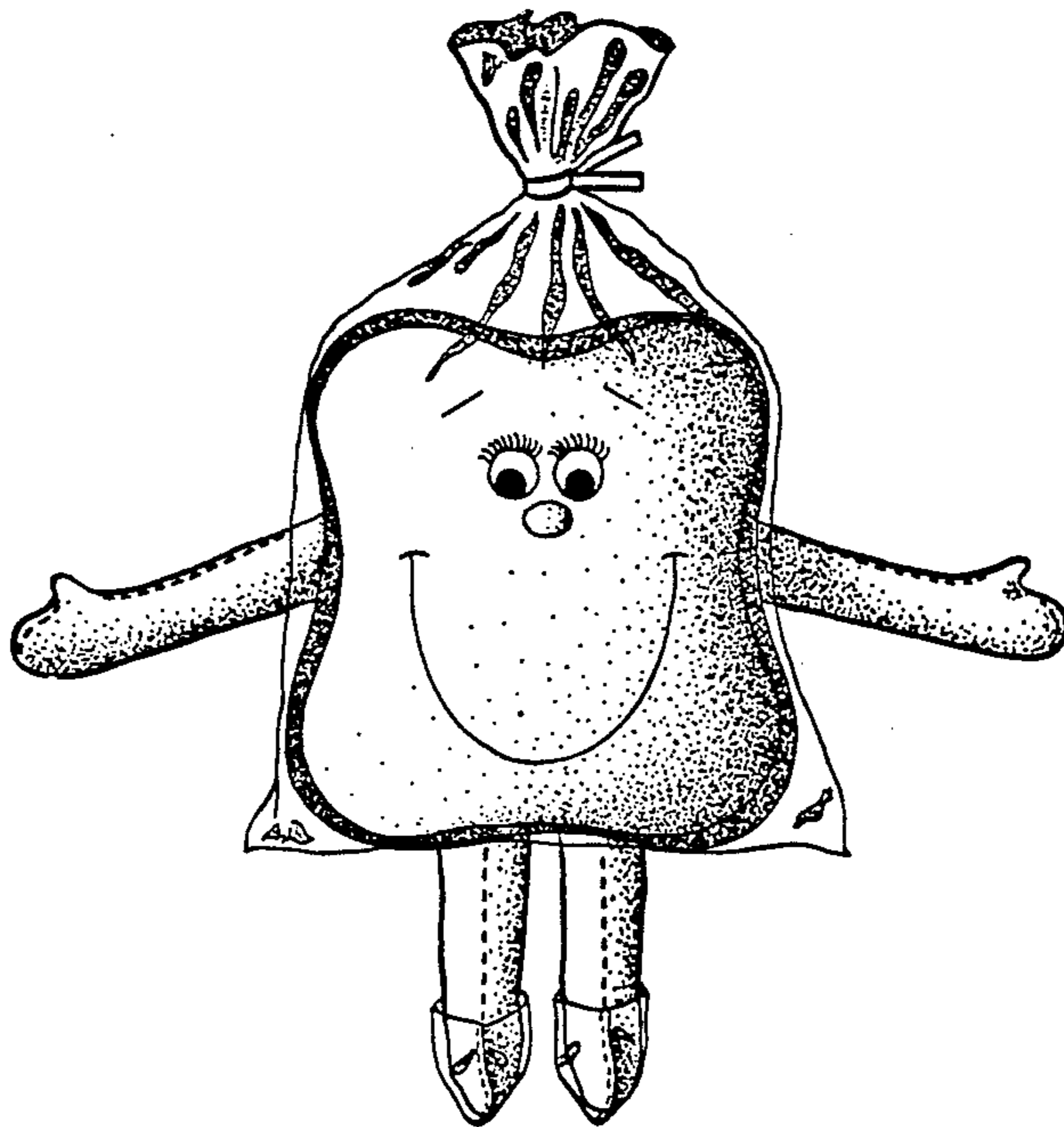

[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a doll resembling a slice of bread in a package, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a doll resembling a slice of bread in a package showing my new design; FIG. 2 is a rear elevational view thereof; FIG. 3 is a left side elevational view thereof, the right side being substantially a mirror image; FIG. 4 is a top plan view thereof; and FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view thereof.



