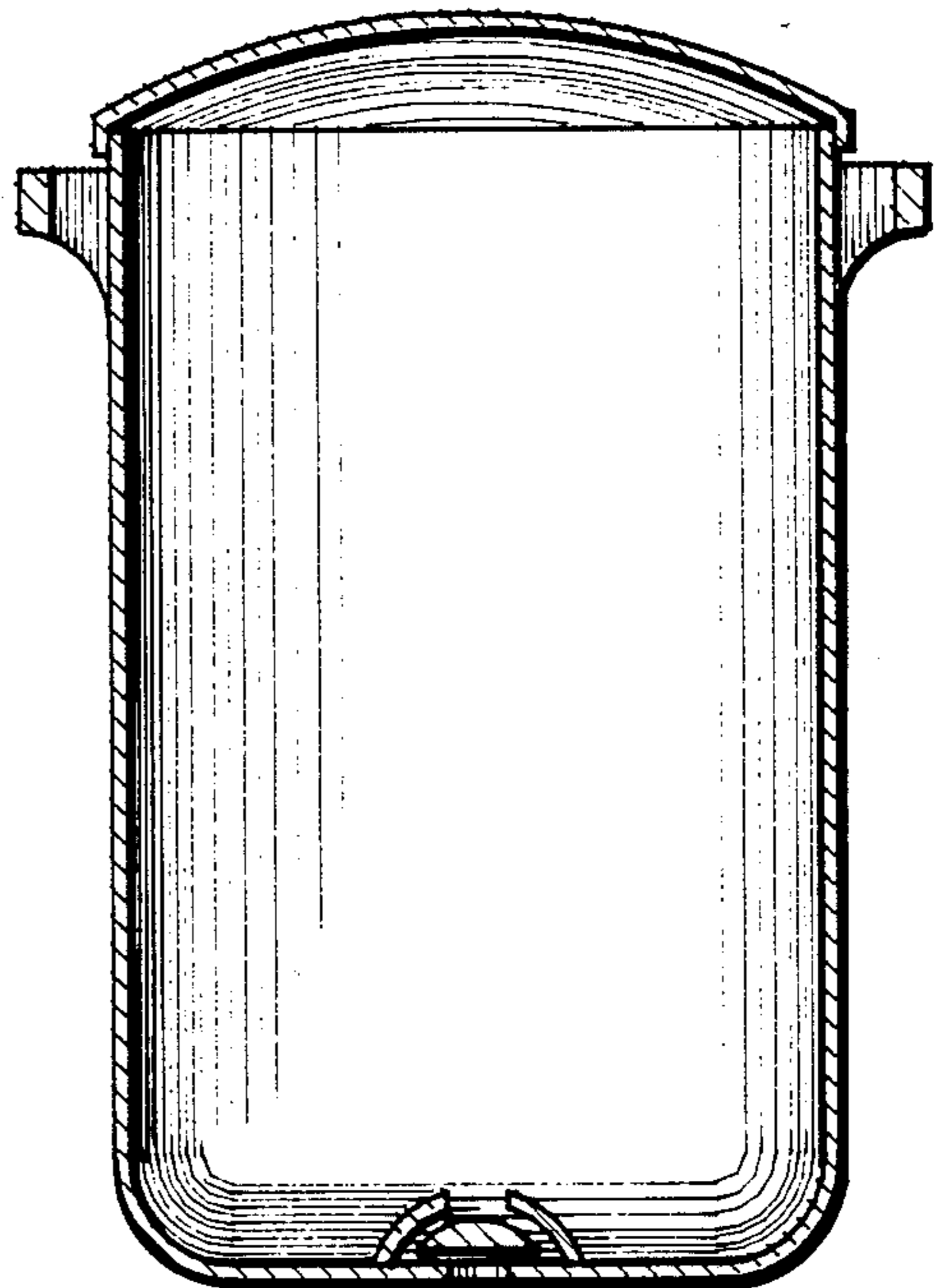
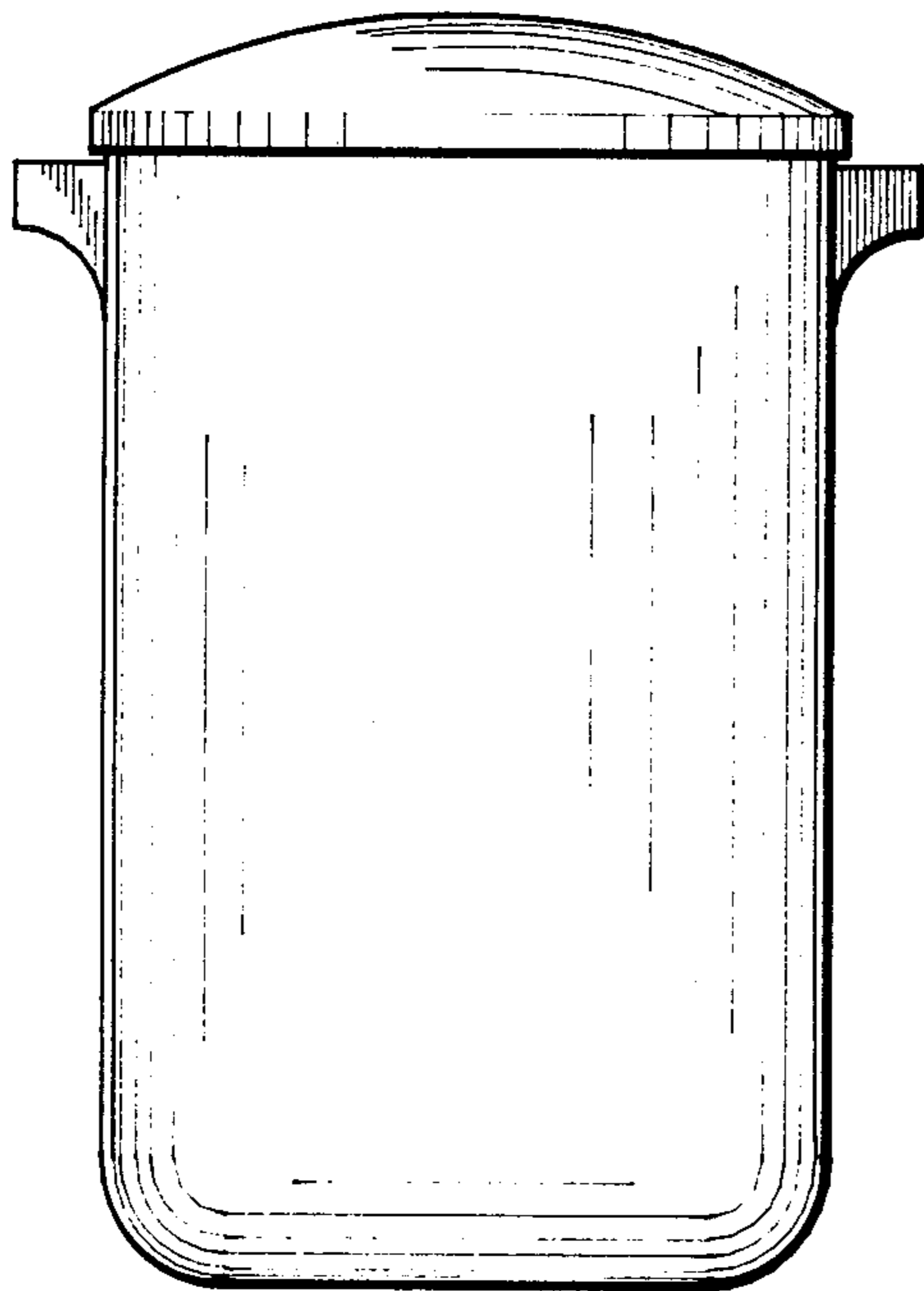

The ornamental design for a trash can, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a trash can showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a rear elevational view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a left side elevational view thereof;
FIG. 4 is a right side elevational view thereof;
FIG. 5 is a top plan view thereof;
FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view thereof; and,
FIG. 7 is a cross sectional view thereof taken along the line 7 of FIG. 5.



