The ornamental design for an automatic pet watering dish, as shown and described.

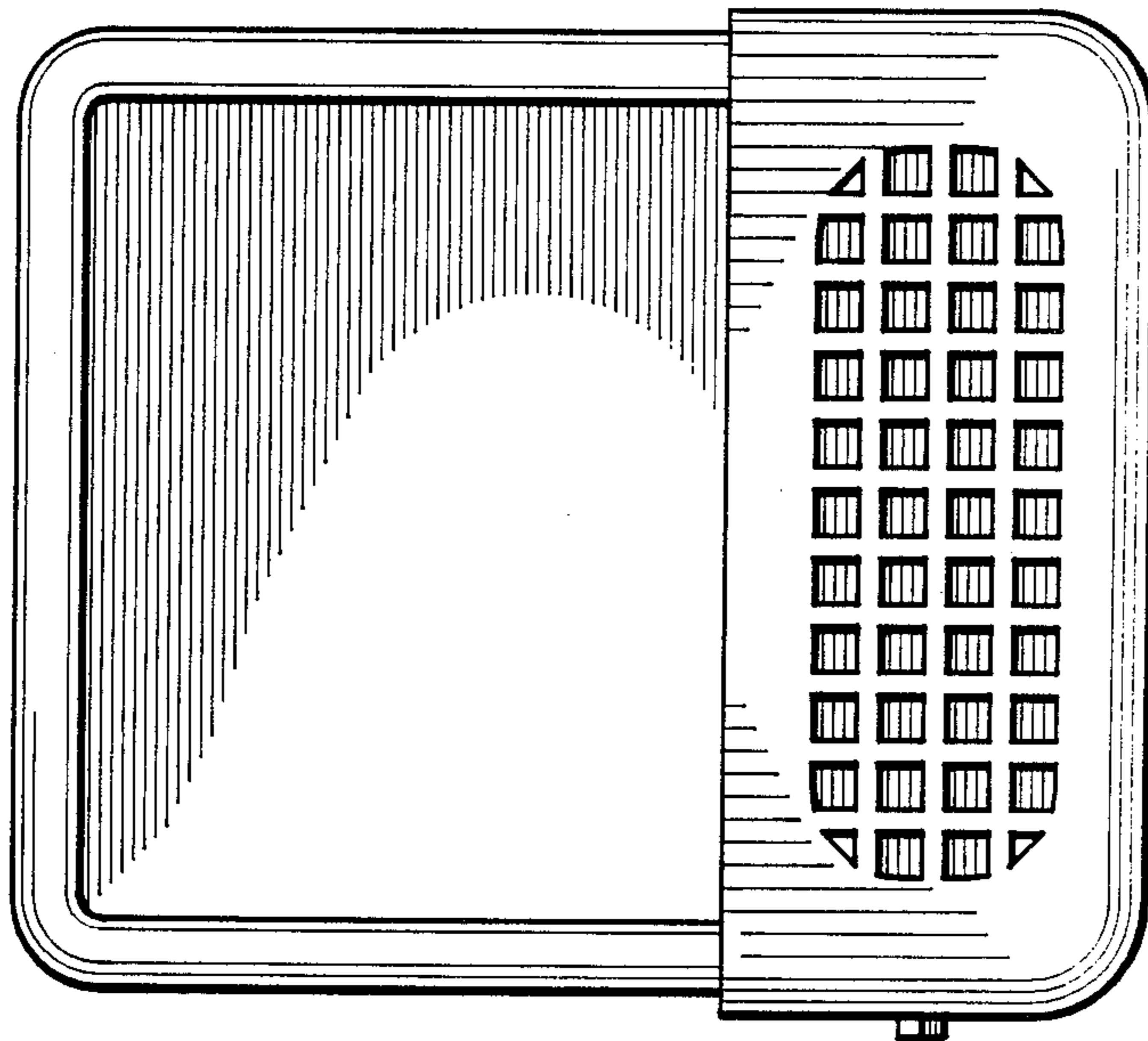
