described.

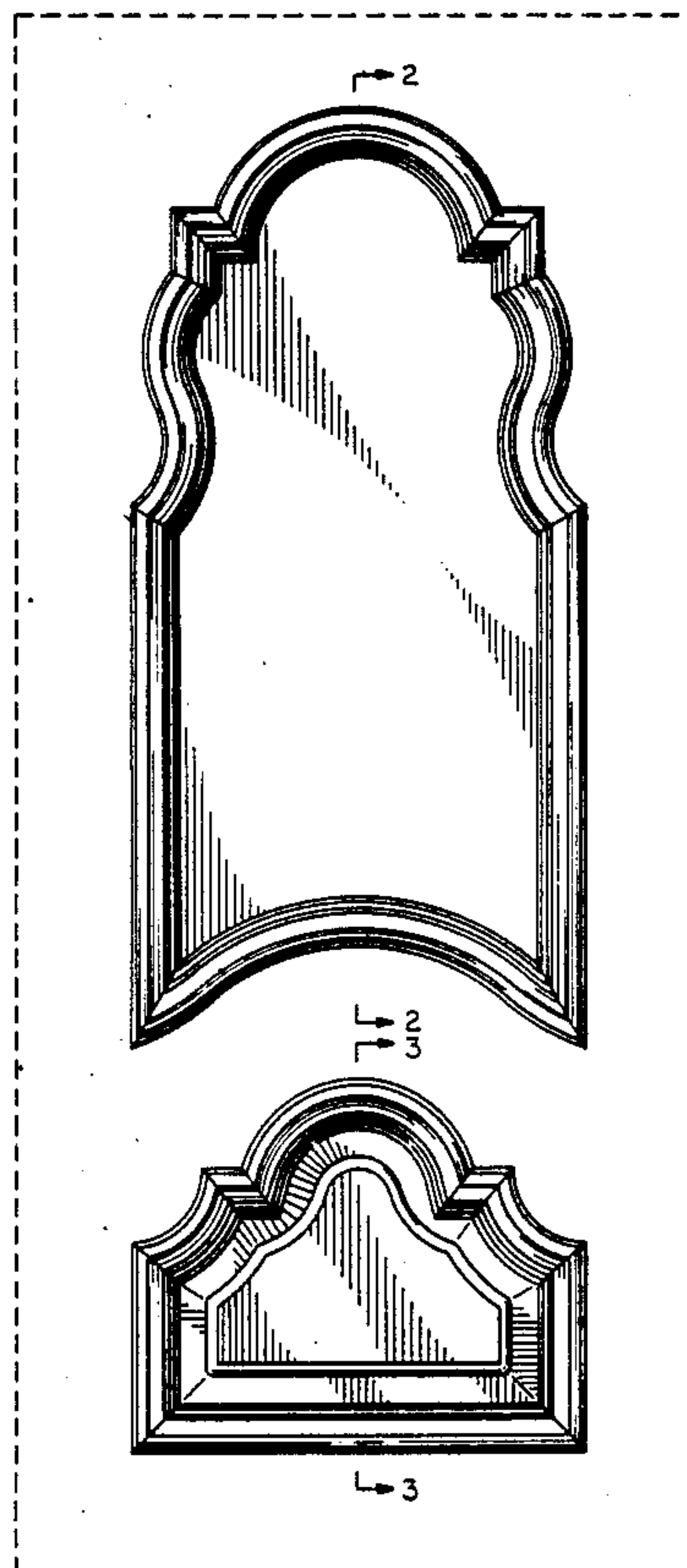
DESCRIPTION

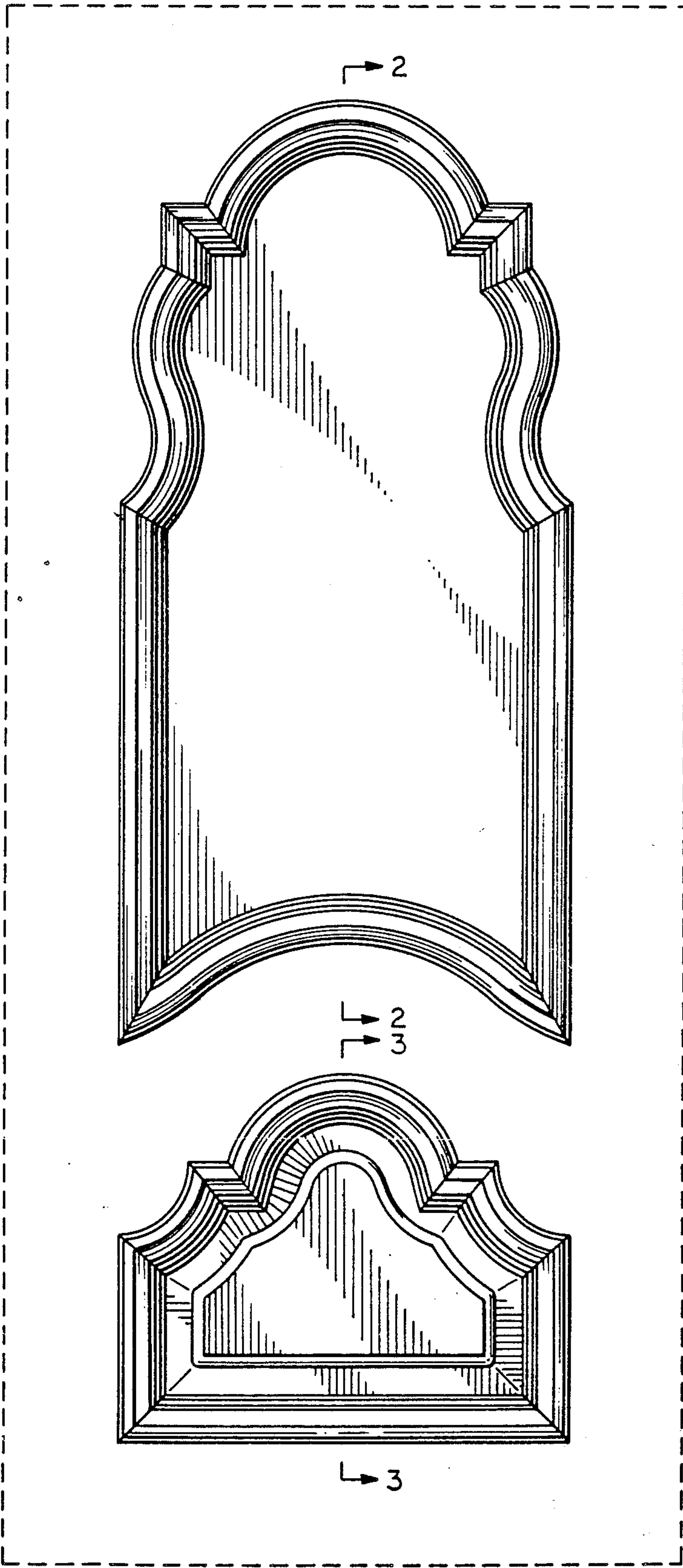
FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a door panel show-

