DESCRIPTION

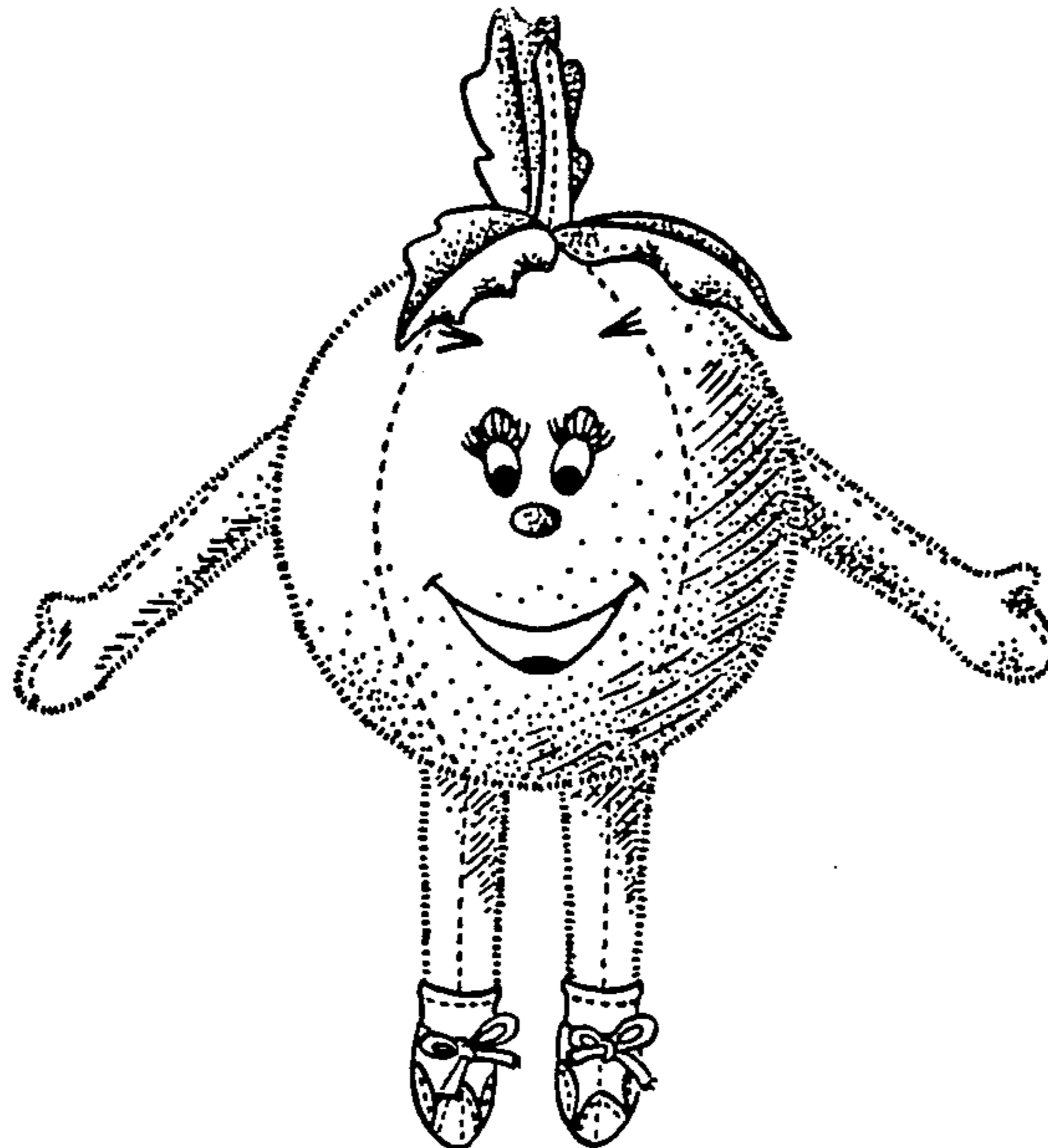
FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a doll resembling an orange showing my new design;

FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view thereof.