DESCRIPTION

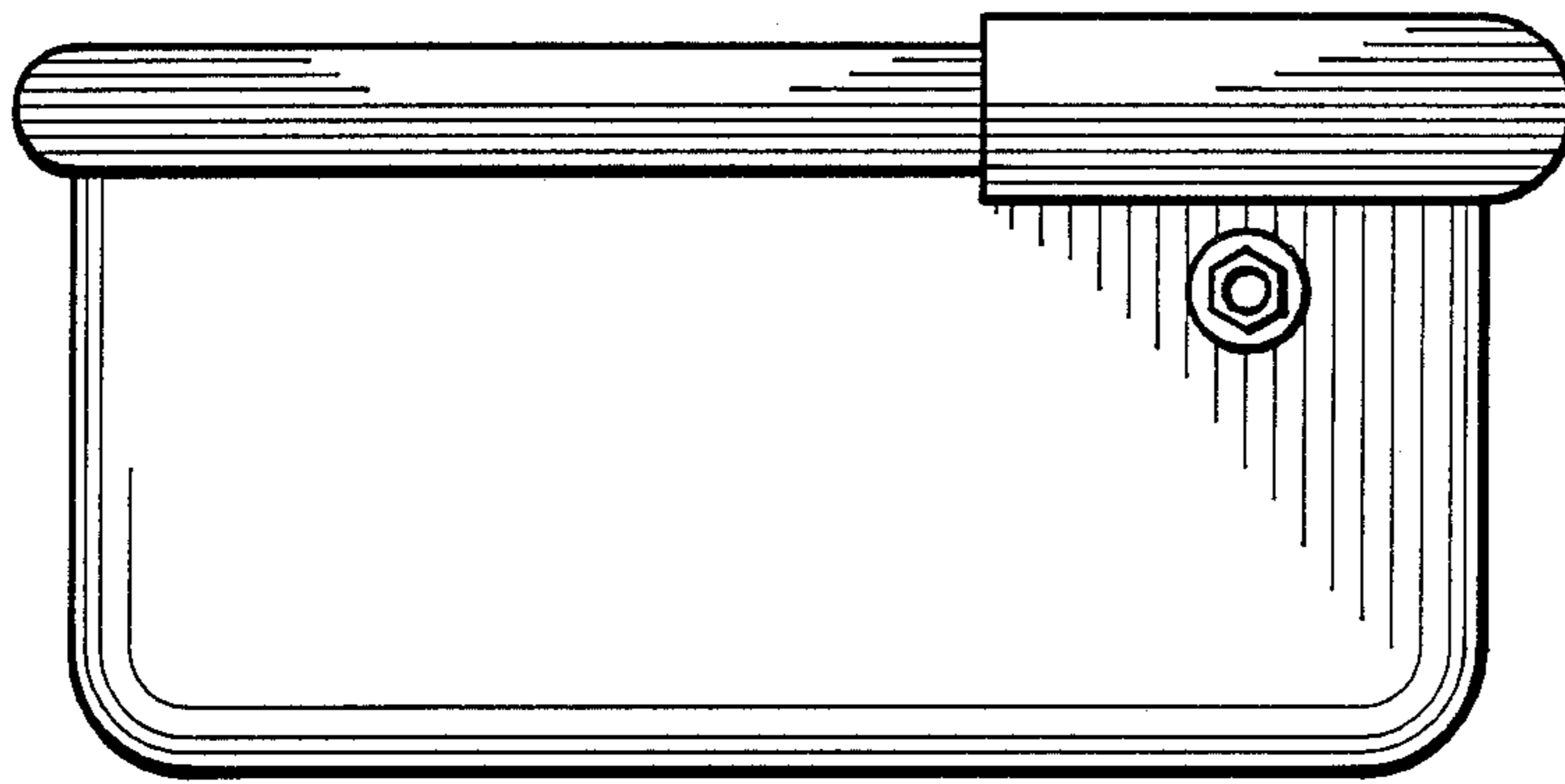

