[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a clip for securing beach towels to chairs or the like, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a clip for securing beach towels to chairs or the like showing our new design; FIG. 2 is a side elevational view thereof, the opposite side being a mirror image of that shown; FIG. 3 is a top plan view thereof; FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view thereof; FIG. 5 is an end elevational thereof; and FIG. 6 is an opposite end elevational view thereof.