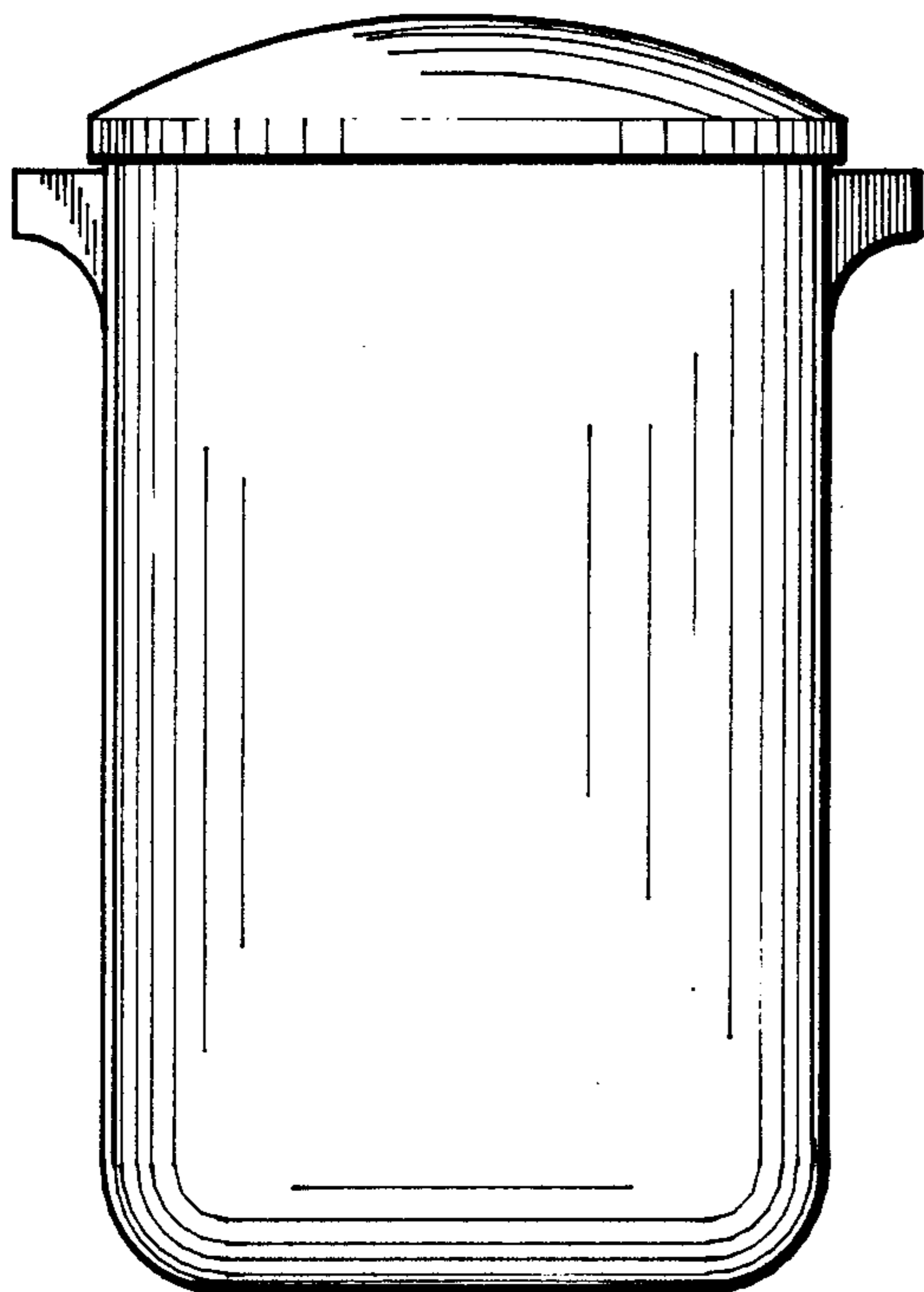

