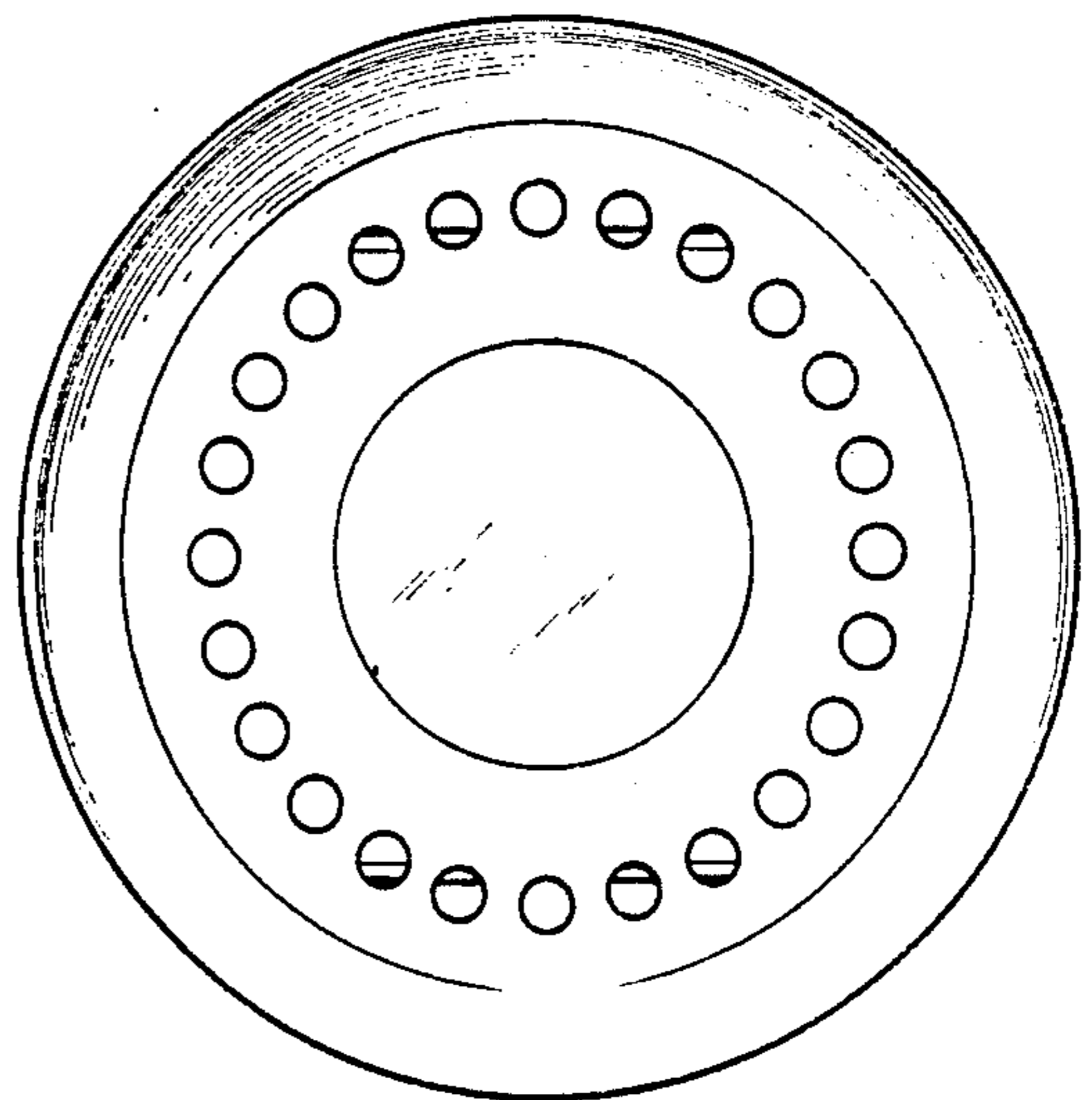
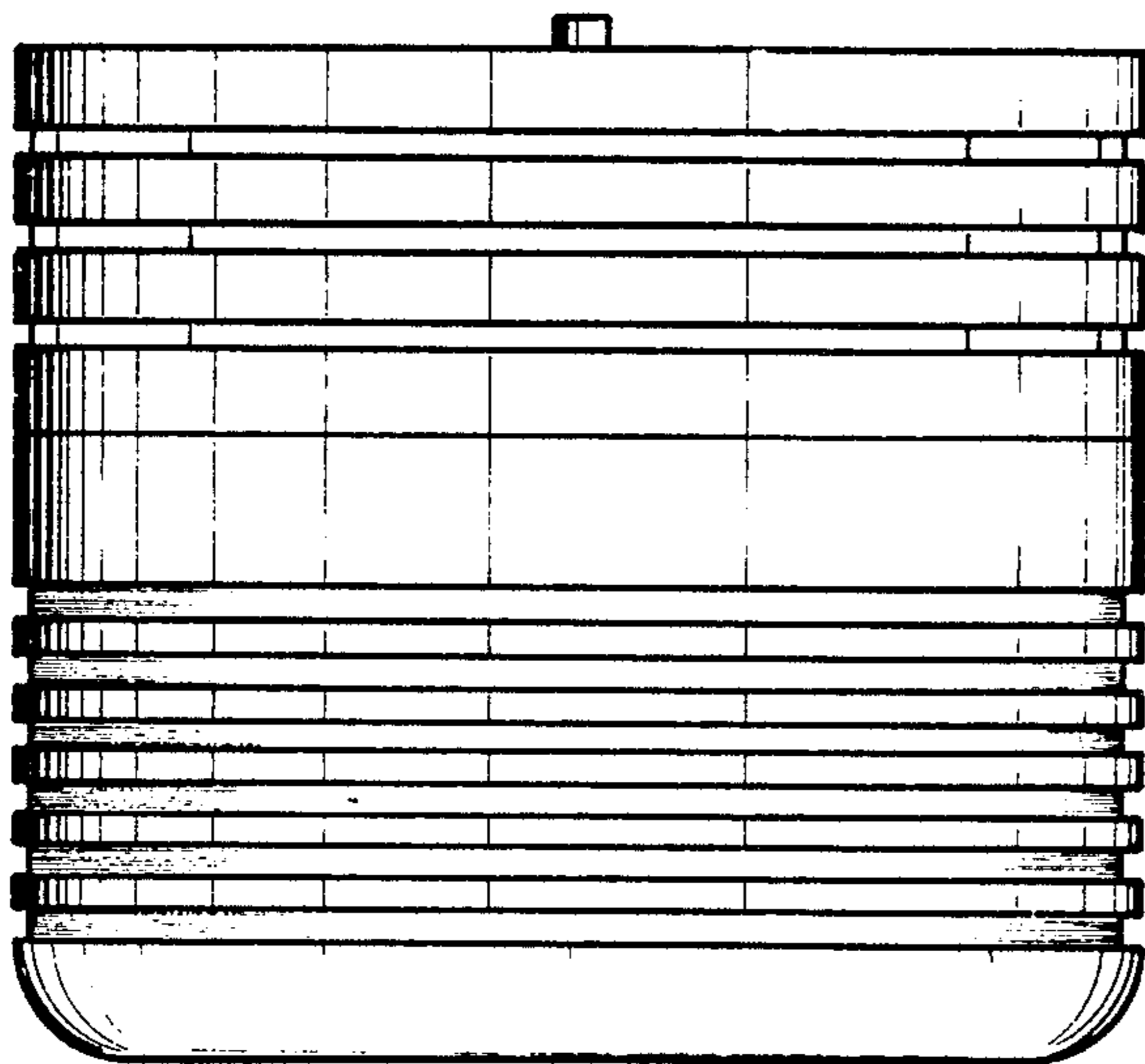

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top perspective view of a combined chandelier and ceiling fan showing my new design;

 FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view thereof.



