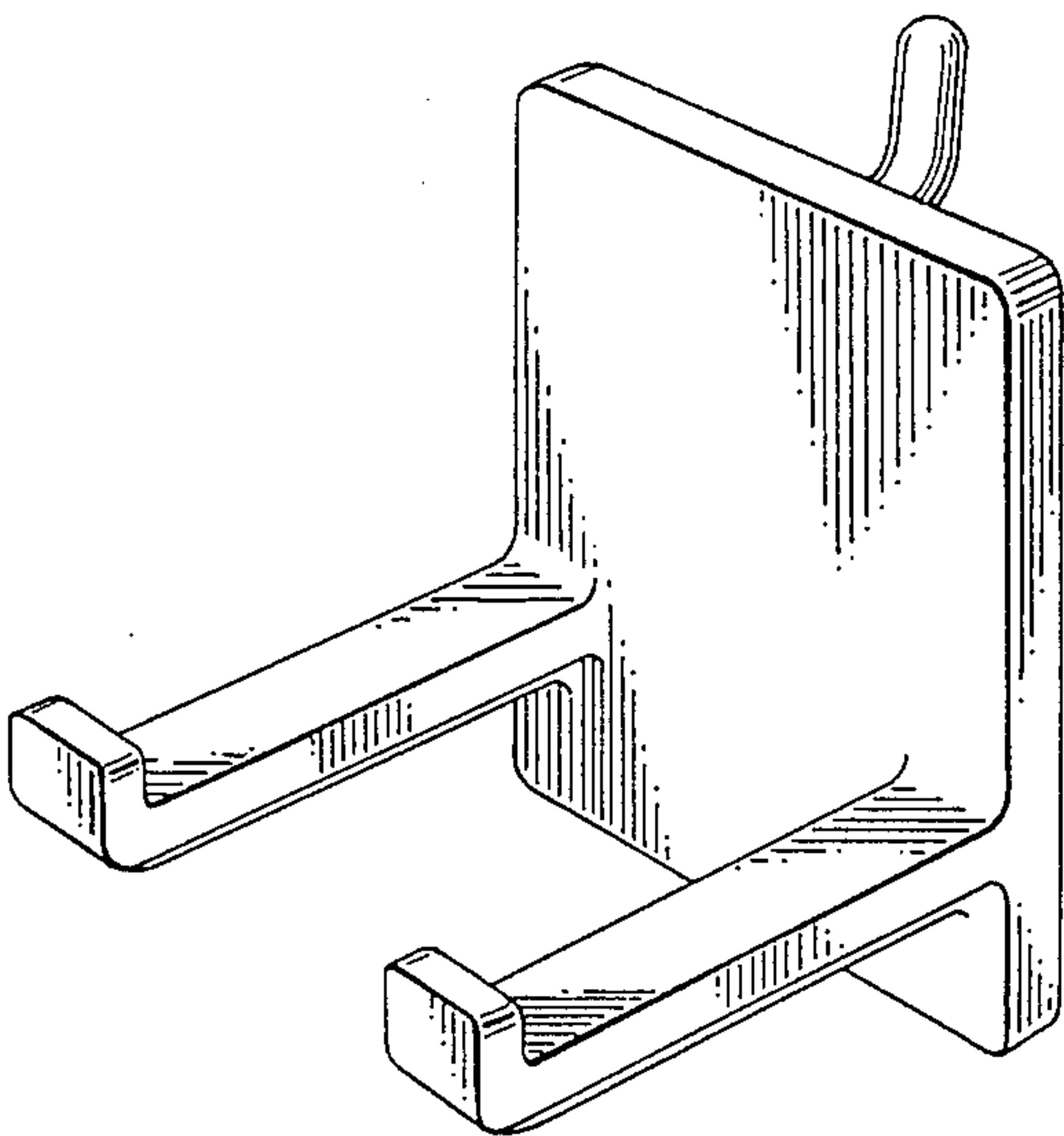

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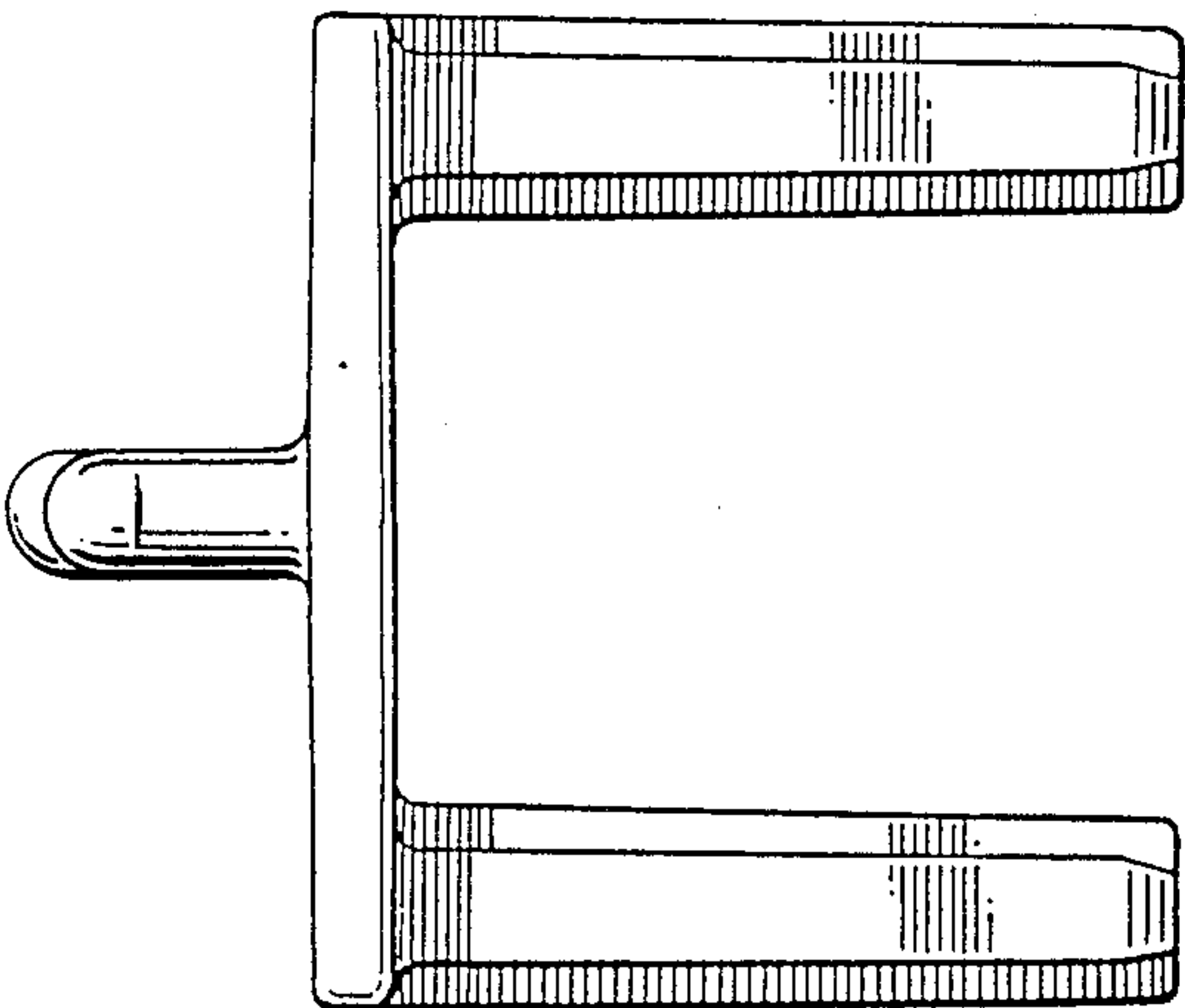

The ornamental design for a two prong hook, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of a two prong hook embodying my new design;
FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a side elevational view thereof. The side opposite to that depicted in FIG. 3 is identical in appearance;
FIG. 4 is a rear elevational view thereof;
FIG. 5 is a top plan view thereof;
FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view thereof.



