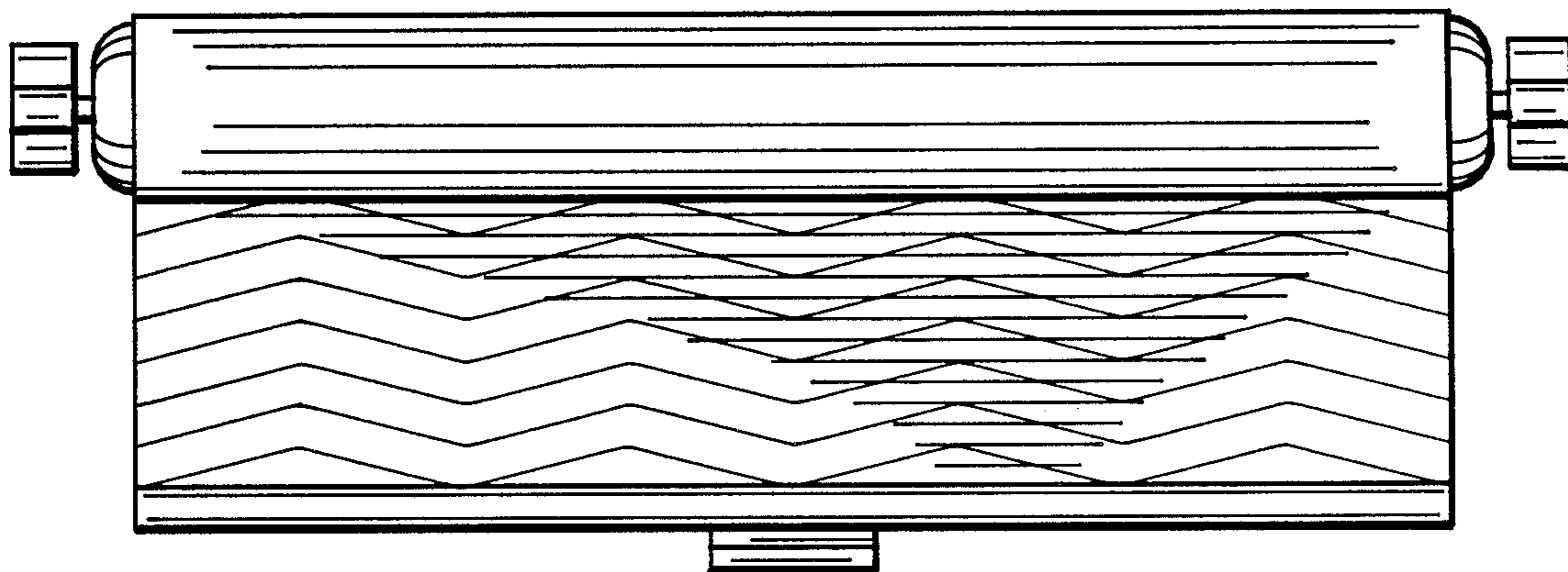

The ornamental design for a vehicle visor-shade, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a vehicle visor-shade showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a rear elevational view thereof;

FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view thereof.



