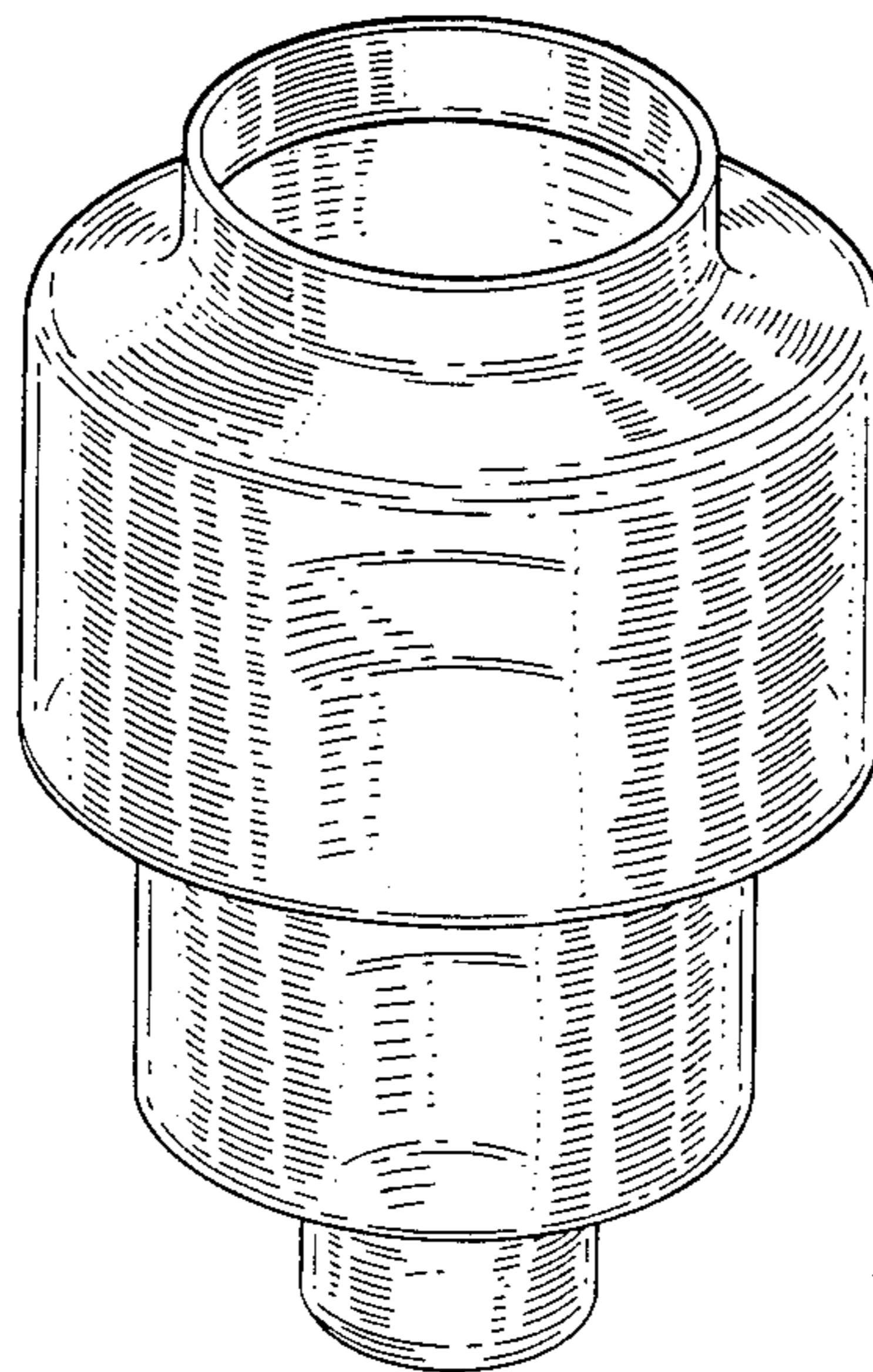

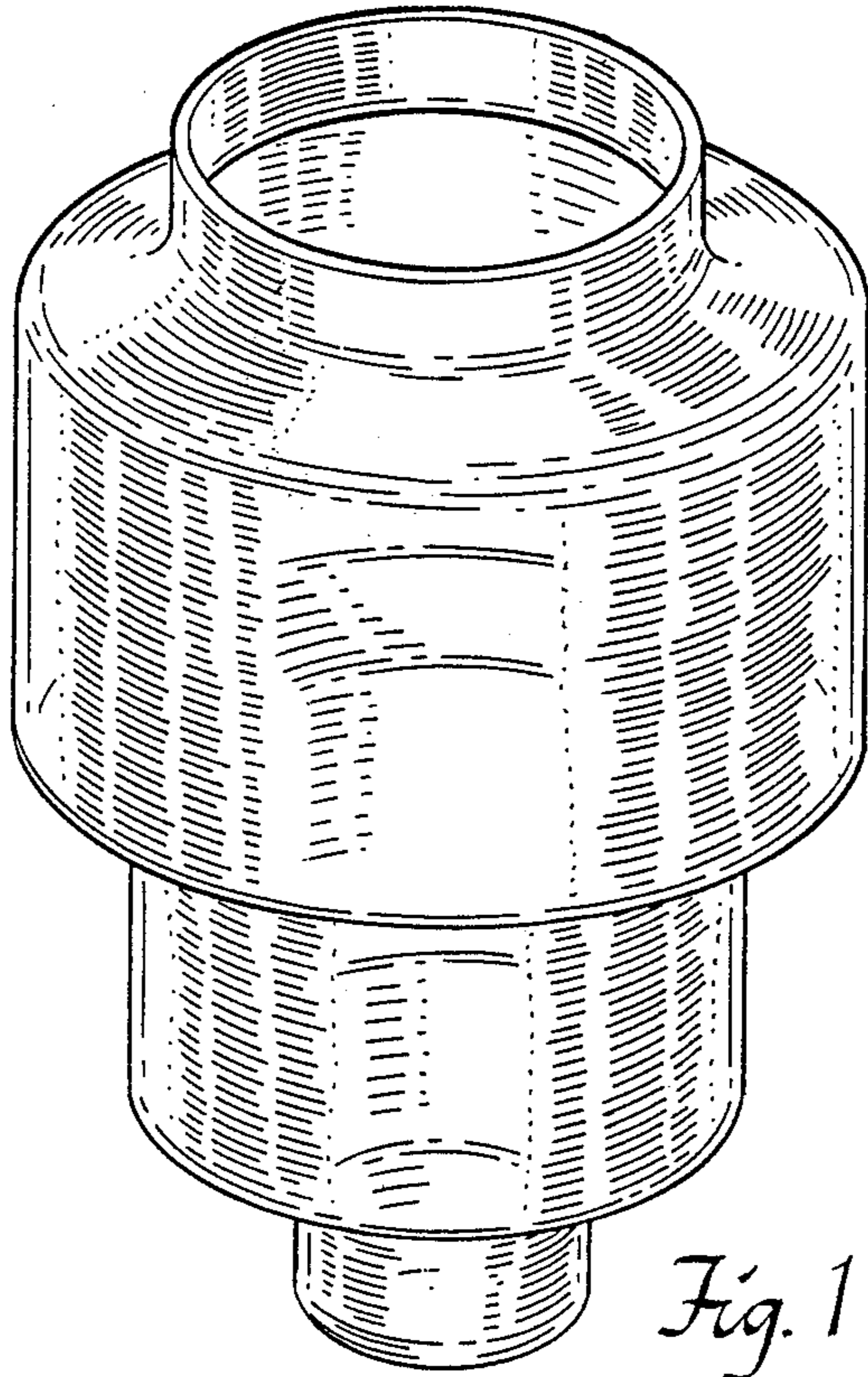
The ornamental design for a bowl body for centrifuge, as shown.

