FIG. 5 is a rear elevational view;

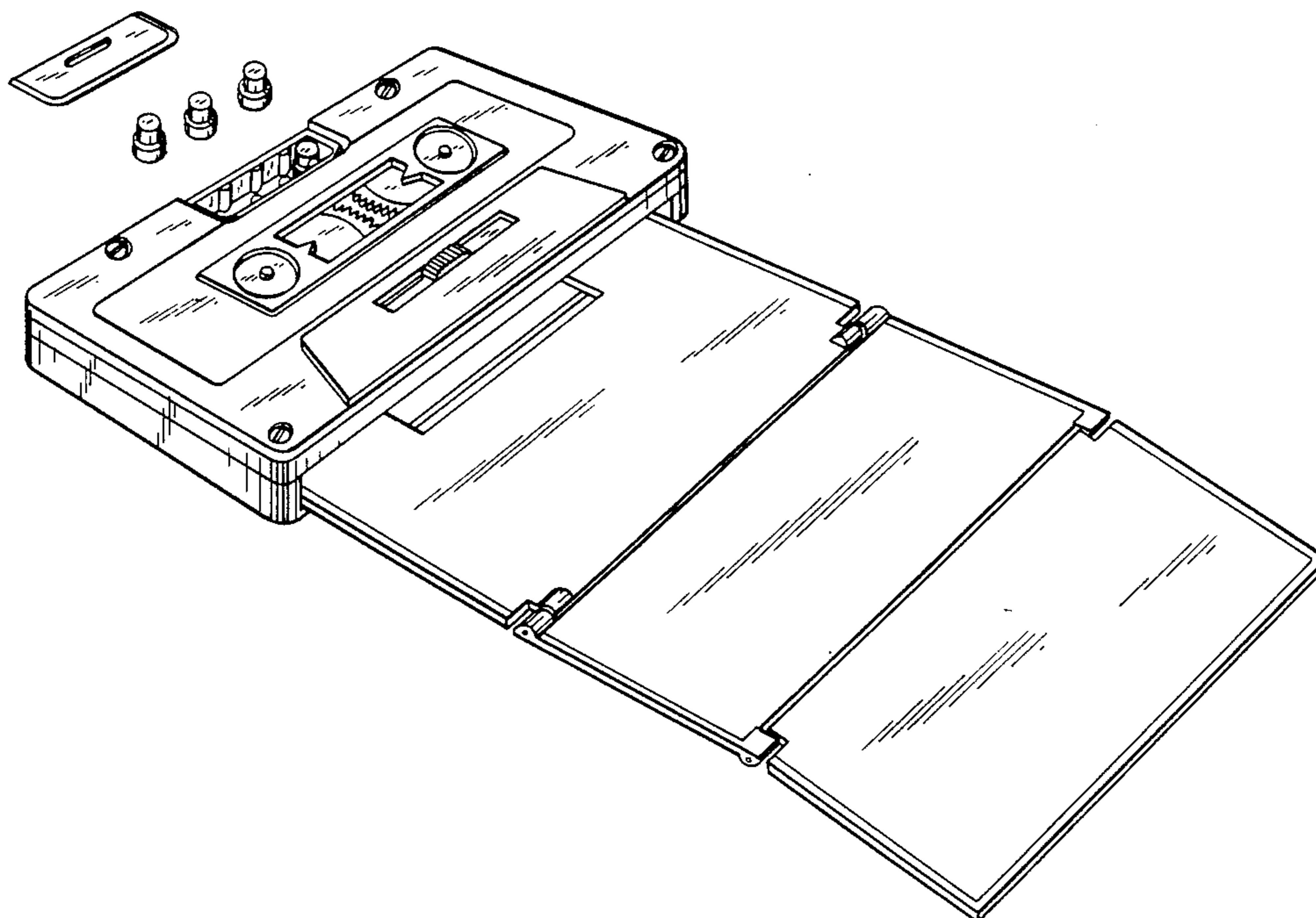
