The ornamental design for a sign holder, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a sign holder showing my new design;
 FIG. 2 is a back elevational view thereof;
 FIG. 3 is a top plan view thereof;
 FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view thereof;
 FIG. 5 is a side elevational view thereof, the opposite side being a mirror image;
 FIG. 6 is a perspective view thereof; and
 FIG. 7 is an exploded perspective view thereof with a sign shown in broken lines for illustrative purposes.

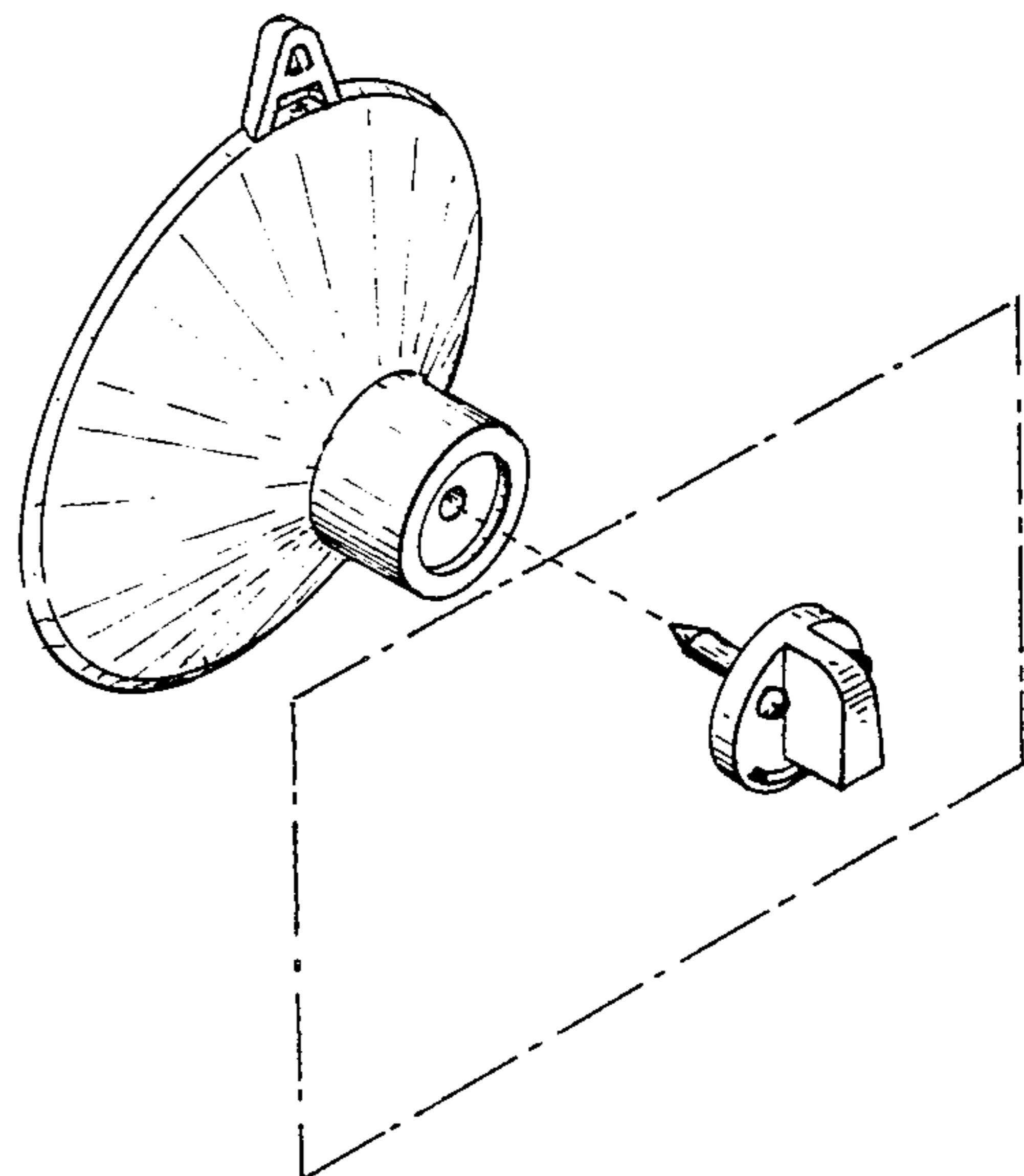
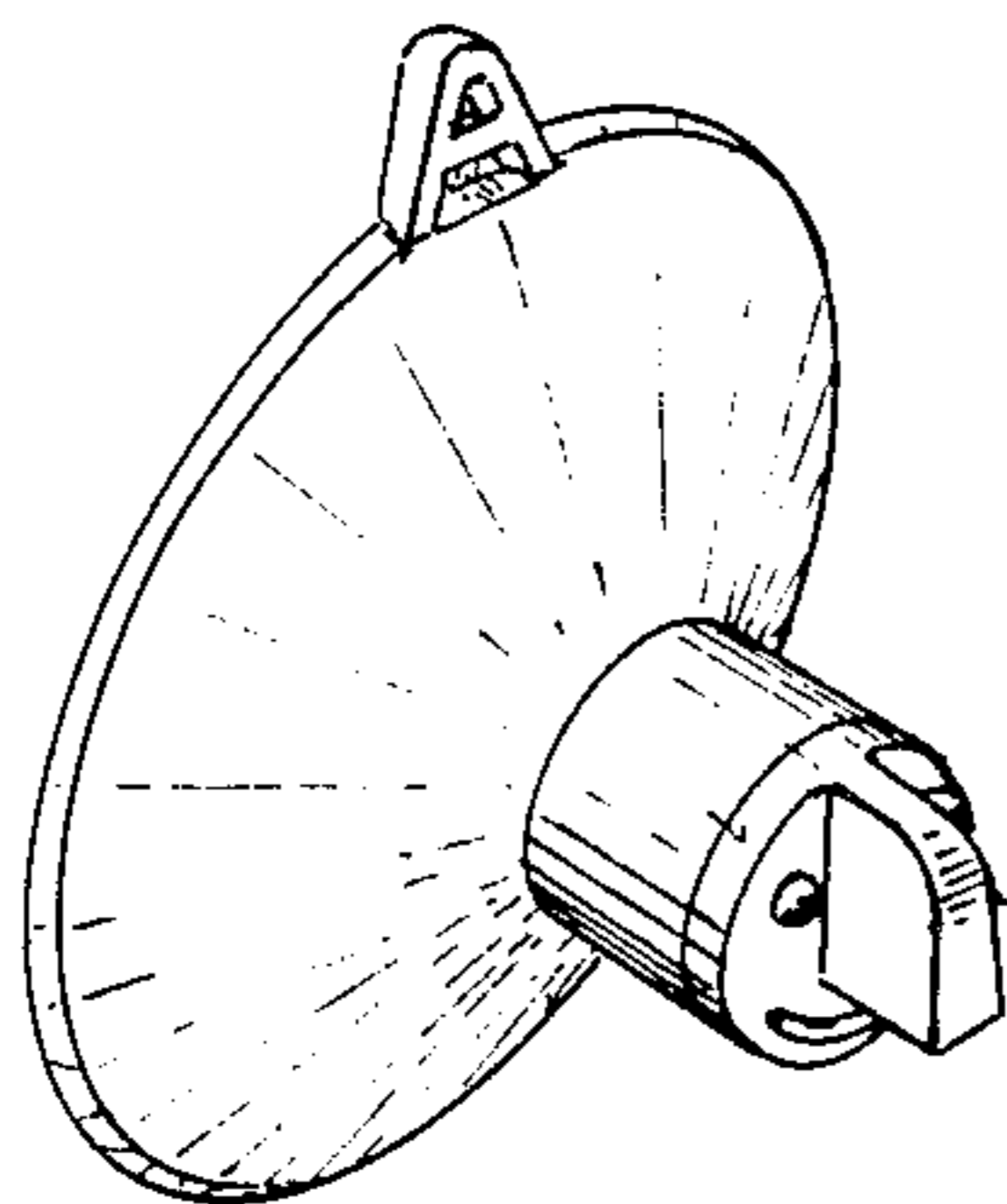

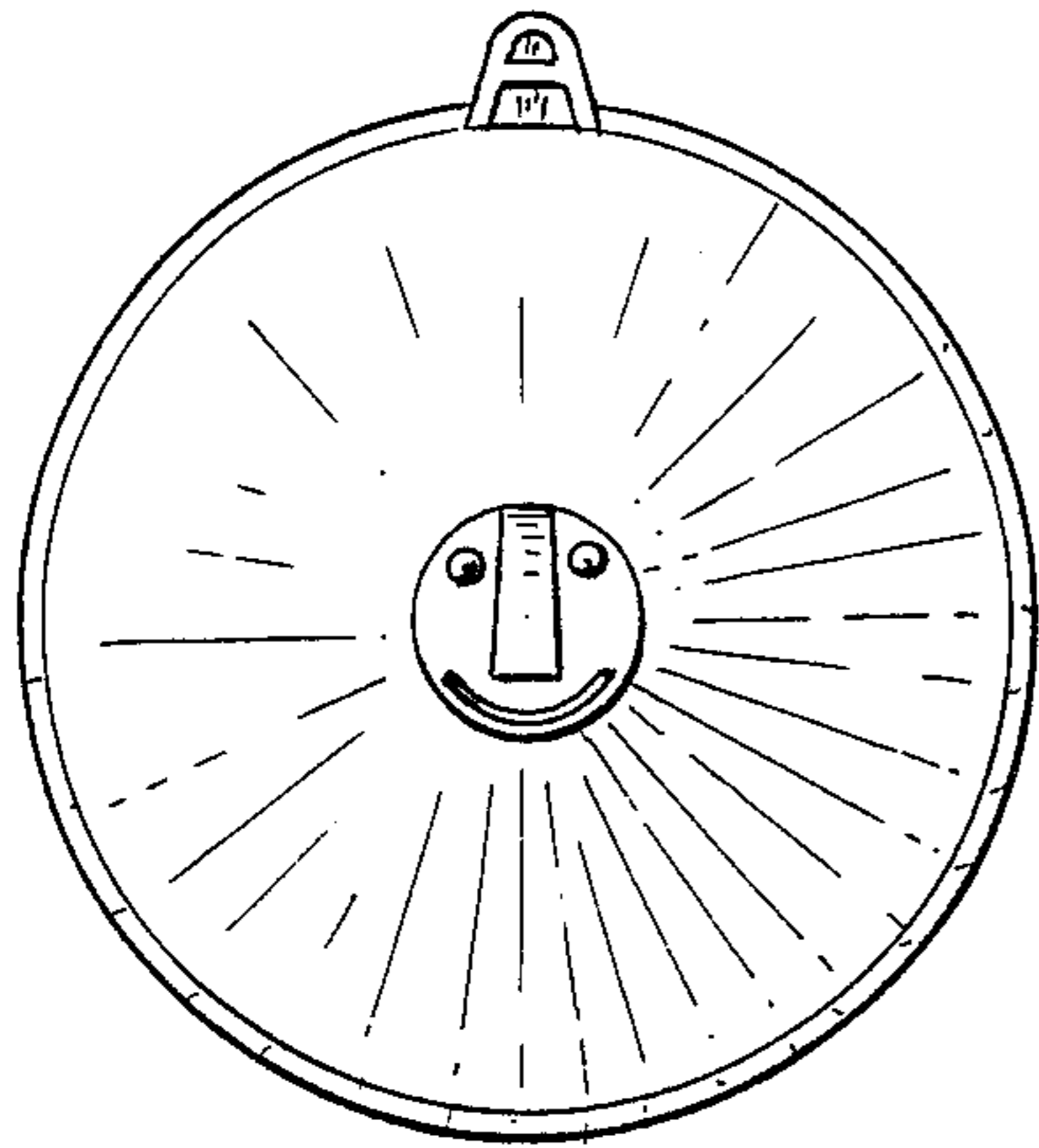

