The ornamental design for pasta, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top perspective view of a pasta showing my new design;

FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof;

FIG. 3 is a bottom plan view thereof;

FIG. 4 is a front elevational view thereof, the undisclosed rear being the same; and

FIG. 5 is a side elevational view thereof, the undisclosed side being the same.

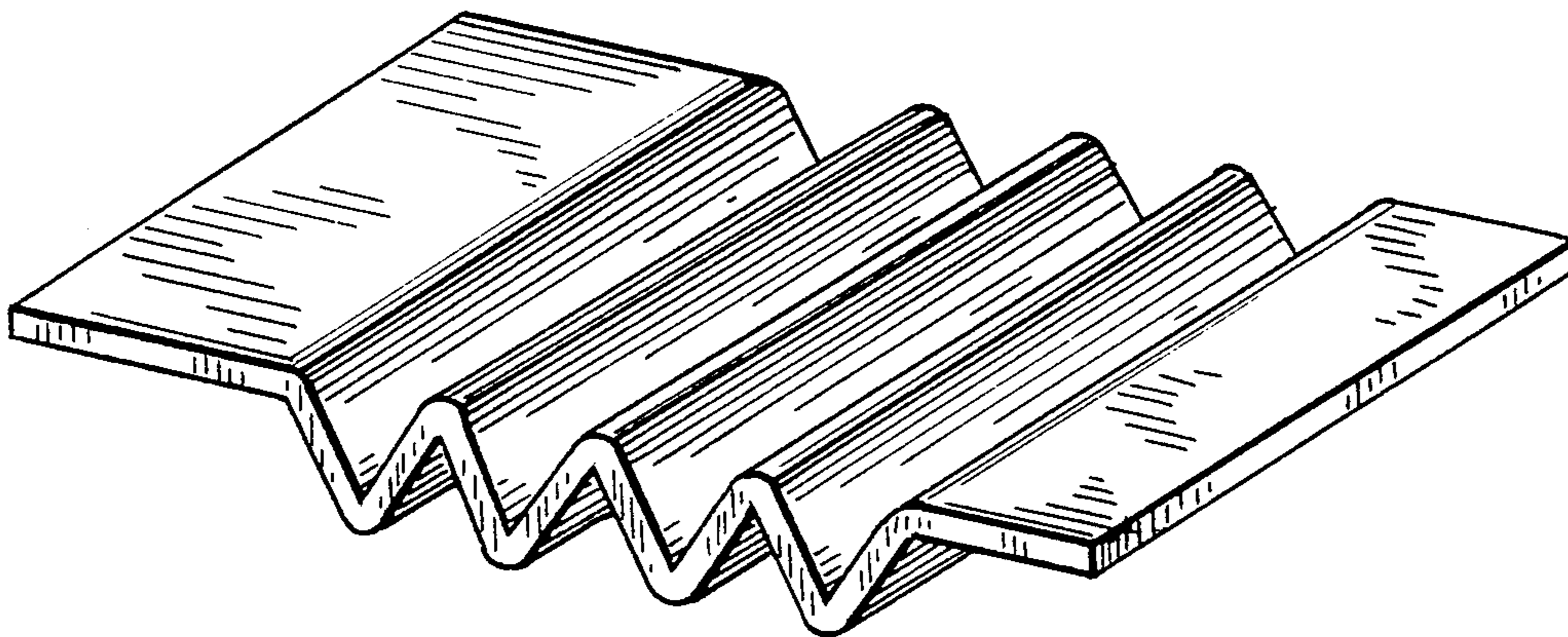

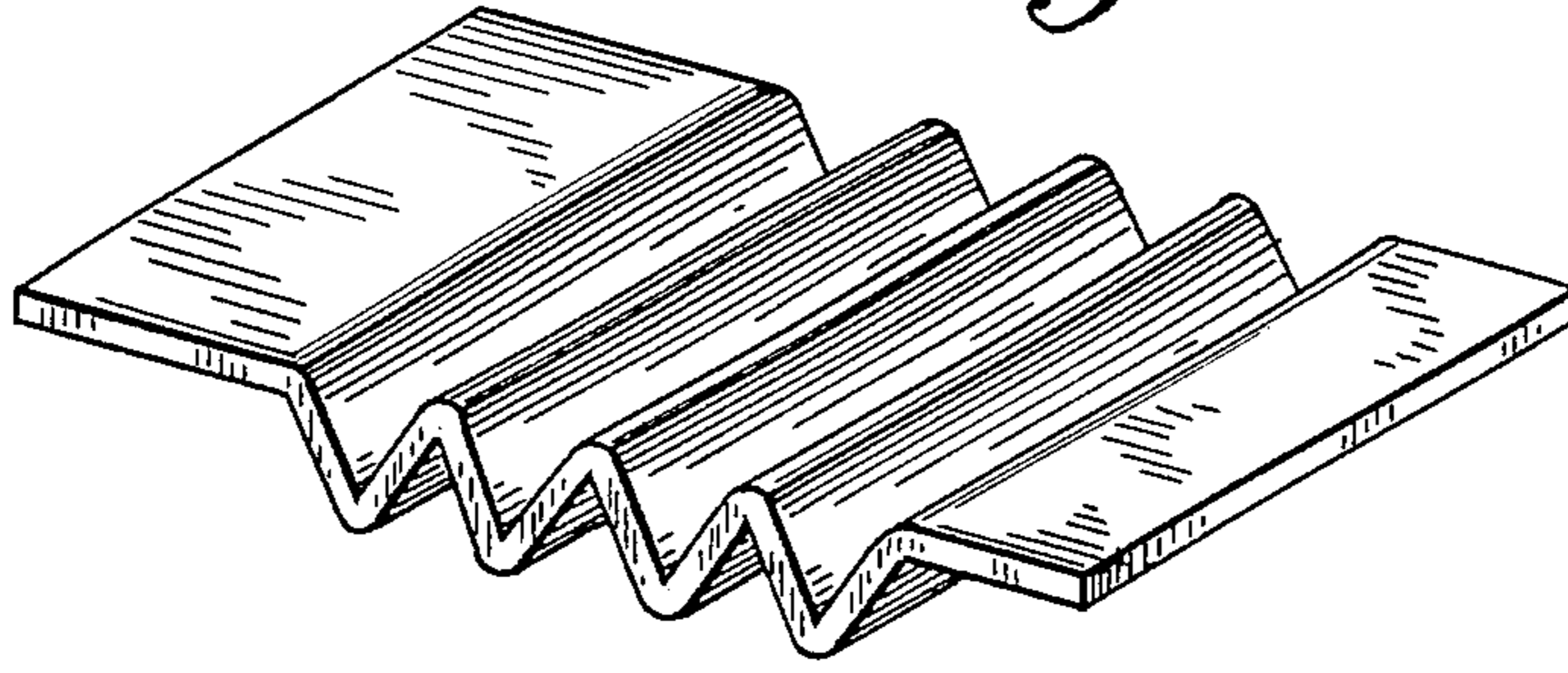

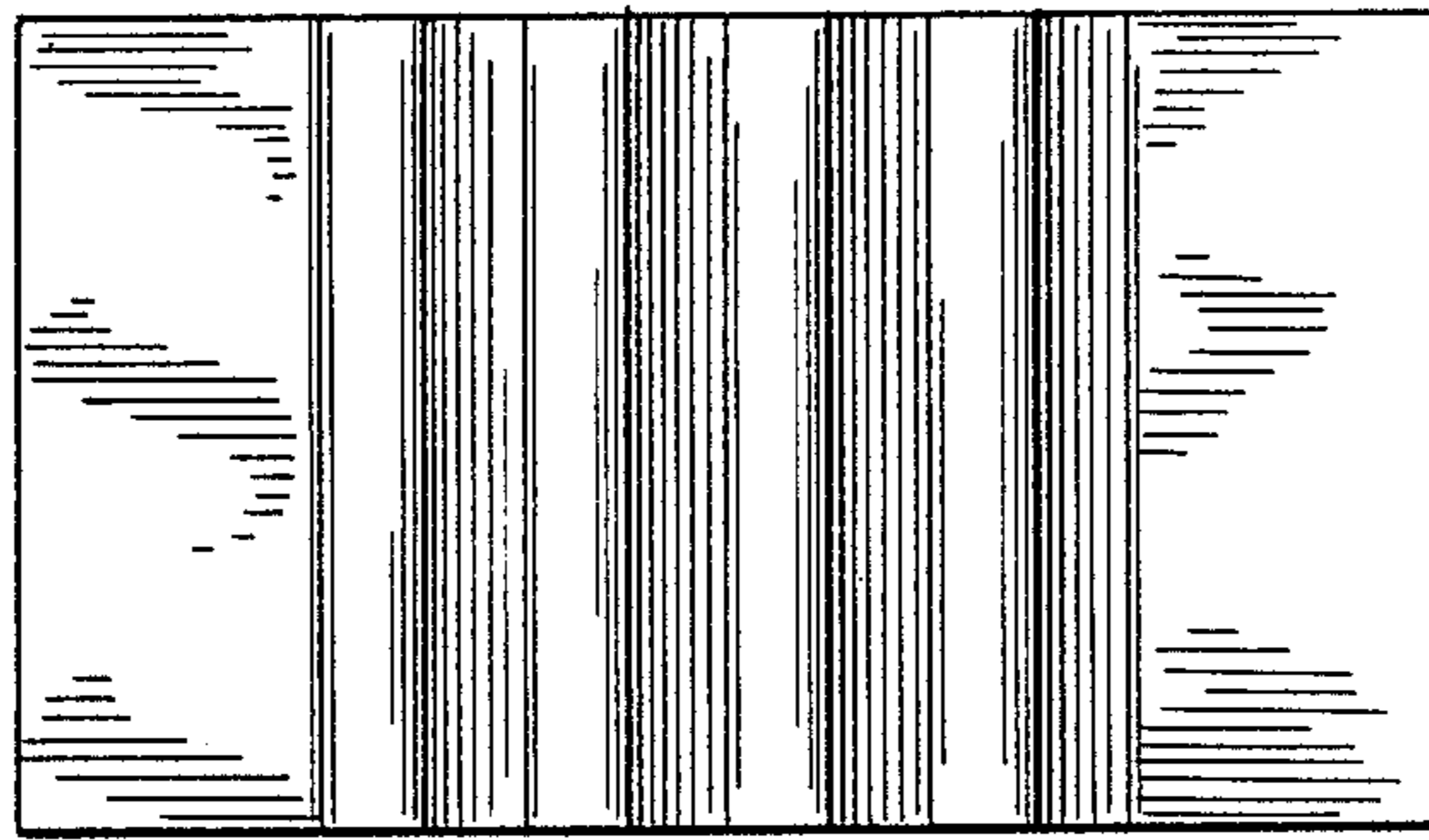

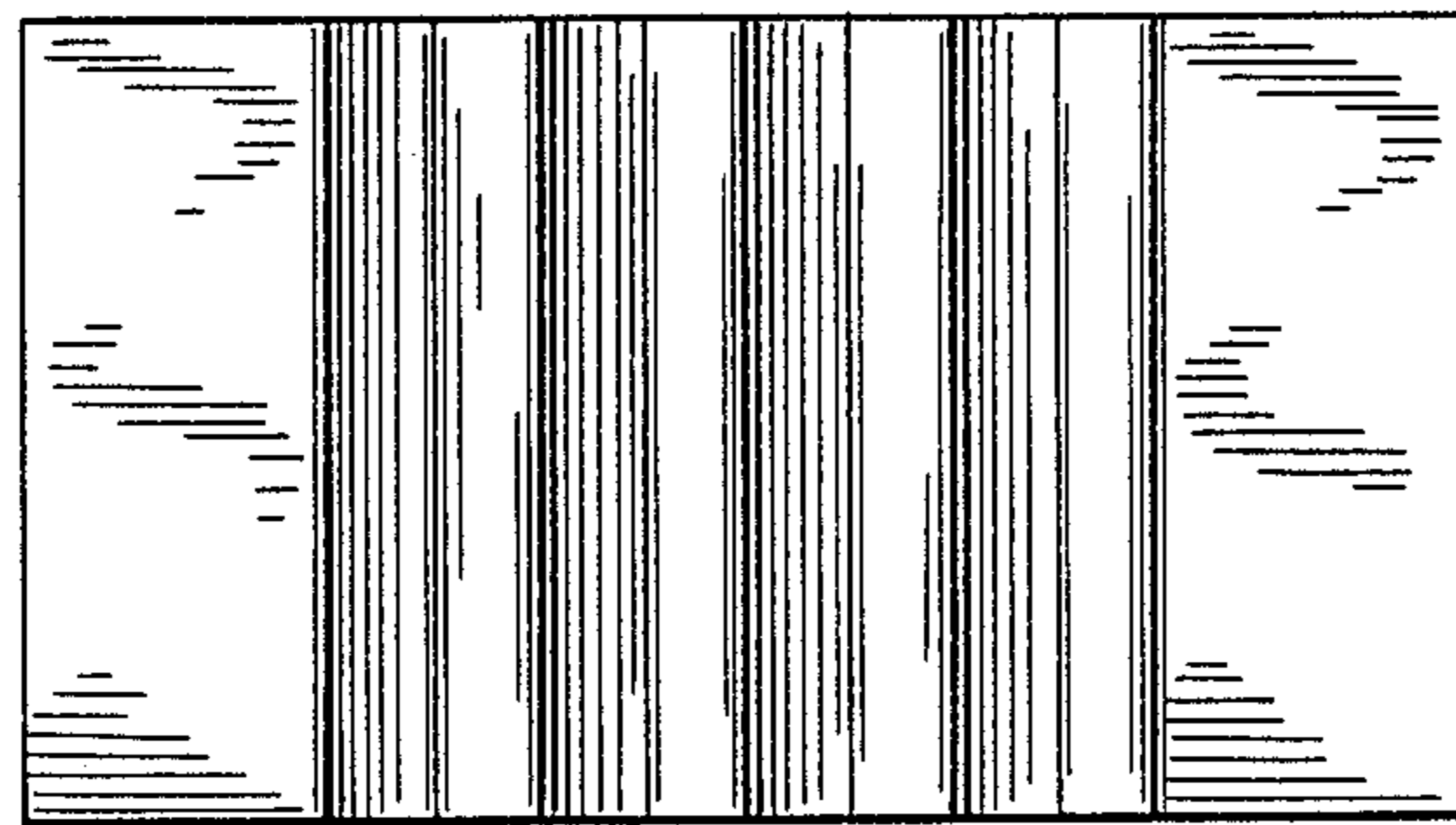