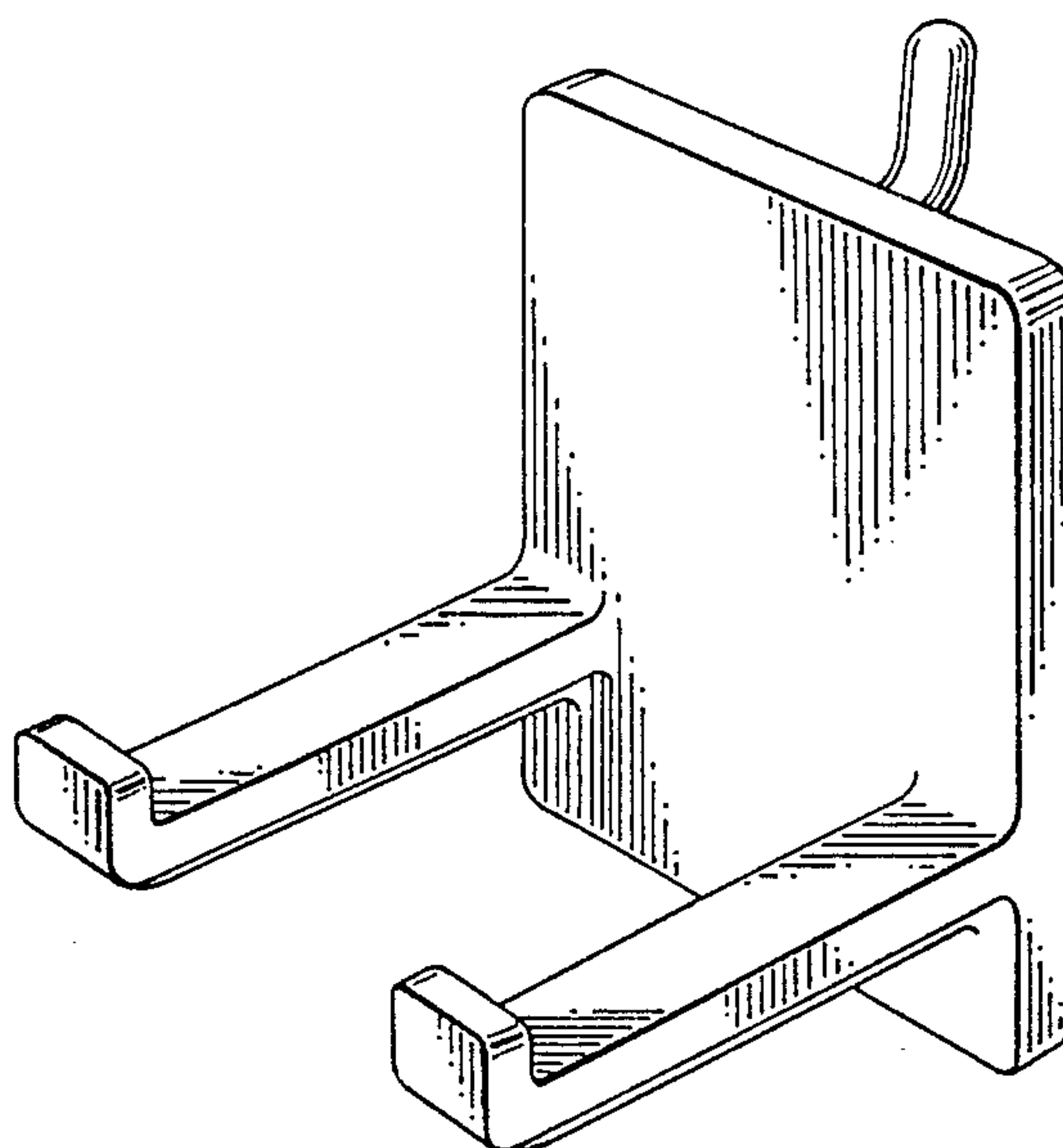

