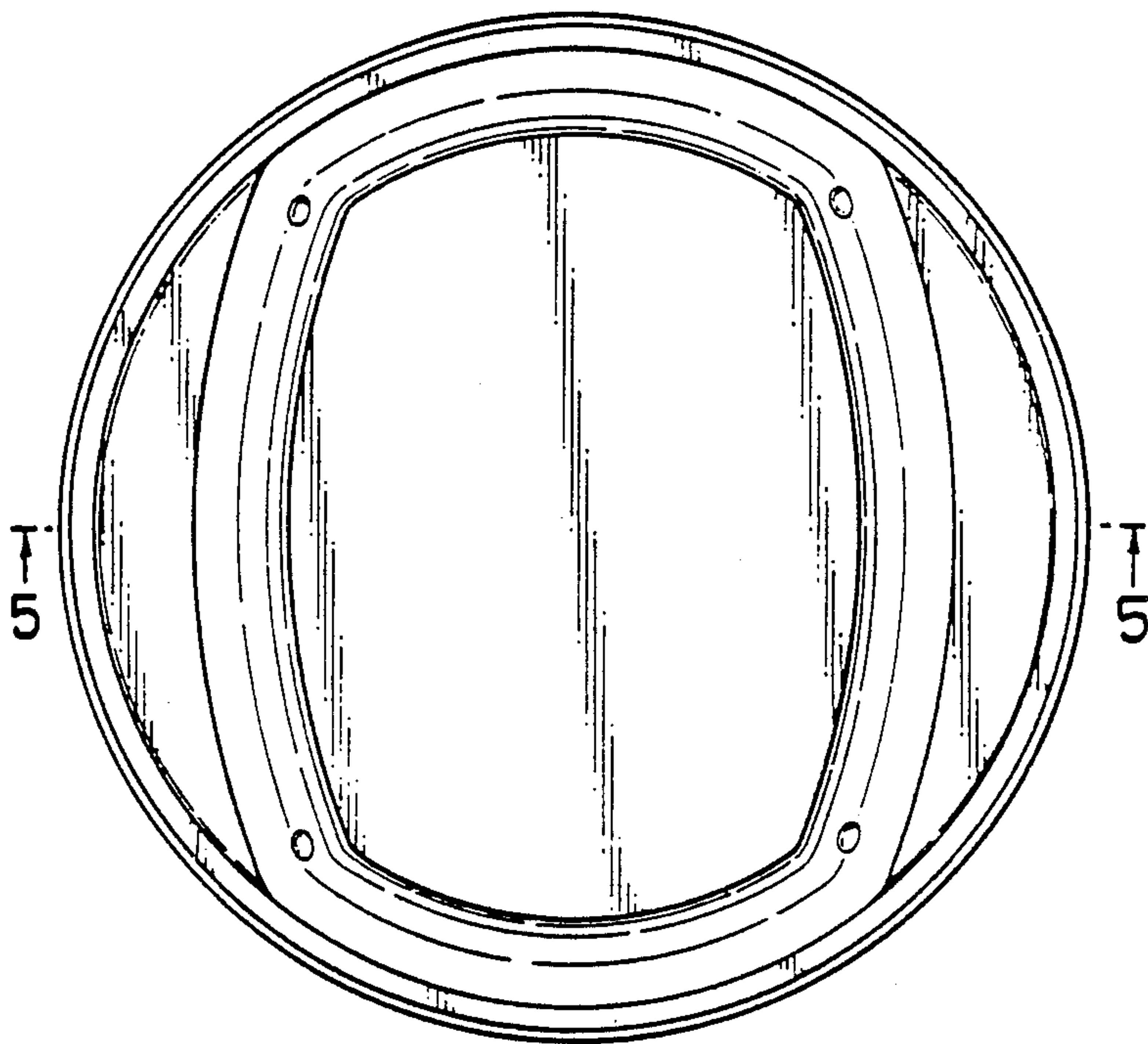

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top plan view of a dish showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a side elevational view, the side opposite is identical thereto;
FIG. 3 is a bottom plan view;

FIG. 5 is a sectional view taken on line 5—5 of FIG. 1.