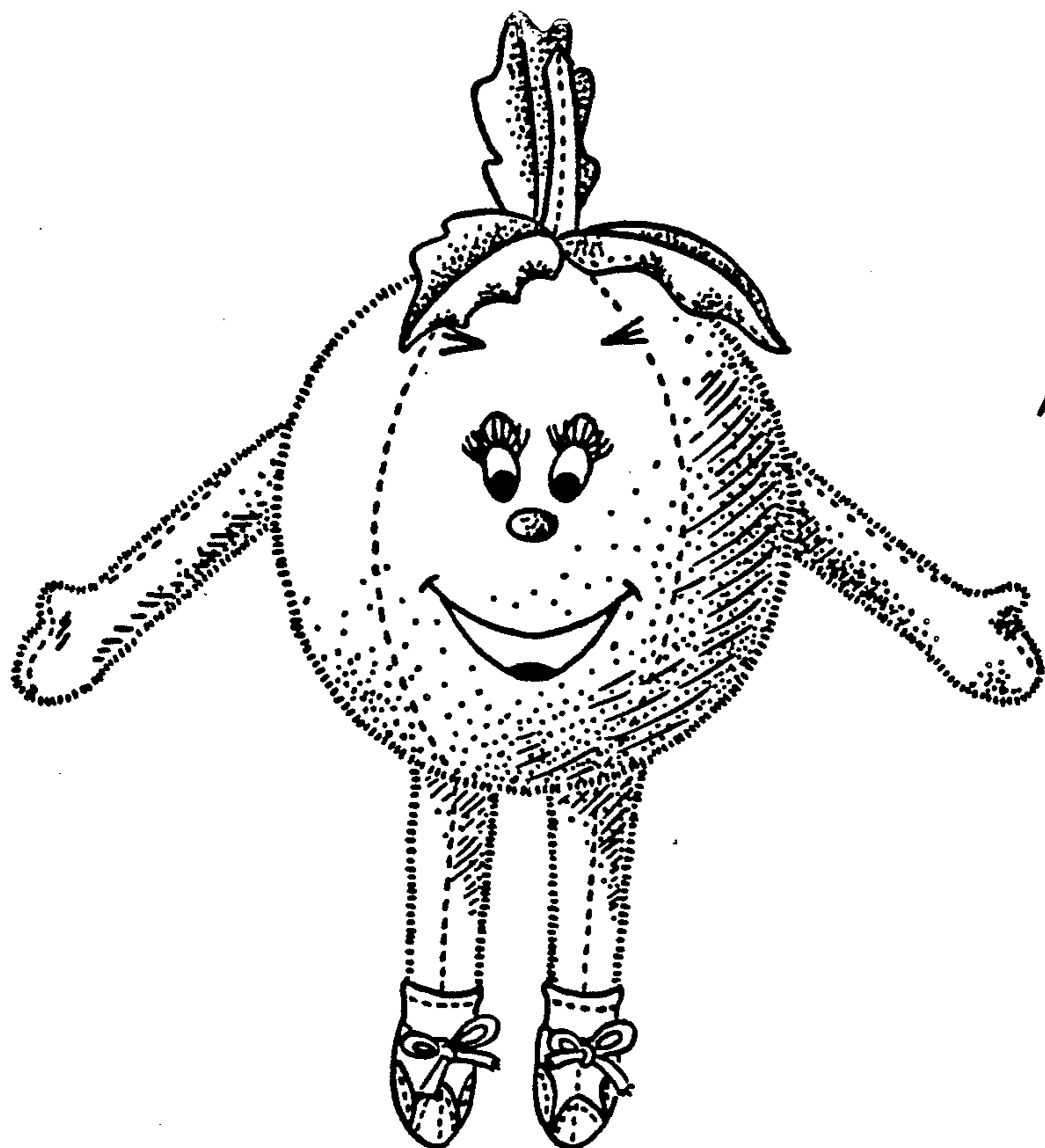
