FIG. 1 is a left front perspective view of sunglasses or similar article showing my new design;

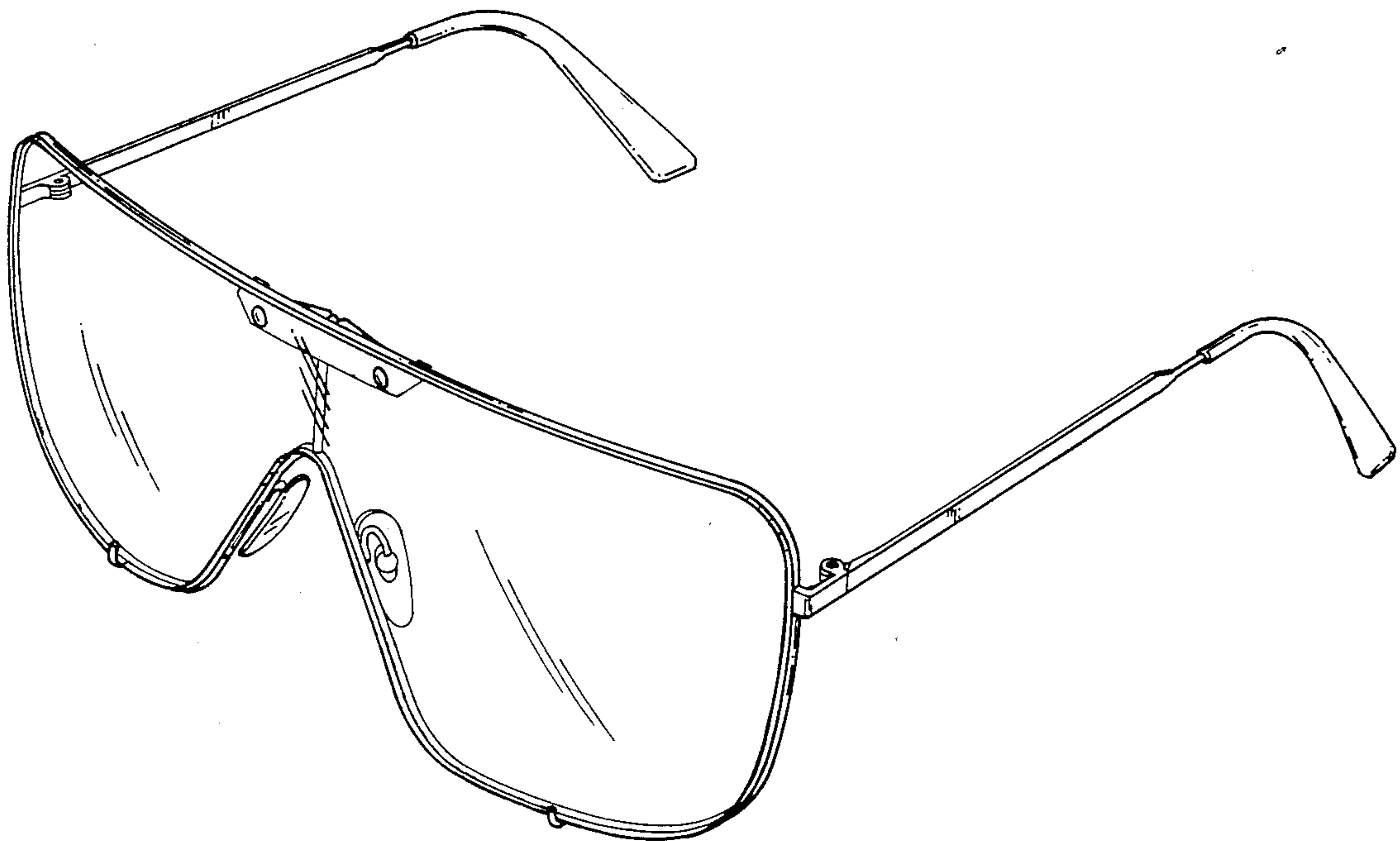
FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof;

FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view thereof.