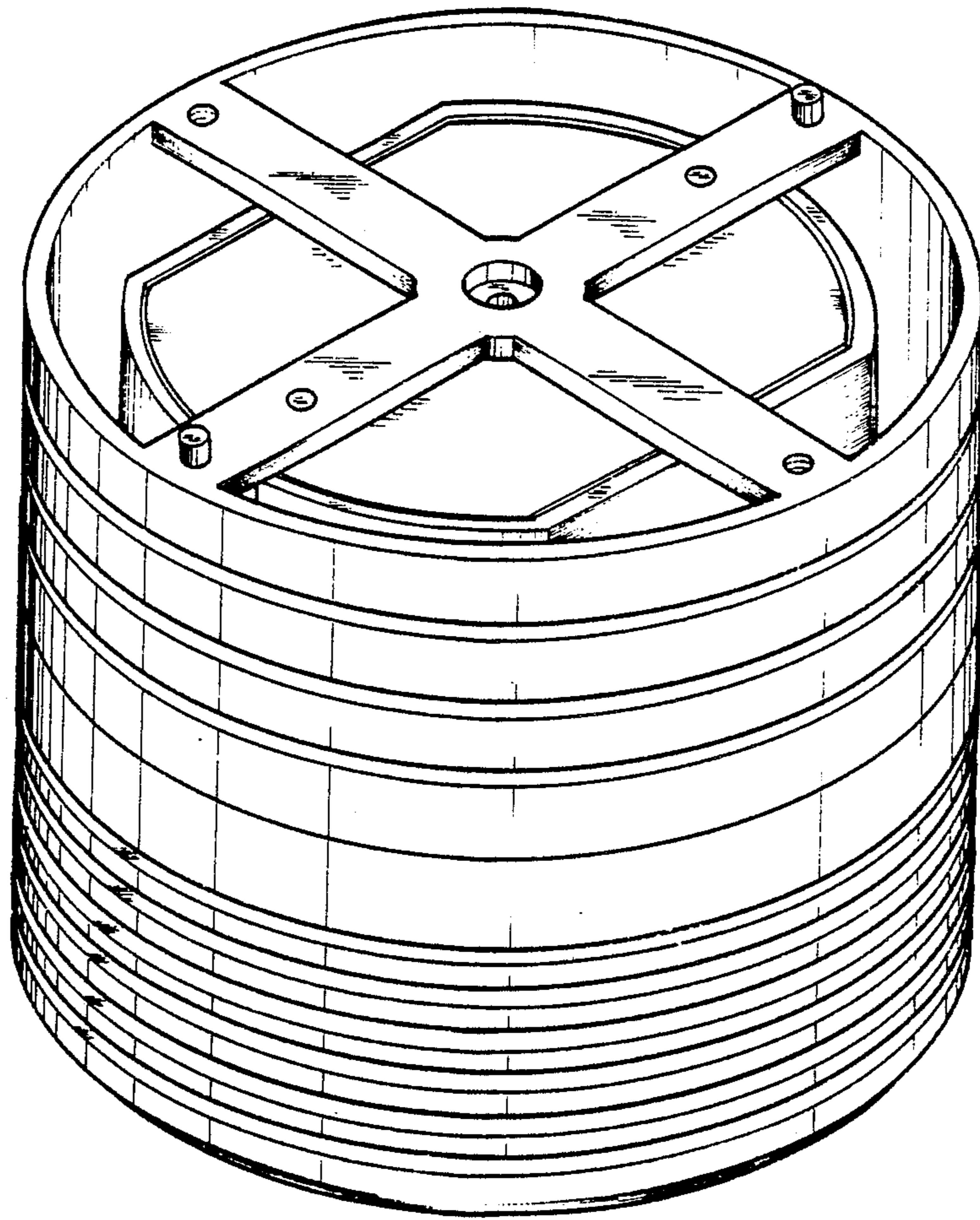

