[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a combined maternity flota-

tion unit and removable central cushion, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top plan view of a combined maternity flotation unit and removable central cushion showing my new design;

FIG. 2 is a bottom plan view thereof;

FIG. 3 is a side elevational view thereof, the opposite side being a mirror image of that shown;

FIG. 4 is a vertical cross-sectional view thereof, taken along line 4—4 of FIG. 1;

FIG. 5 is an end elevational view thereof;

FIG. 6 is an opposite end elevational view thereof;

FIG. 7 is a vertical, cross-sectional view thereof, taken along line 7—7 of FIG. 1;

FIG. 8 is a top plan view thereof, with the central cushion element removed;

FIG. 9 is a vertical cross-sectional view thereof, taken along line 9—9 of FIG. 8;

FIG. 10 is a vertical cross-sectional view thereof, taken along line 10—10 of FIG. 8;

FIG. 11 is a top plan view of the removable central cushion element thereof;

FIG. 12 is a side elevational view of the removable central cushion element thereof, the opposite side being a mirror image of that shown; and

FIG. 13 is an end elevational view of the removable central cushion element thereof, the opposite end being a mirror image of that shown.