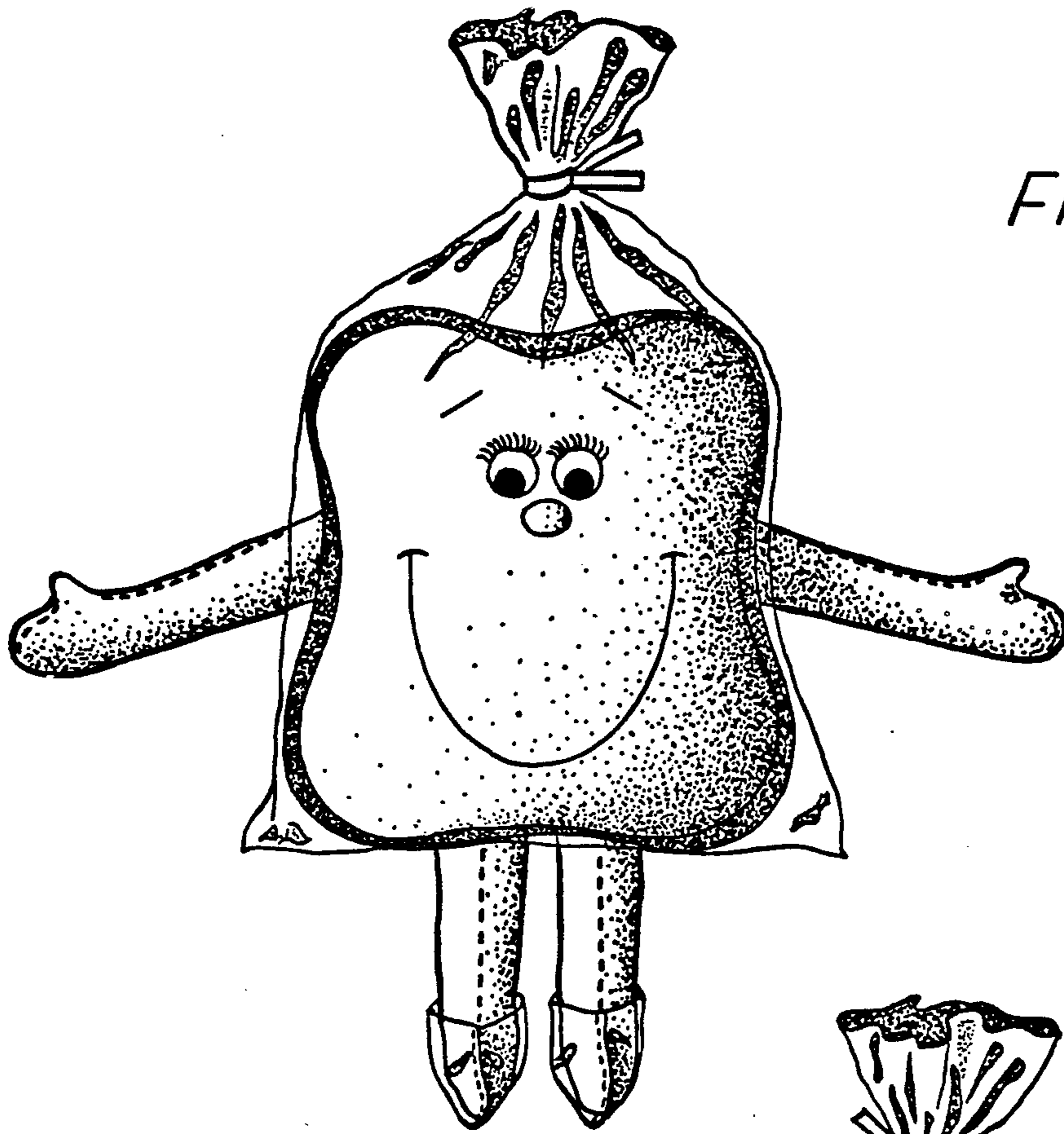