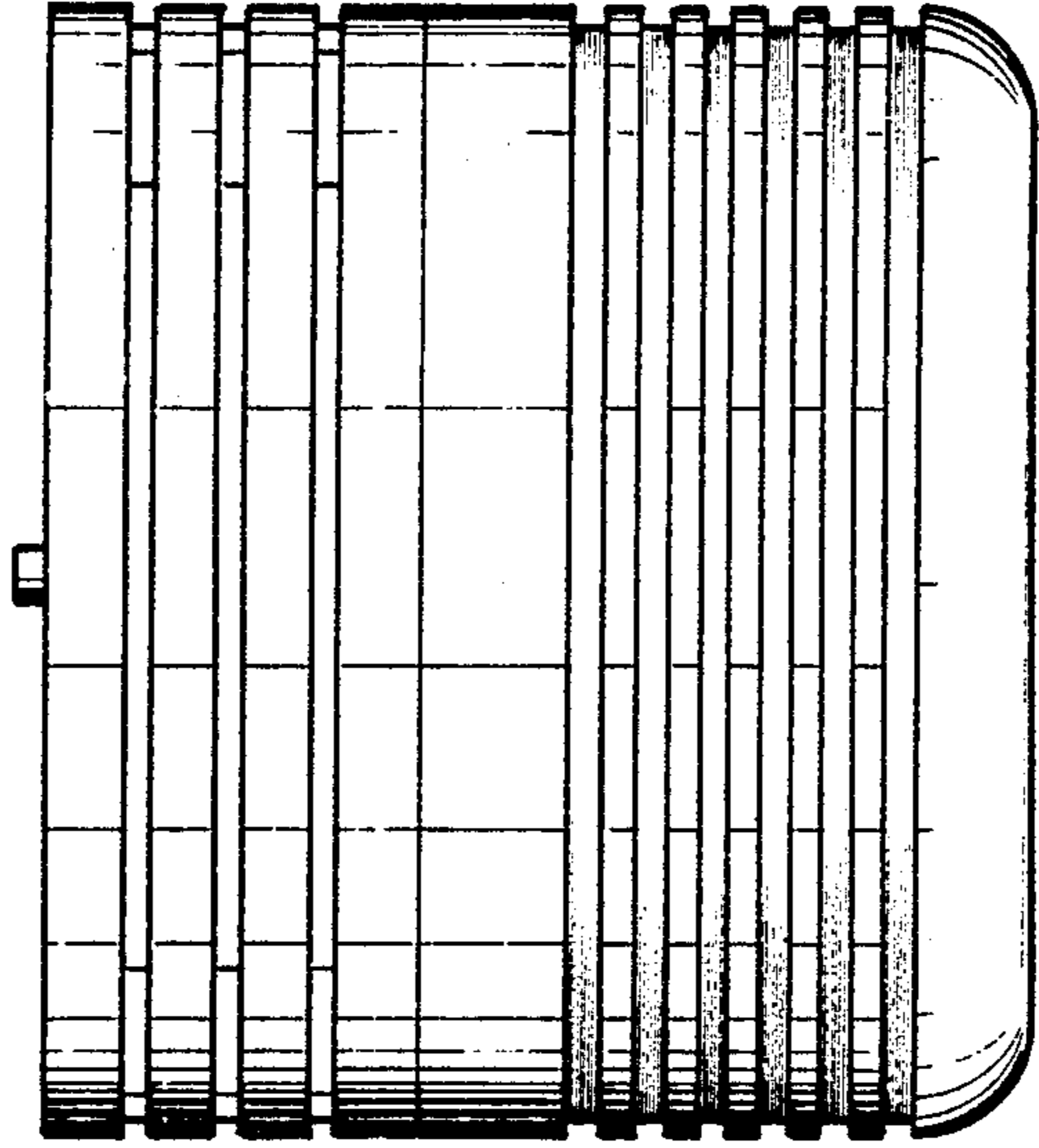

