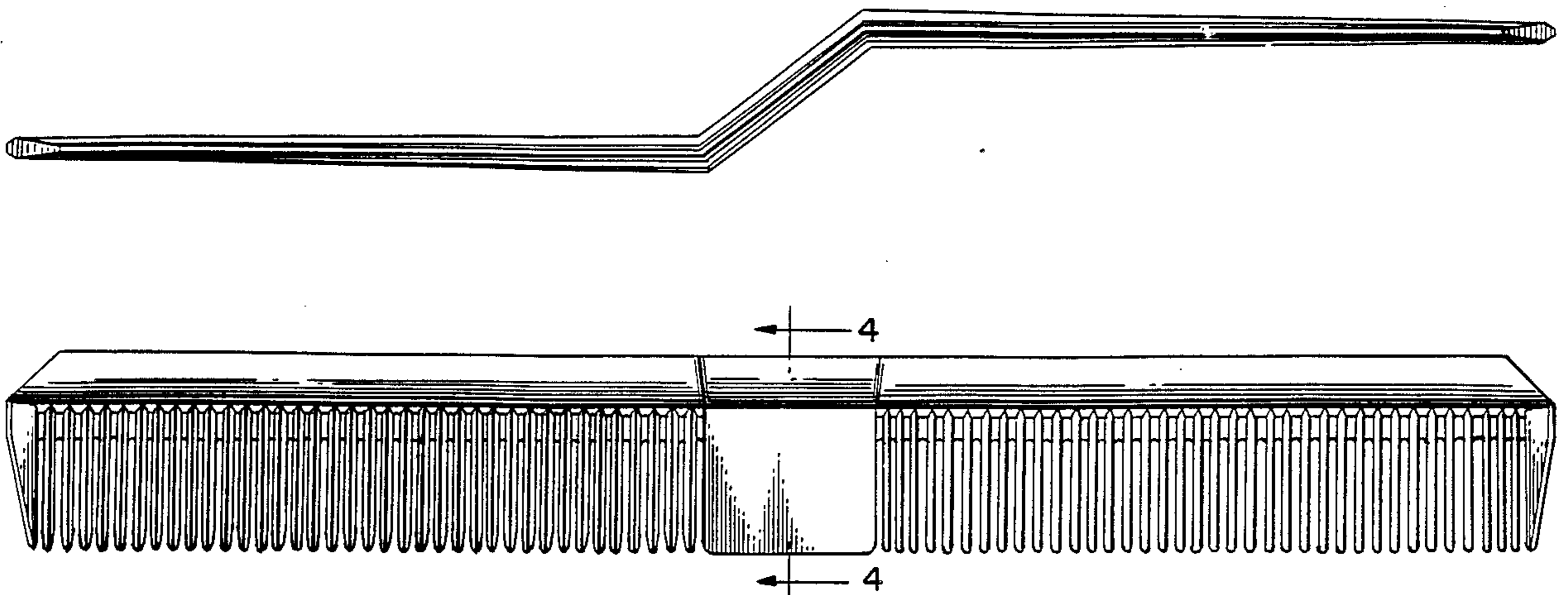

The ornamental design for a comb, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top plan view of a comb embodying my design;
 FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof;
 FIG. 3 is an enlarged fragmentary top plan view thereof;
 FIG. 4 is an enlarged cross sectional view taken on line 4—4 of FIG. 2;
 FIG. 5 is an enlarged fragmentary plan view, as seen from the bottom of FIG. 8;
 FIG. 6 is an enlarged fragmentary plan view as seen from the bottom of FIG. 9;
 FIG. 7 is an enlarged cross sectional view taken on line 7—7 of FIG. 8;
 FIG. 8 is an enlarged fragmentary elevational view of the left hand portion of FIG. 2;
 FIG. 9 is an enlarged fragmentary elevational view of the right hand portion of FIG. 8;
 FIG. 10 is an enlarged right end elevational view thereof; and
 FIG. 11 is an enlarged left end elevational view thereof.