purposes only and forms no part of the claimed design.





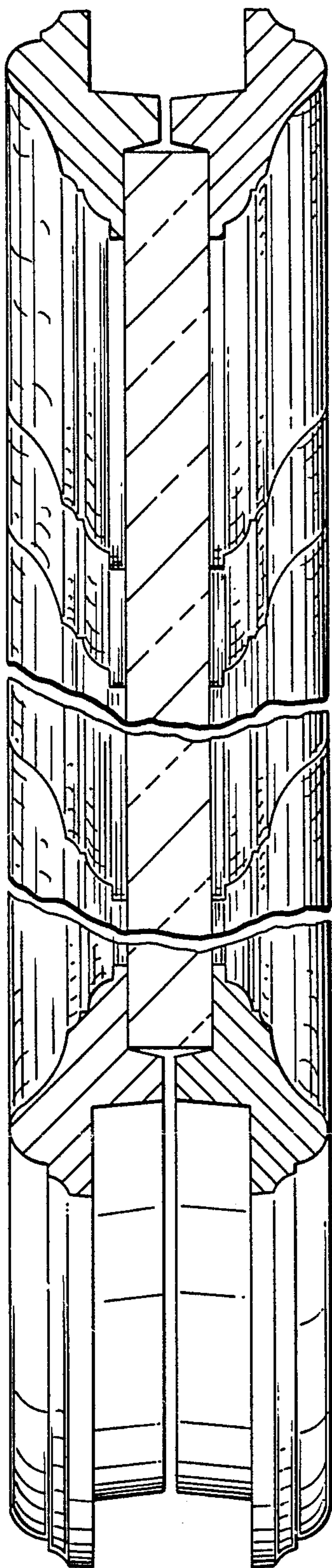

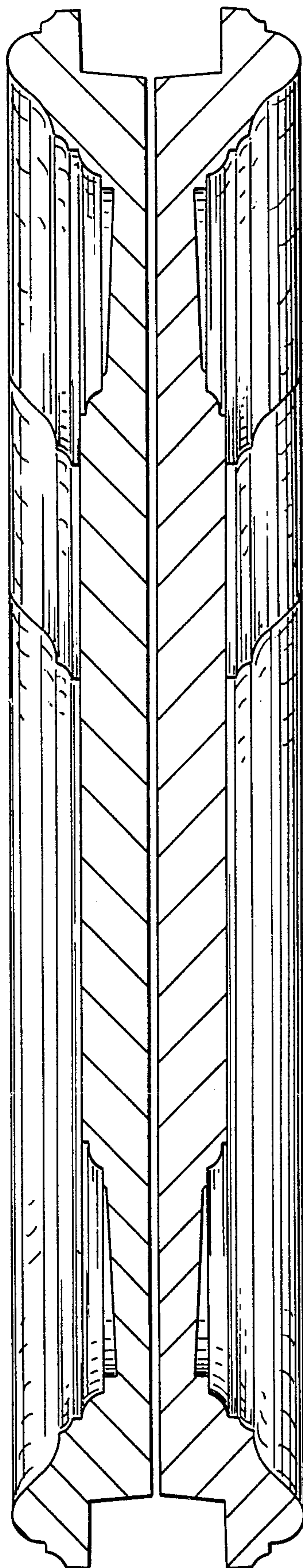