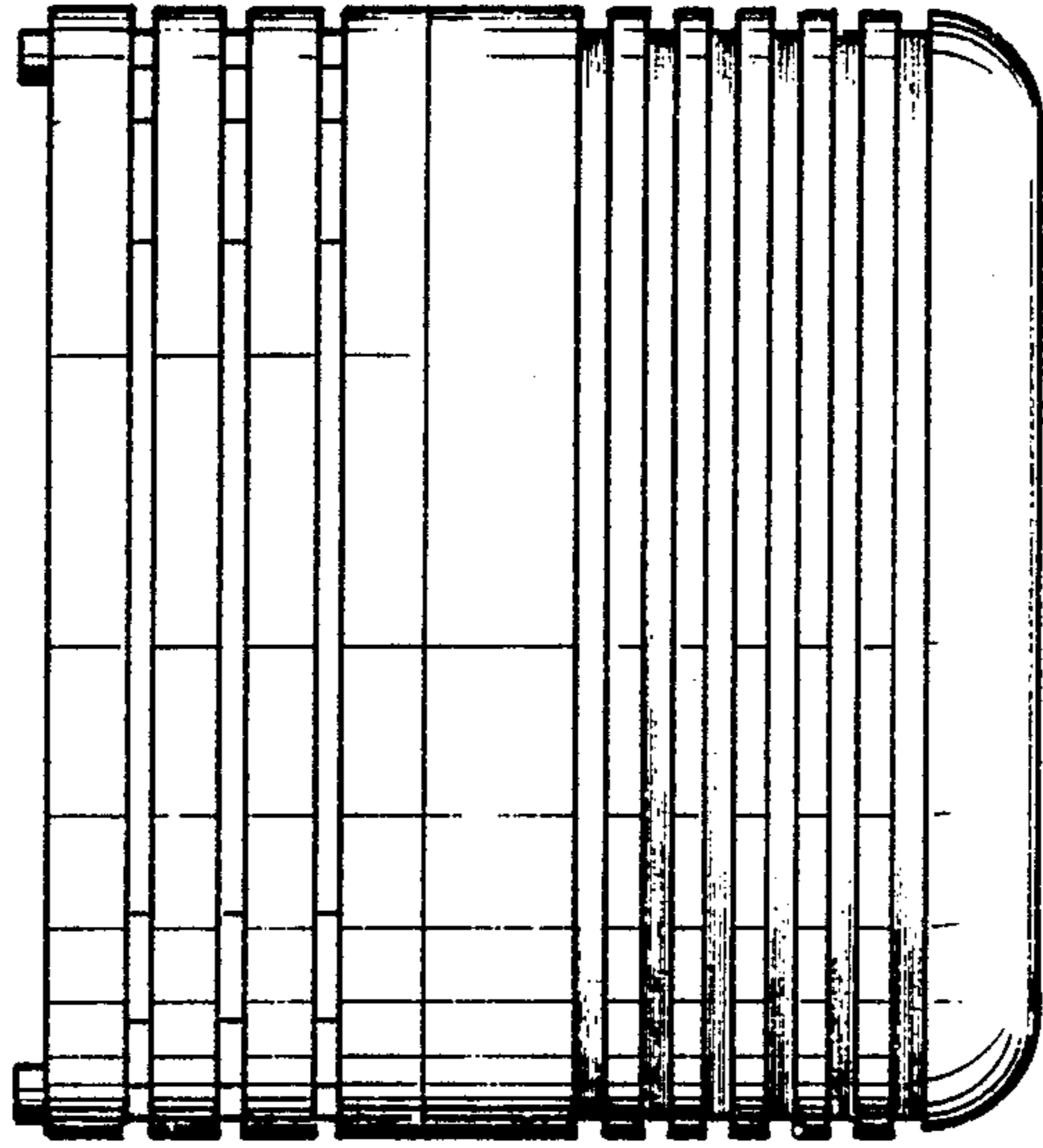