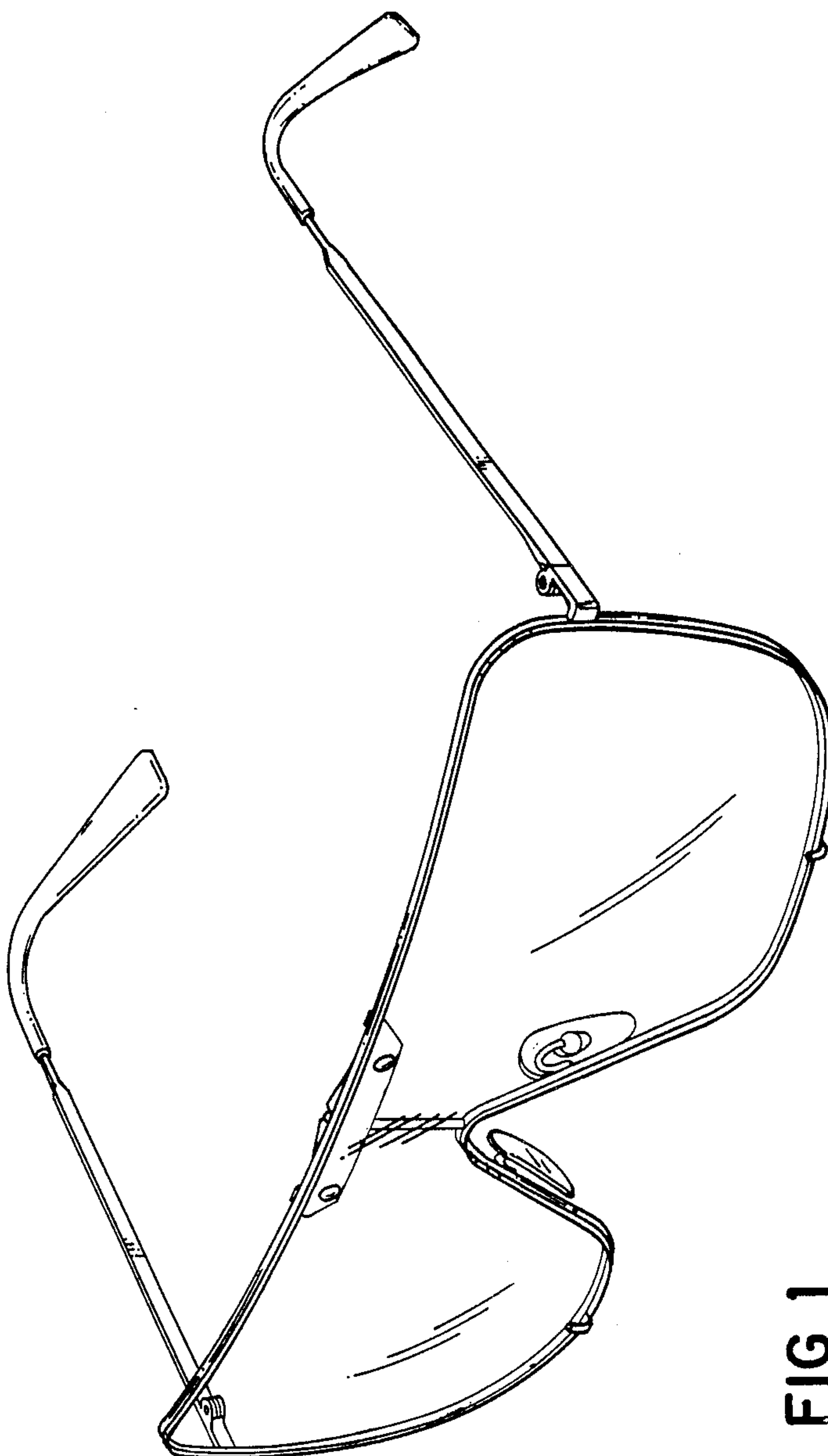

