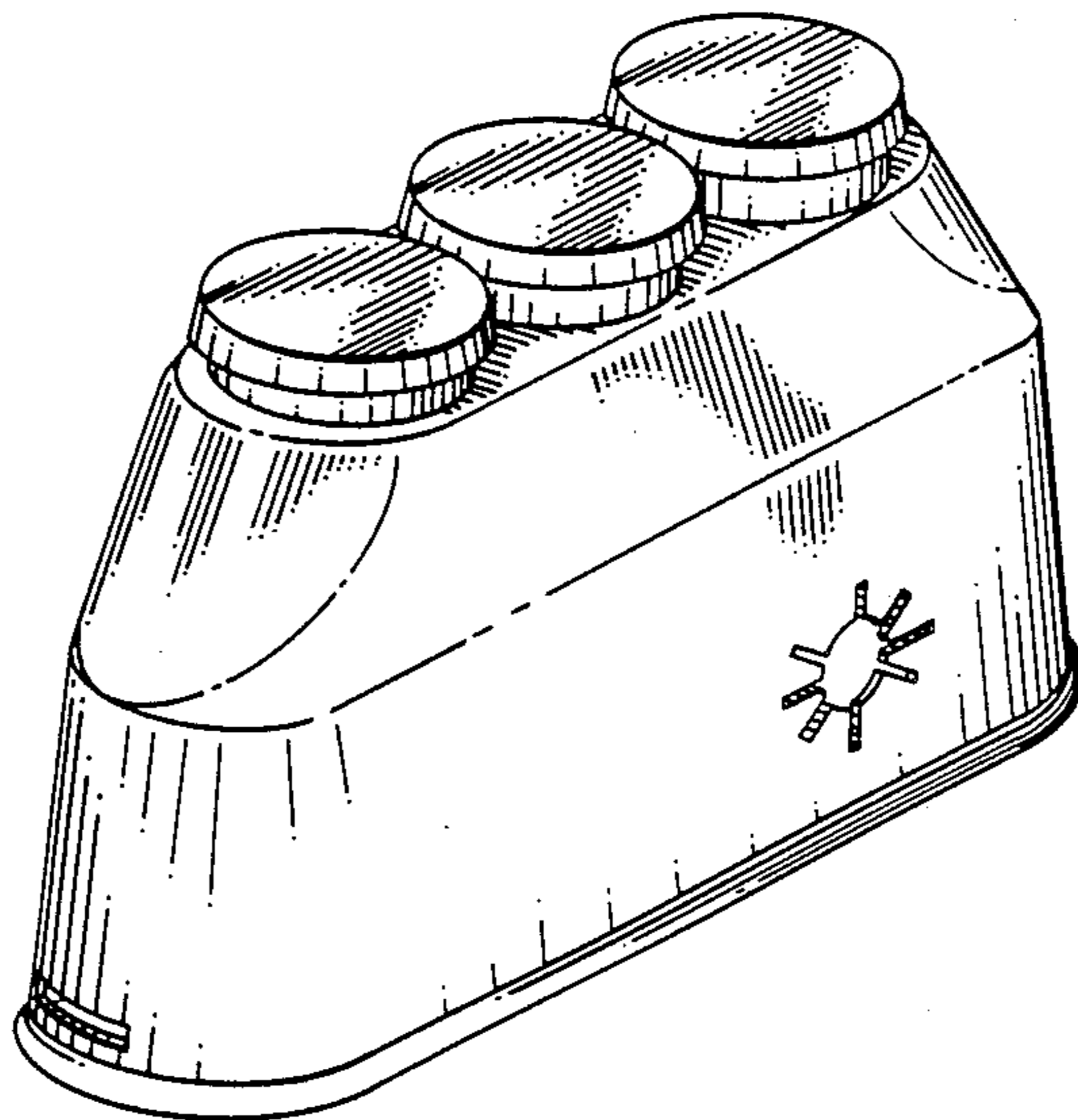

[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a quiver hood for archery bows, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a quiver hood for archery bows showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a front side elevational view;
FIG. 3 is a rear side elevational view;
FIG. 4 is a top view, the opposing bottom view being unornamented; and
FIG. 5 is a left end elevational view, the opposing right end elevation view being a mirror image thereof.