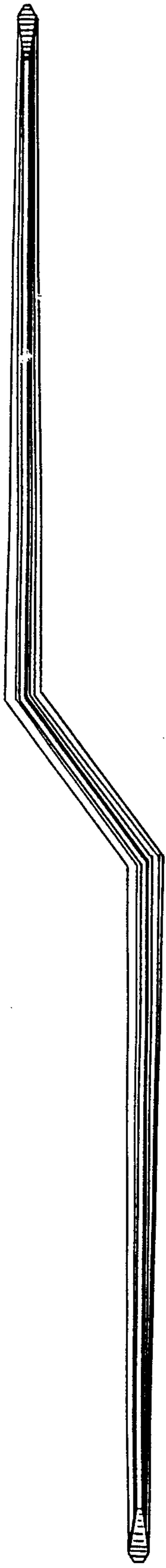

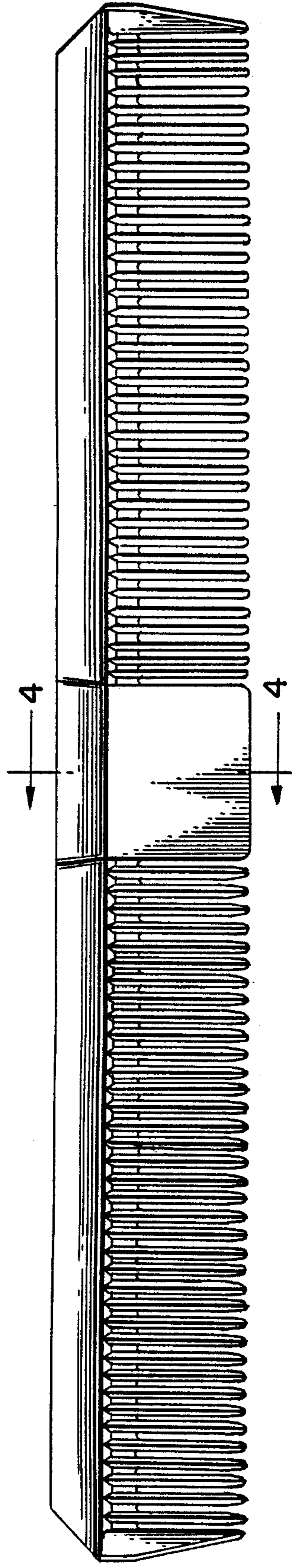

