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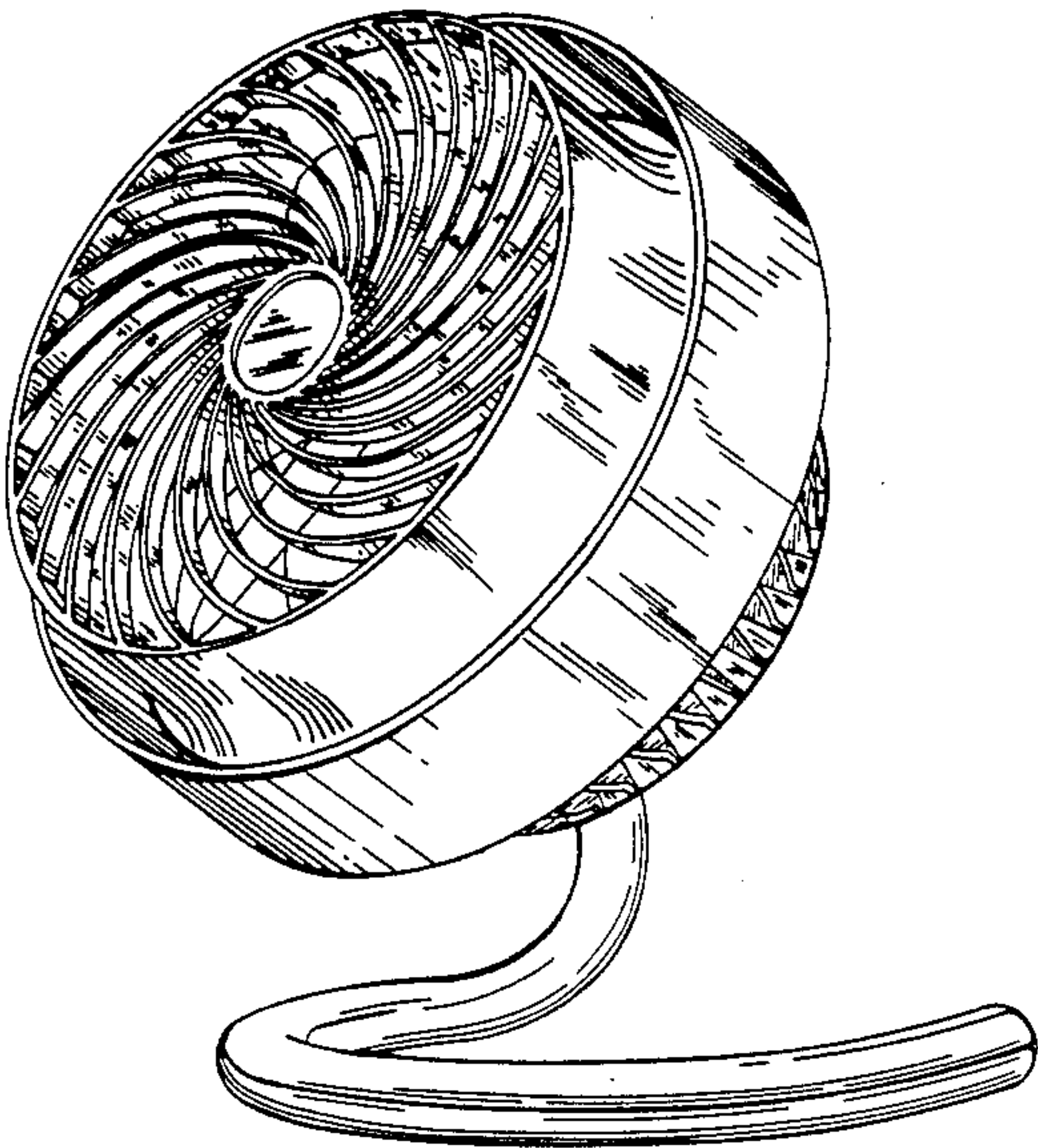

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a cross-sectional view of a fan taken along line 1—1 in FIG. 2, showing the support stand in elevation; FIG. 2 is a front elevation view thereof taken along line 2—2 in FIG. 1; FIG. 3 is a front and right side perspective view thereof; and FIG. 4 is a rear and left side perspective view thereof.



