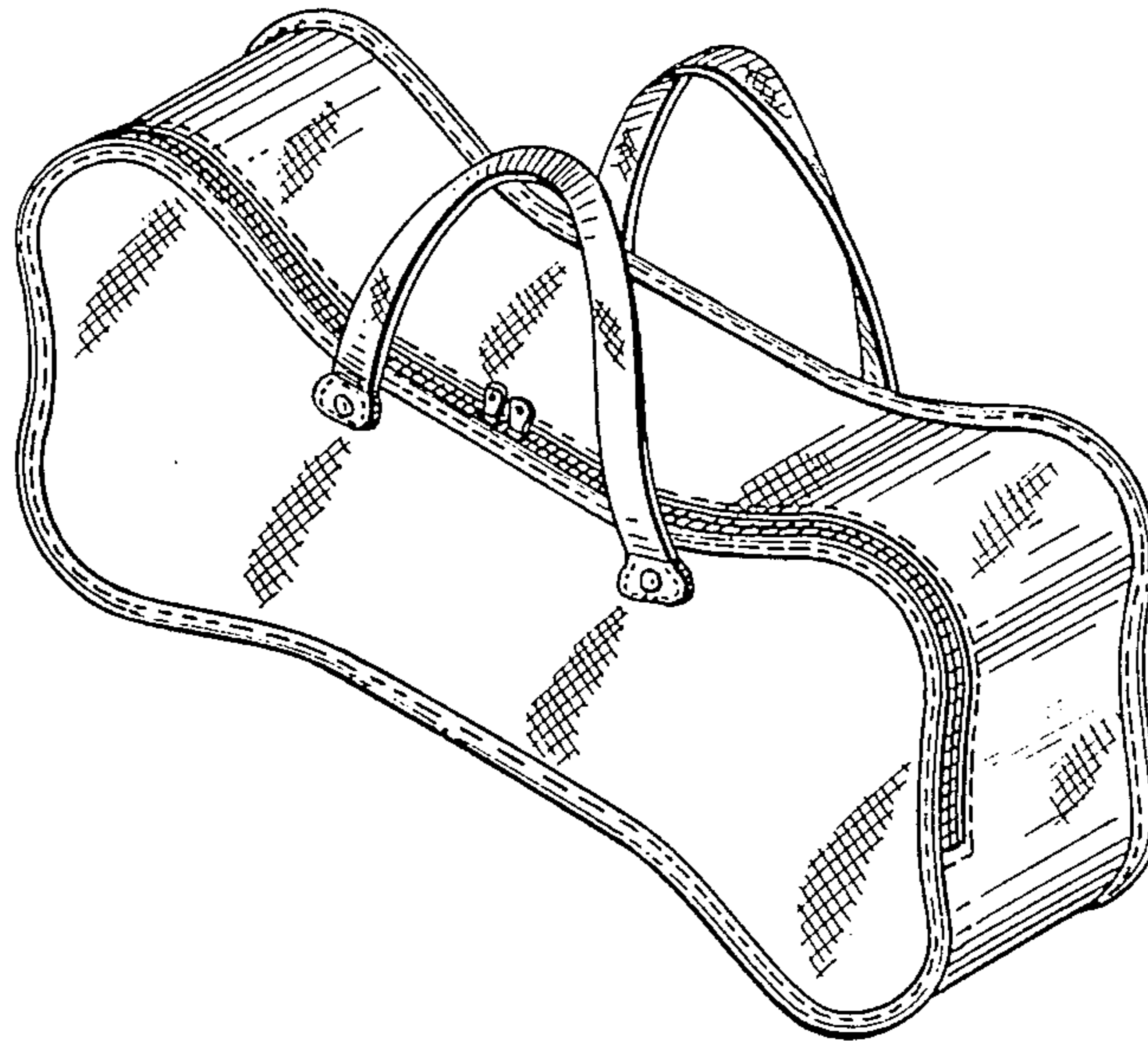

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front, top and right side, isometric view of a pet carrying case, embodying my new design. FIG. 2 is a front, elevational view thereof; FIG. 3 is a left side elevational view thereof; FIG. 4 is a top plan view thereof; FIG. 5 is a rear elevational view thereof; and FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view thereof.



