as shown and described.



DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a plan view of a canine protective garment
showing my new design; and

FIG. 2 is a perspective view thereof.

The broken line showing of a dog in FIG. 2 is for illus-

the fabric is of conventional thickness.