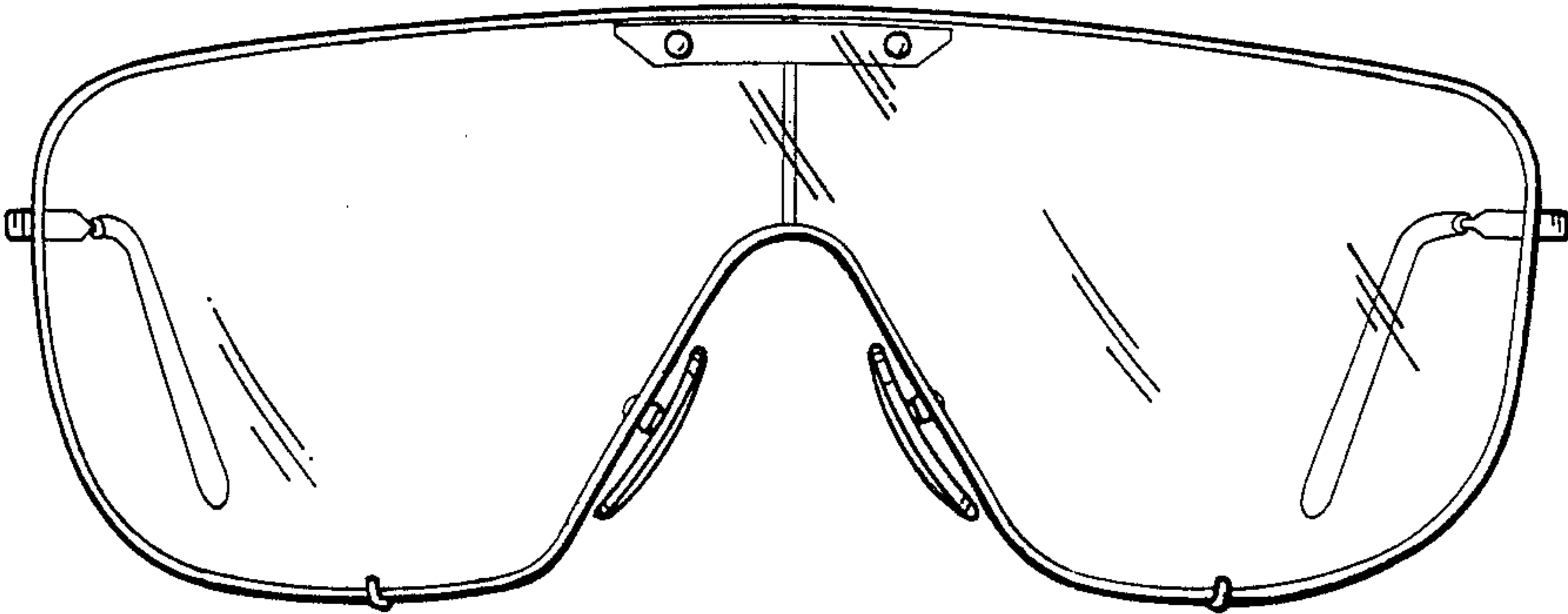