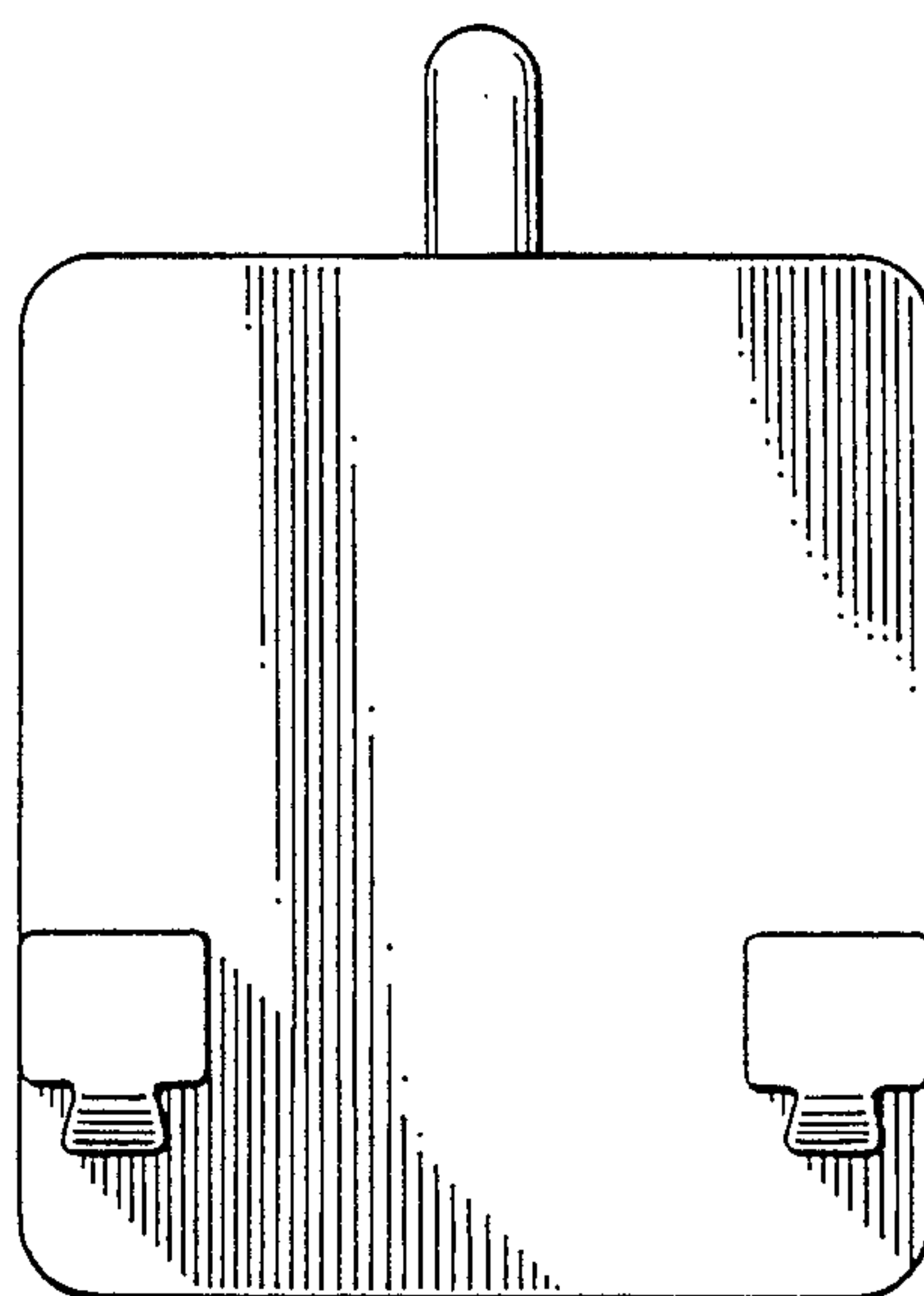