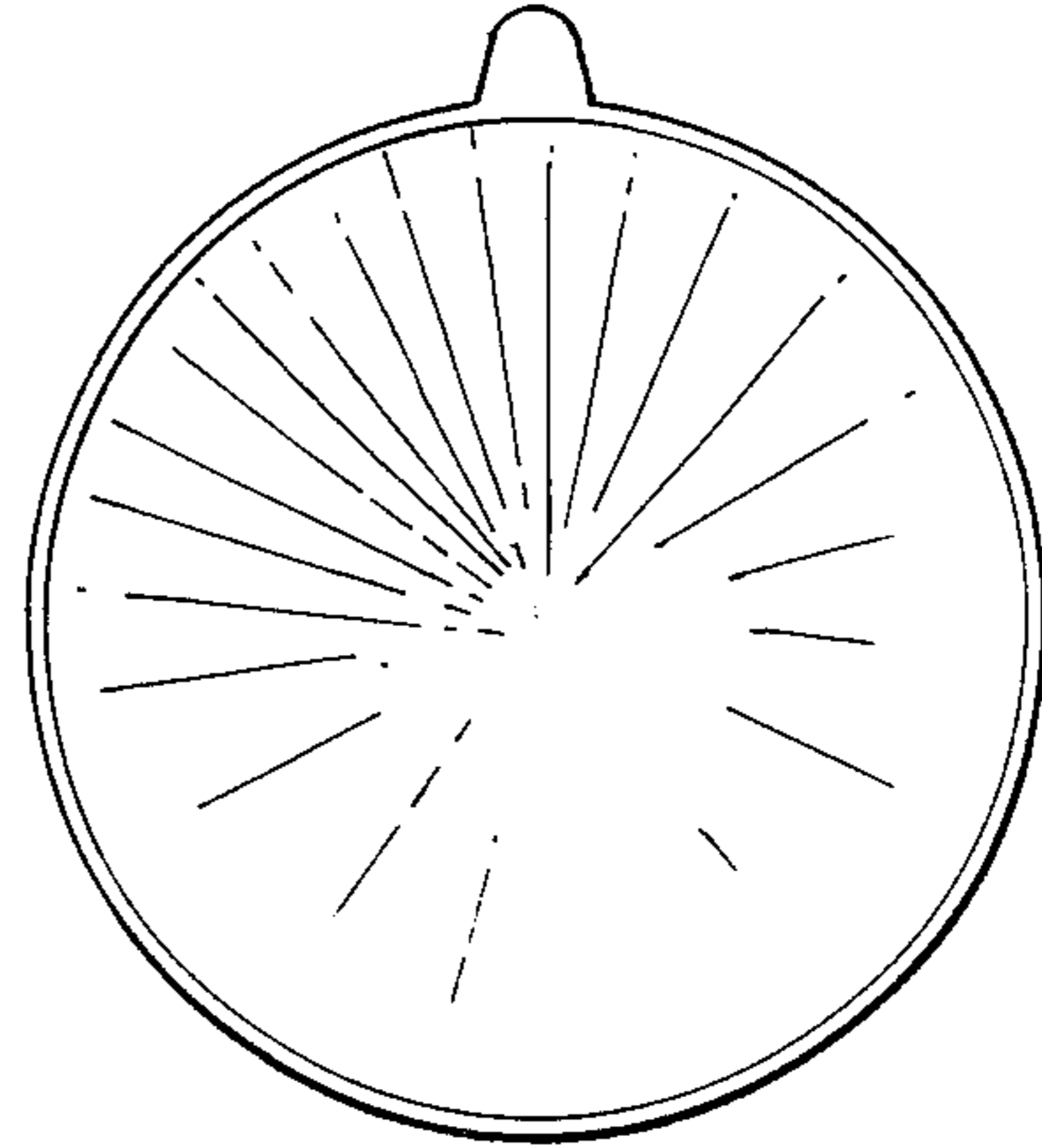

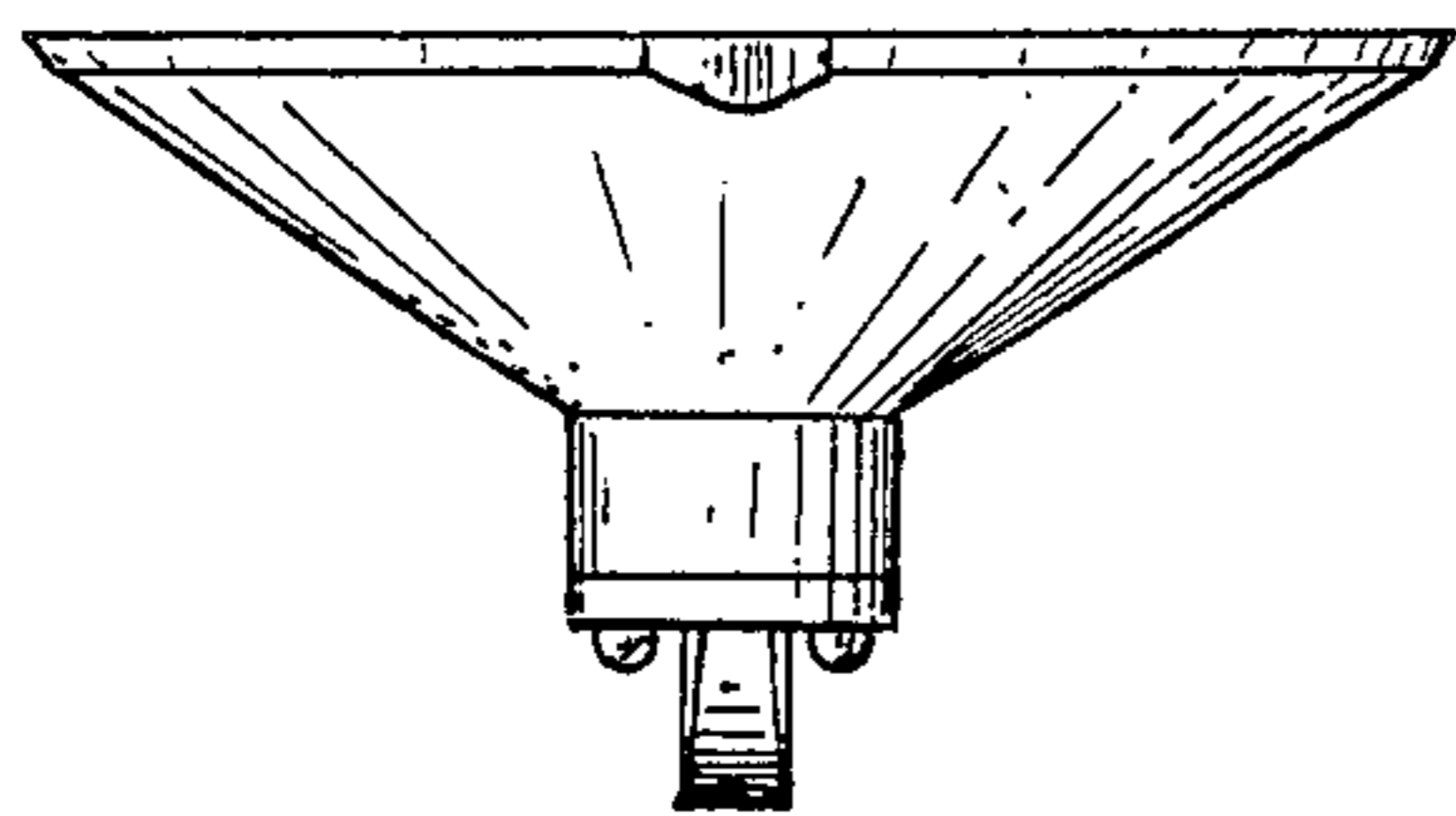