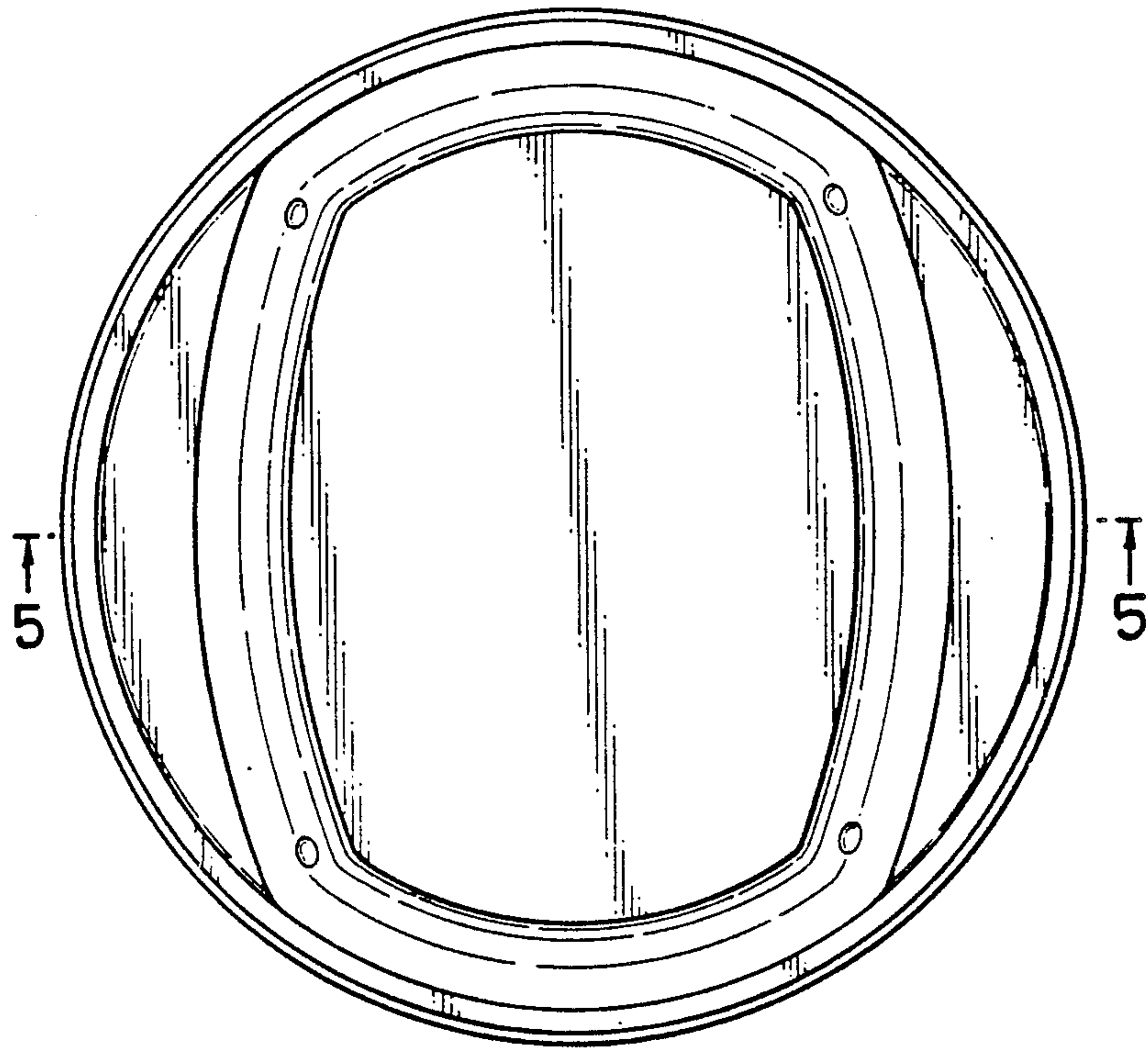

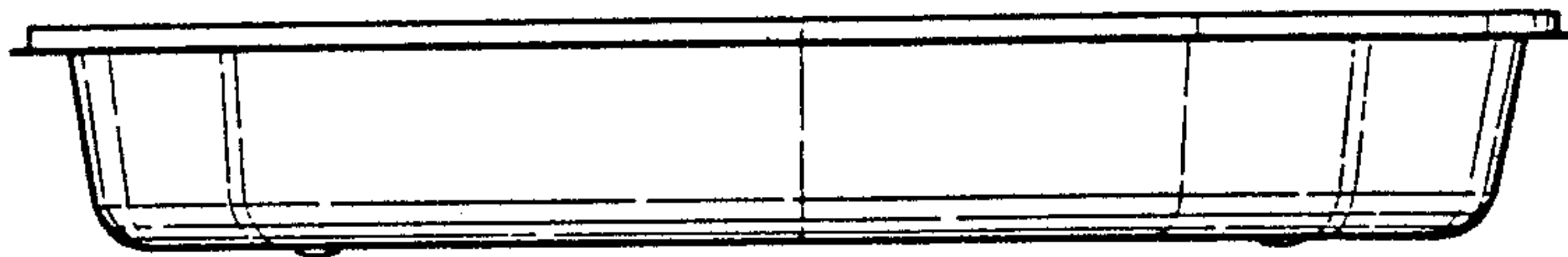