FIG. 6 is a perspective view with the game board in a partially extended position; and

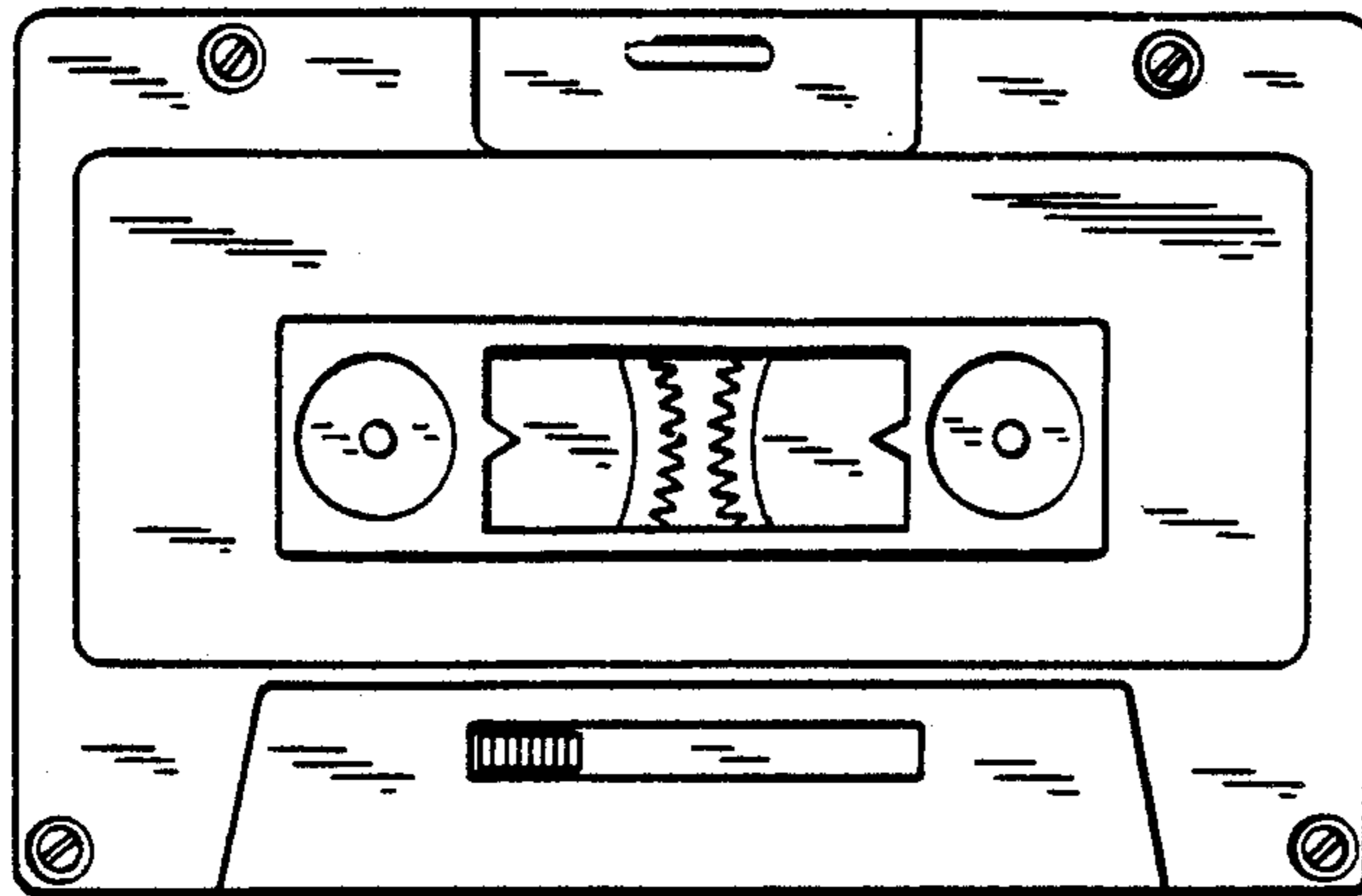

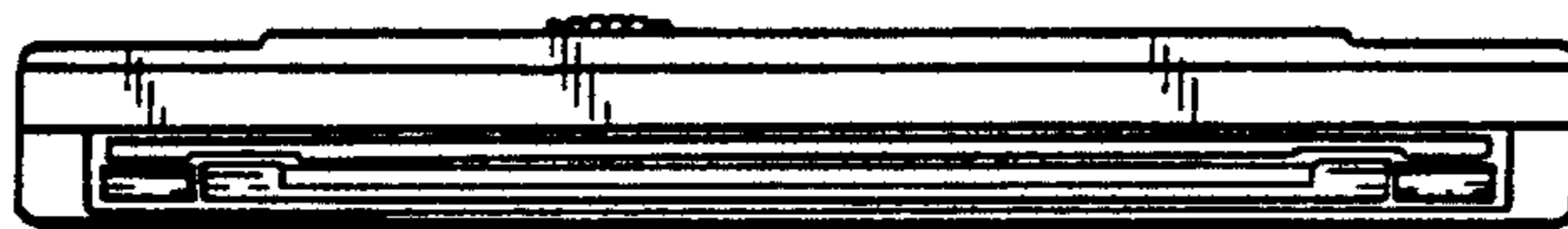