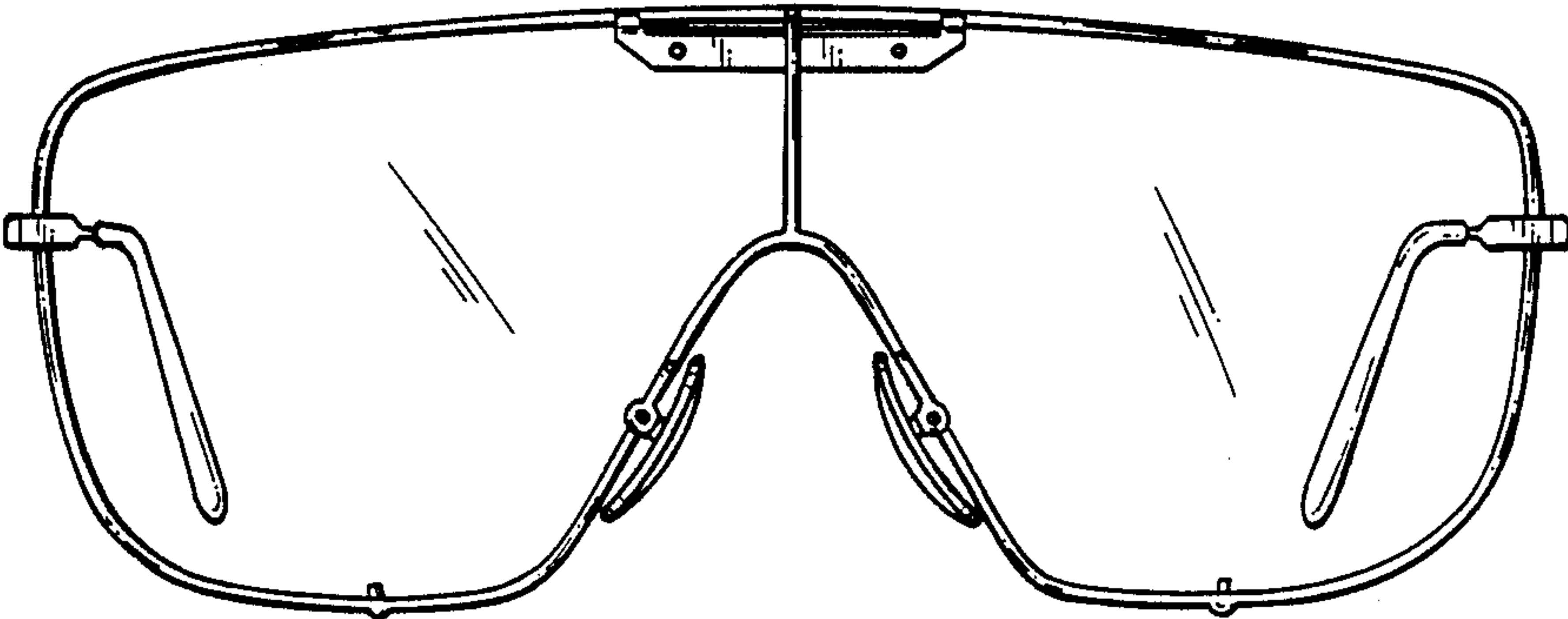

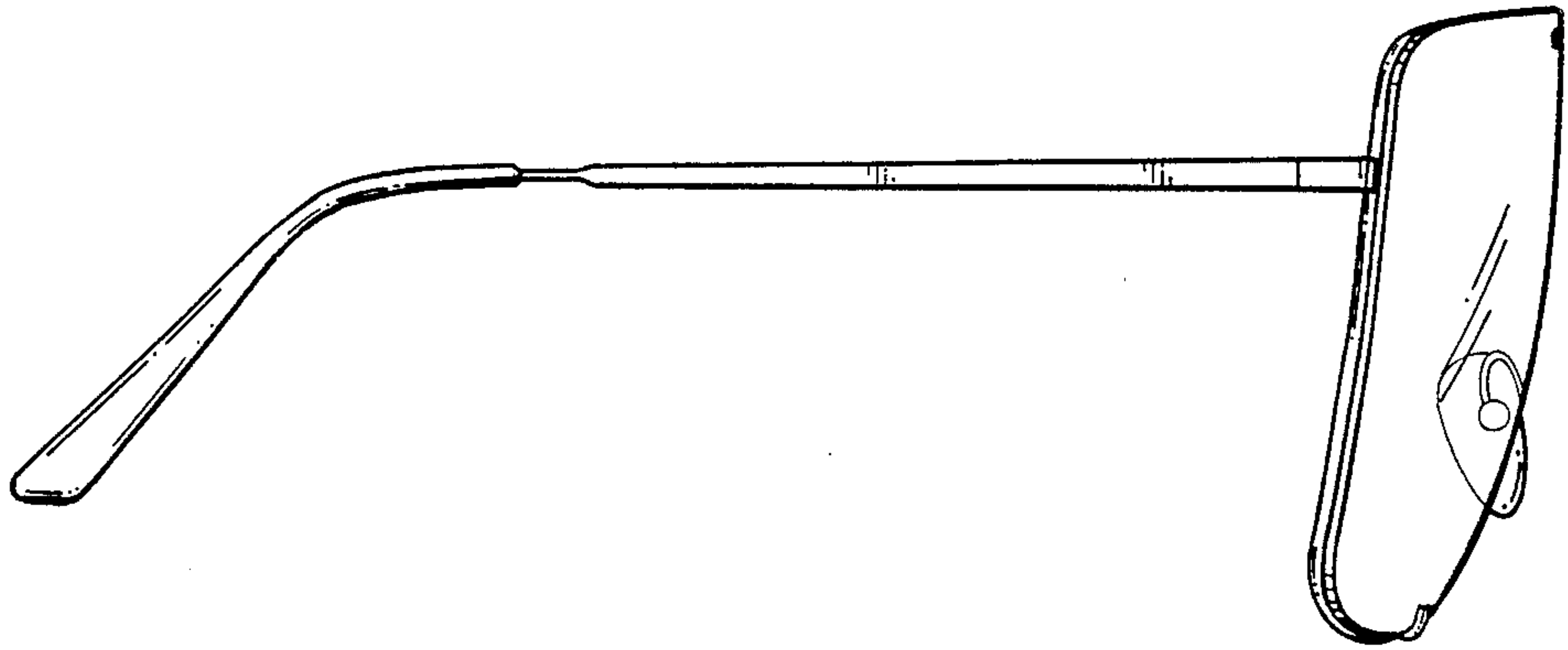