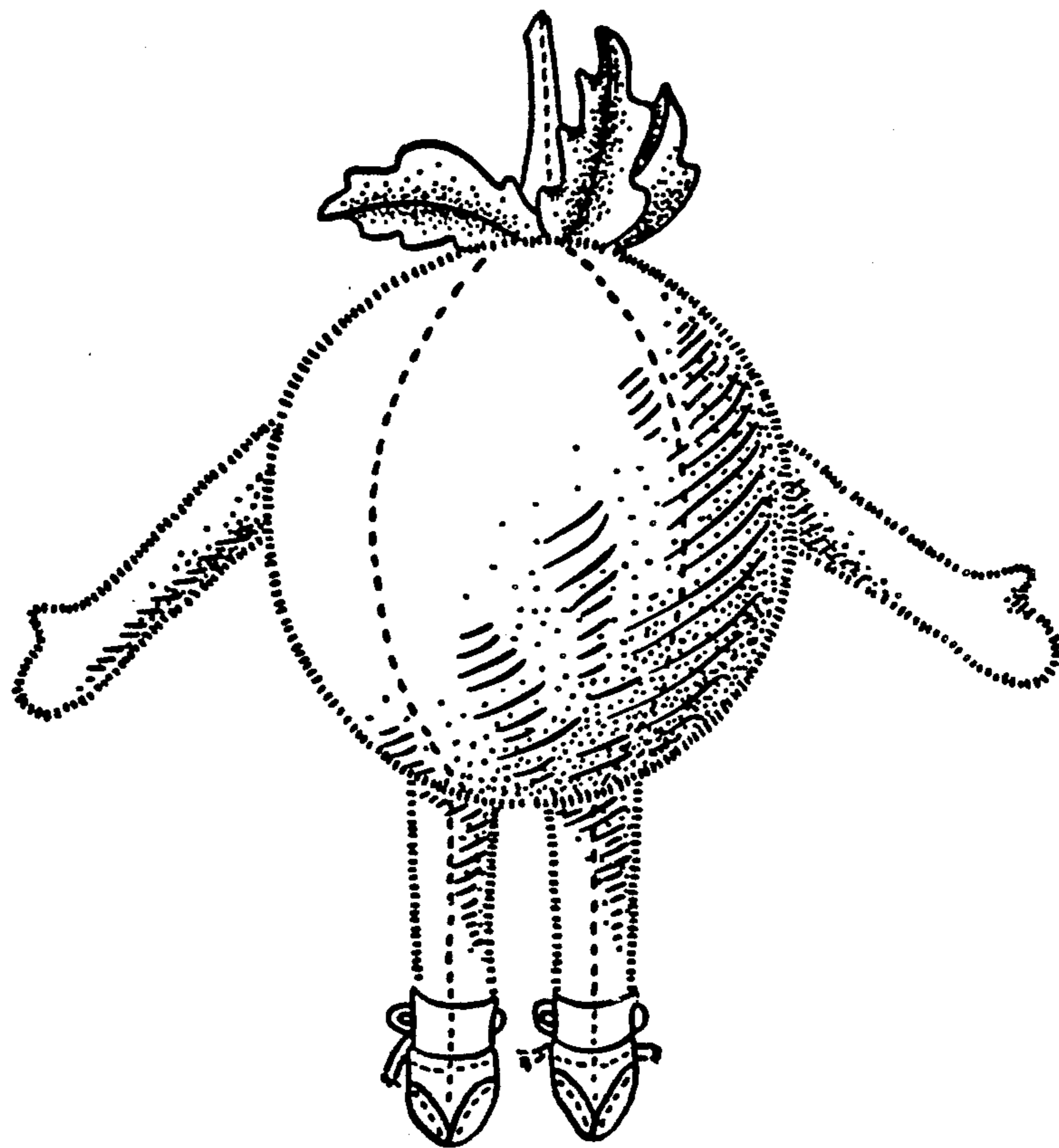