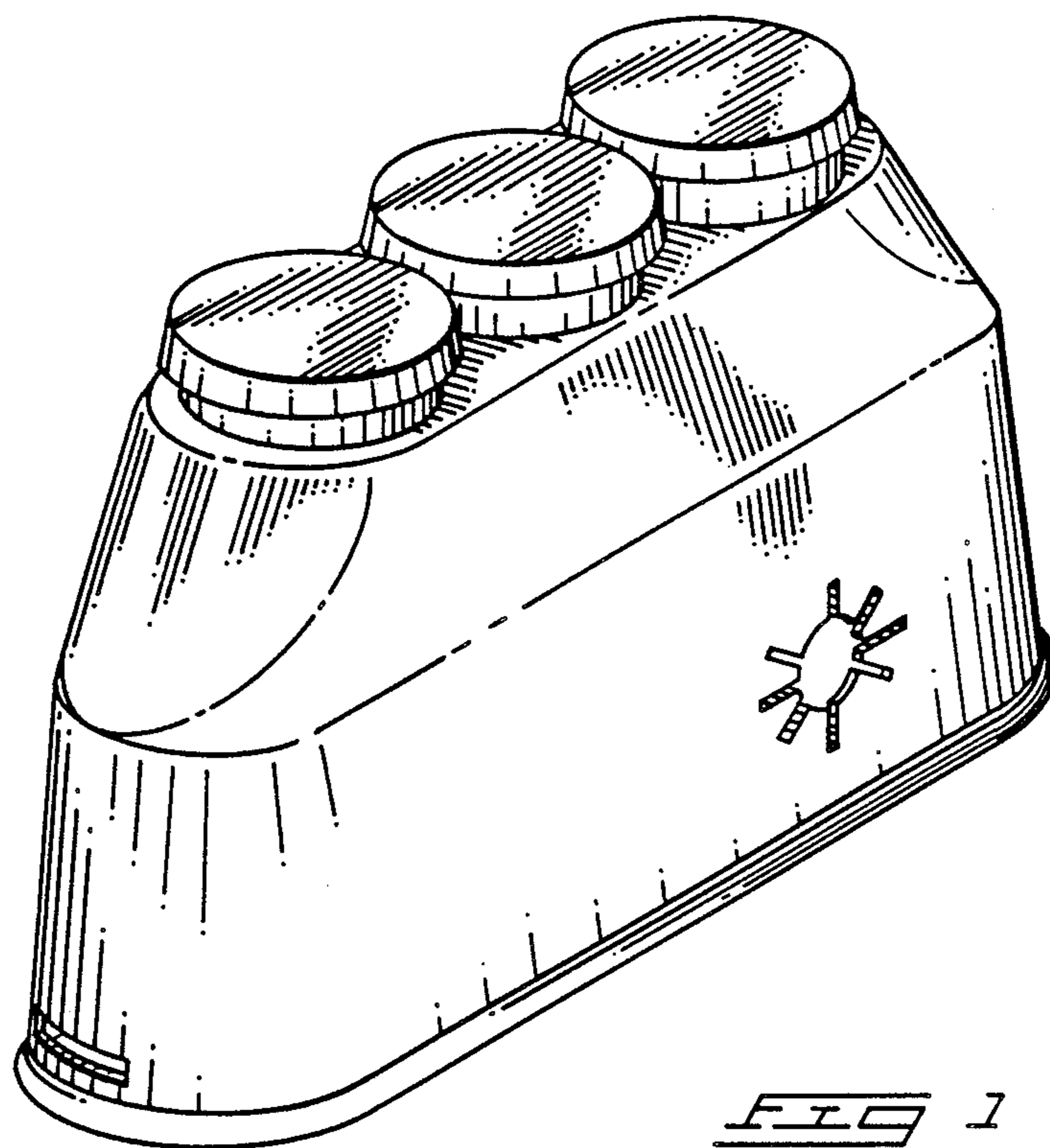