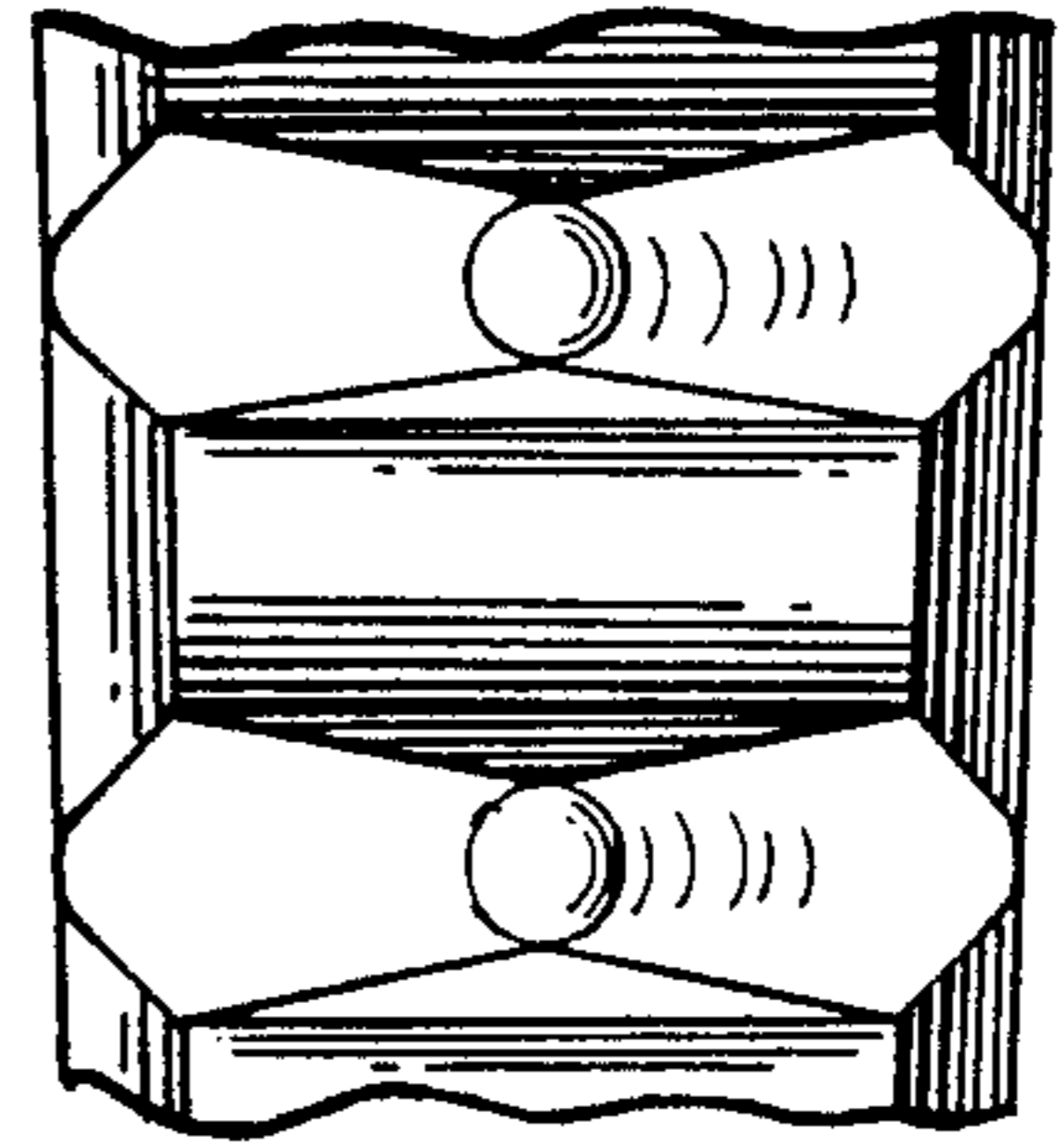