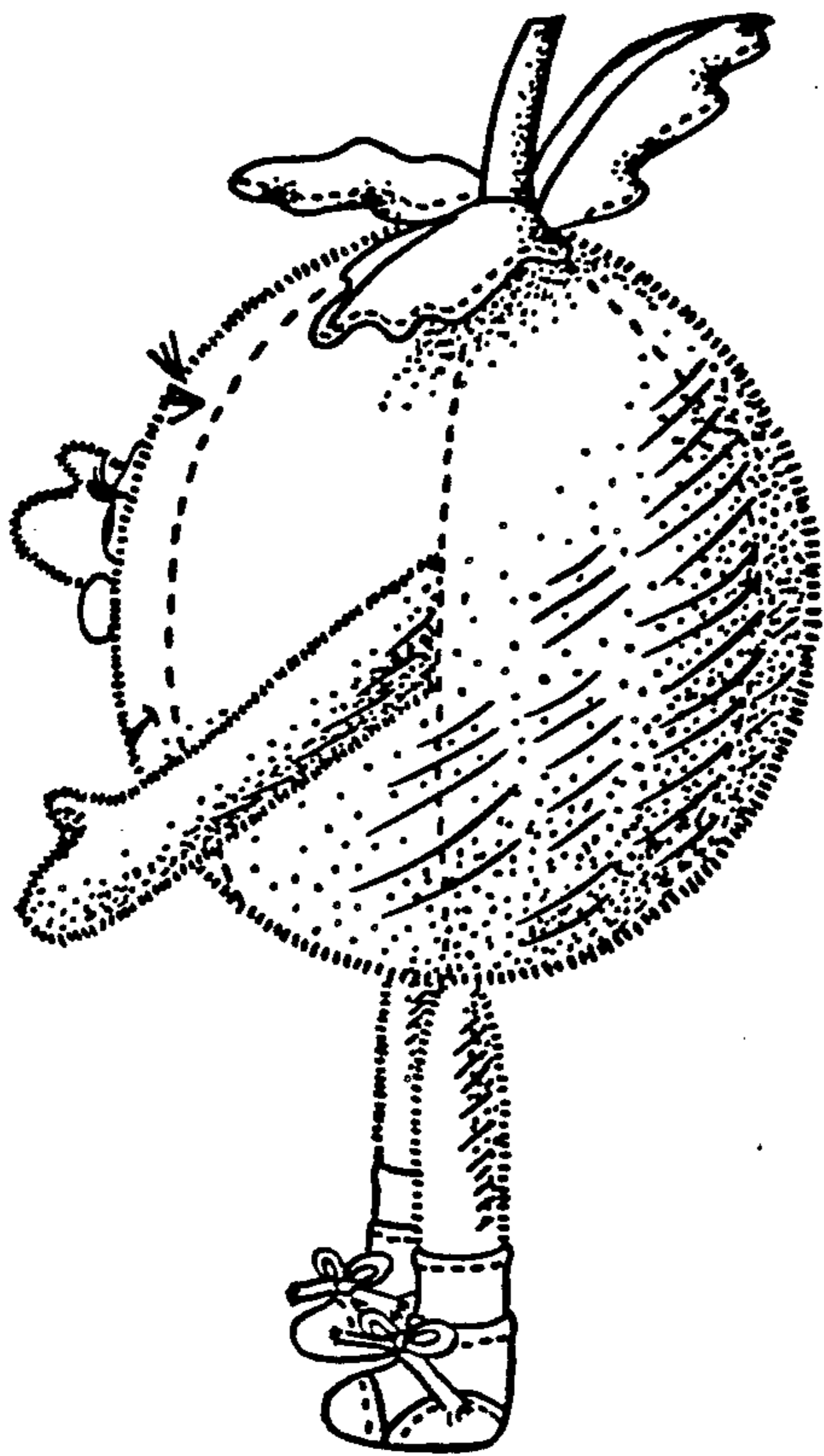

