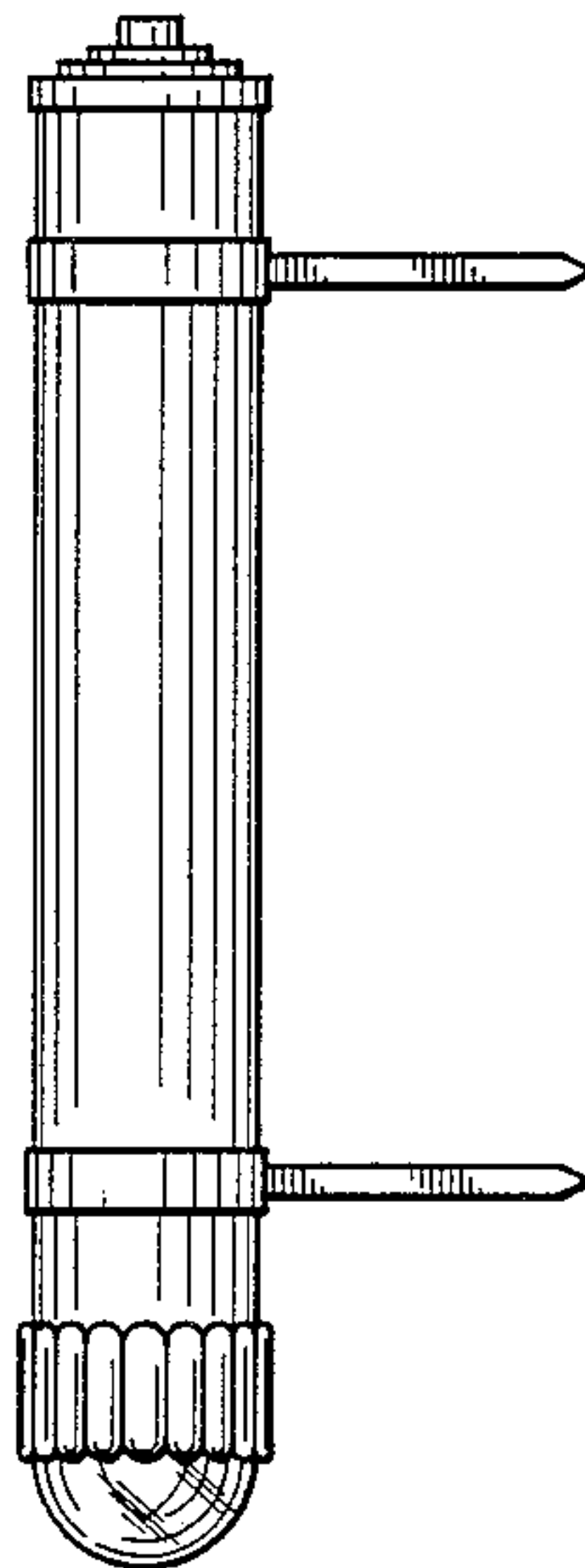
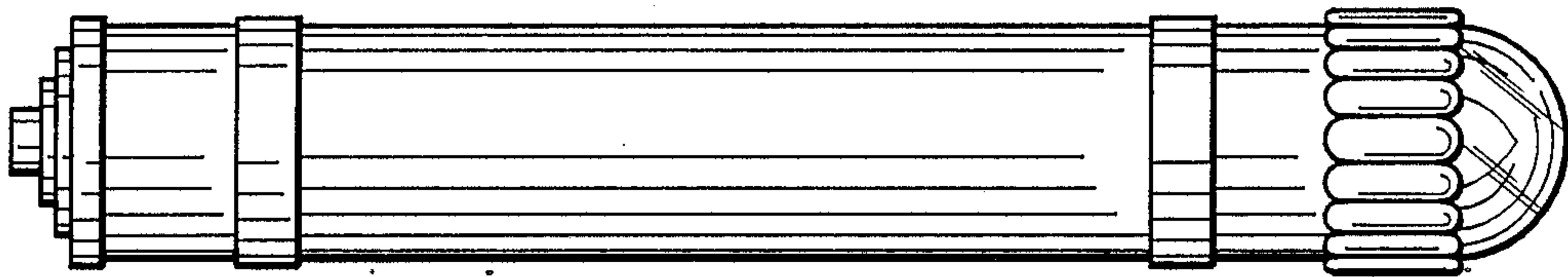