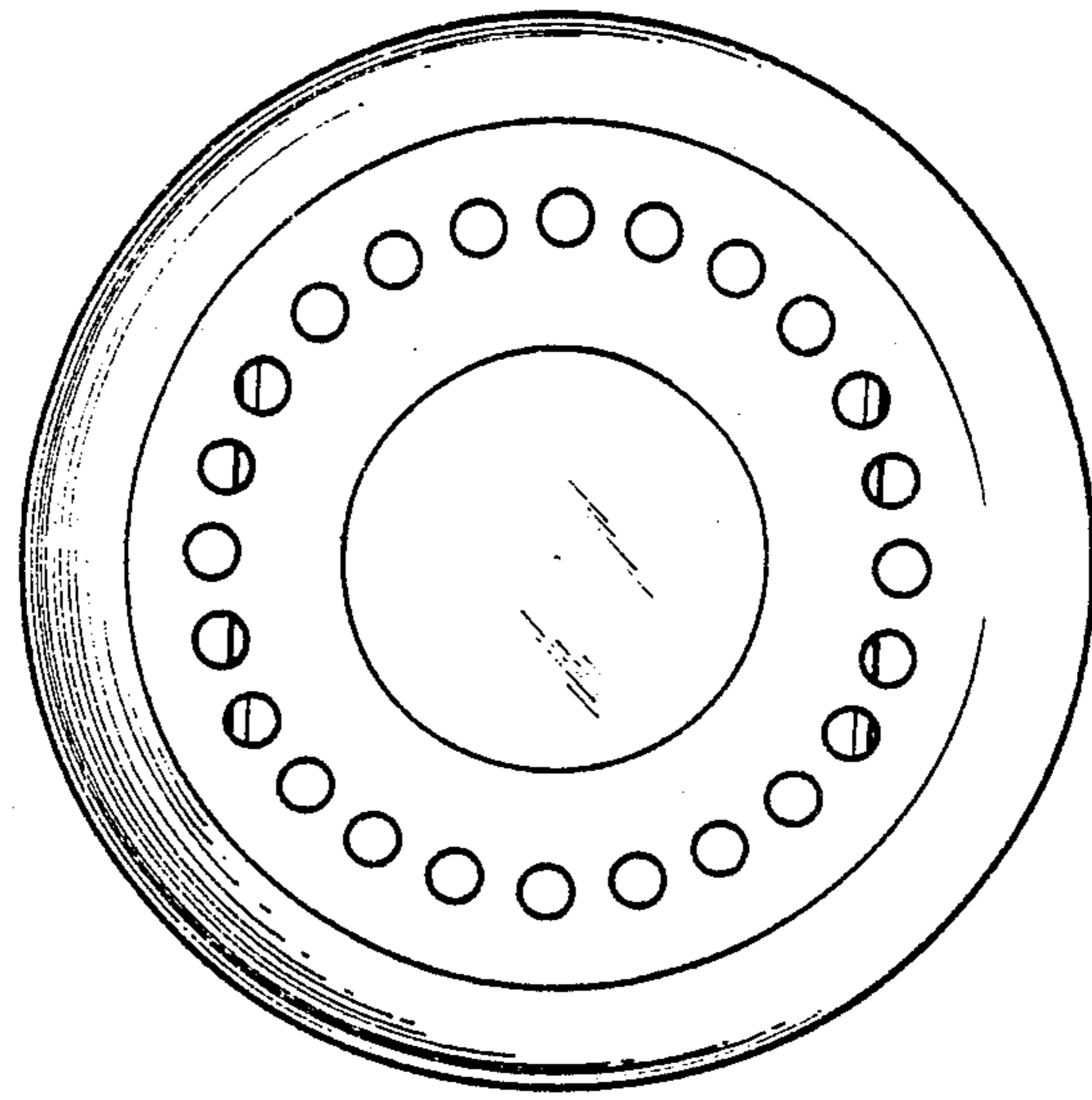