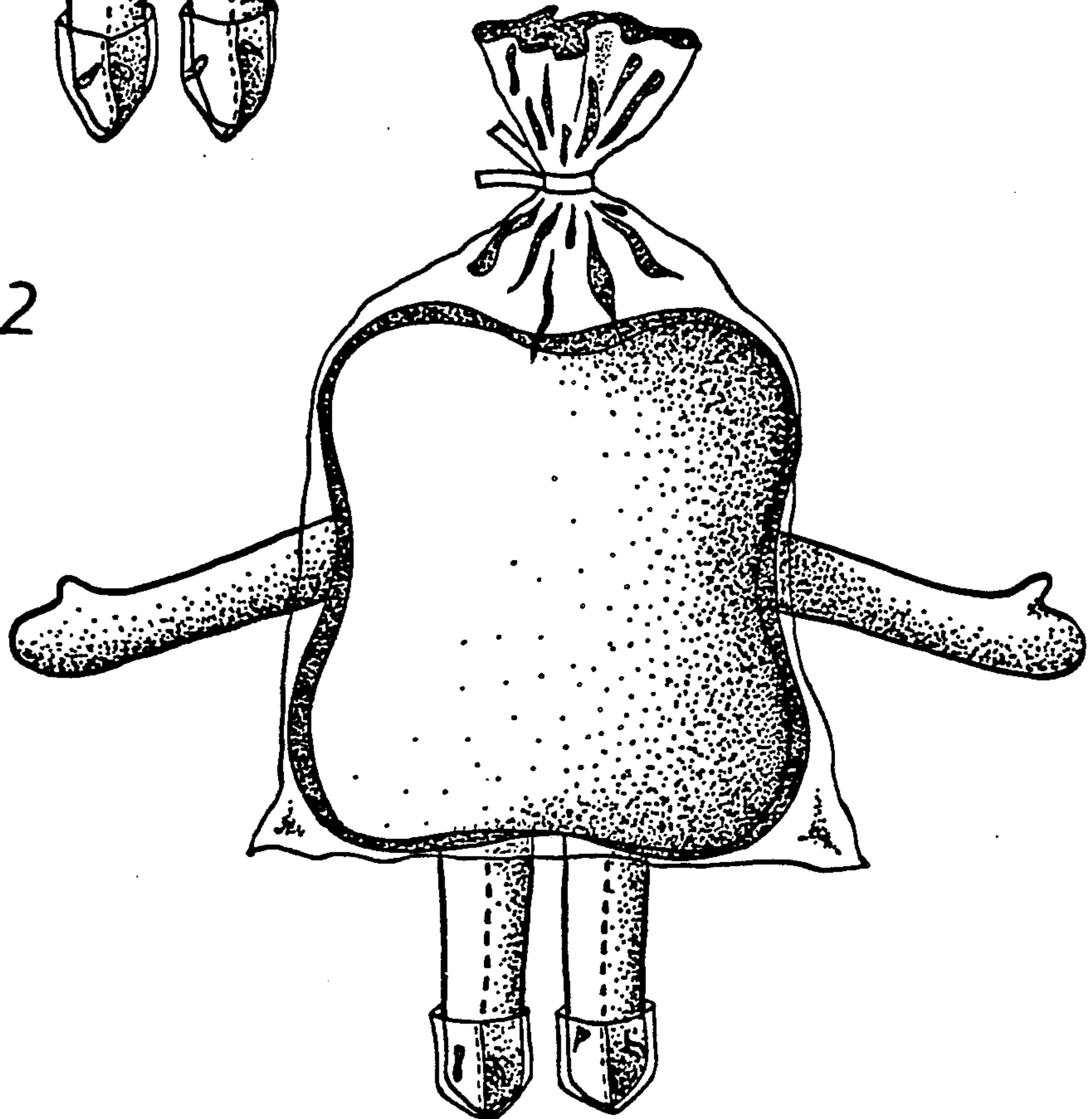

