The ornamental design for picture frame assembly or similar article, as shown and described.

## **DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a picture frame assembly or similar article showing our new design;
FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a front elevational view thereof;
FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view thereof;
FIG. 5 is a rear elevational view thereof;
FIG. 6 is an enlarged sectional view taken along line 6—6 of FIG. 3;
FIG. 7 is an enlarged sectional perspective view taken

along line 7—7 of FIG. 3; FIG. 8 is a right side elevational view thereof, the oppo-

site side being a mirror image; FIG. 9 is a perspective view thereof in an alternate position;


FIG. 10 is a top plan view of FIG. 9;

FIG. 14 is a right side elevational view of FIG. 9, the opposite side being a mirror image.



