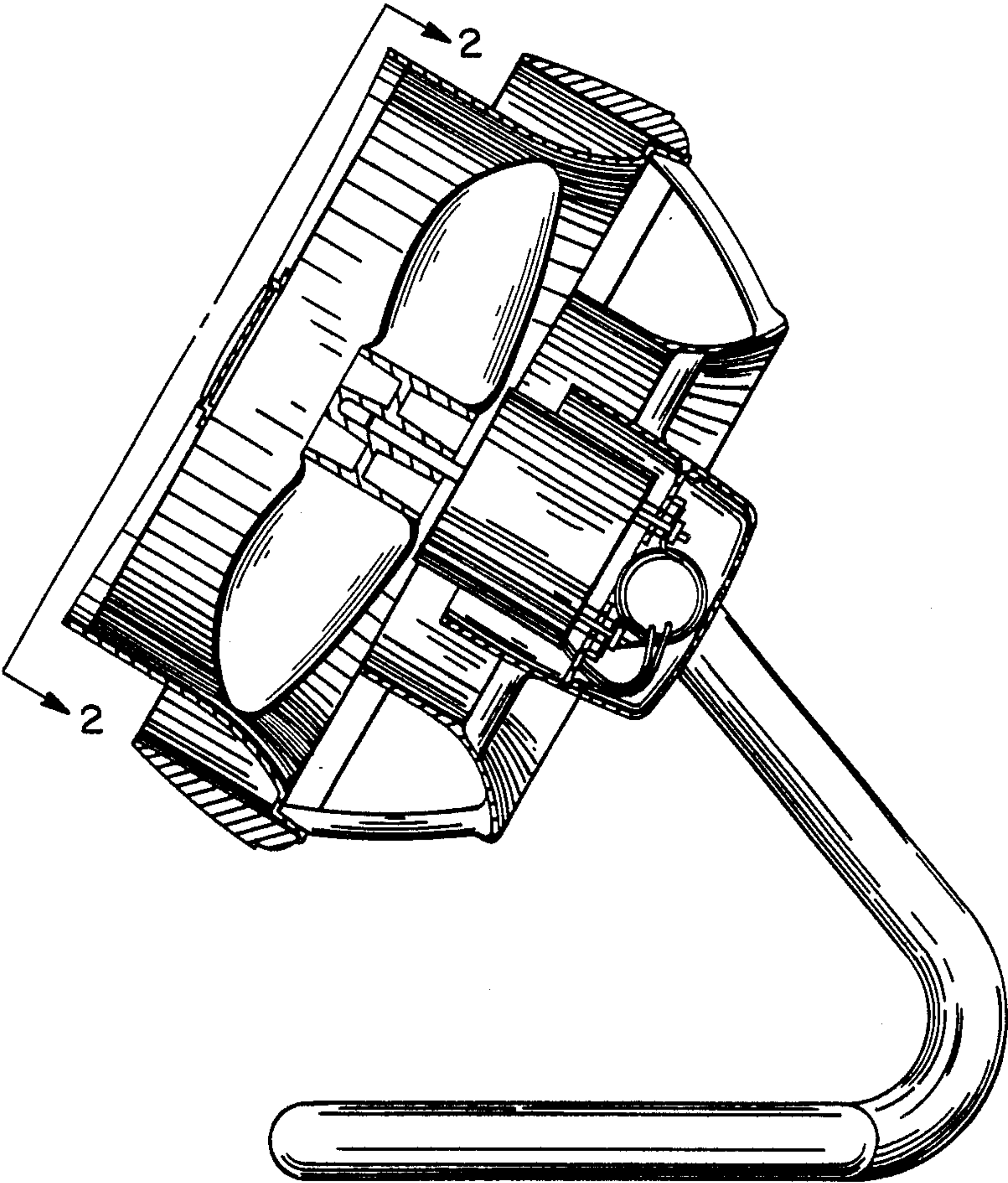