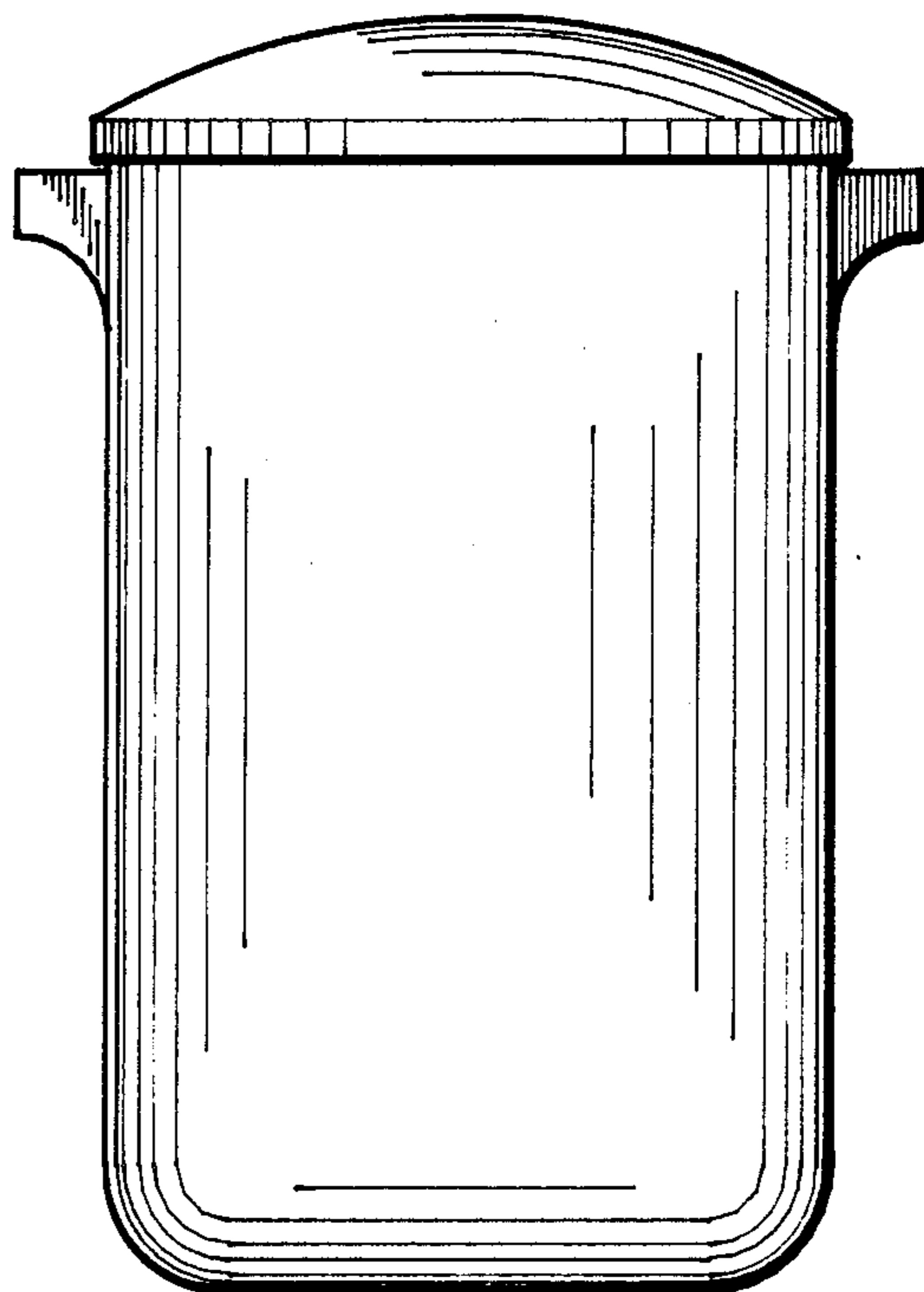