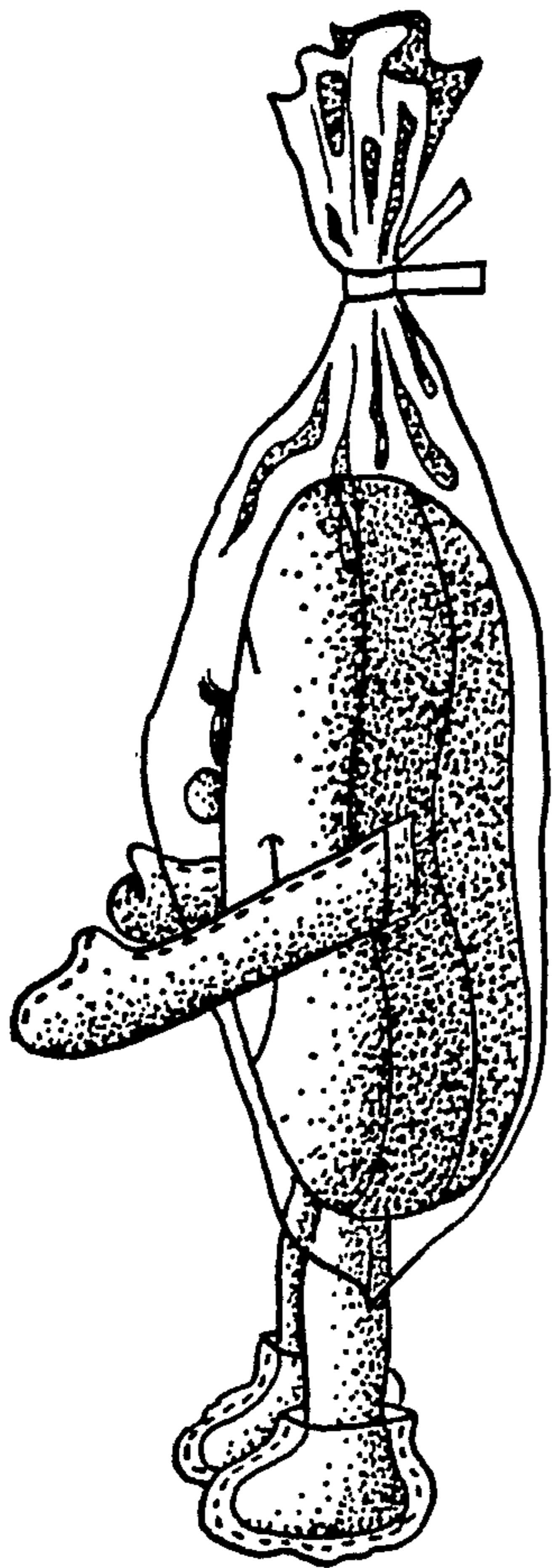

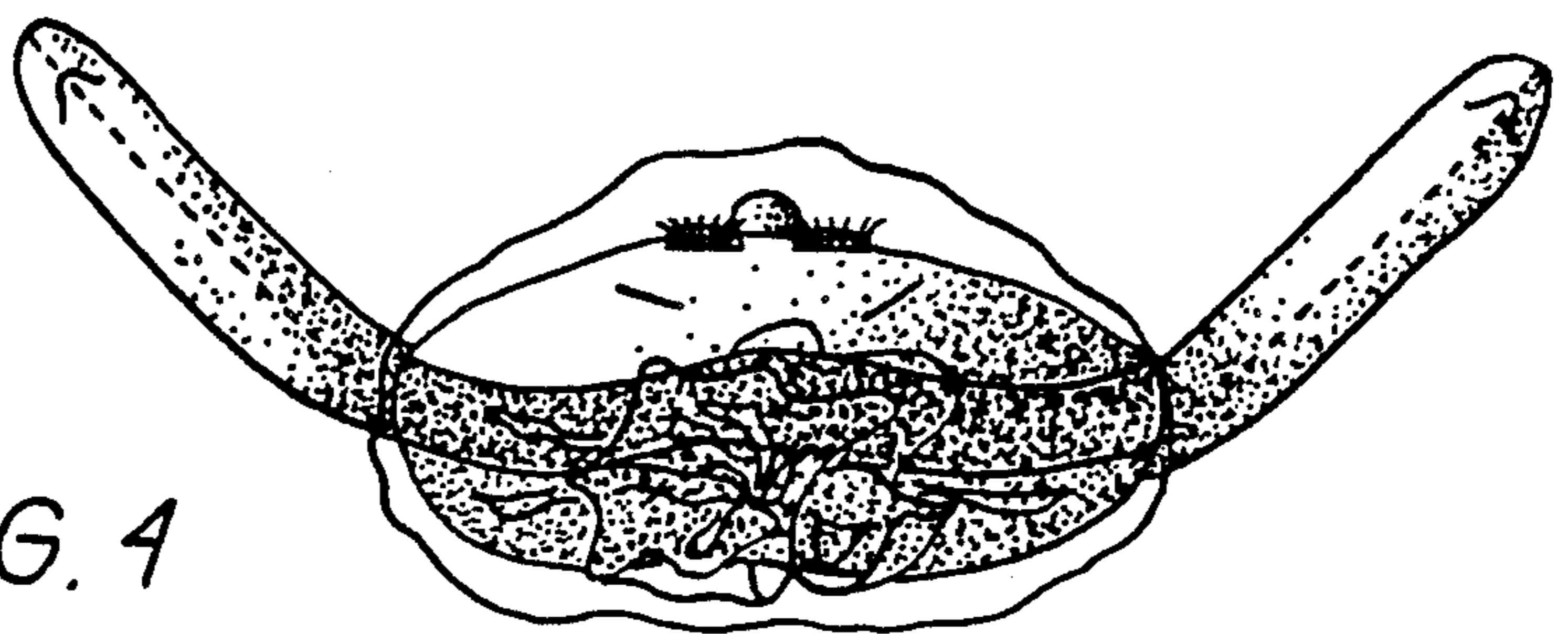