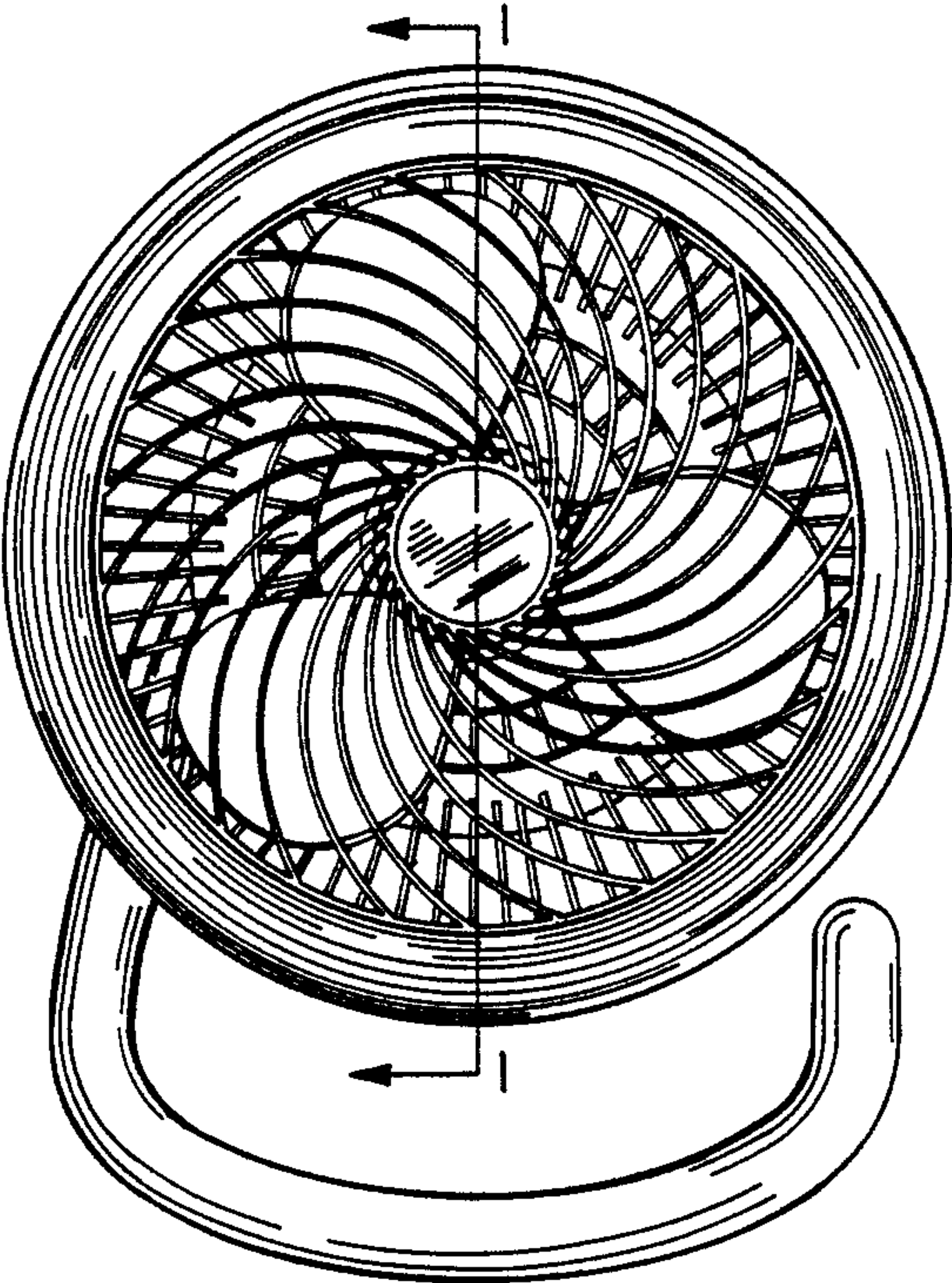