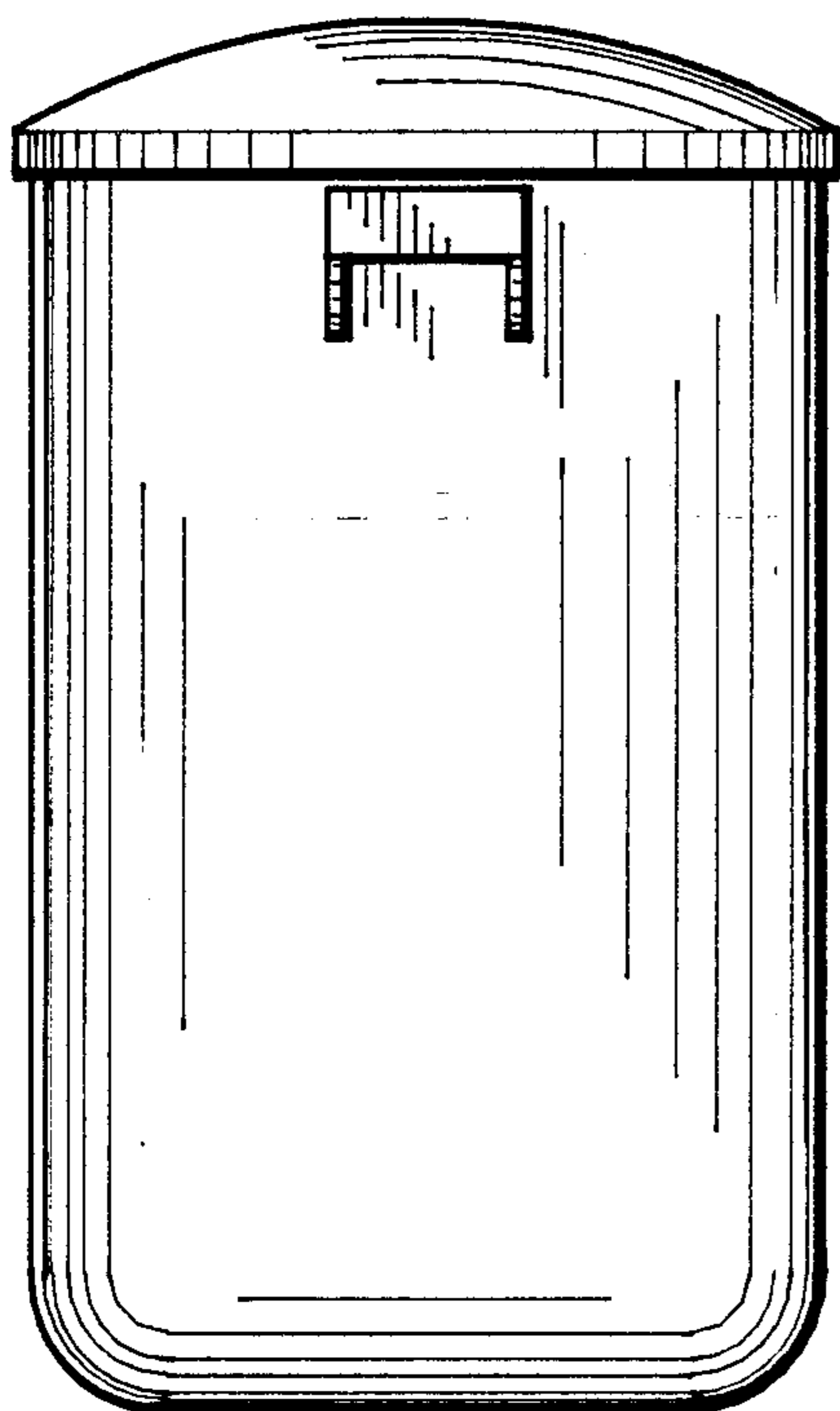