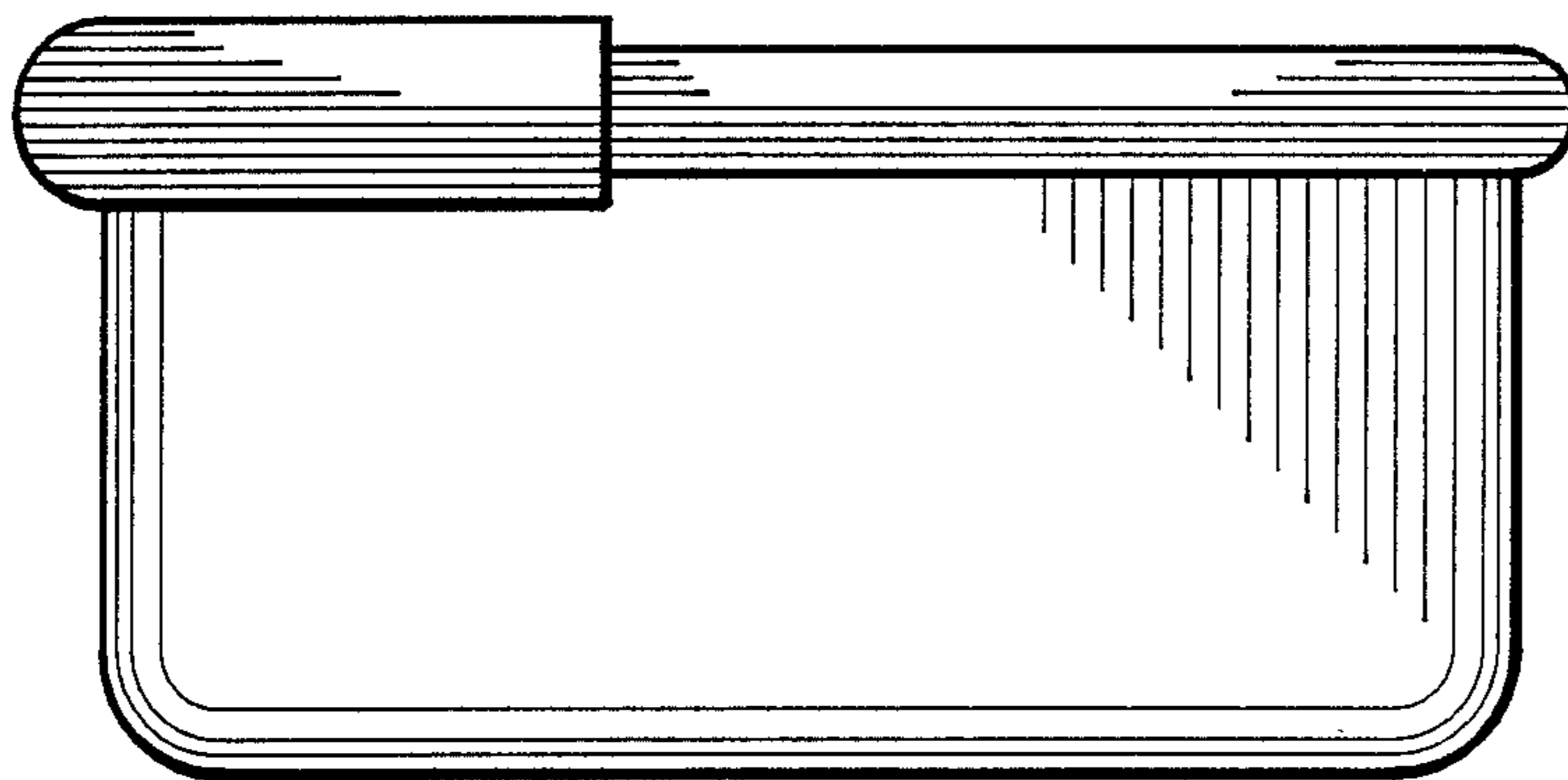