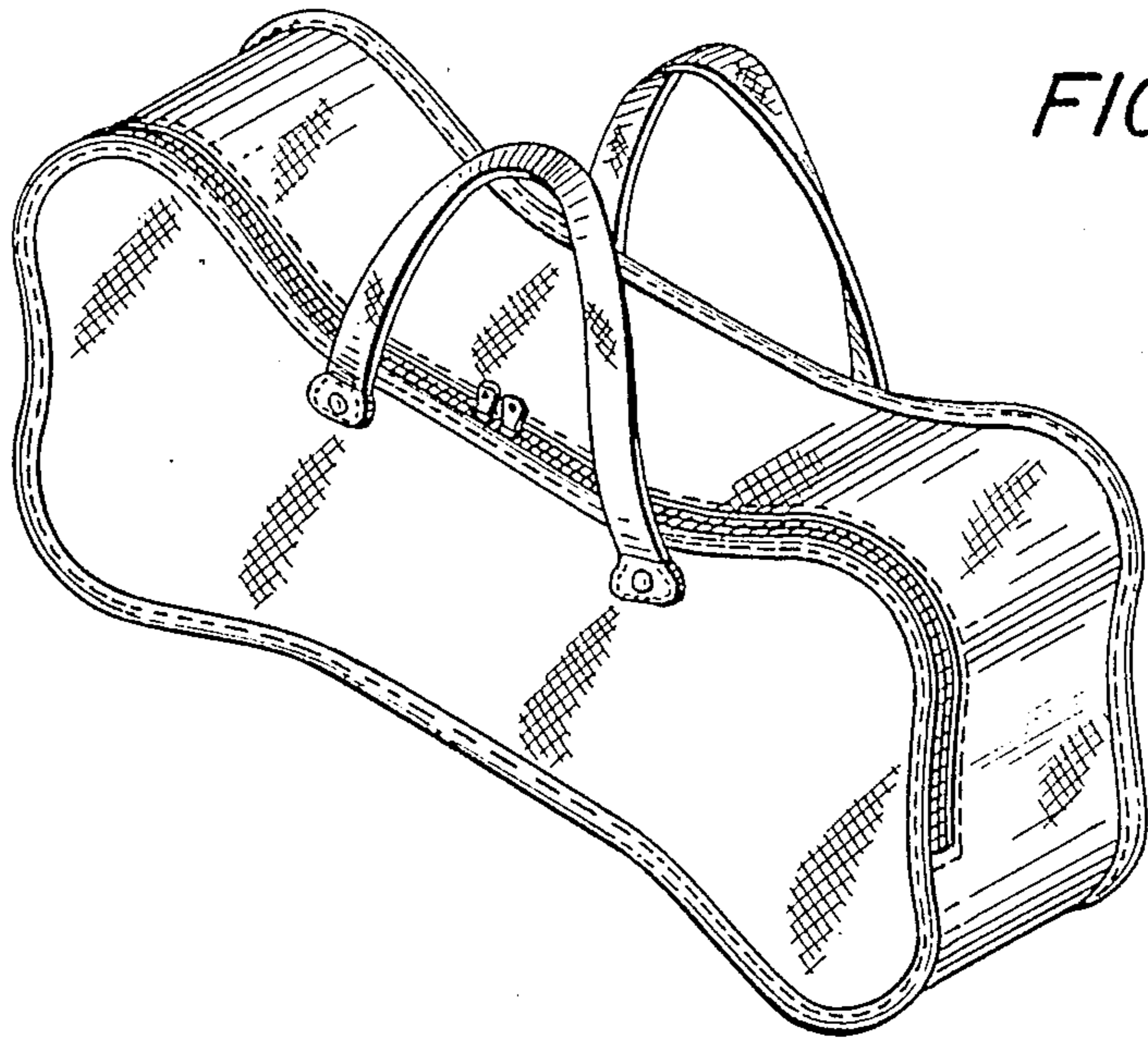