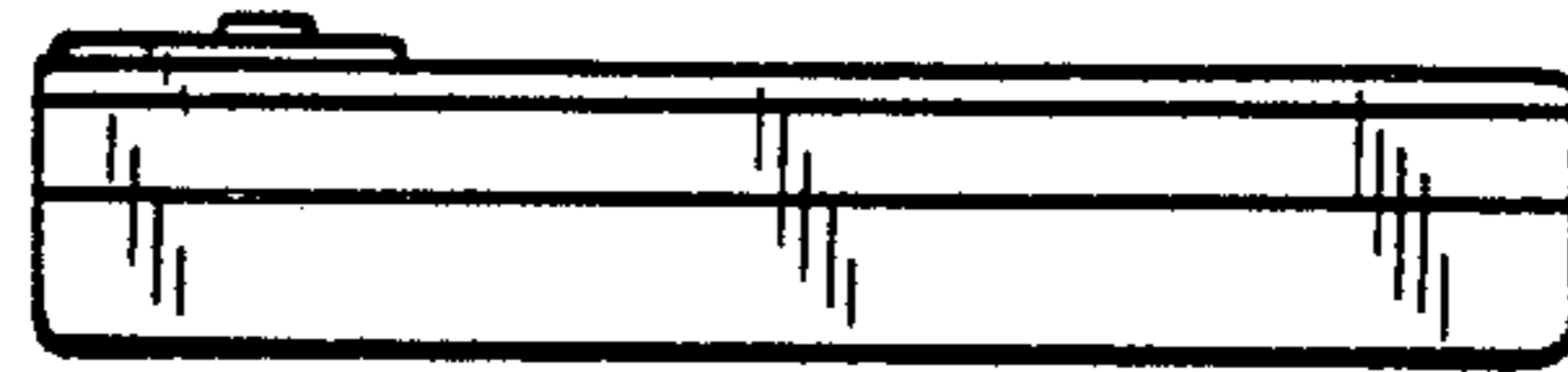