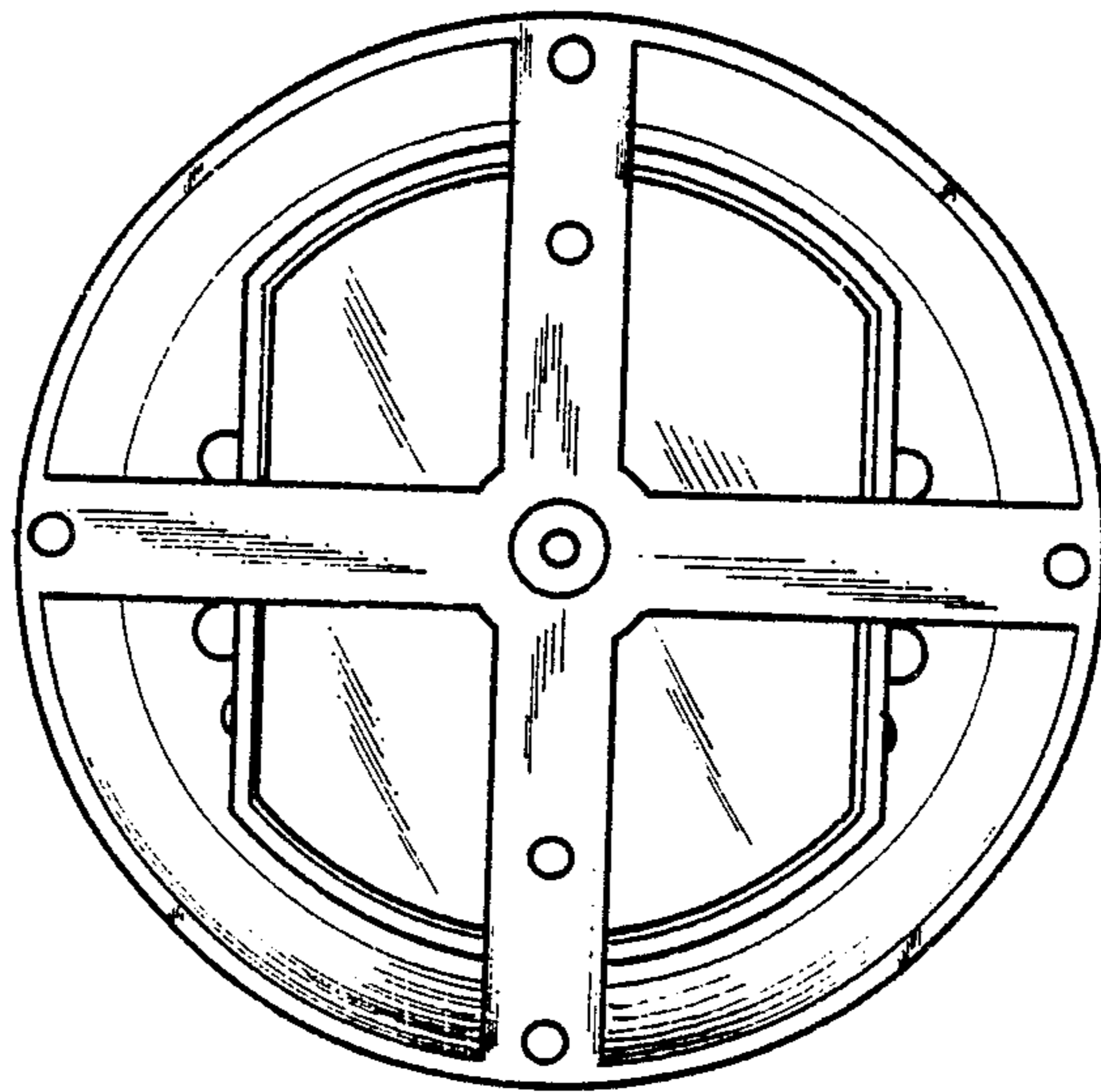