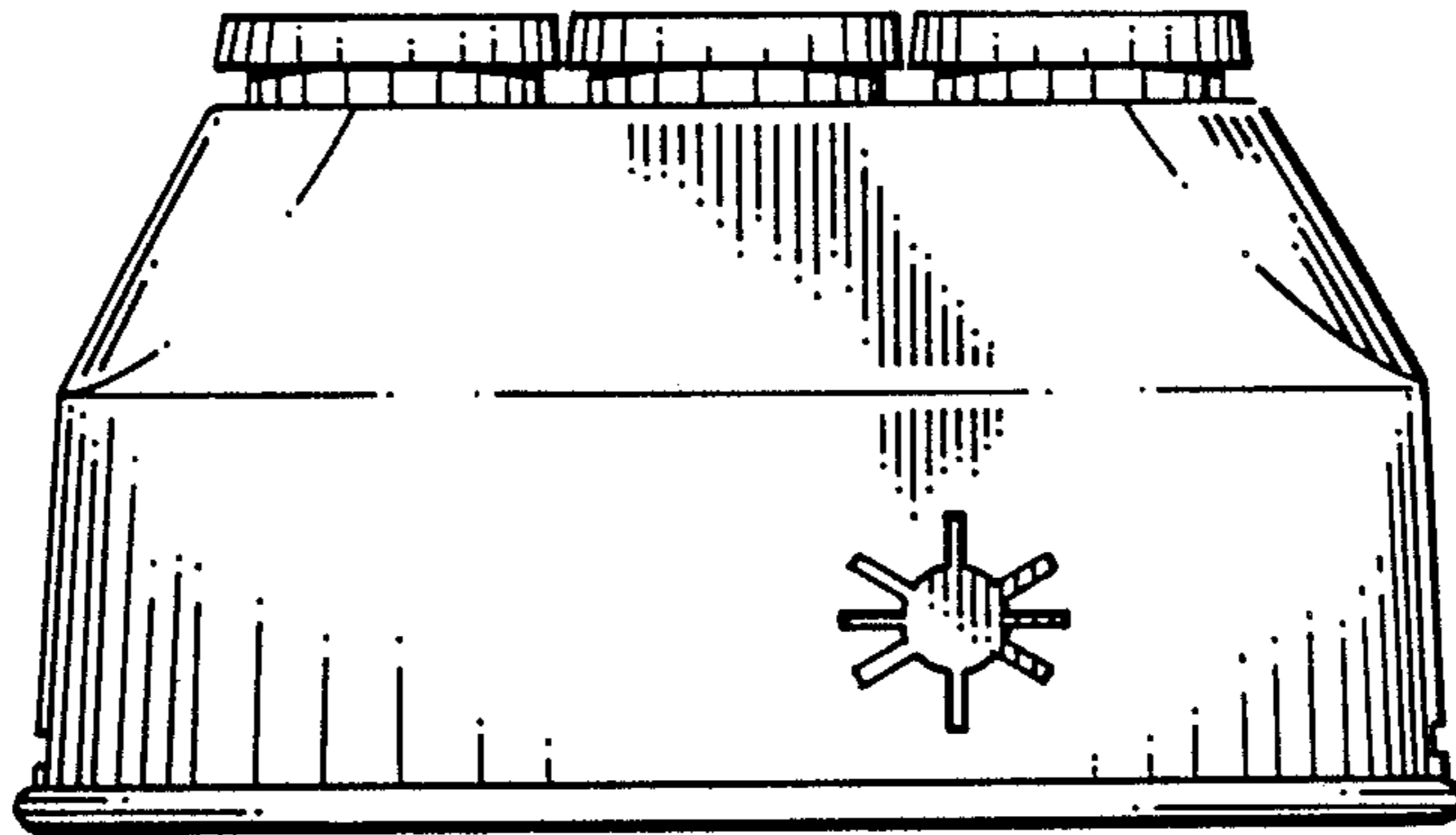