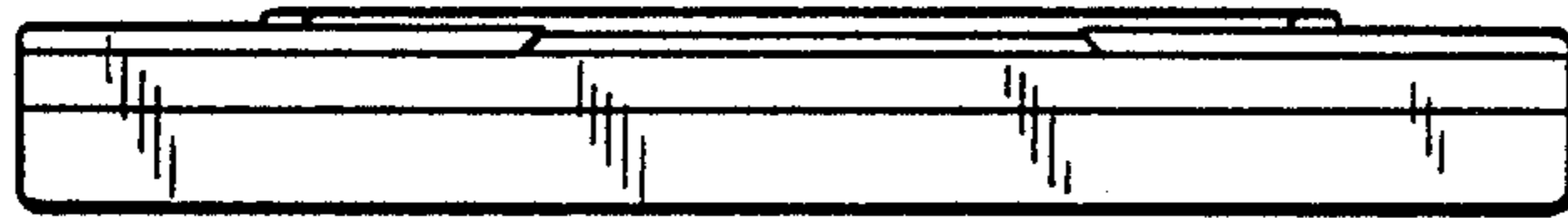

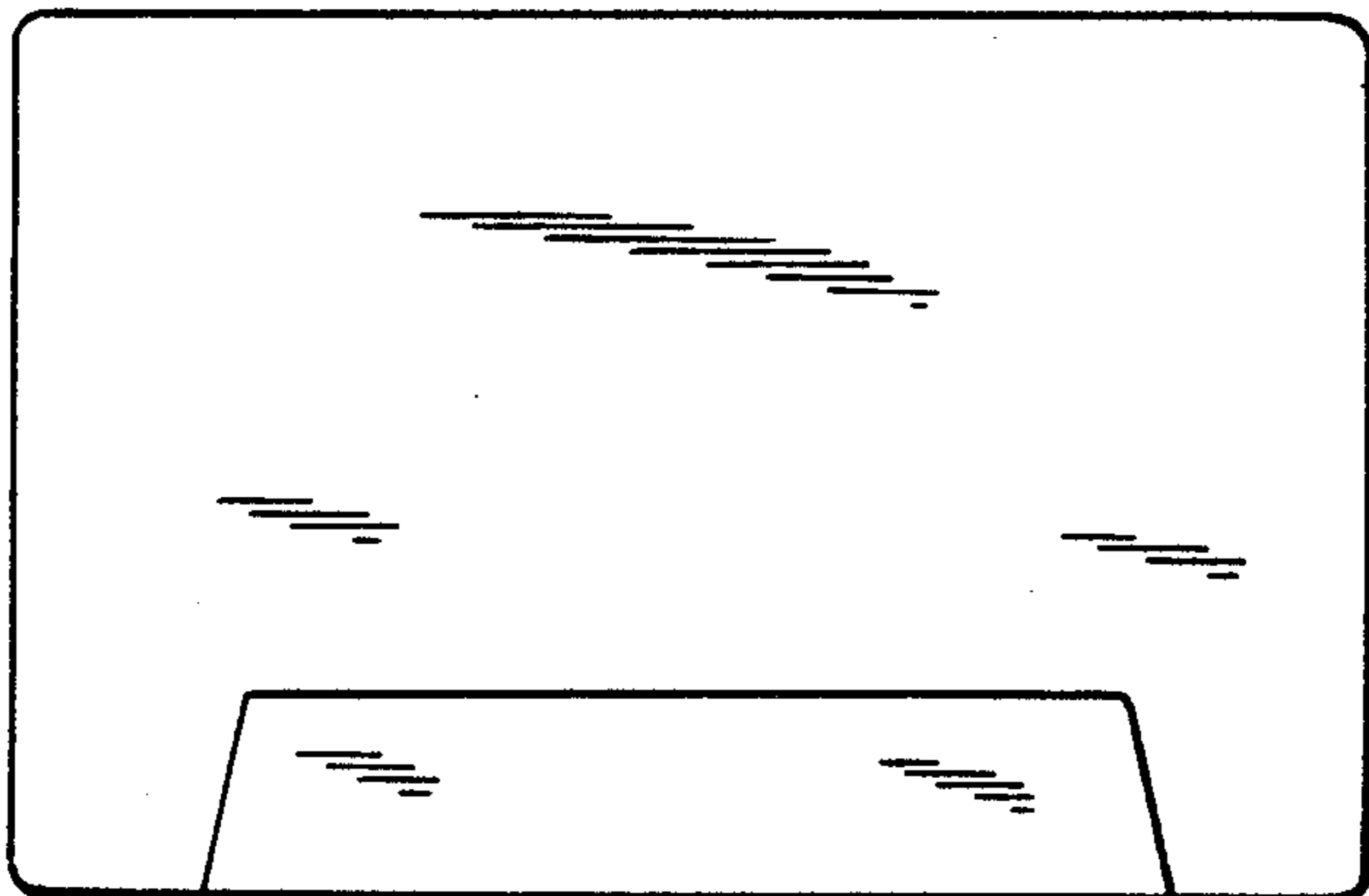