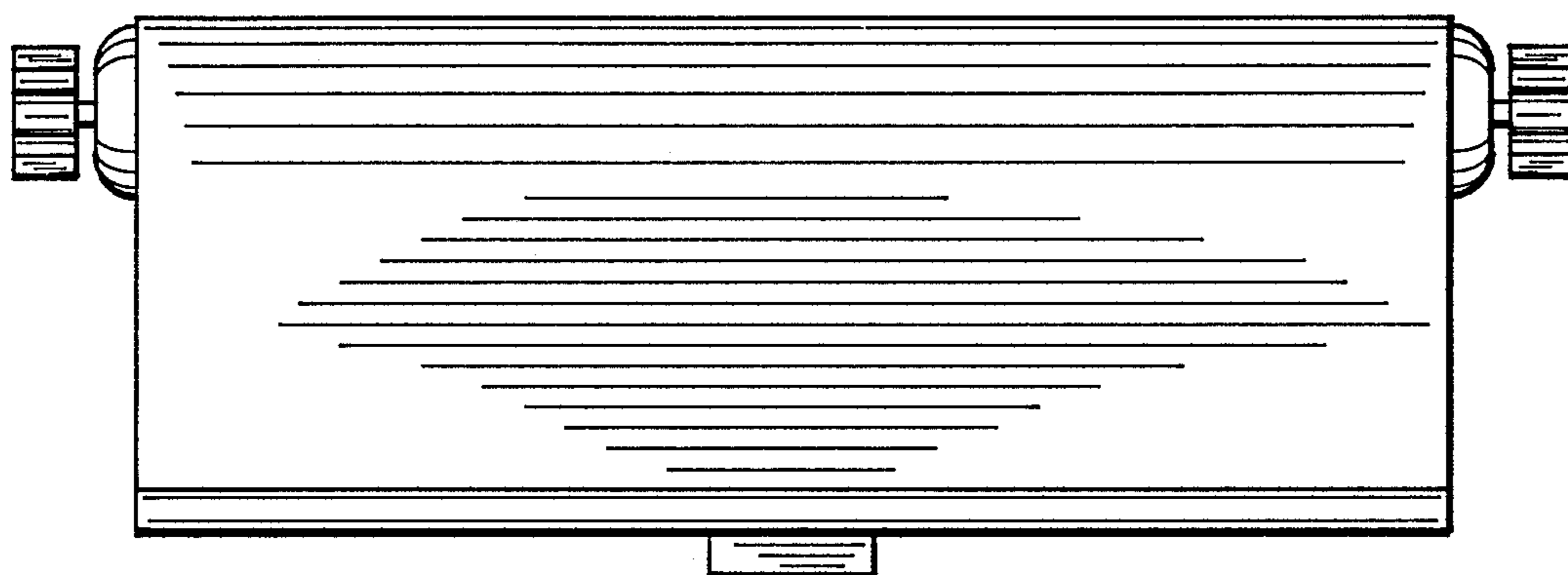