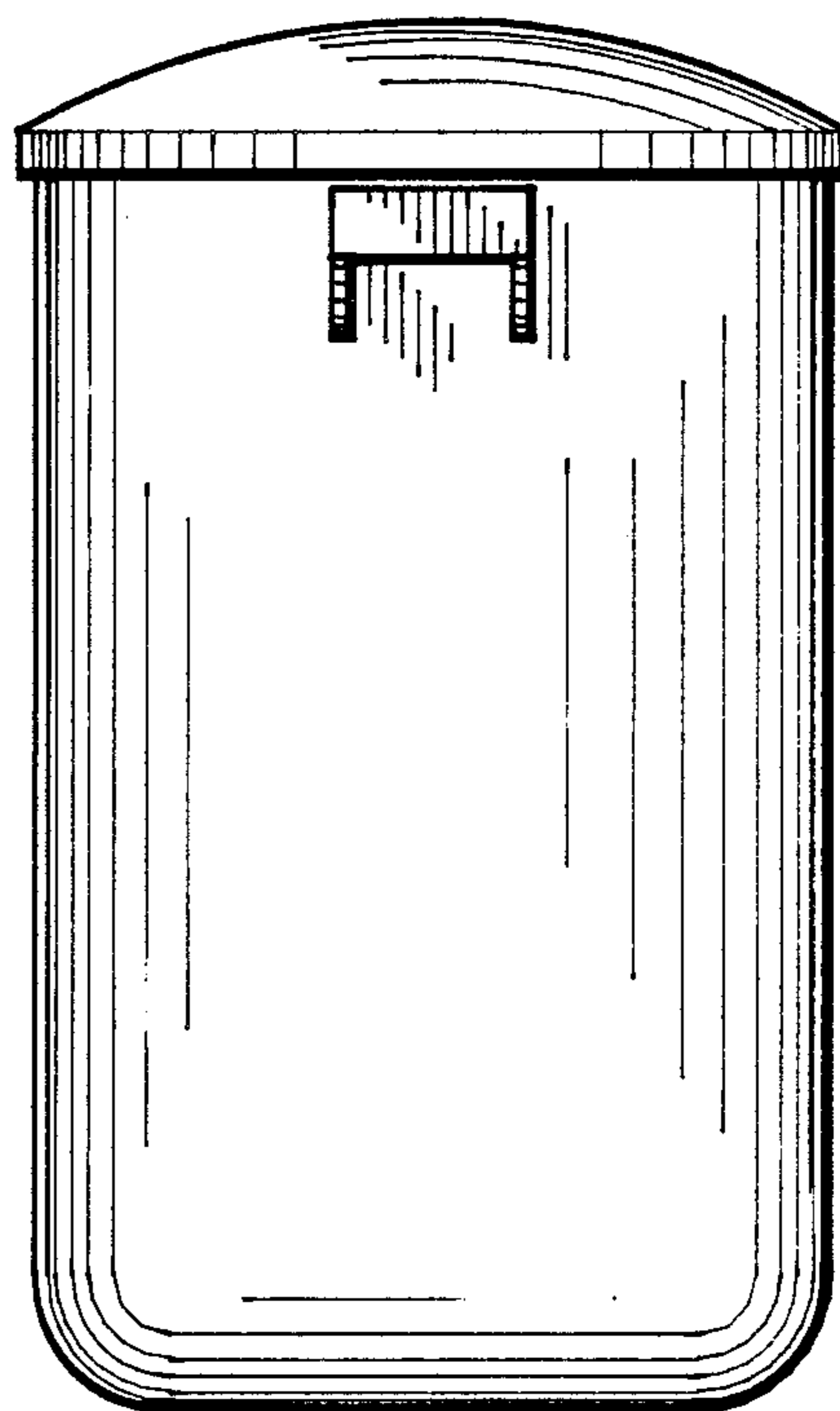