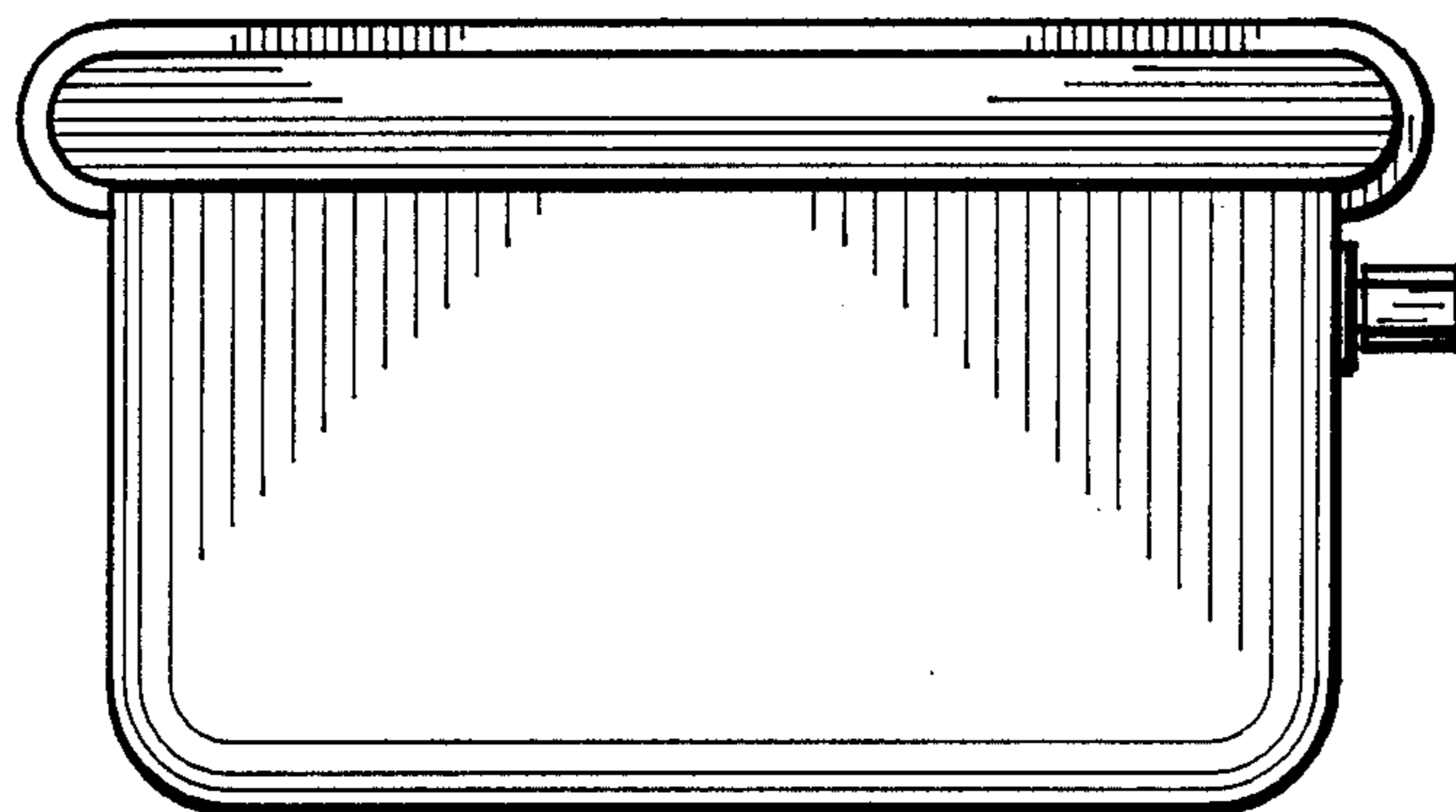