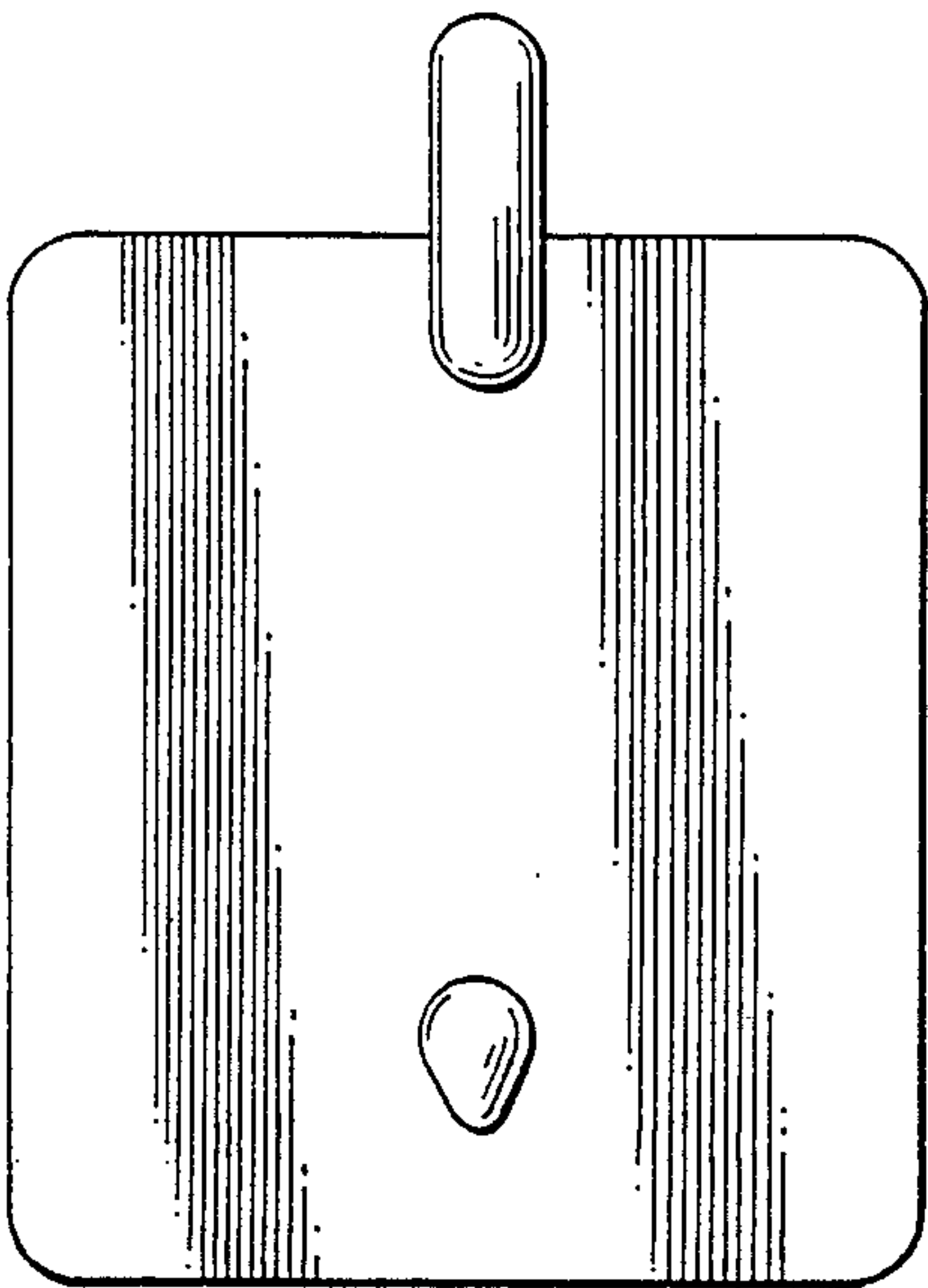