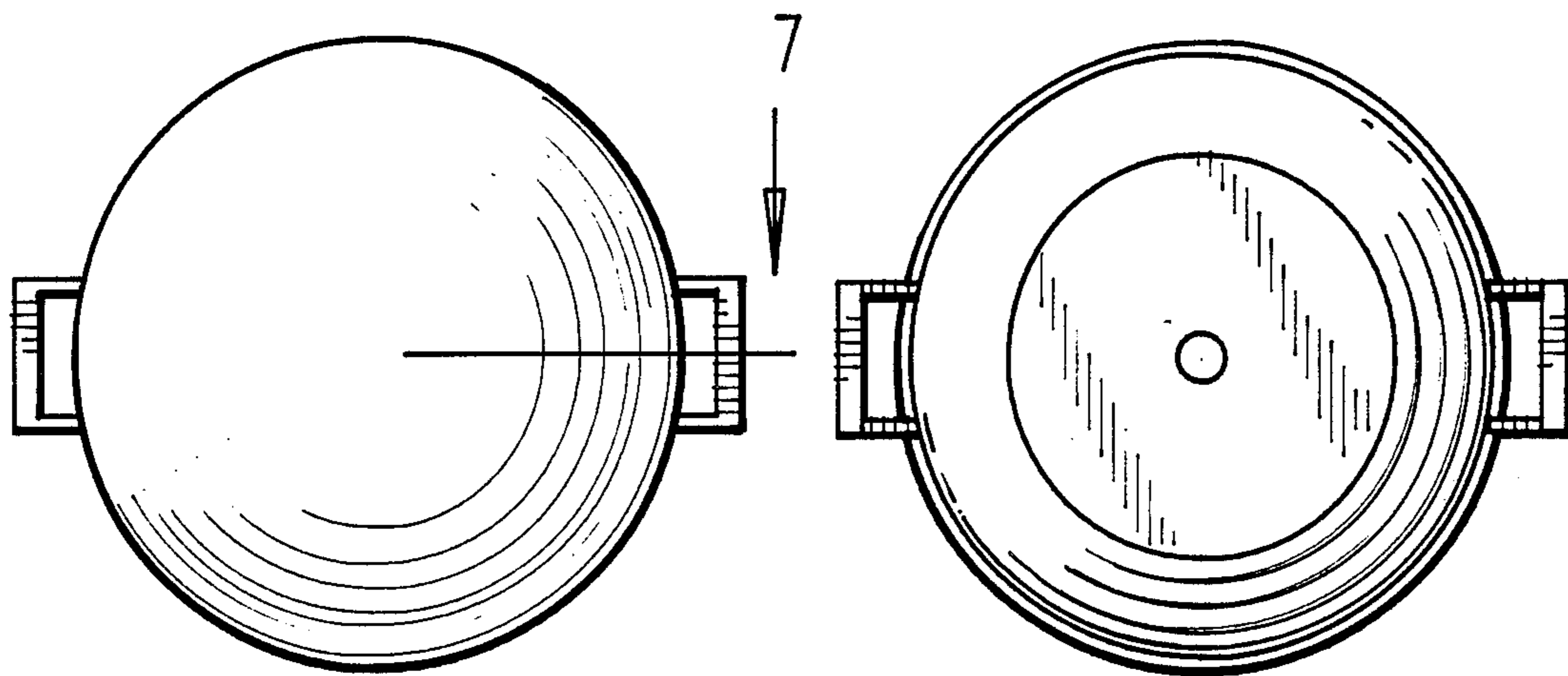