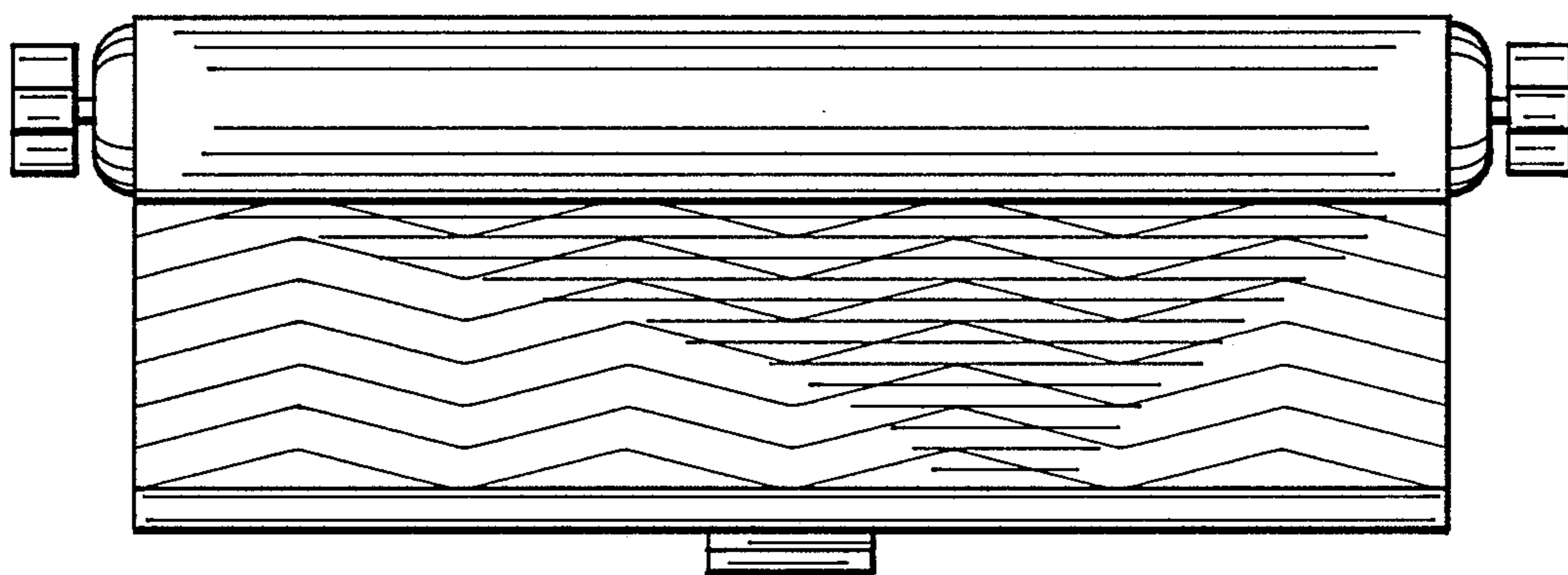

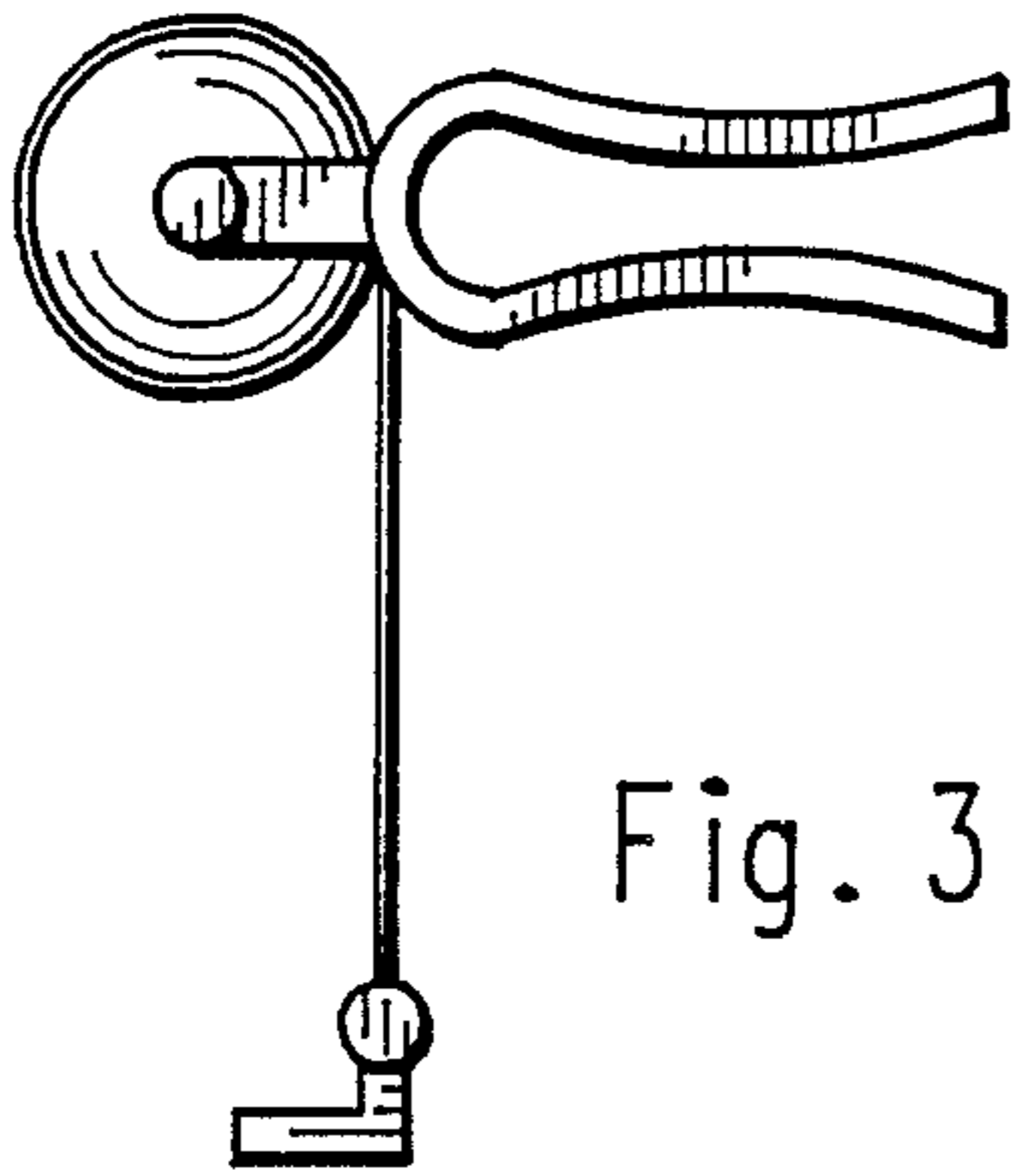