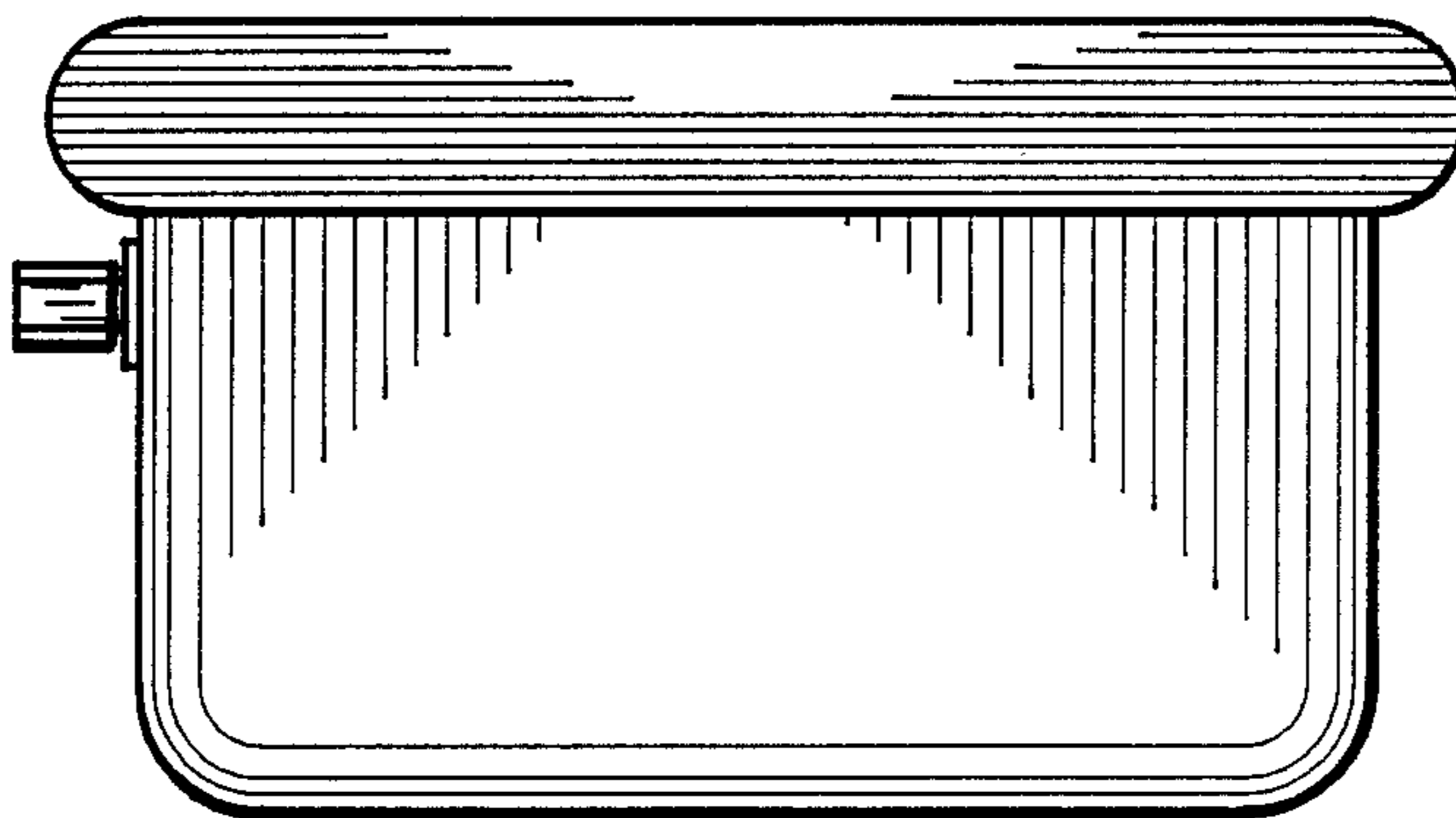