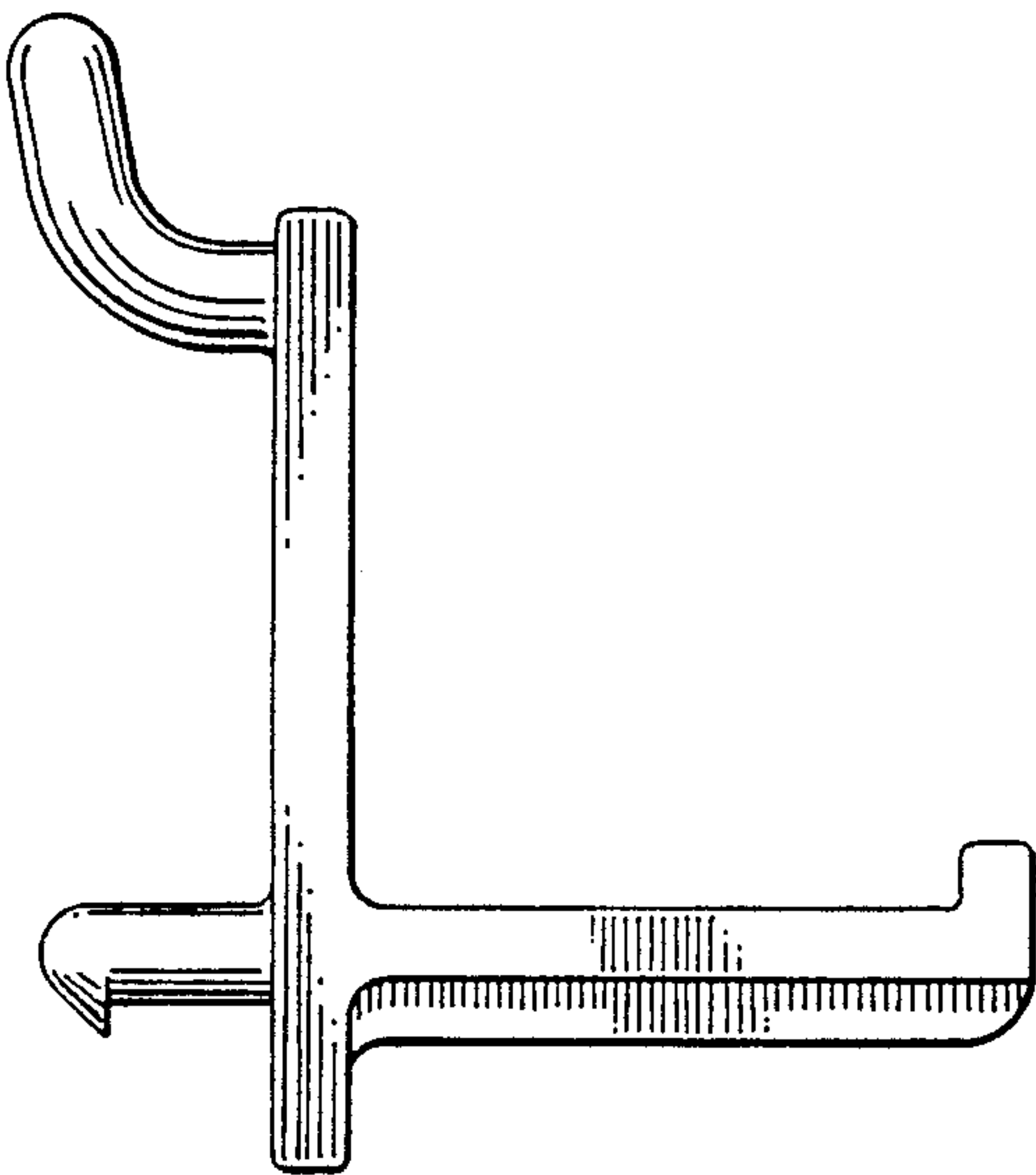