DESCRIPTION

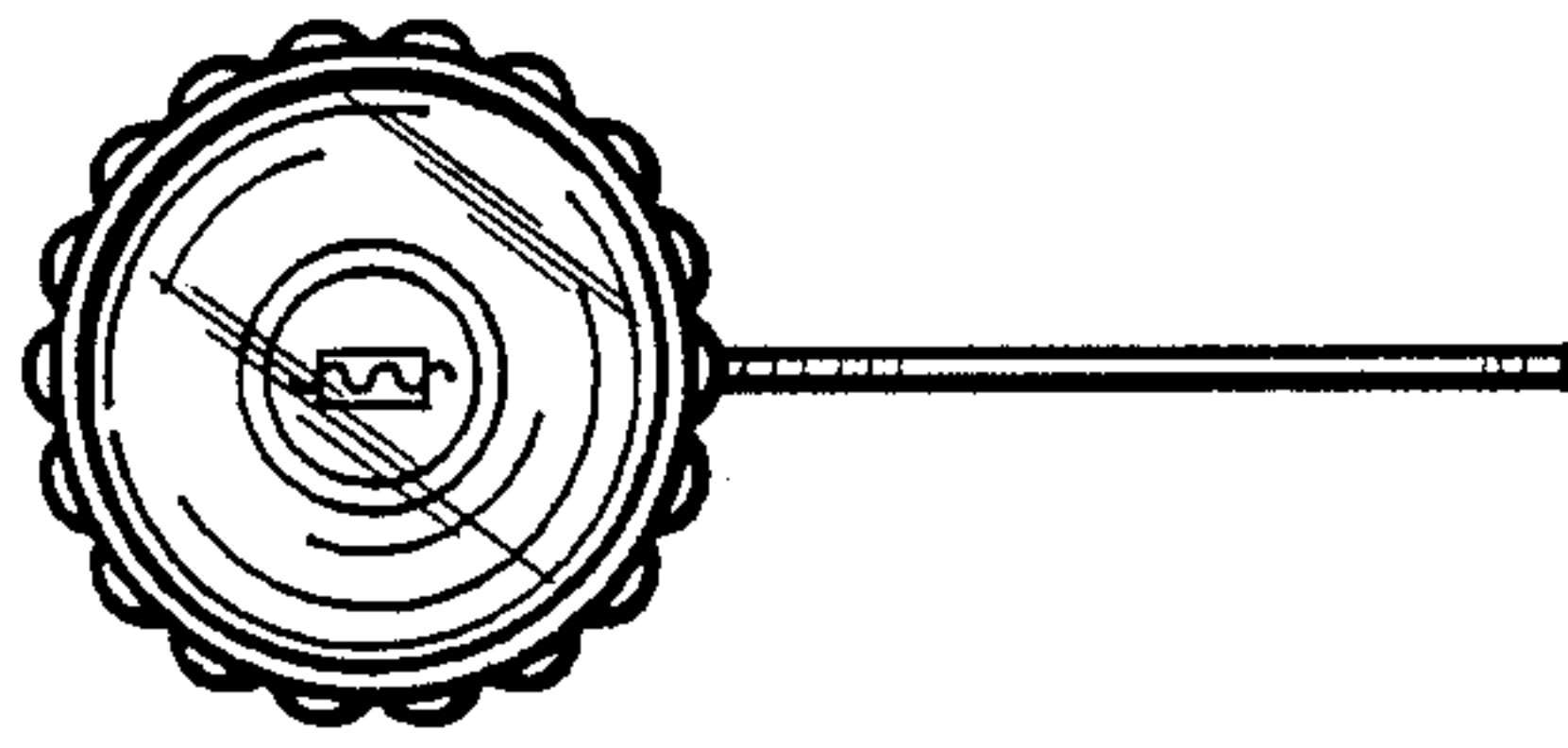

