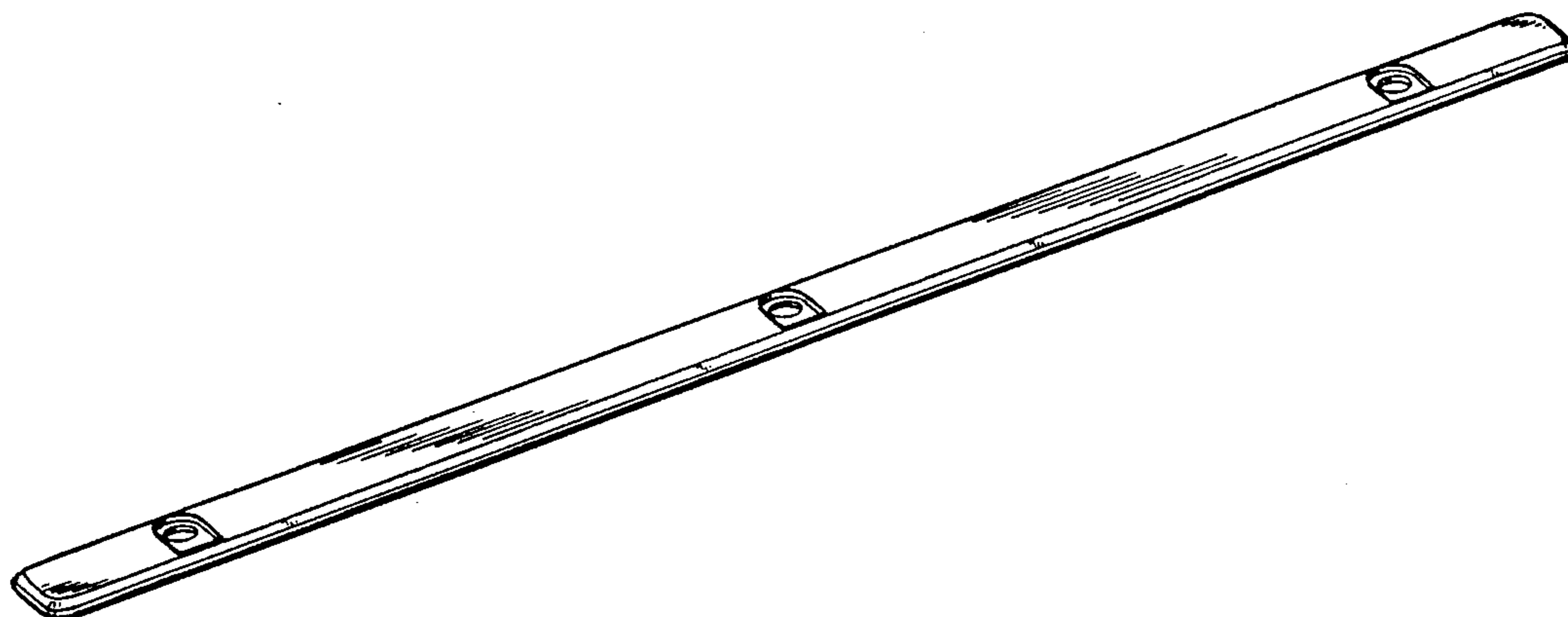

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a binding strip showing our new design;
FIG. 2 is an end elevational view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a top plan view thereof;
FIG. 4 is a side elevational view thereof;
FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view thereof; and
FIG. 6 is an enlarged perspective view of a portion thereof.



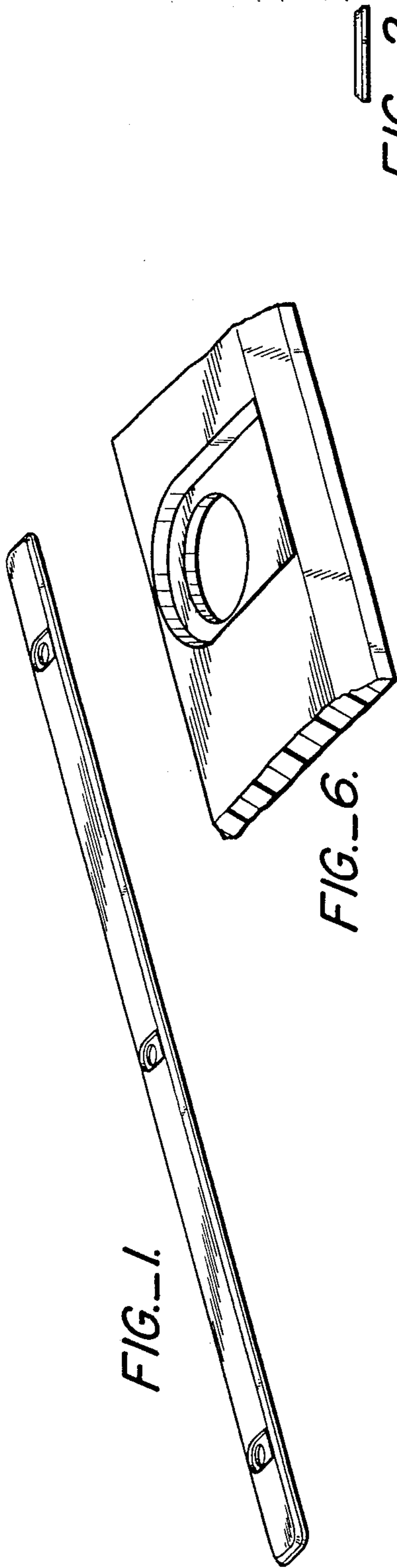