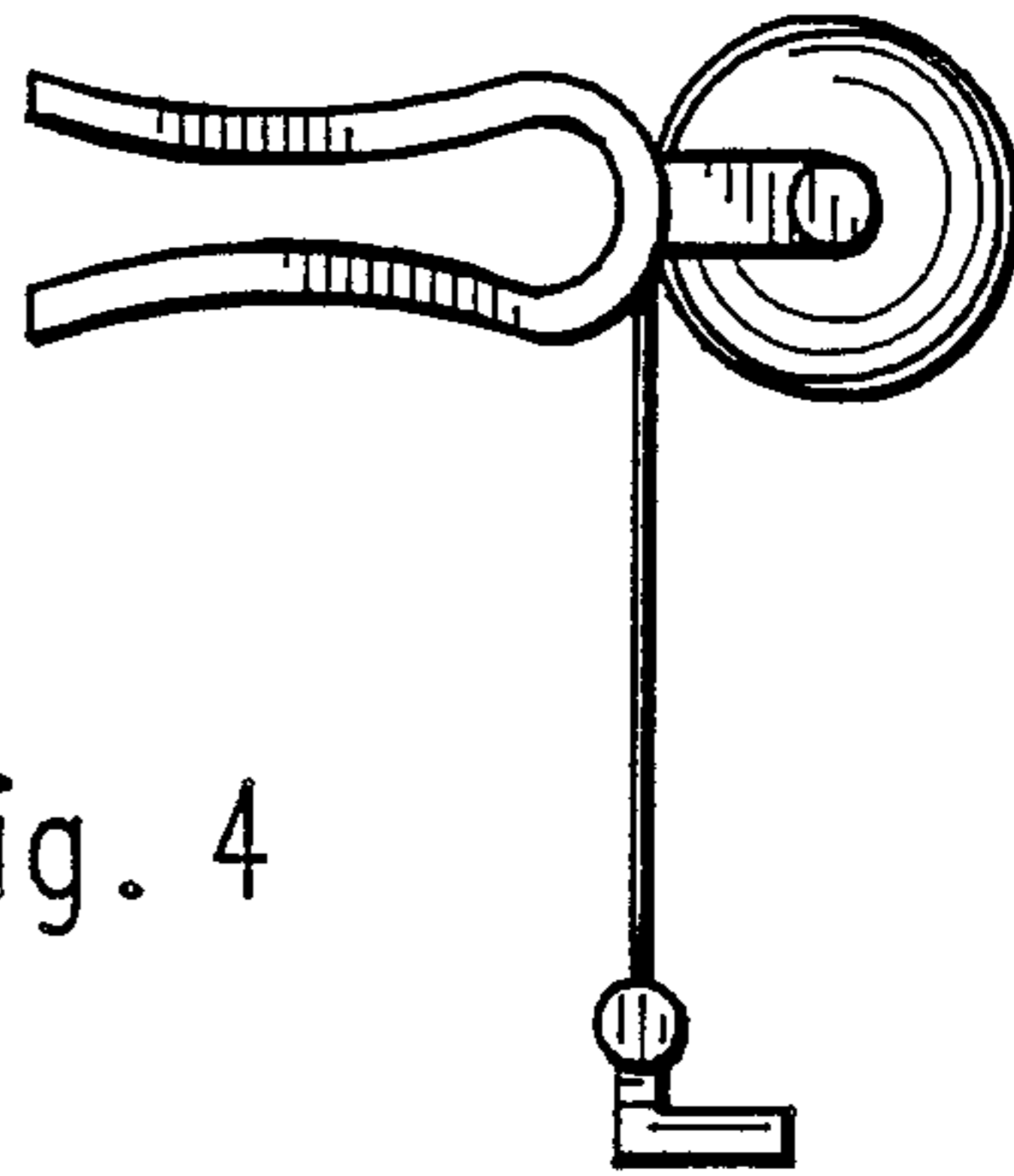