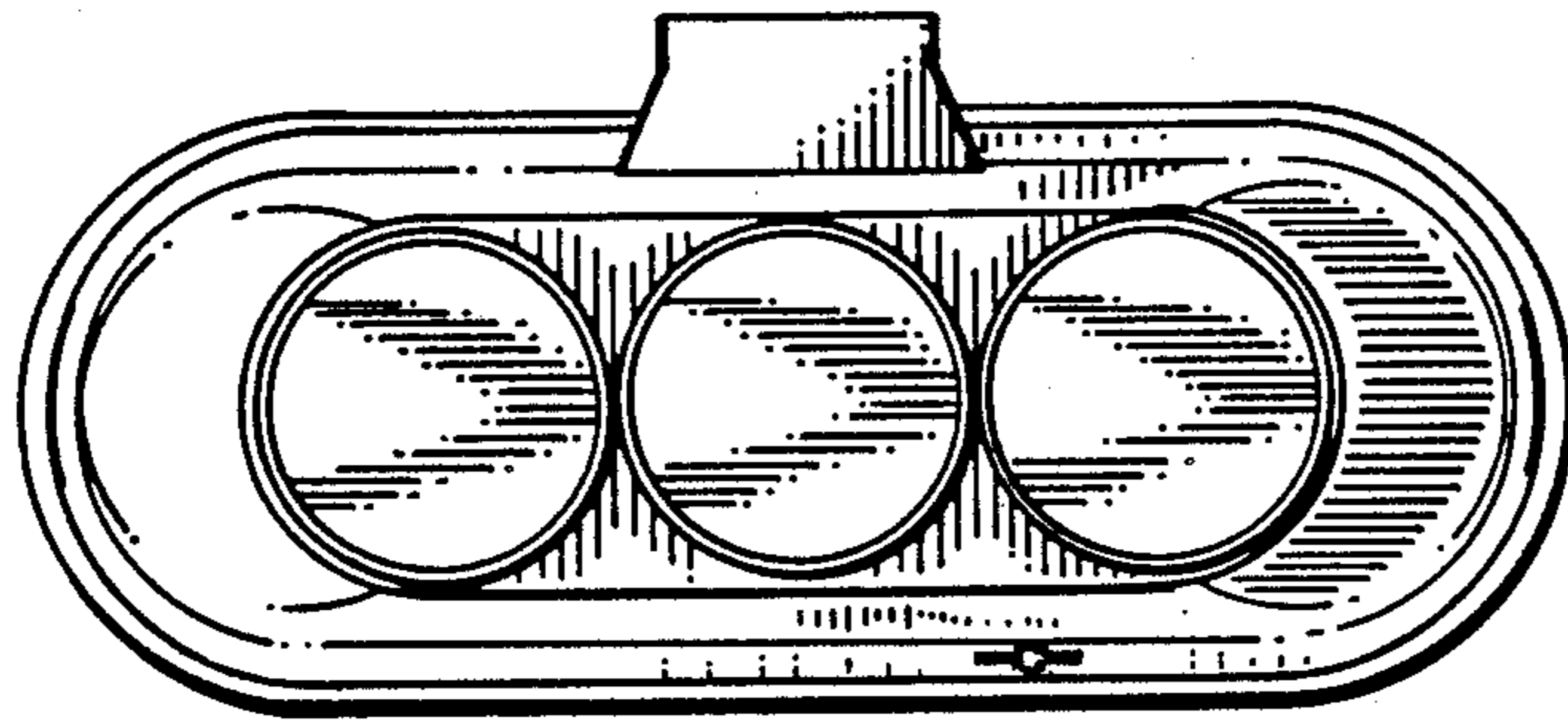