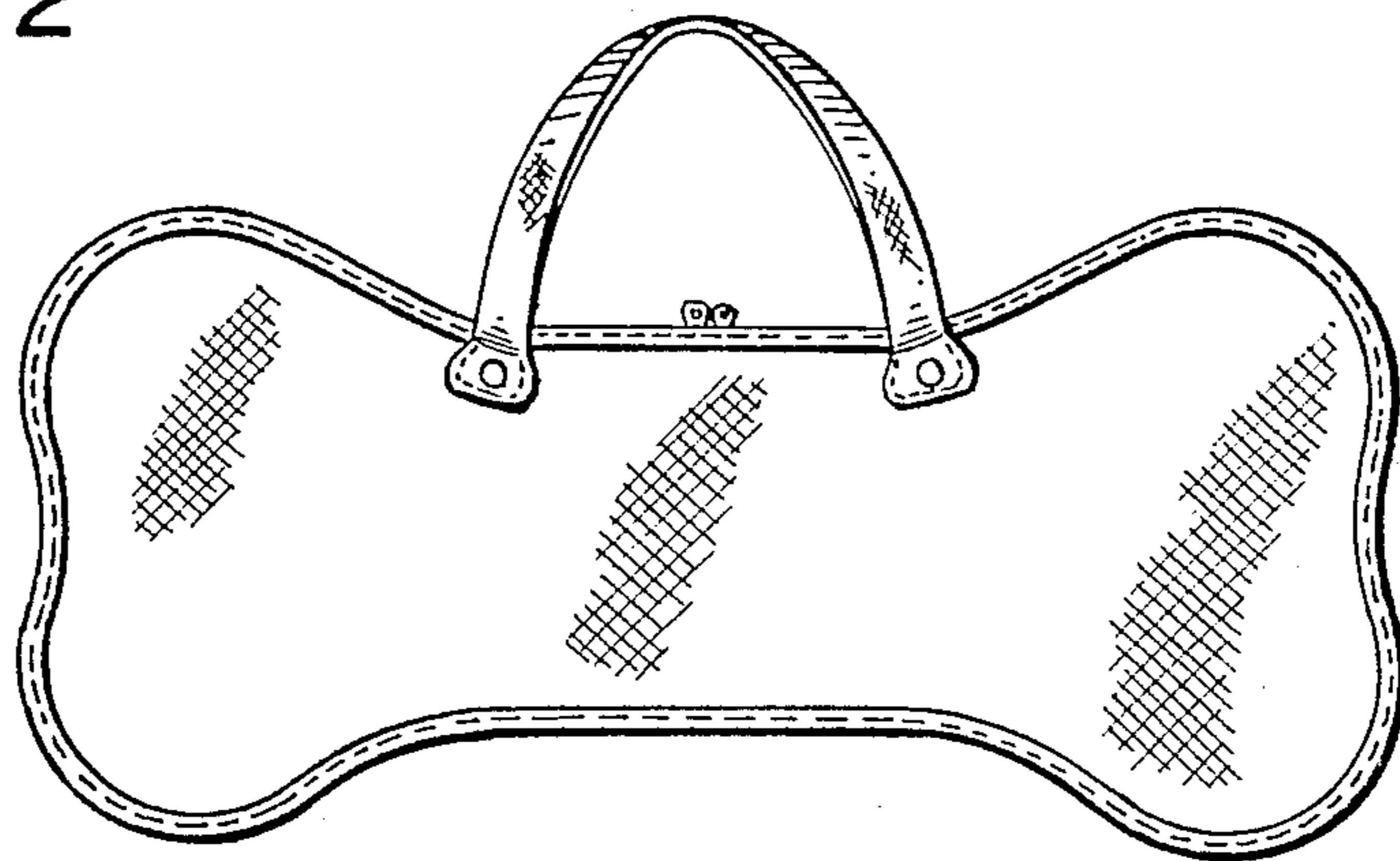