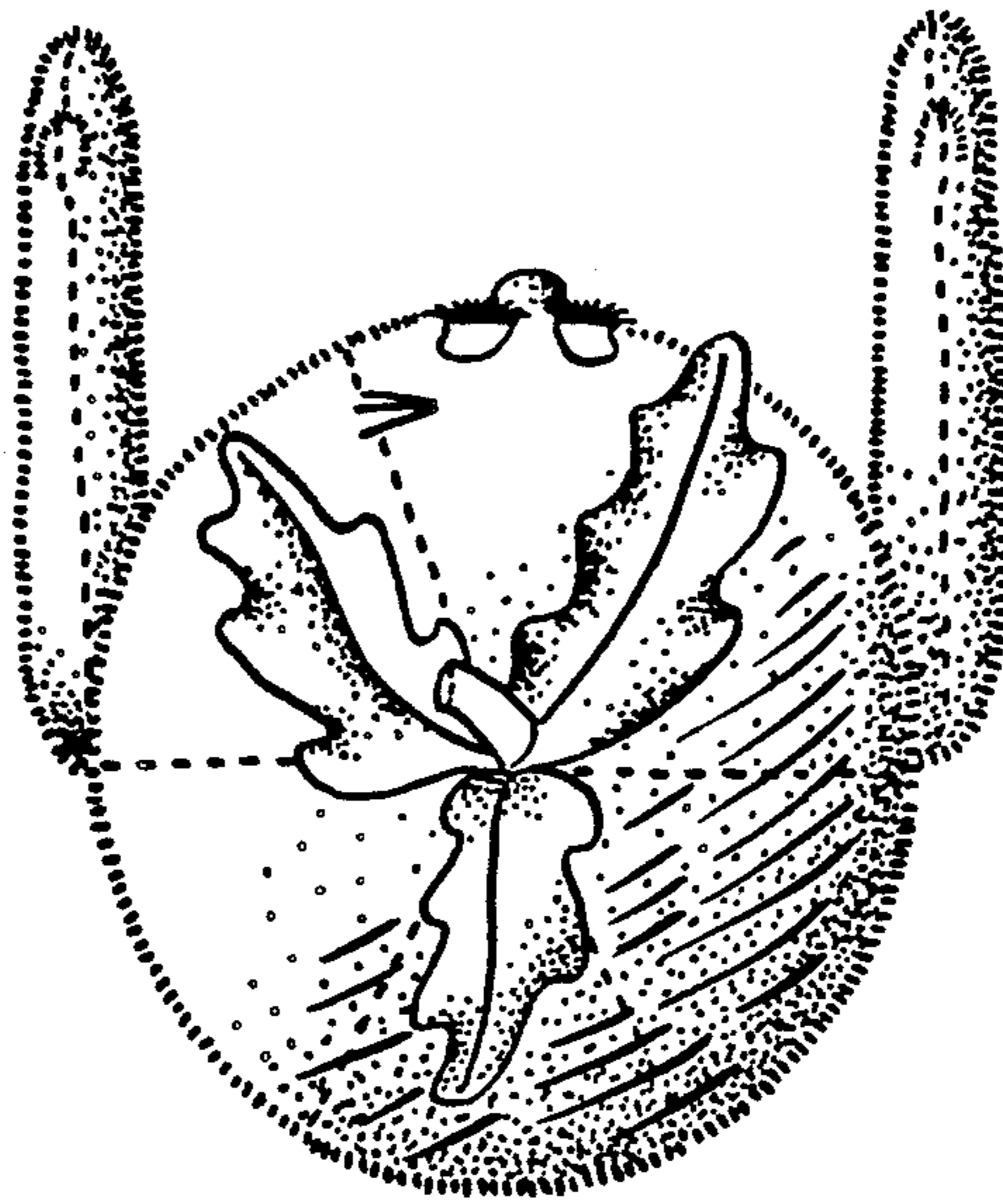