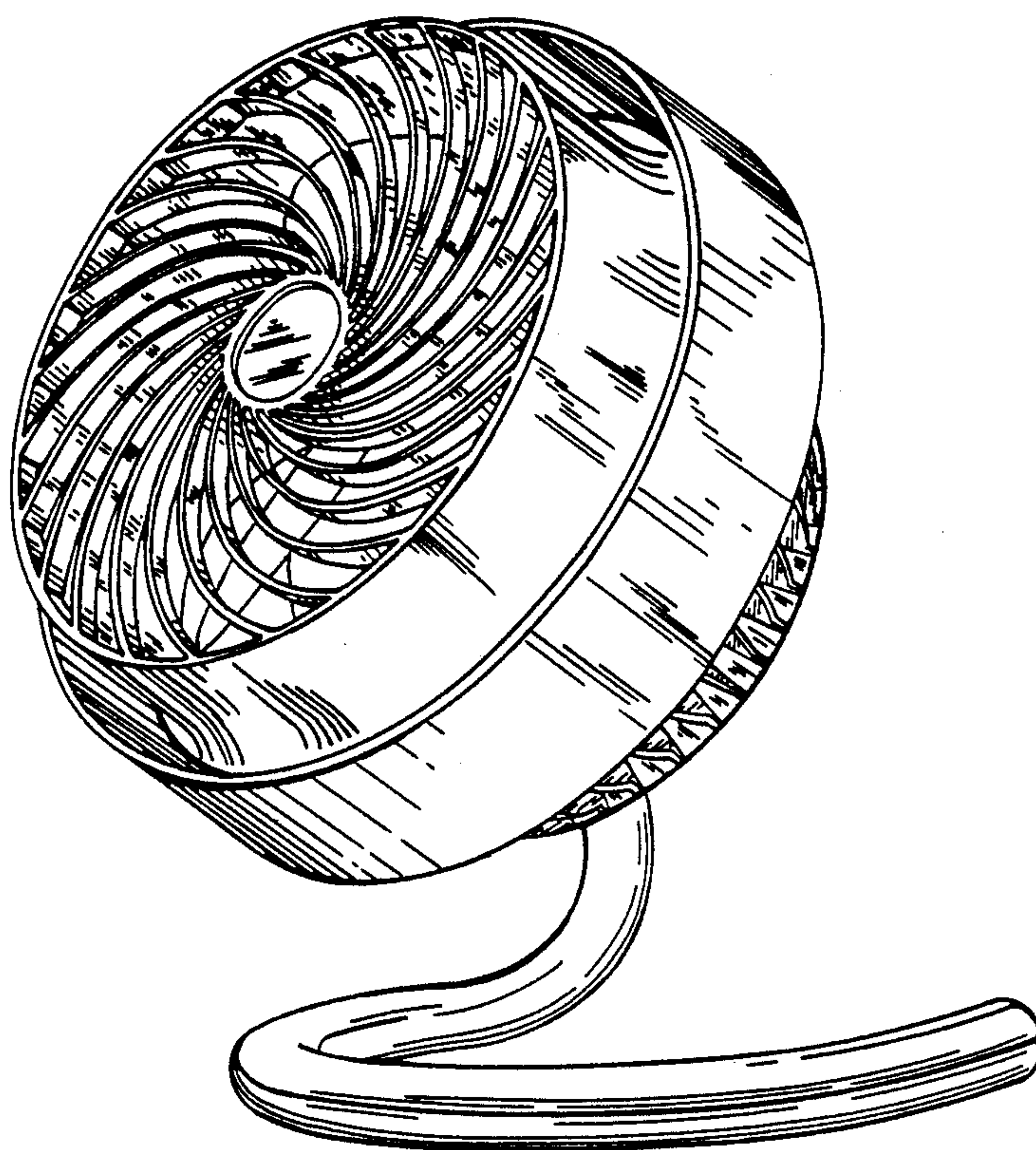