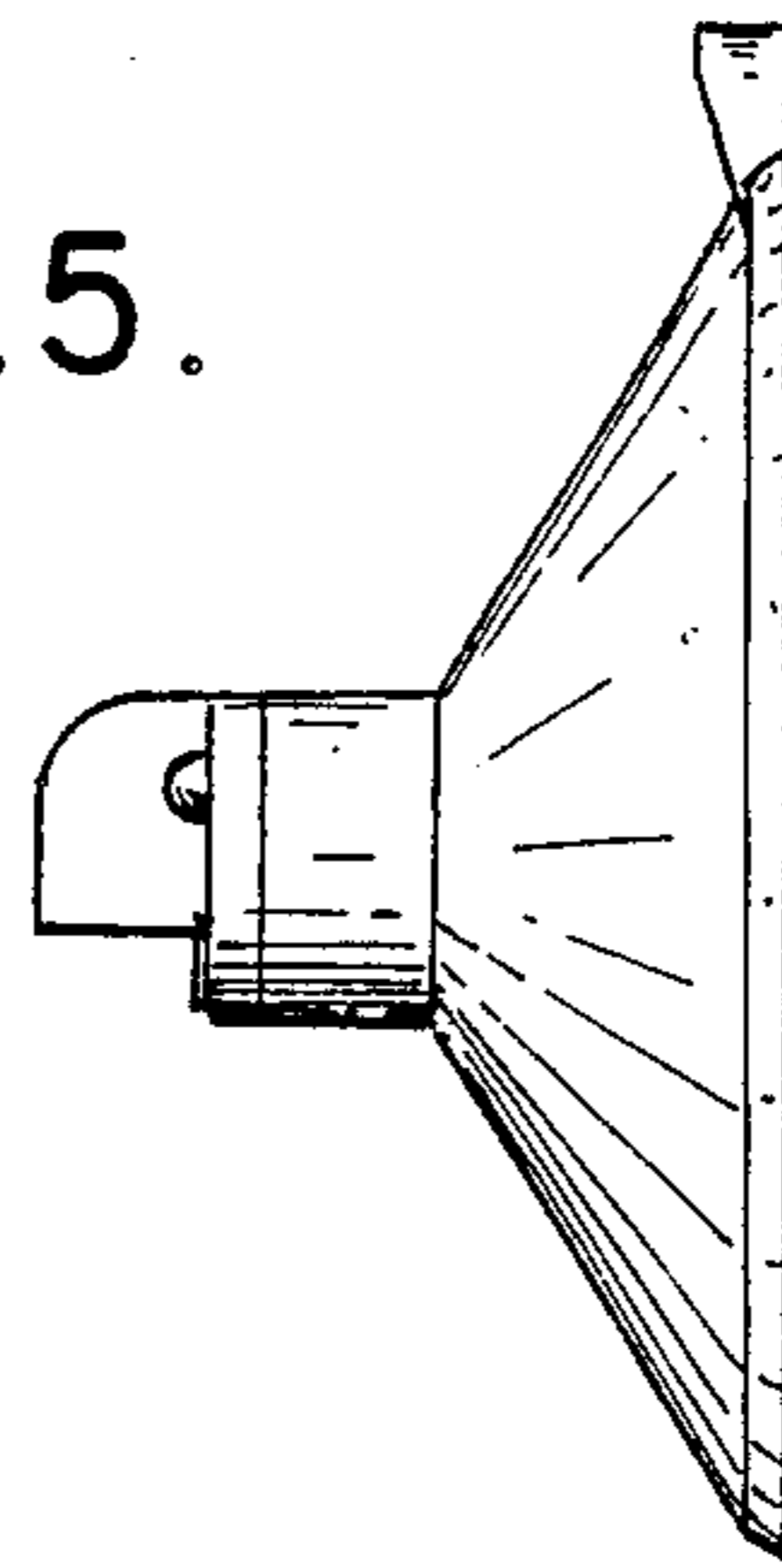

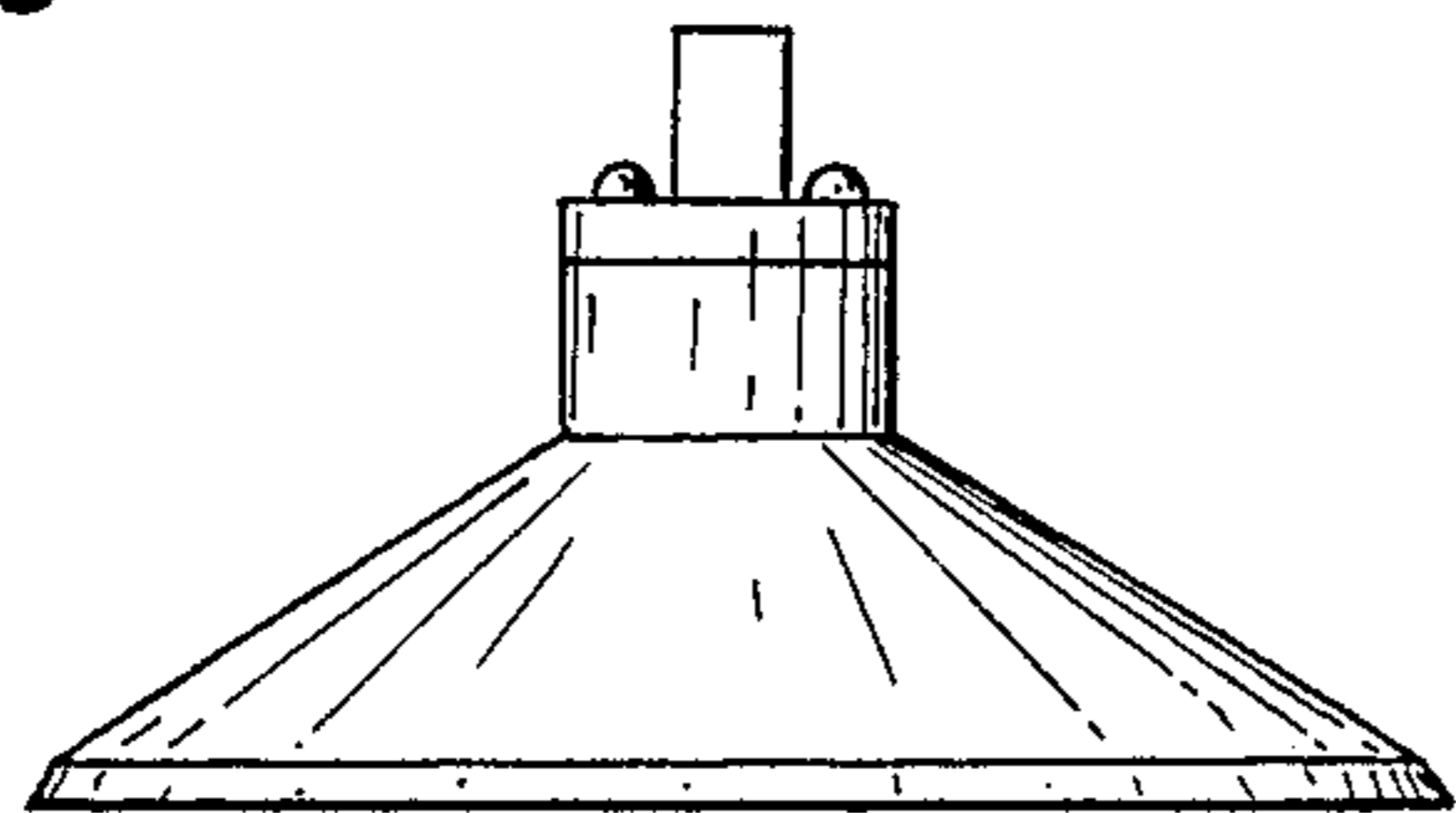

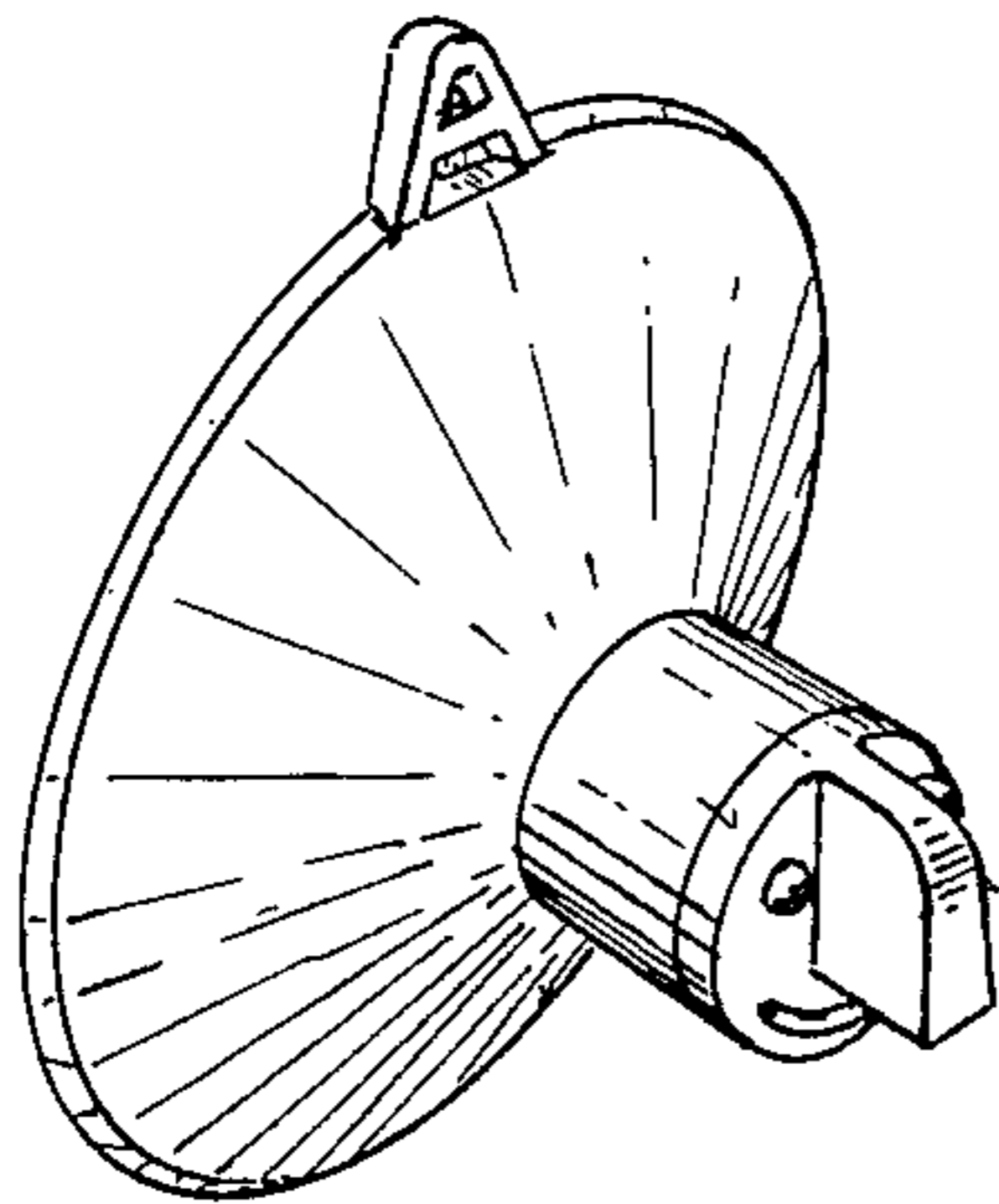
