[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a support frame for a merchandise display unit, as shown and described.

**DESCRIPTION**

The FIGURE is a side perspective view of a support frame for a merchandise display unit, showing our new design.

The side and end of the support frame for a merchandise display unit not shown are the same in appearance as the side and end shown, while the undisclosed top is conventional in appearance.