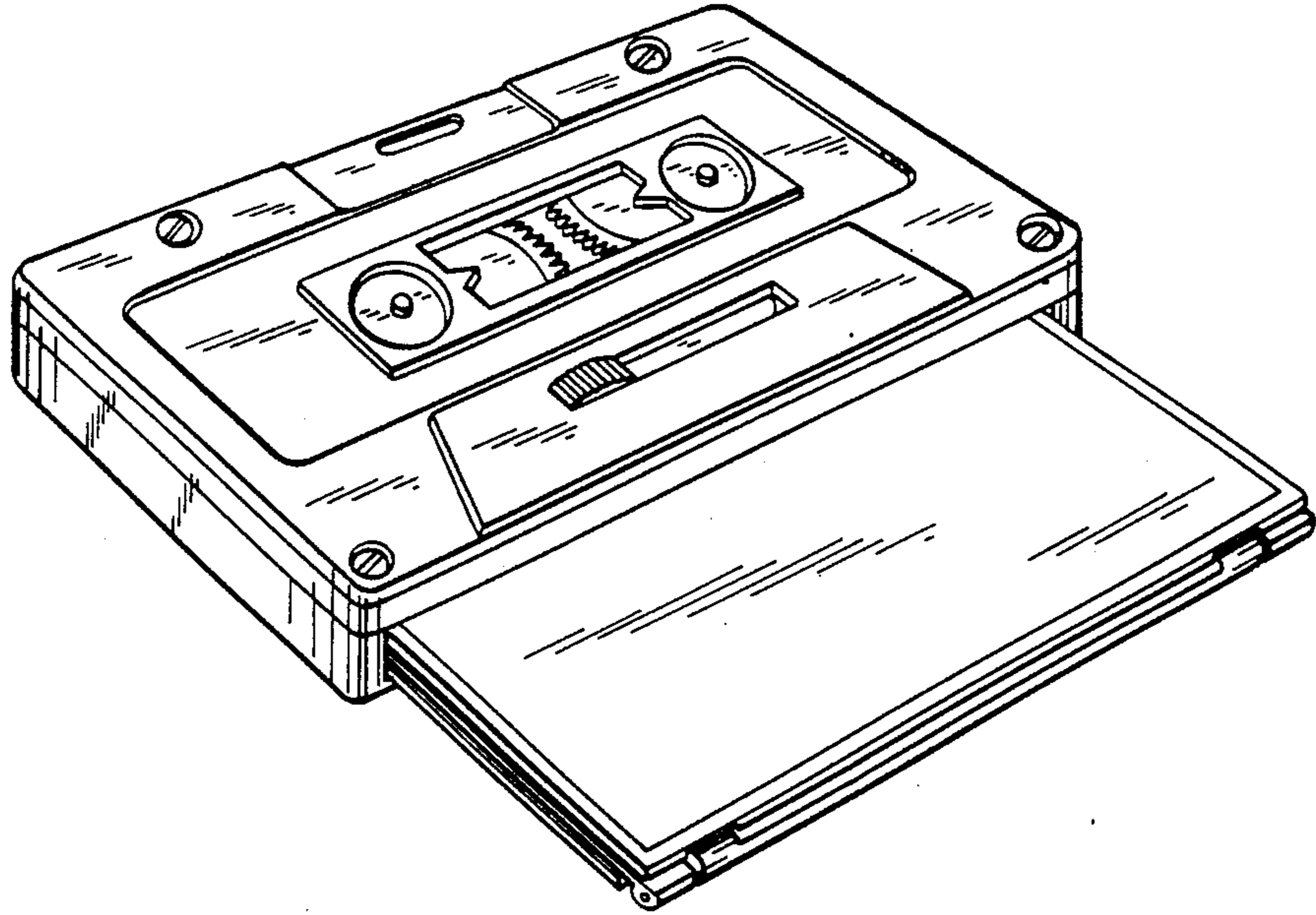

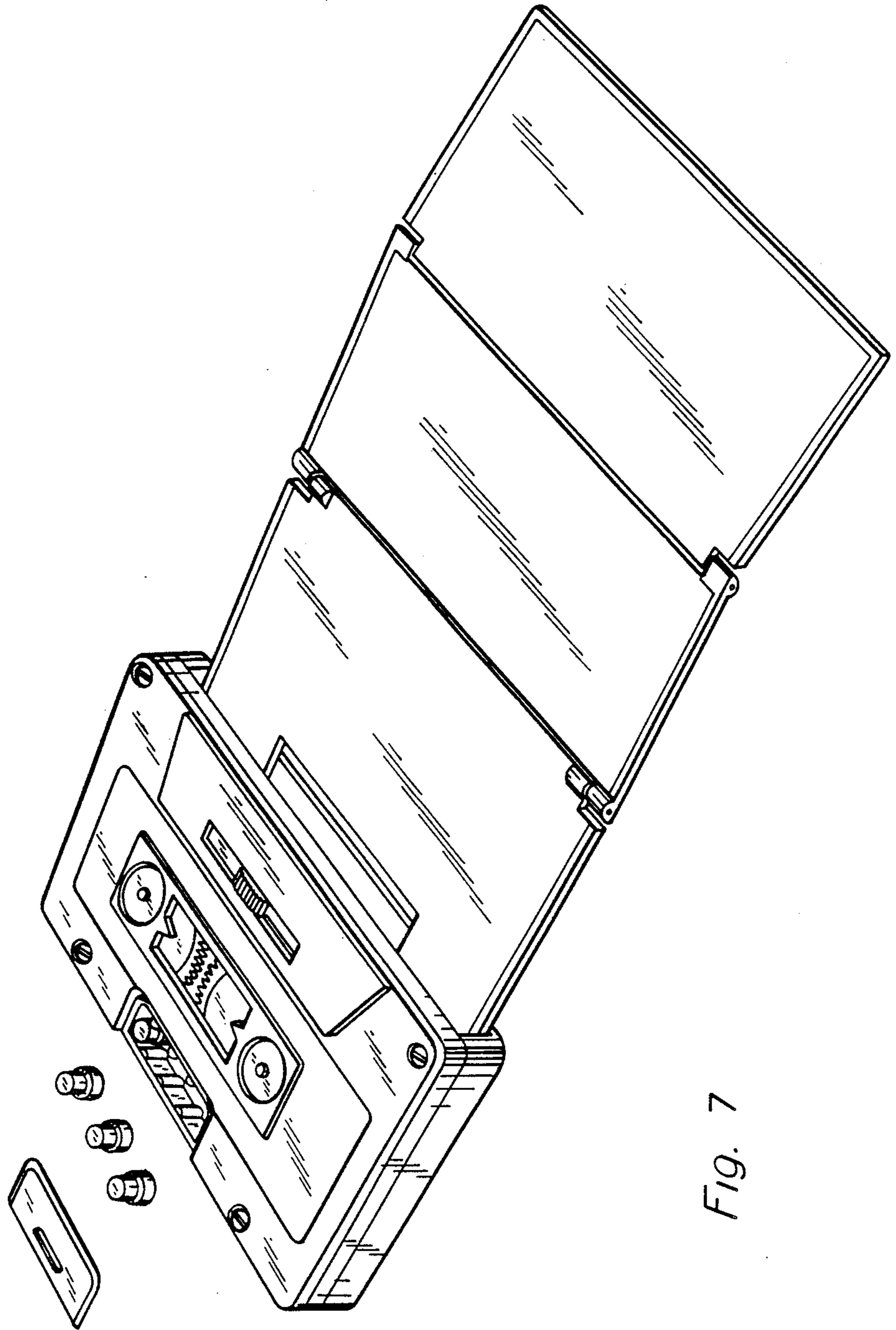