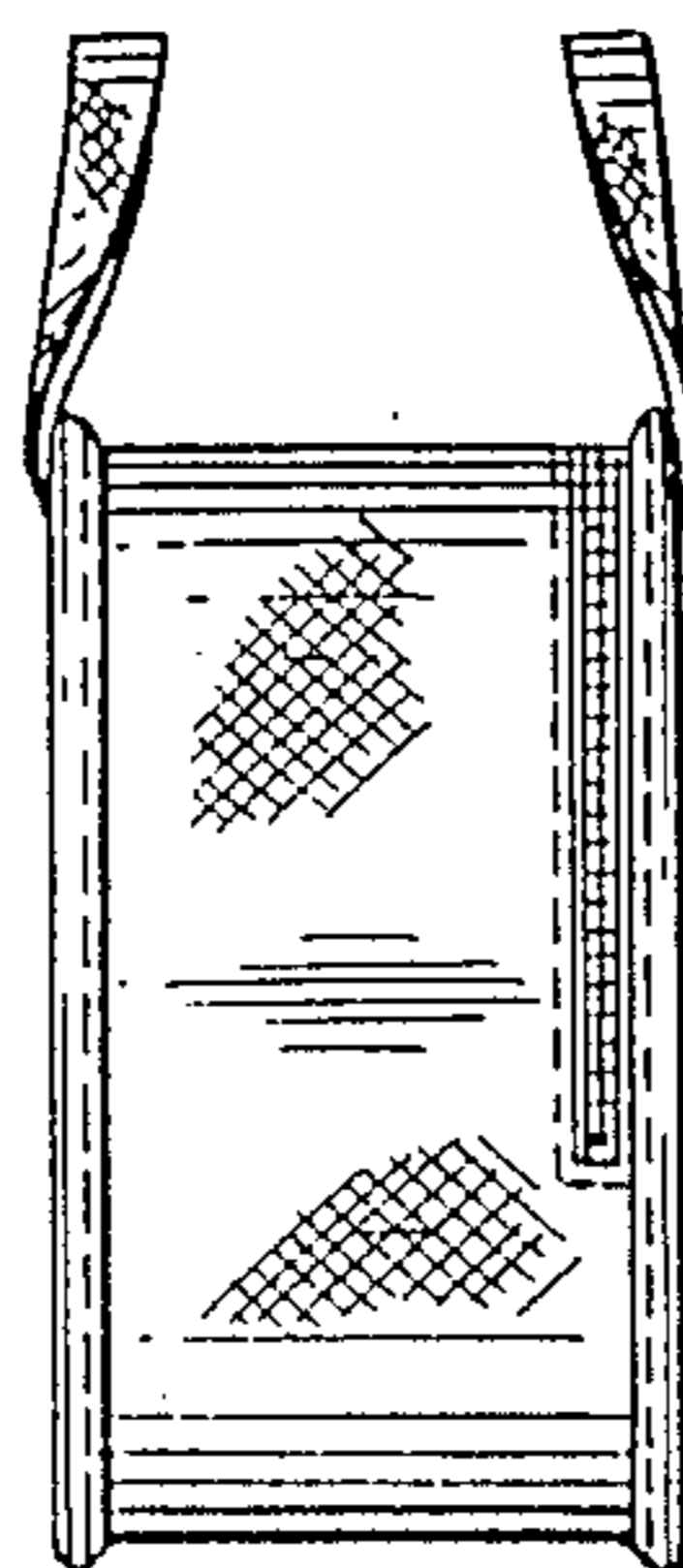

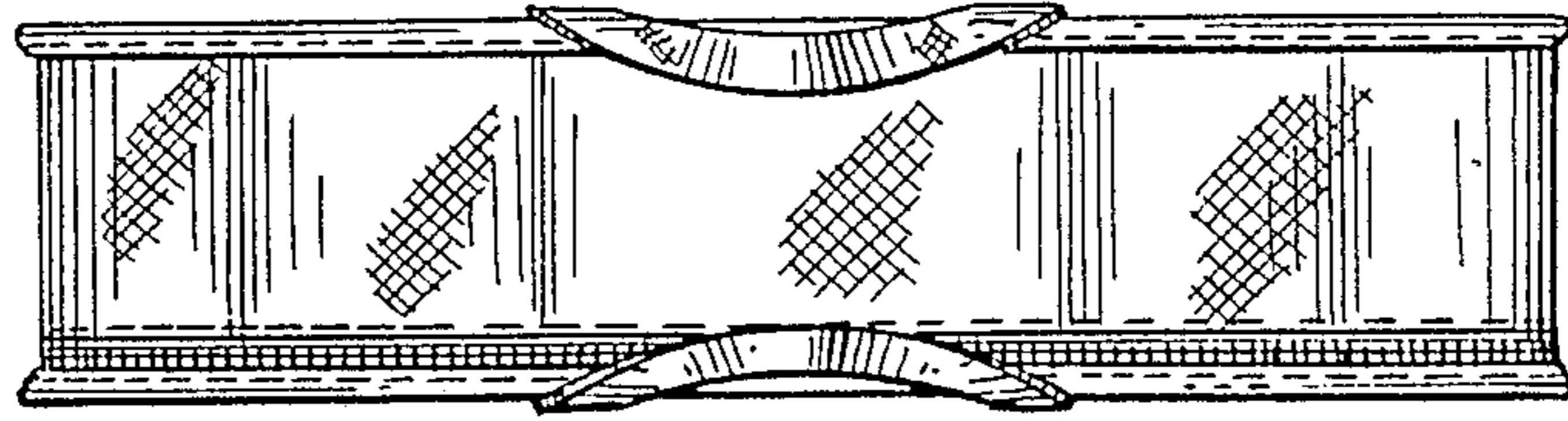