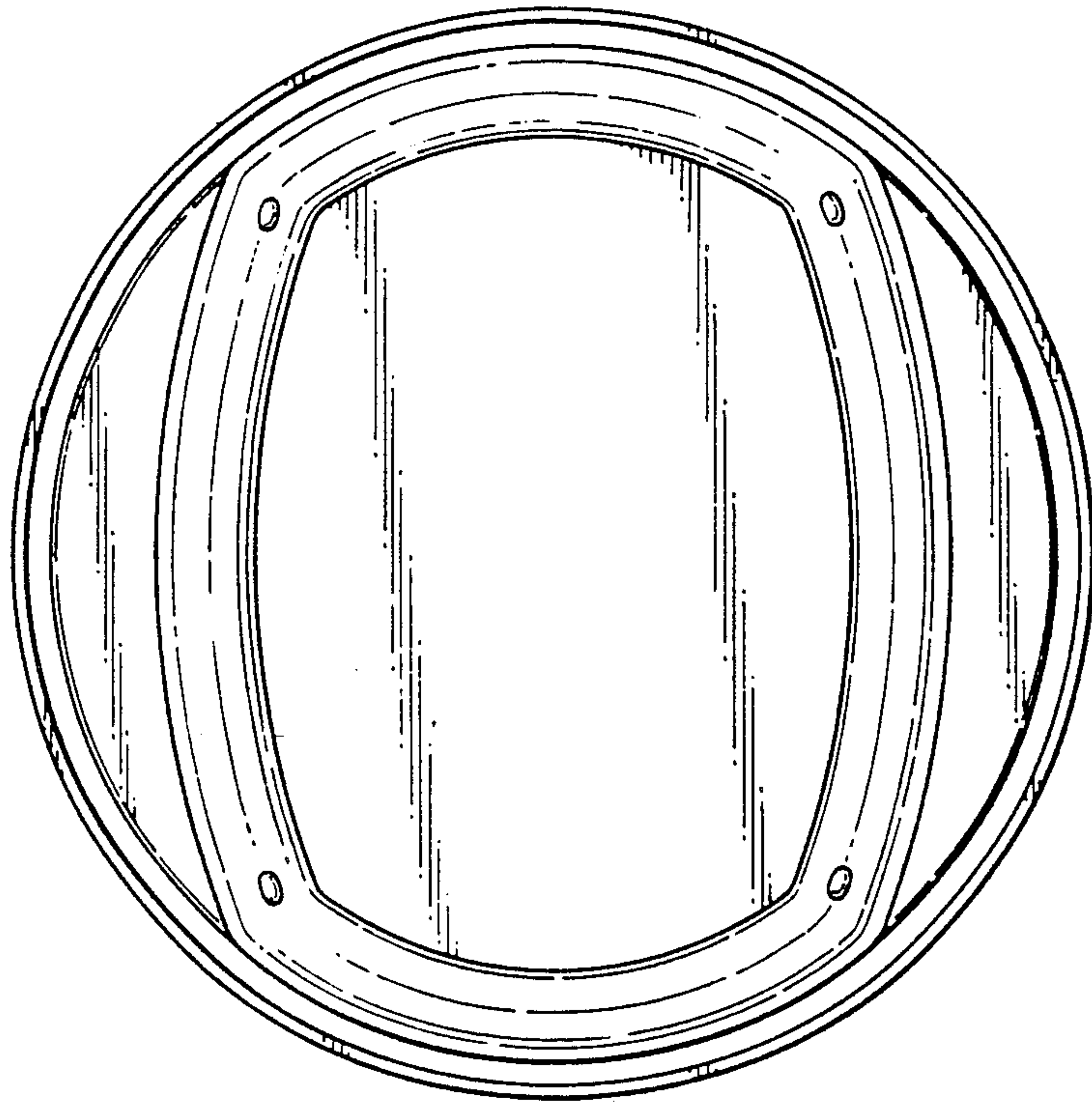