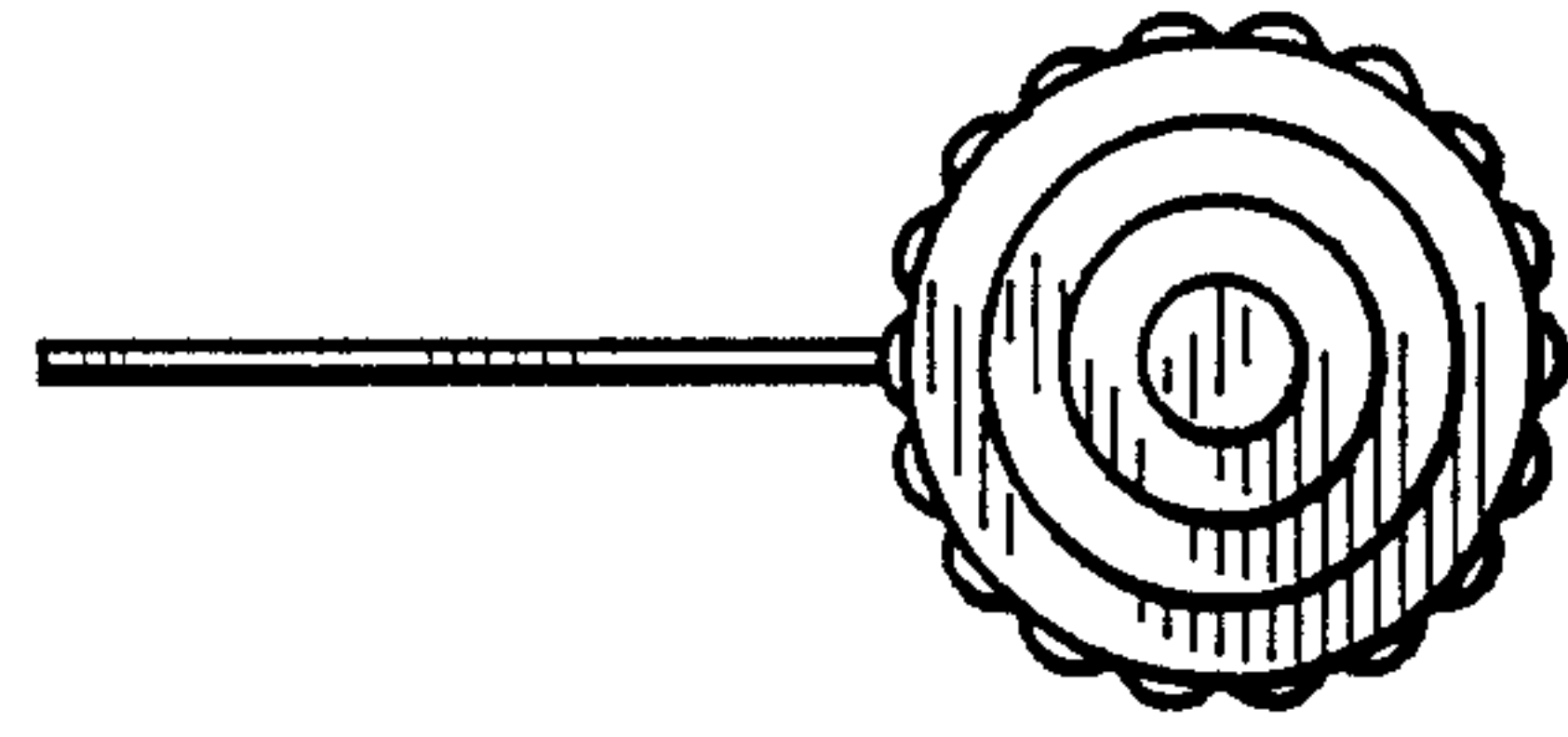

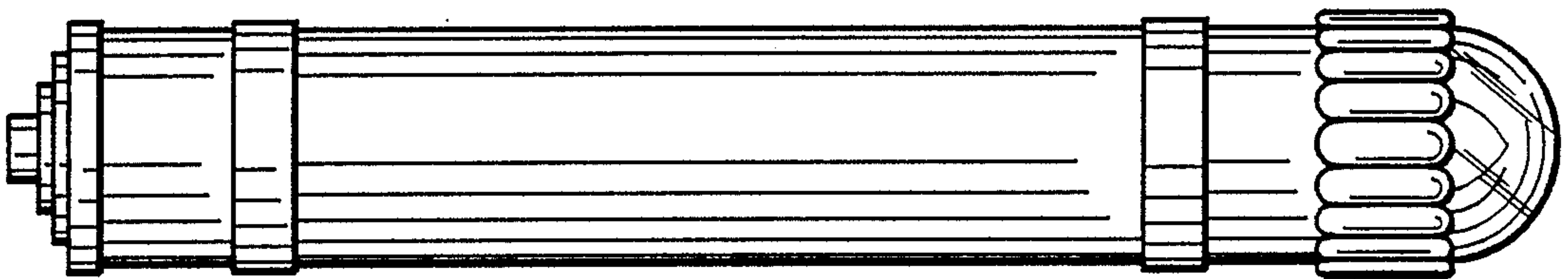