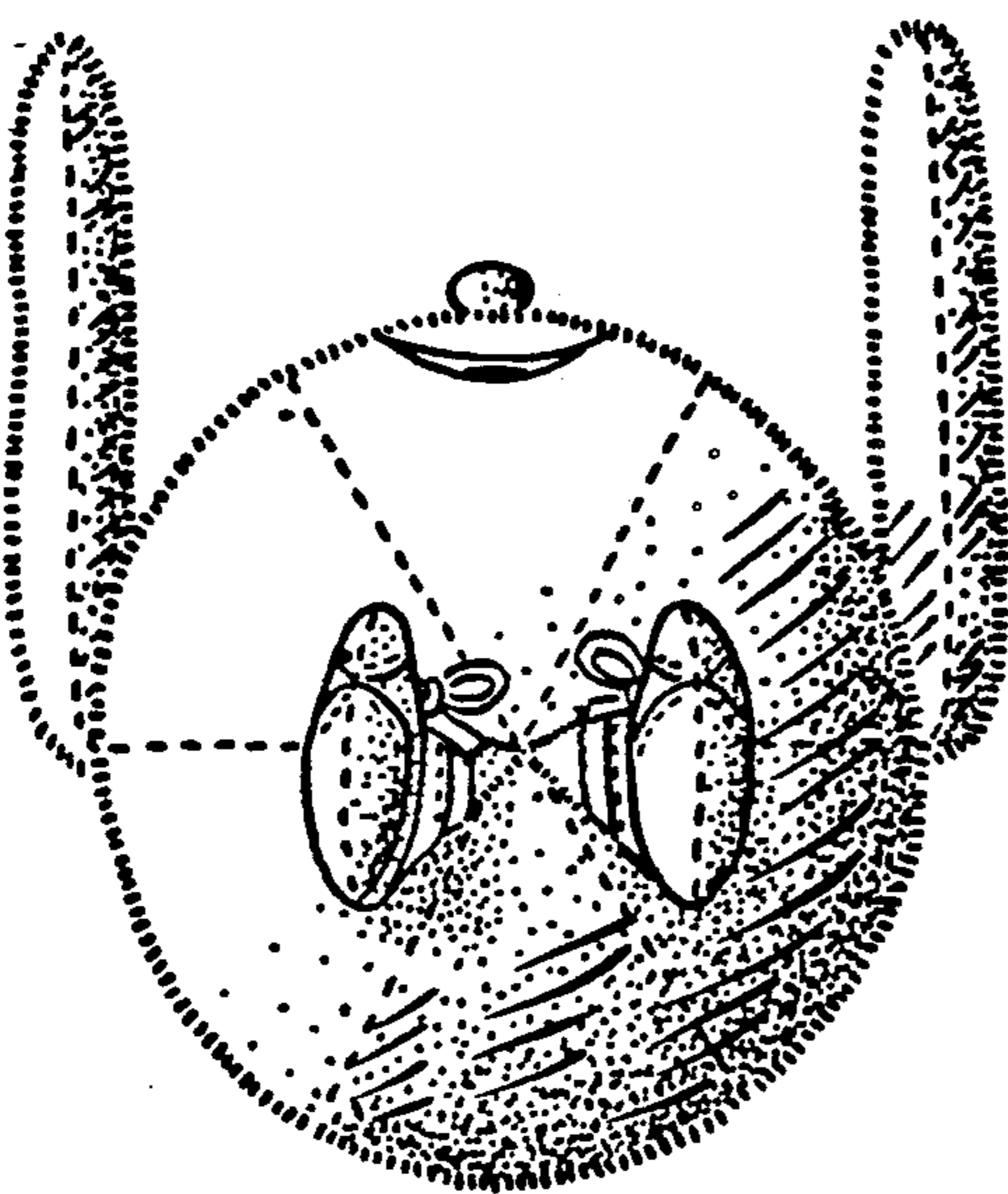