**DESCRIPTION**

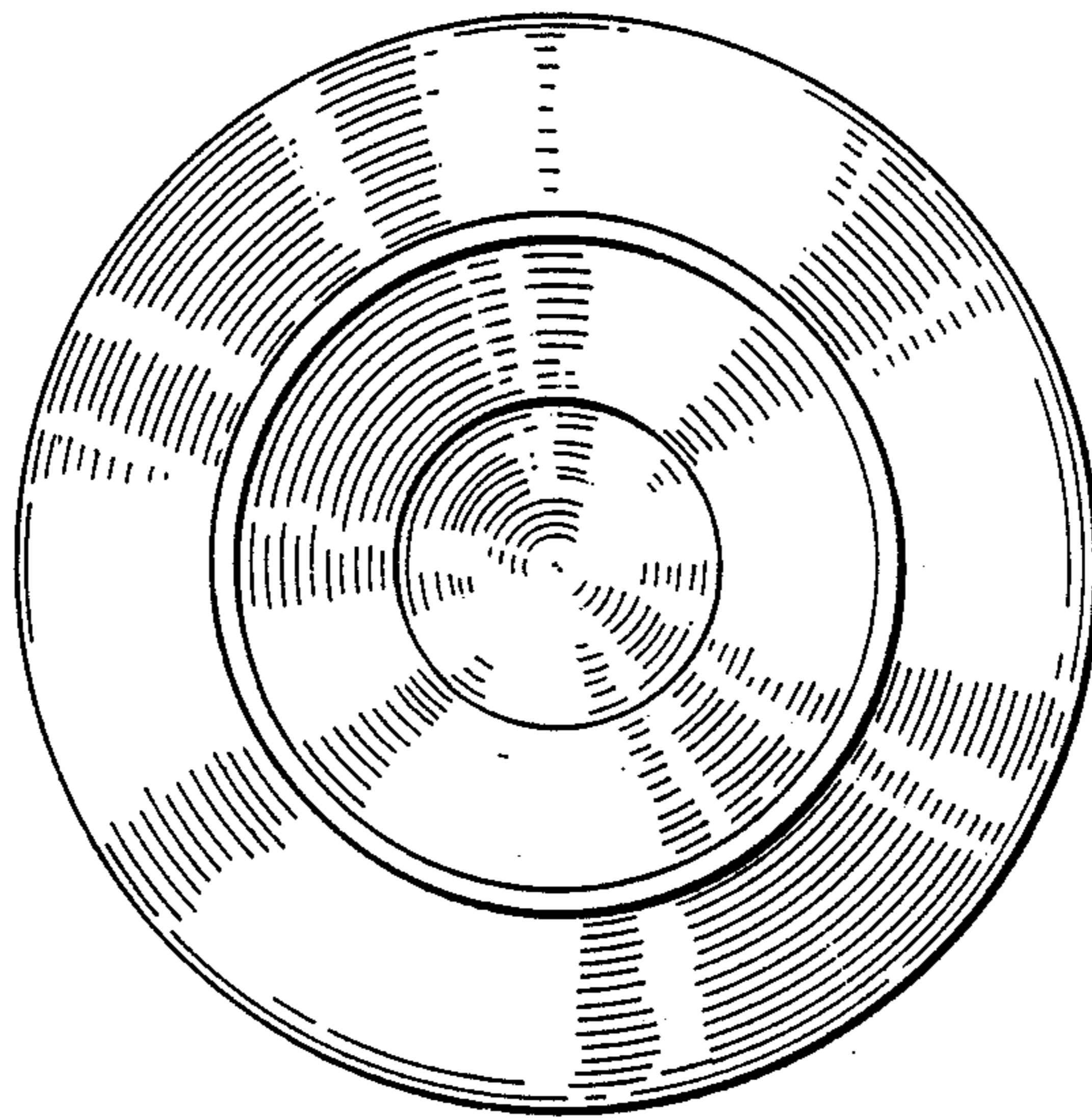
FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a bowl body for centrifuge embodying my new design;

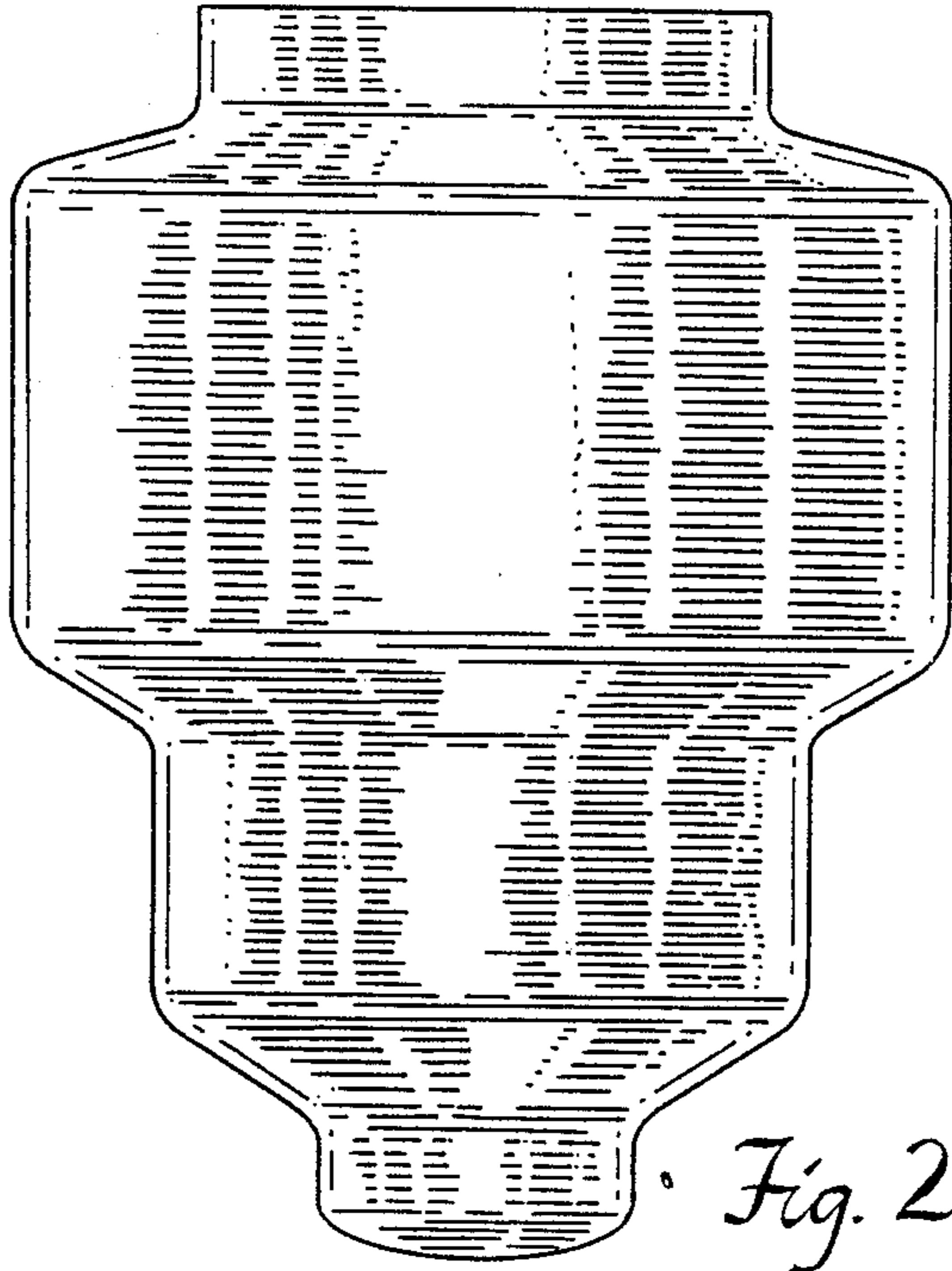

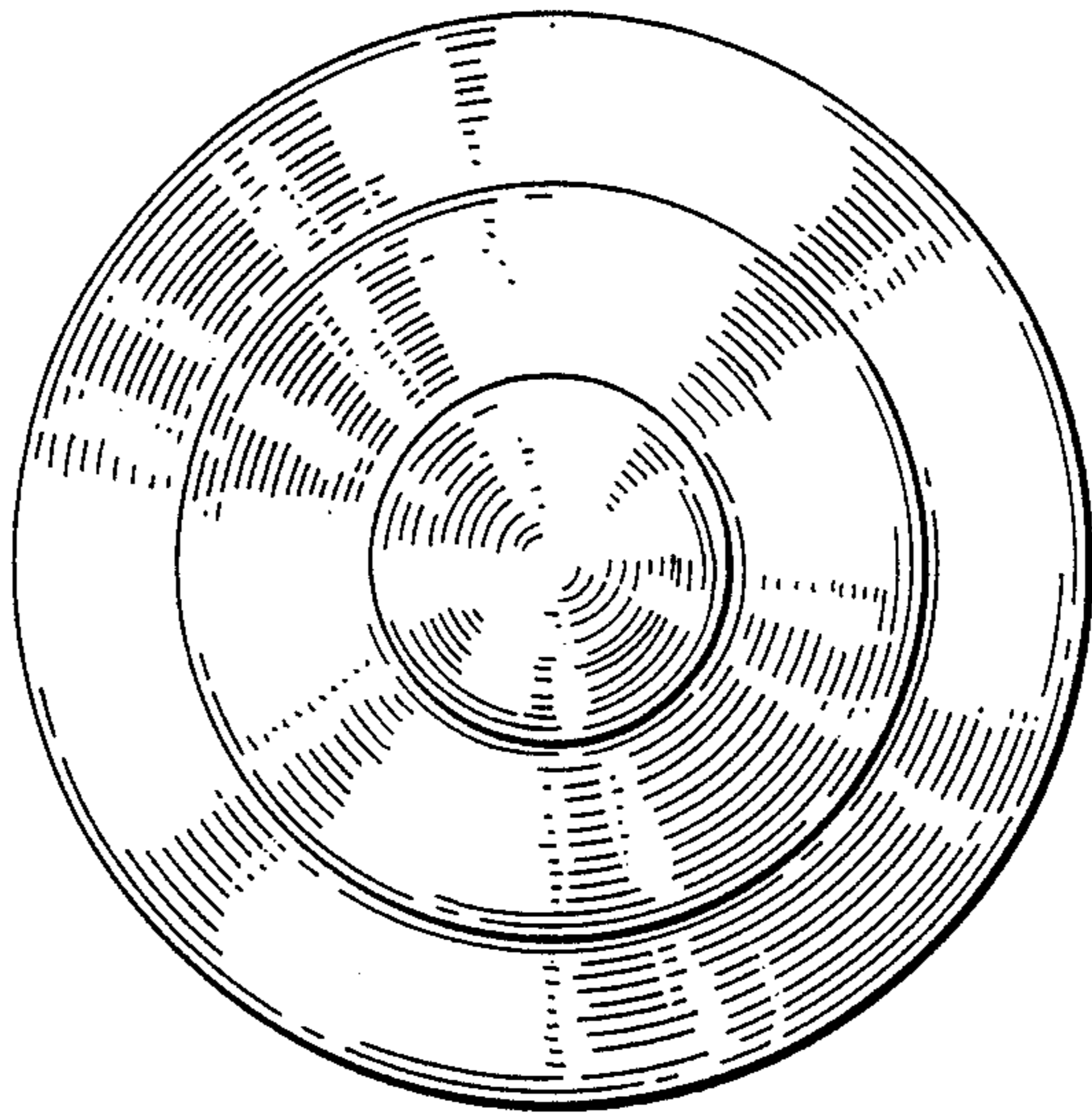