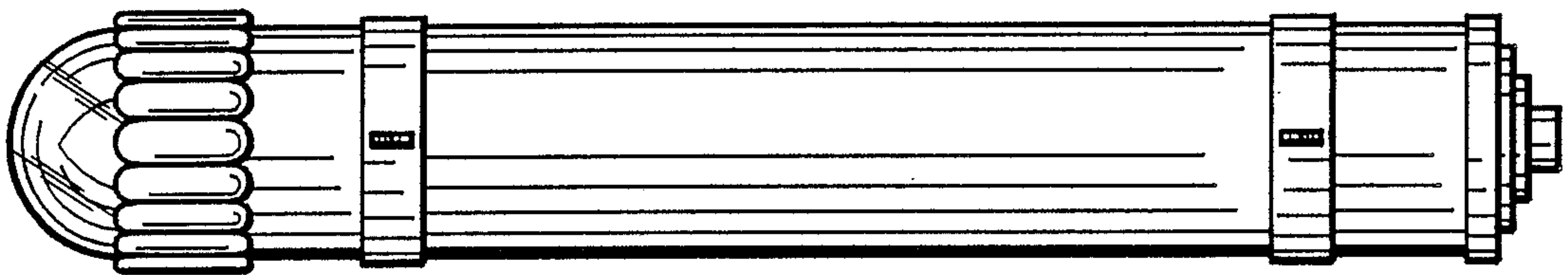

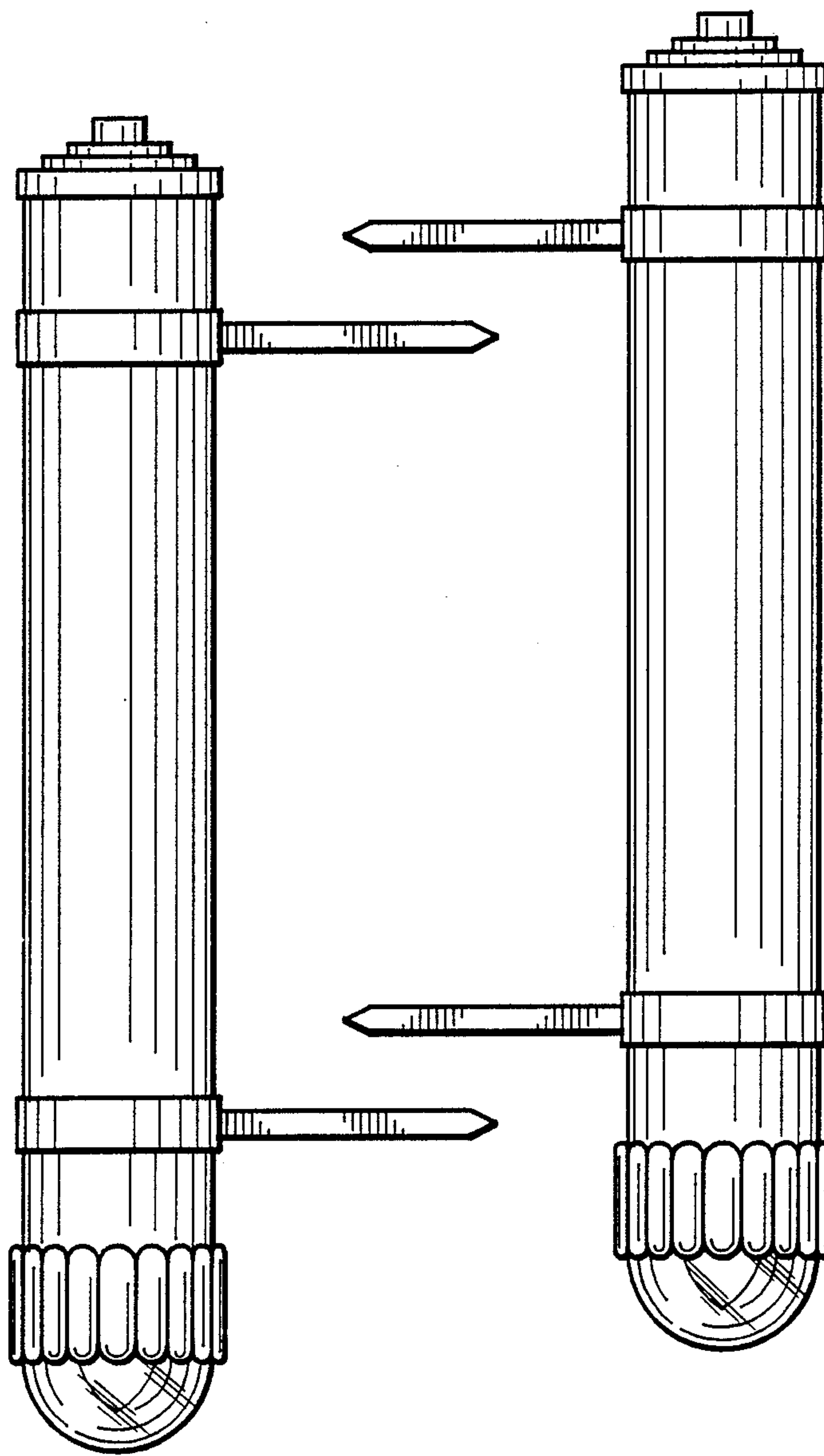