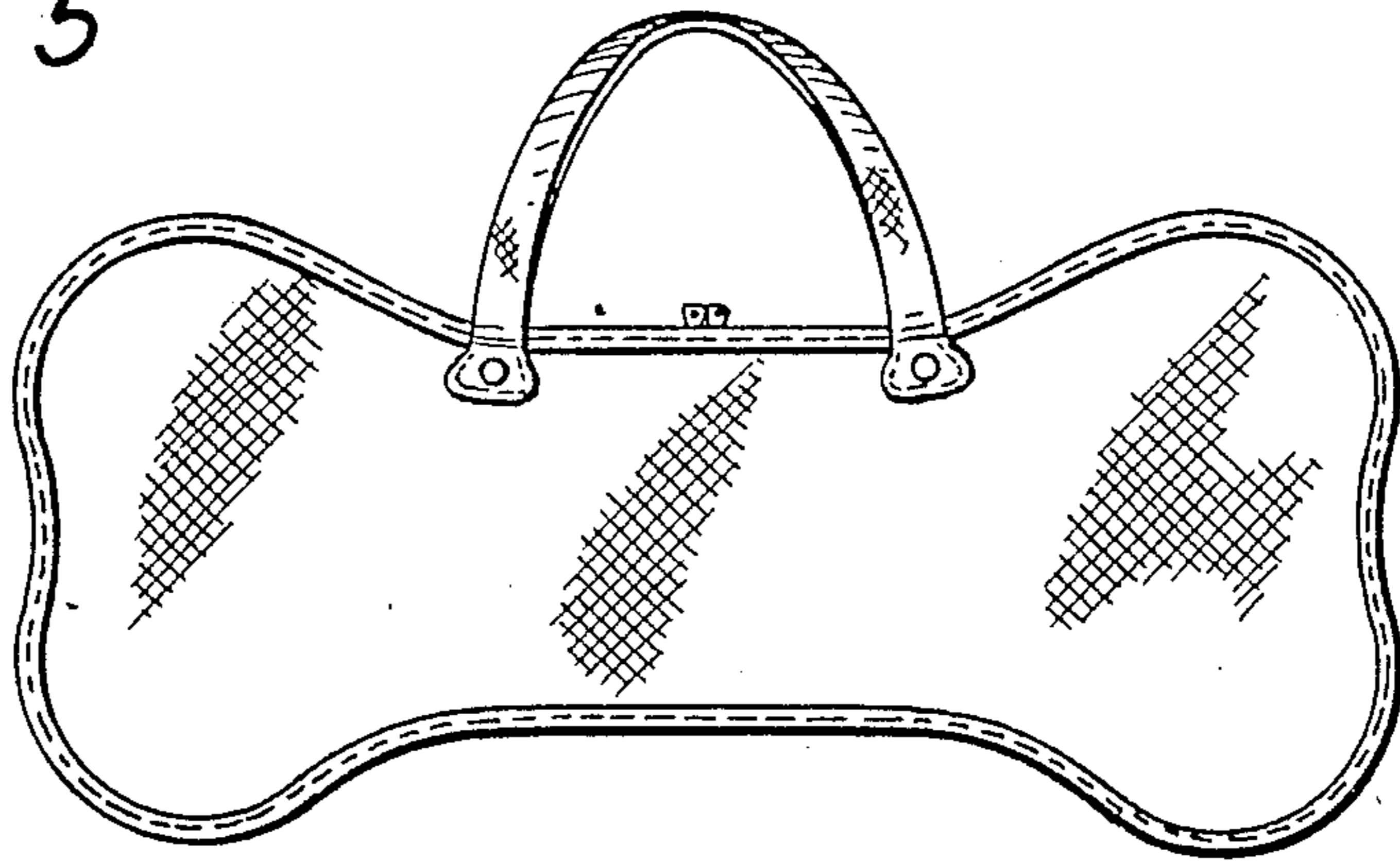