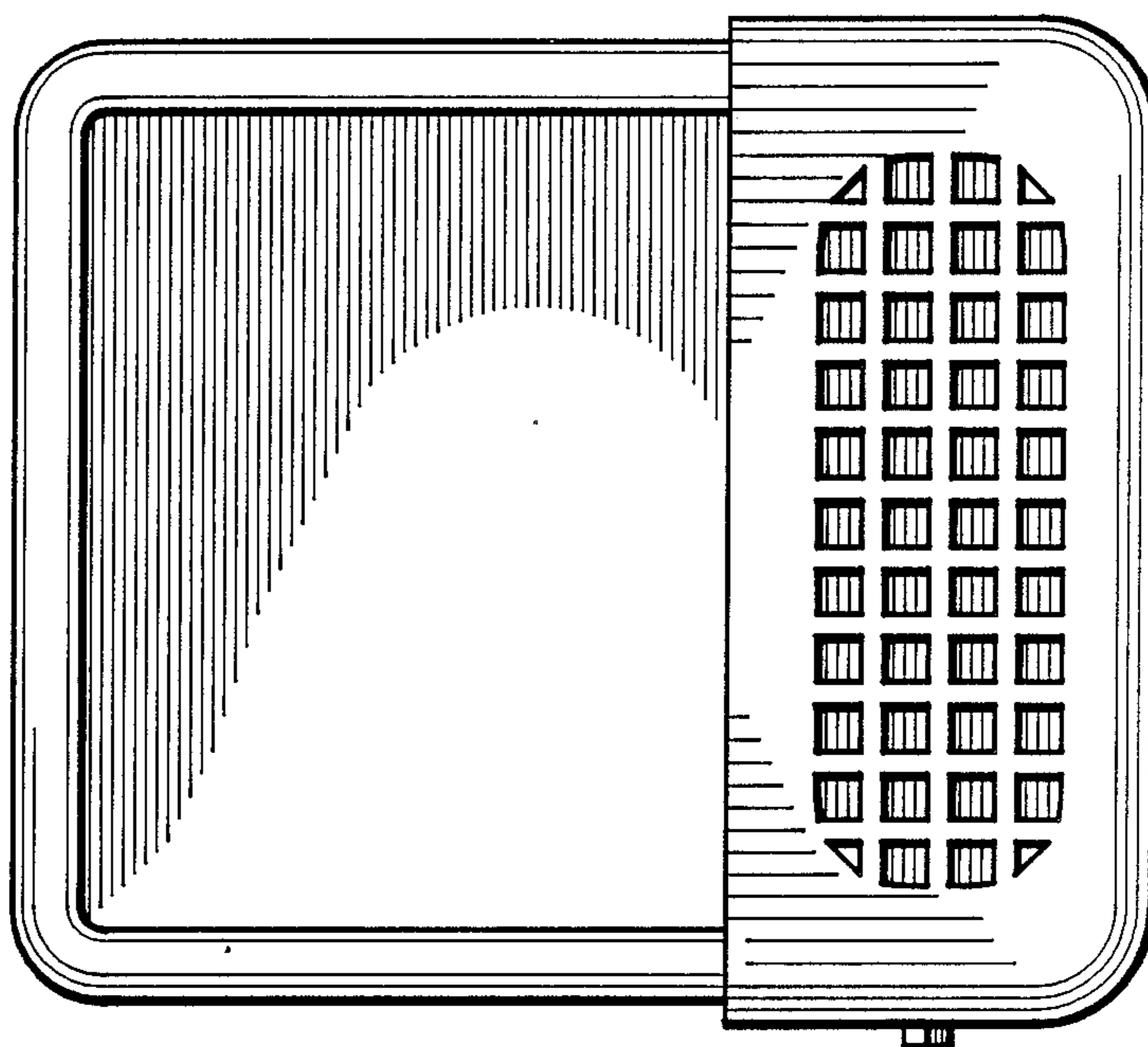
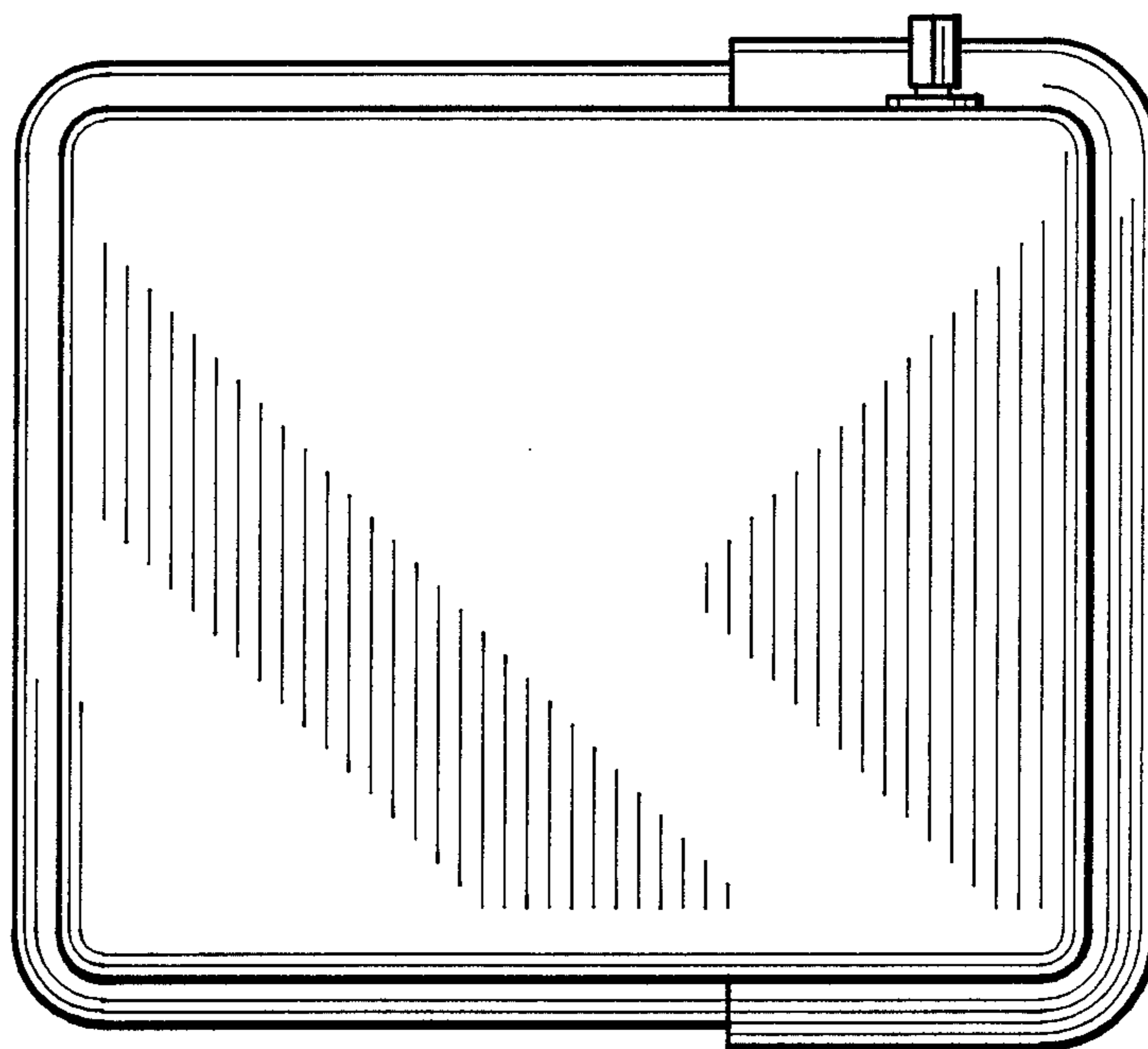