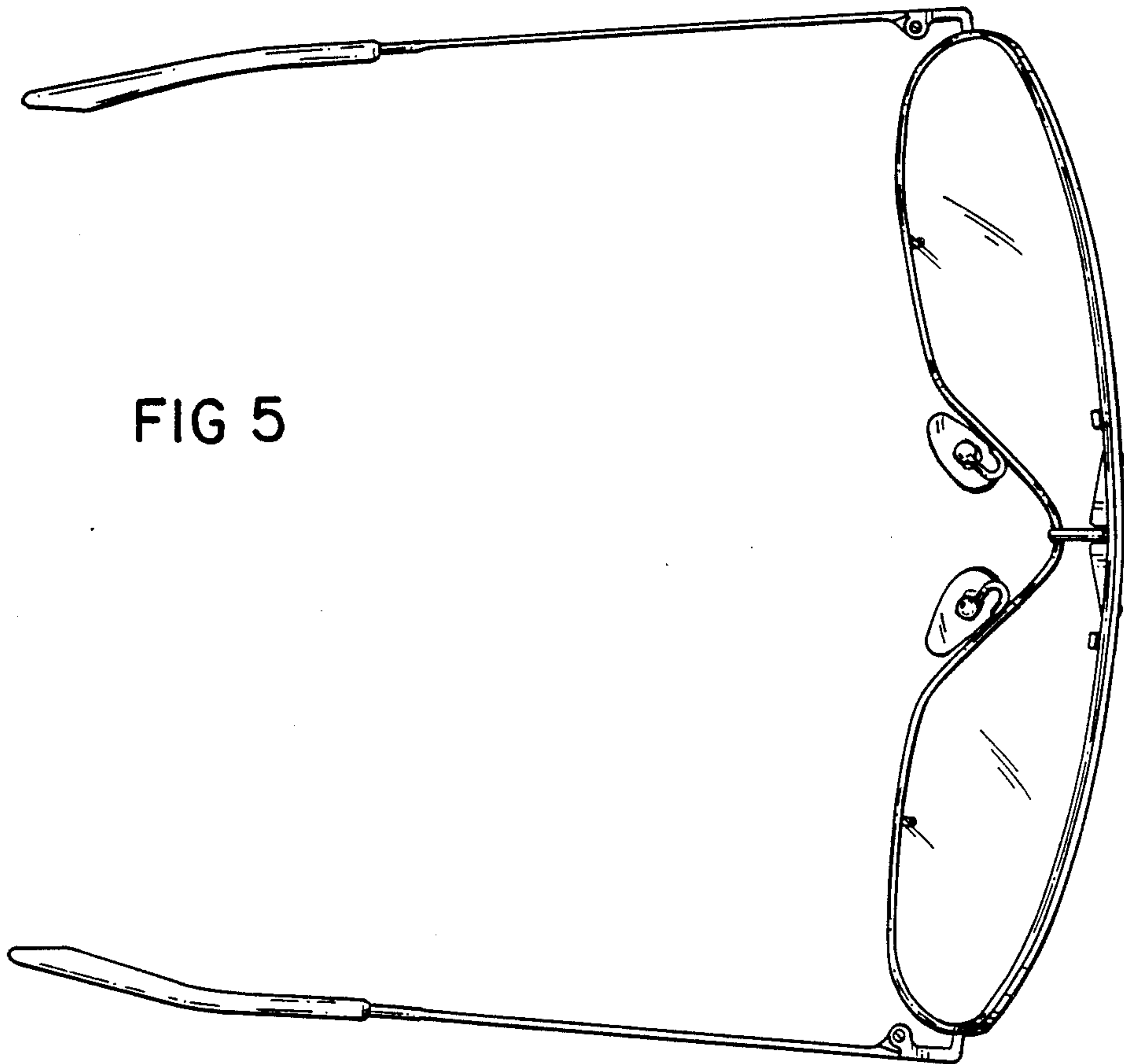