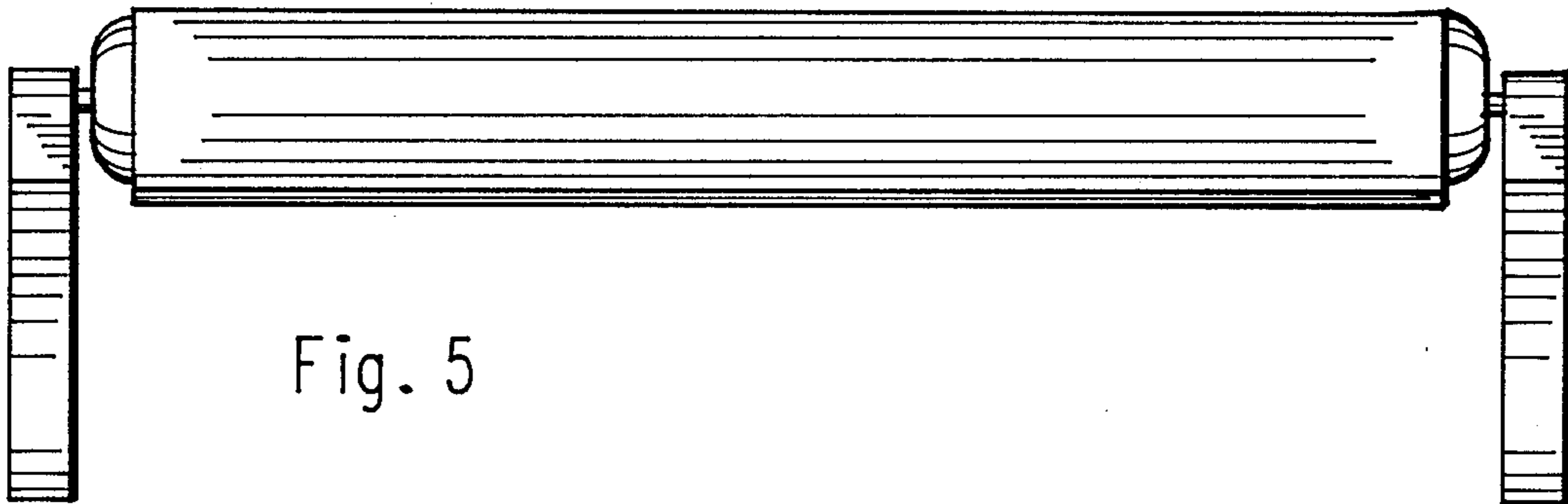

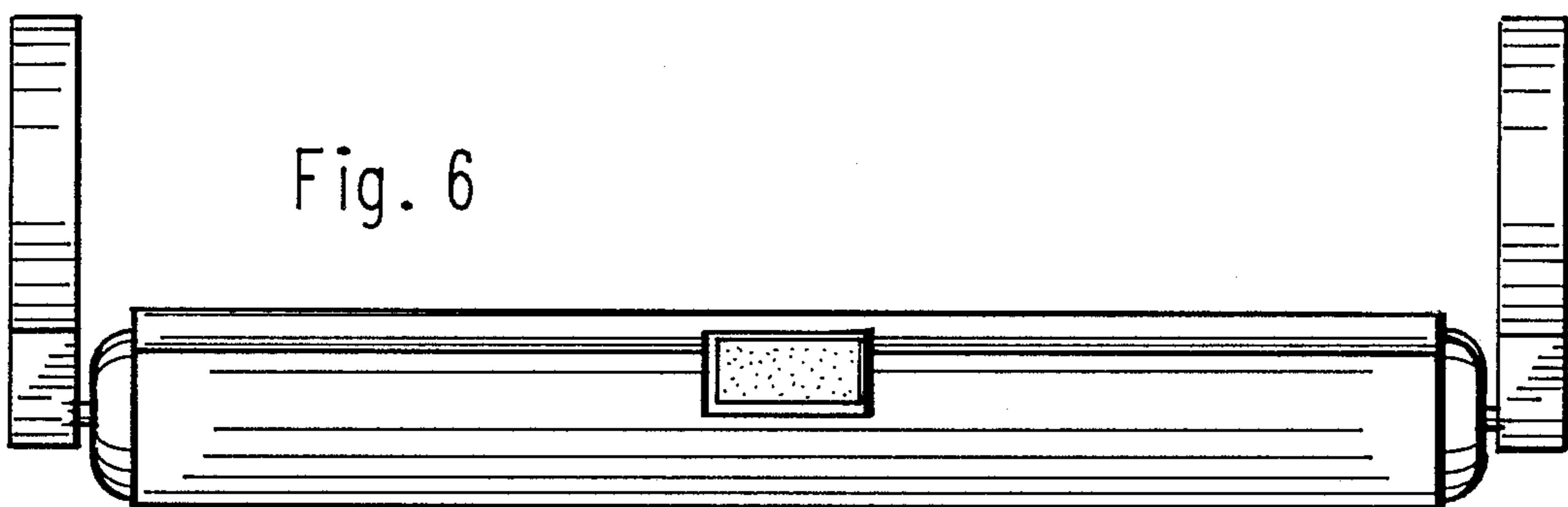