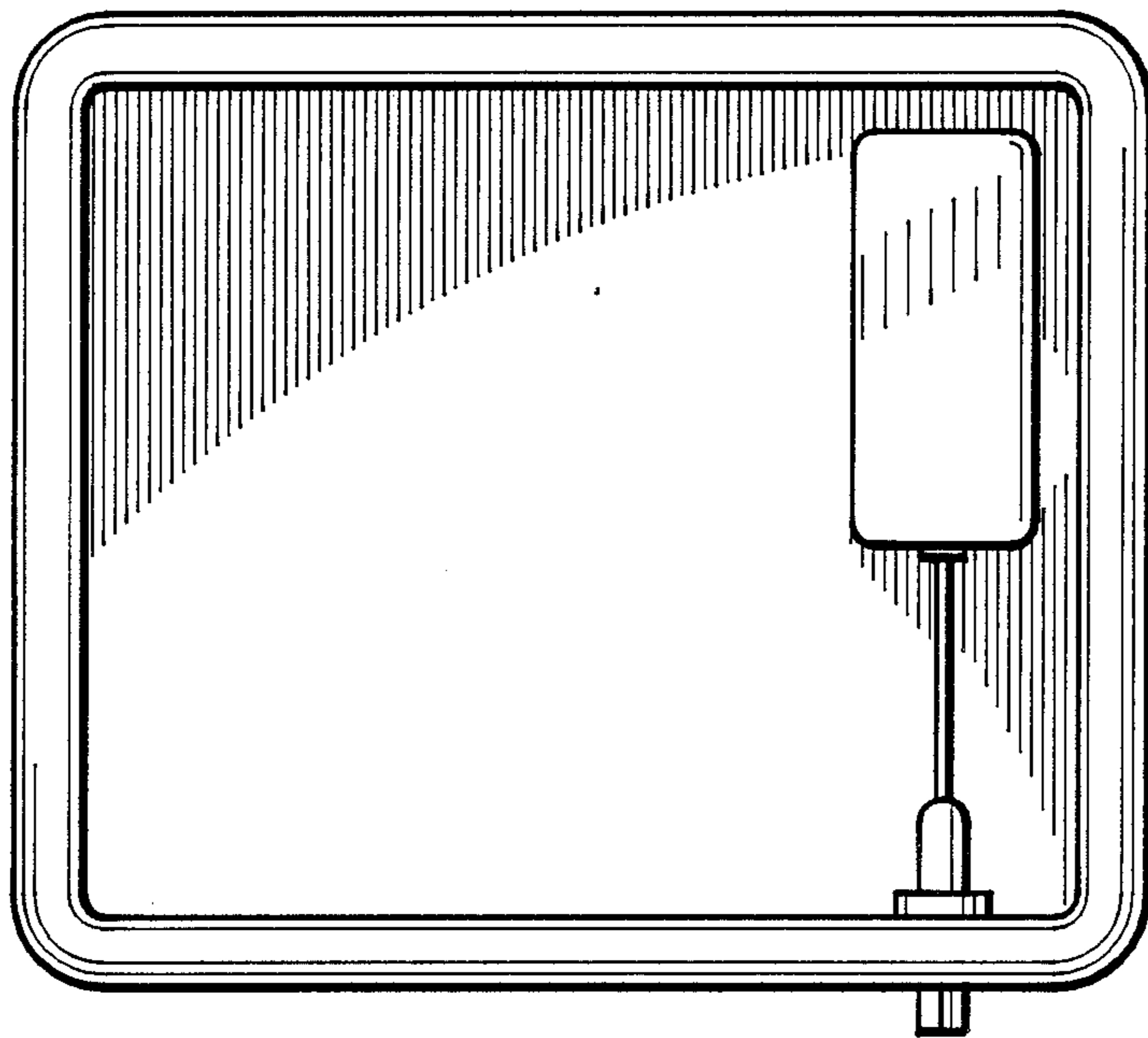