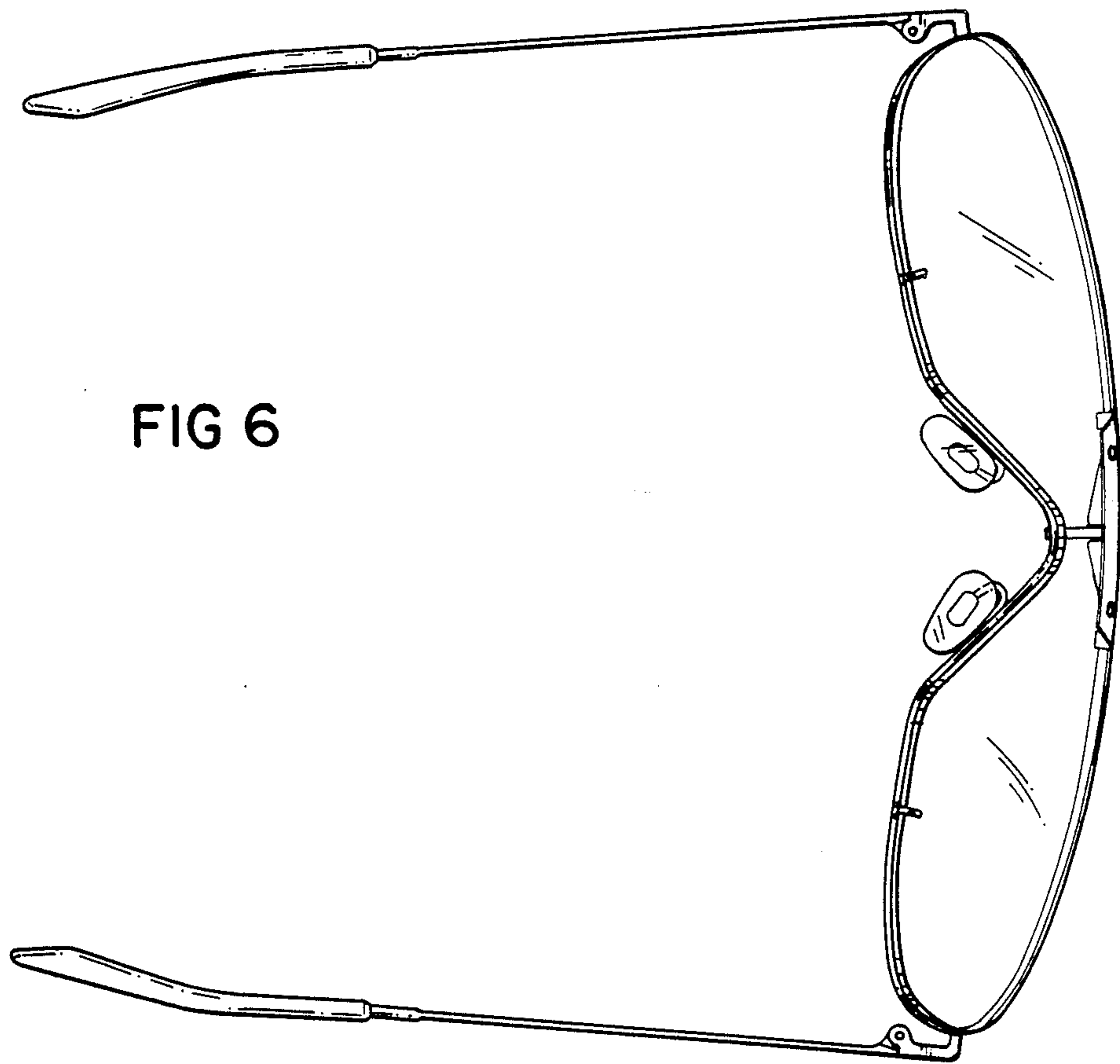