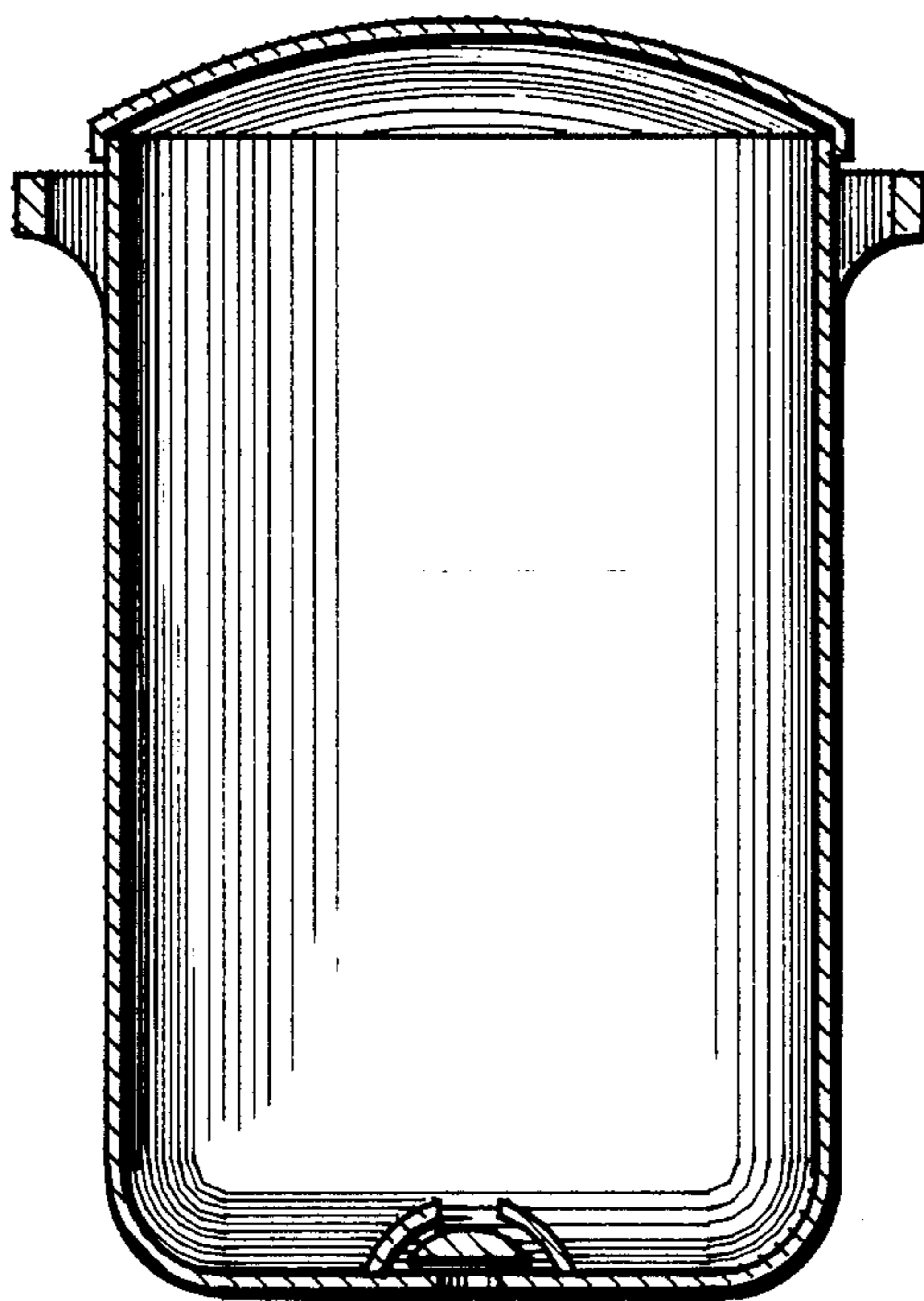