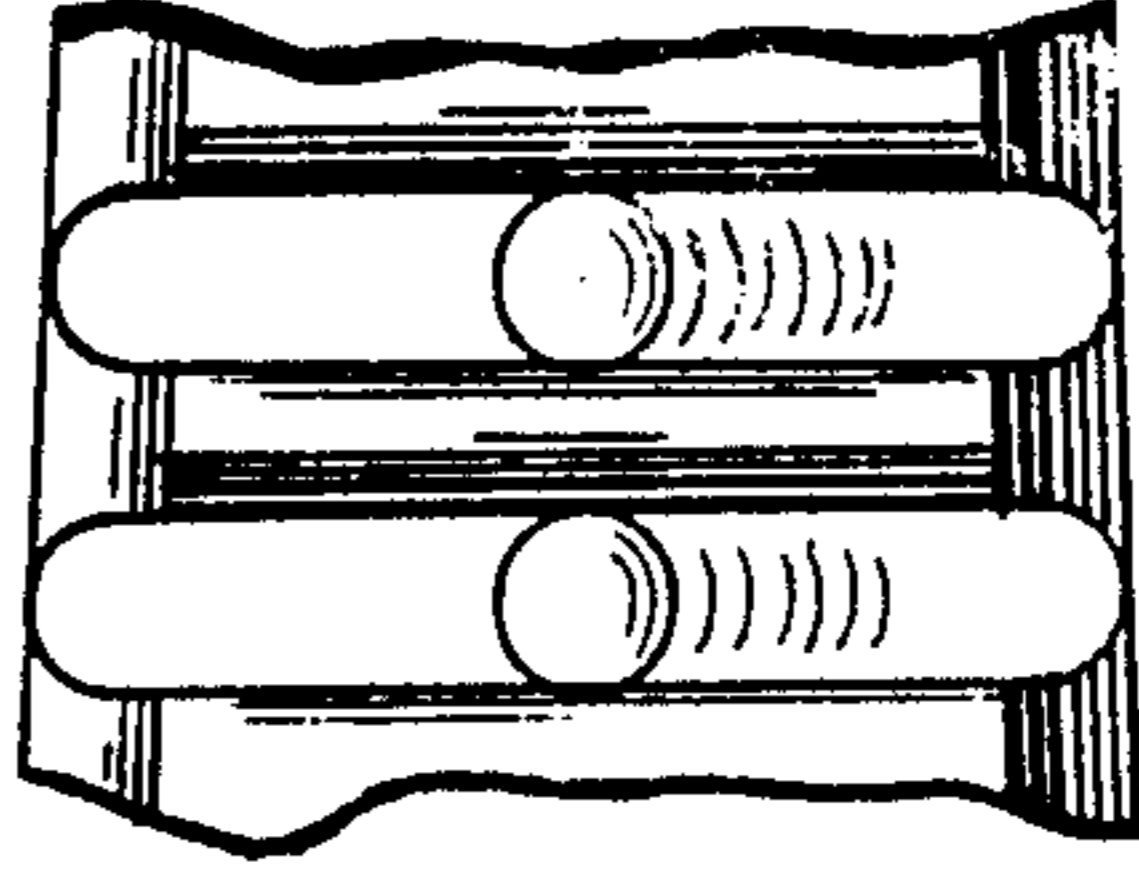

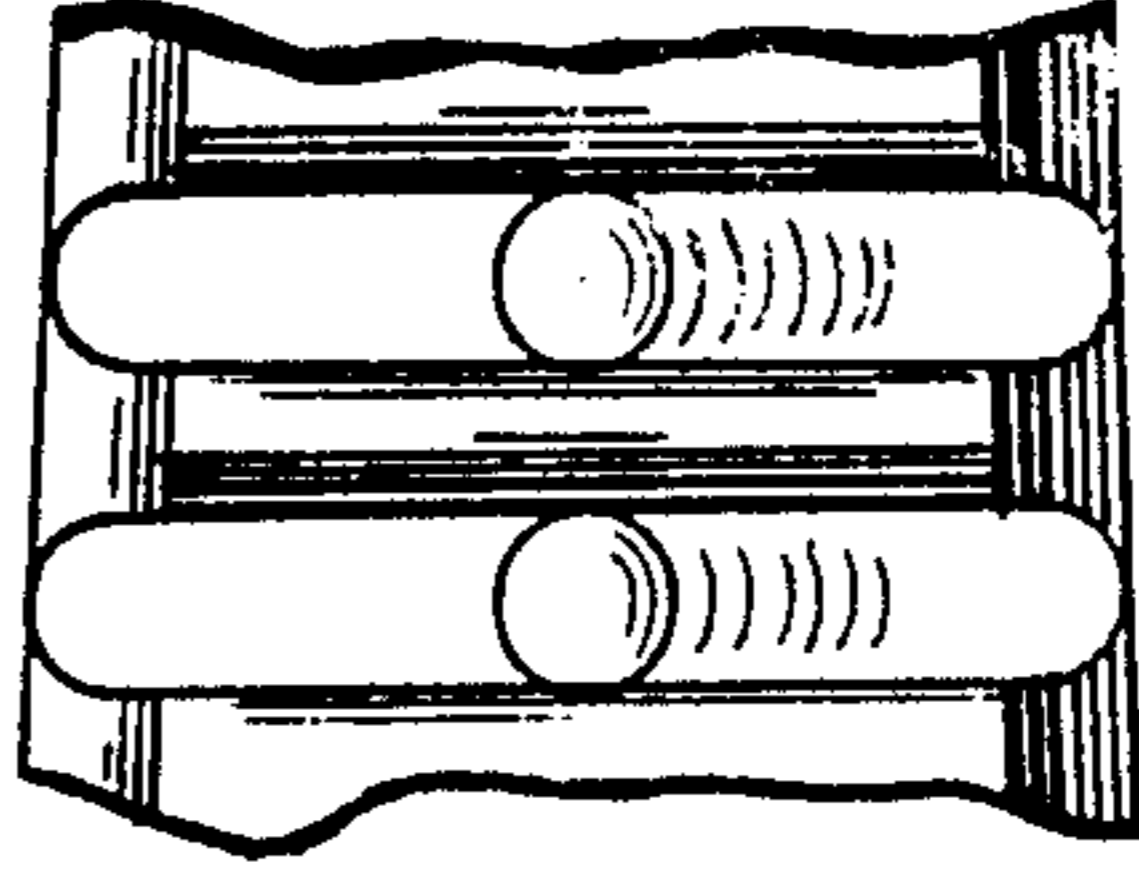