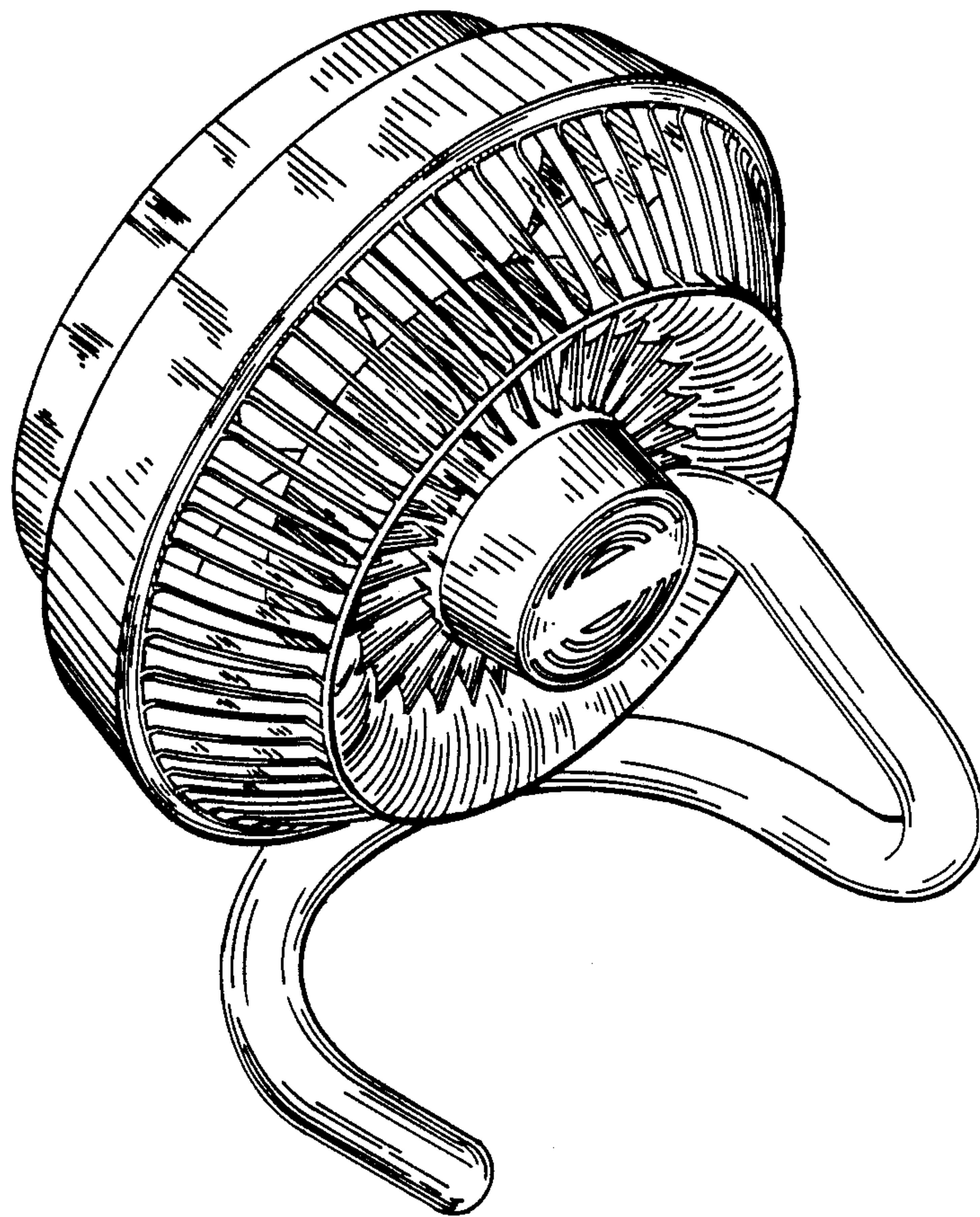