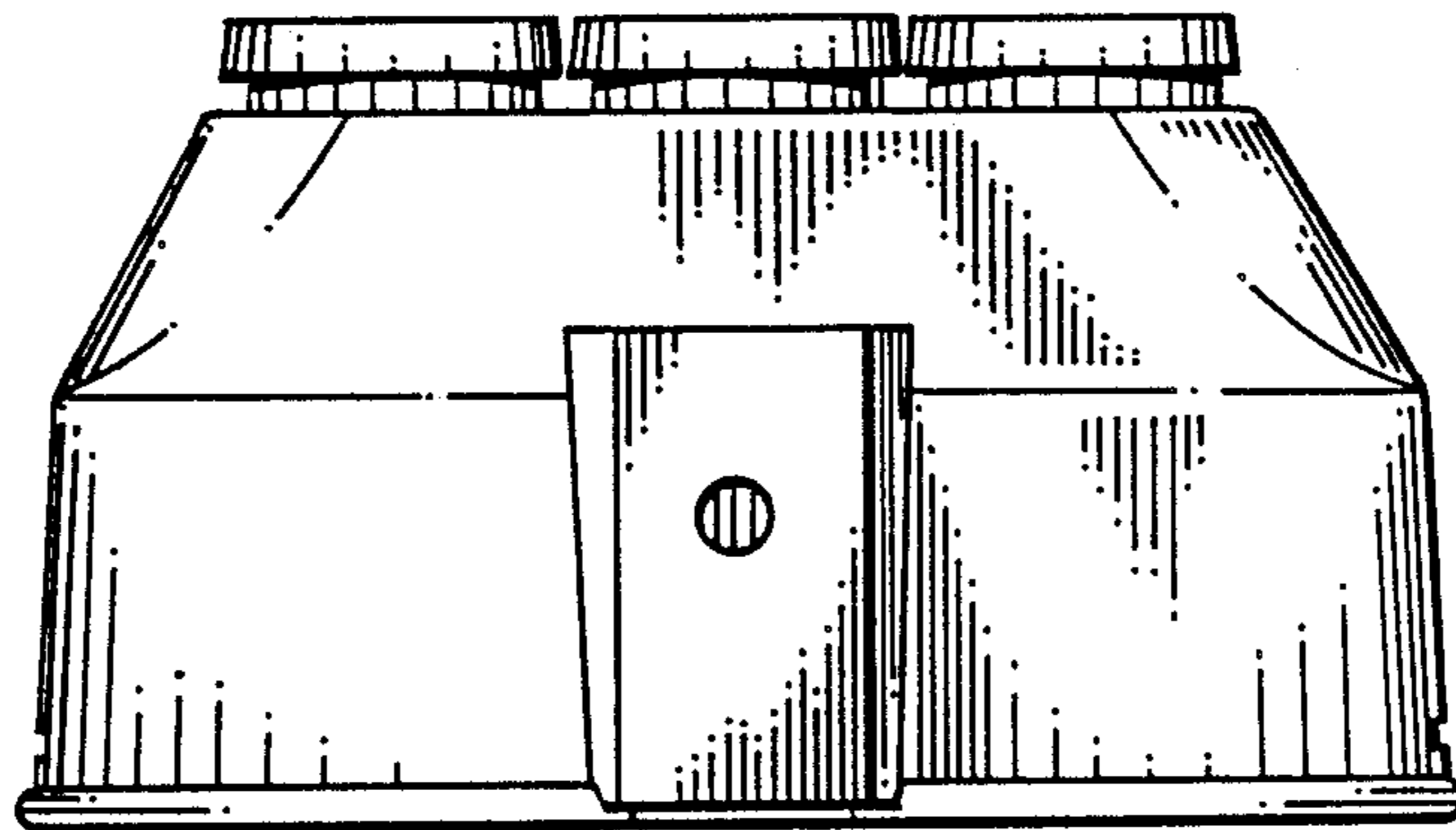