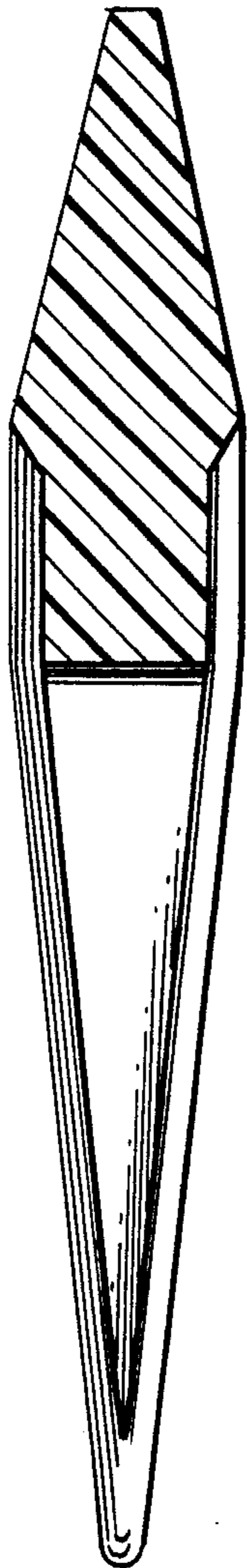

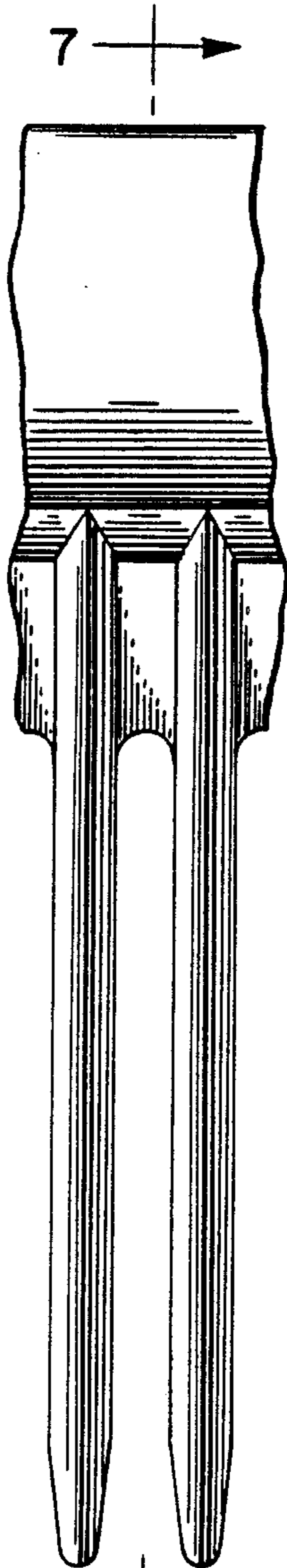