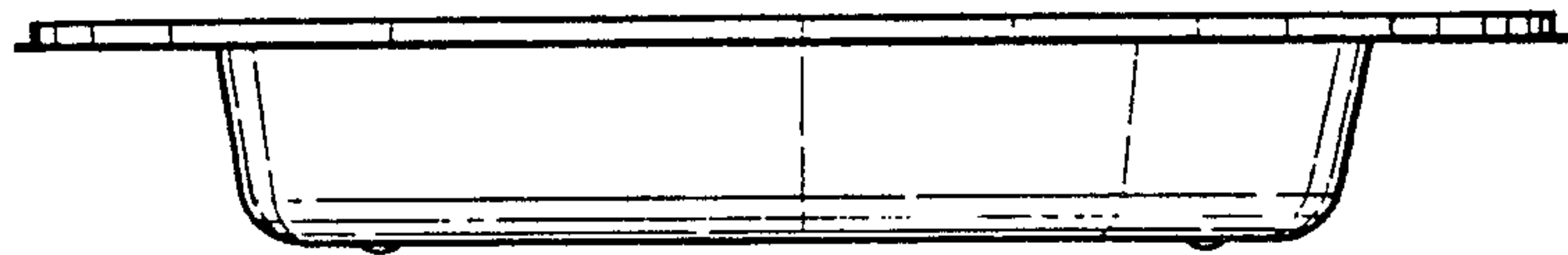

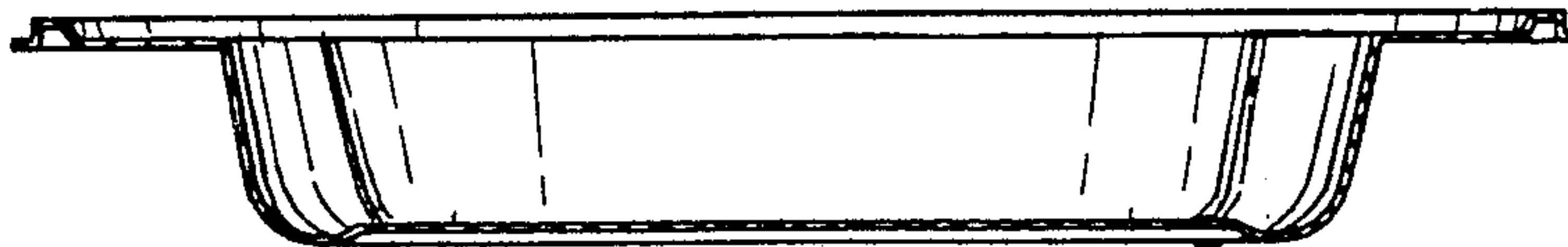