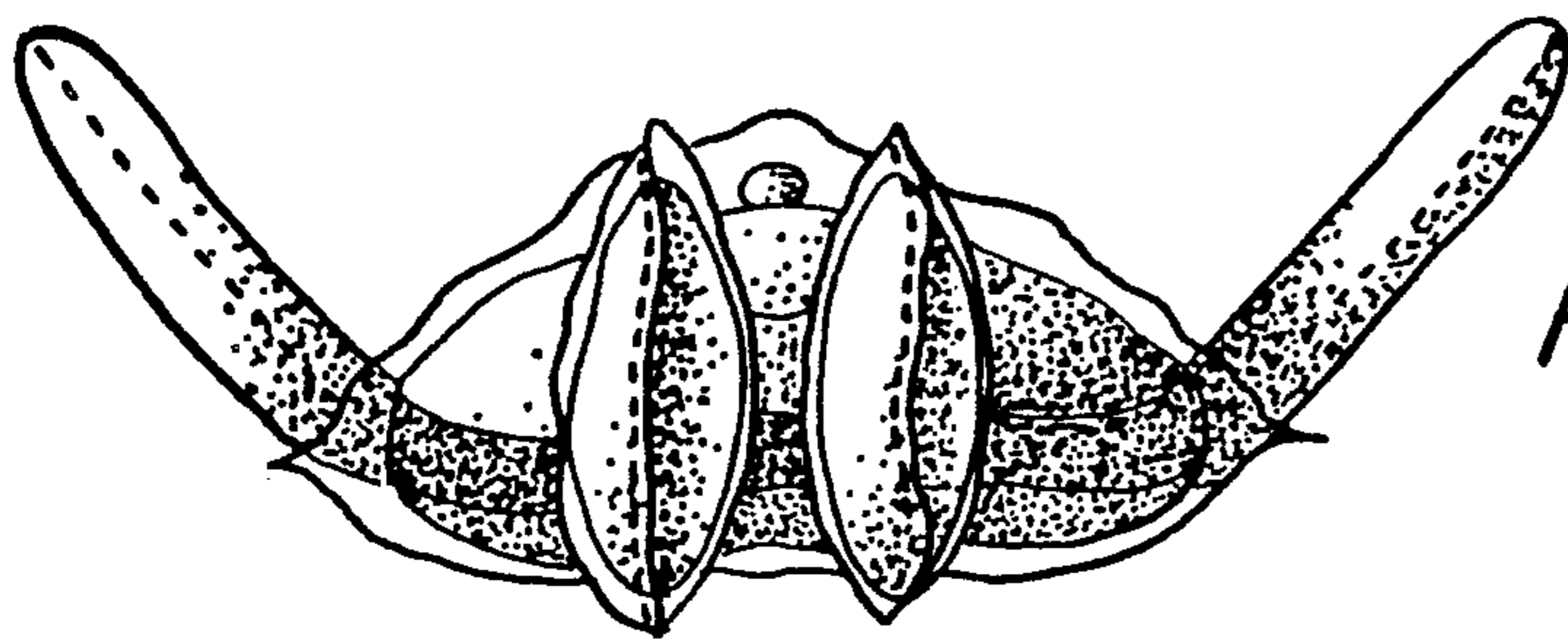