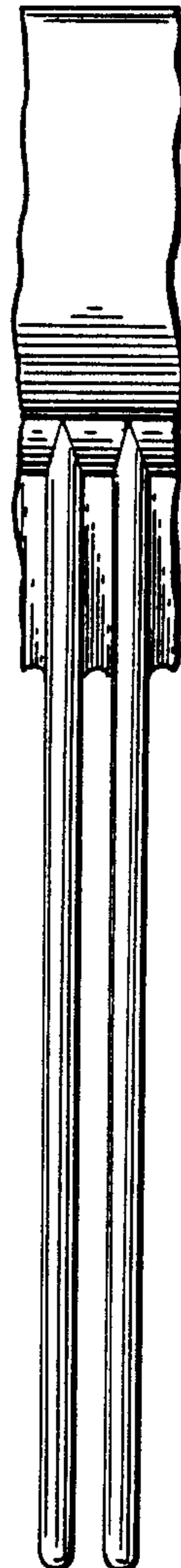

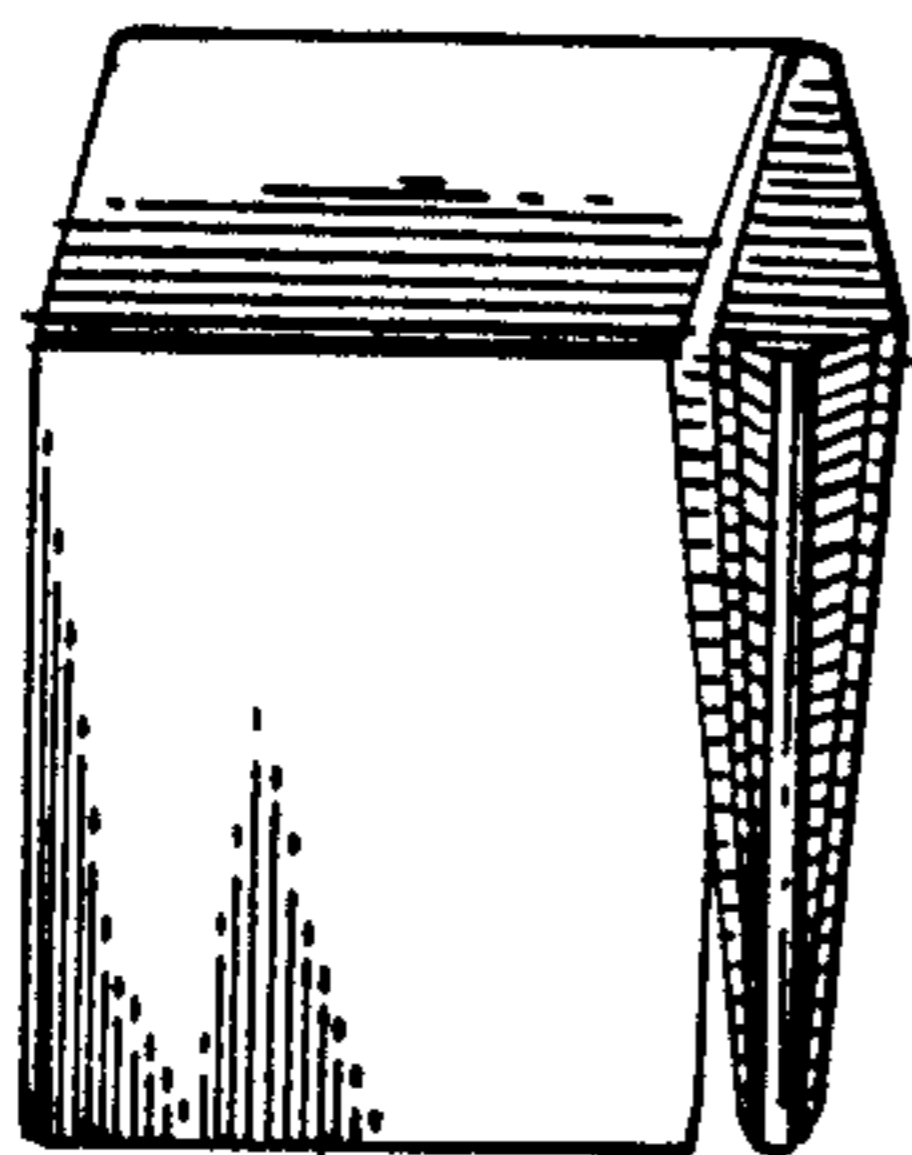

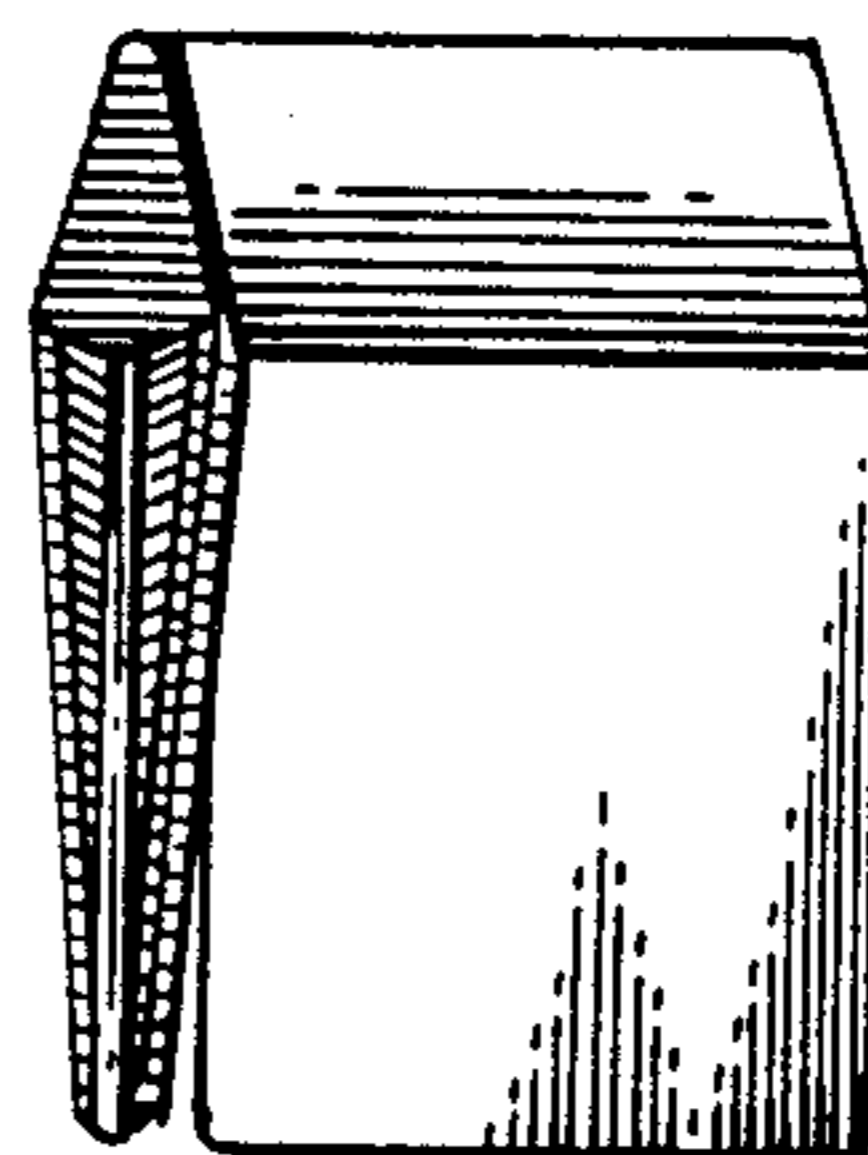