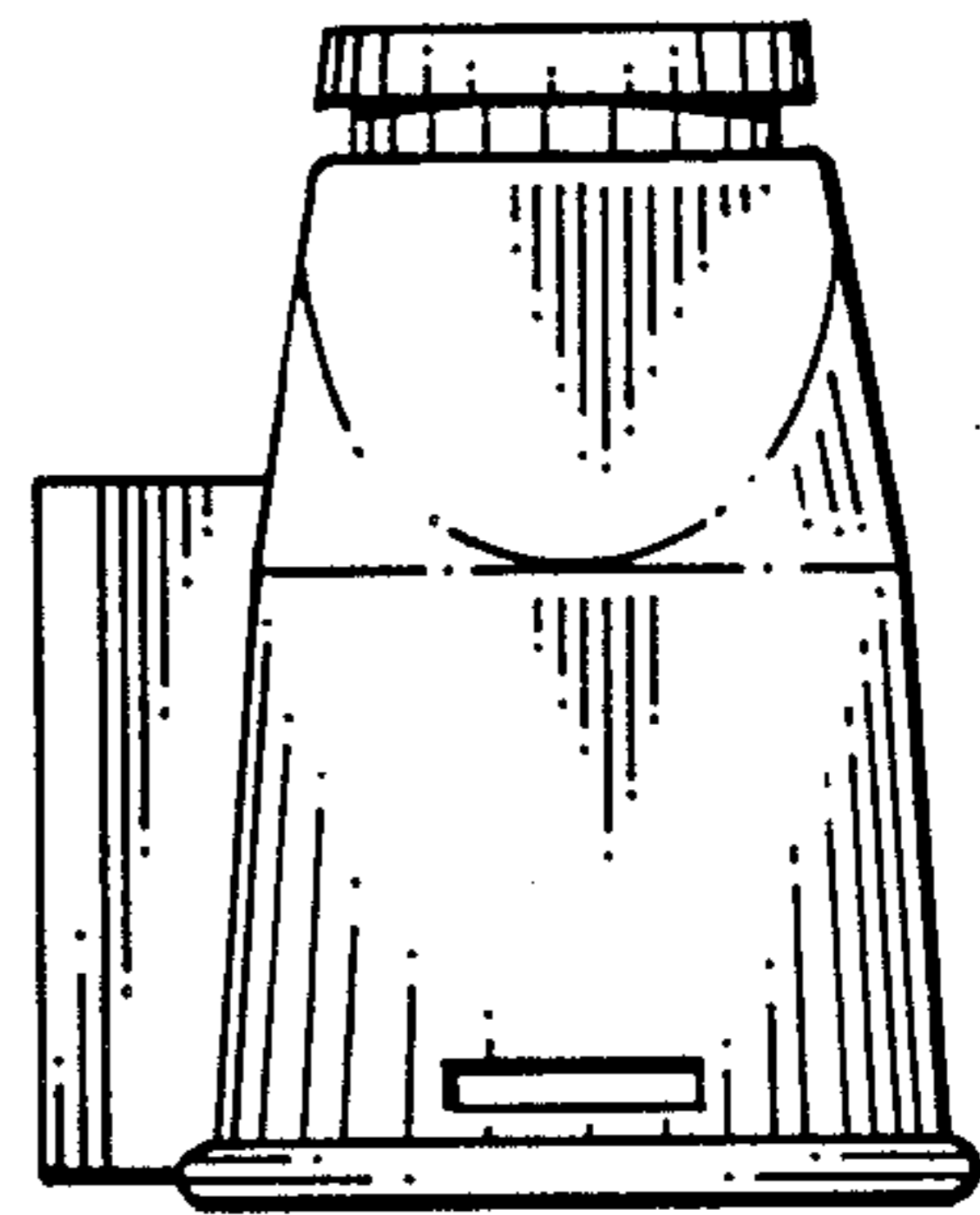
