The ornamental design for a door panel, as shown and described.


DESCRIPTION


FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a door panel showing my new design;

FIG. 2 is a cross-sectional view taken along line 2—2 of FIG. 1; and,


FIG. 3 is a cross-sectional view taken along line 3—3 of FIG. 1.