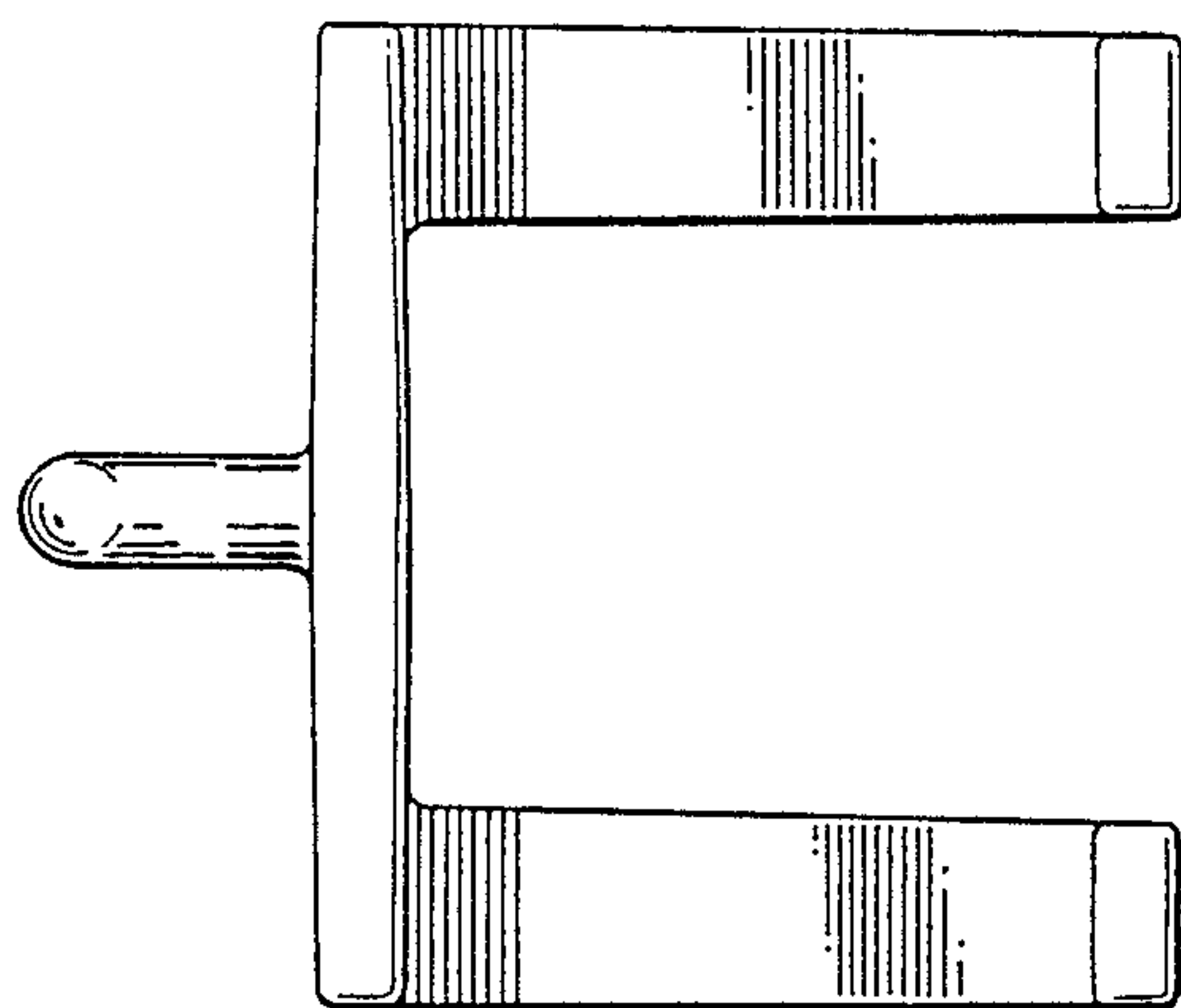

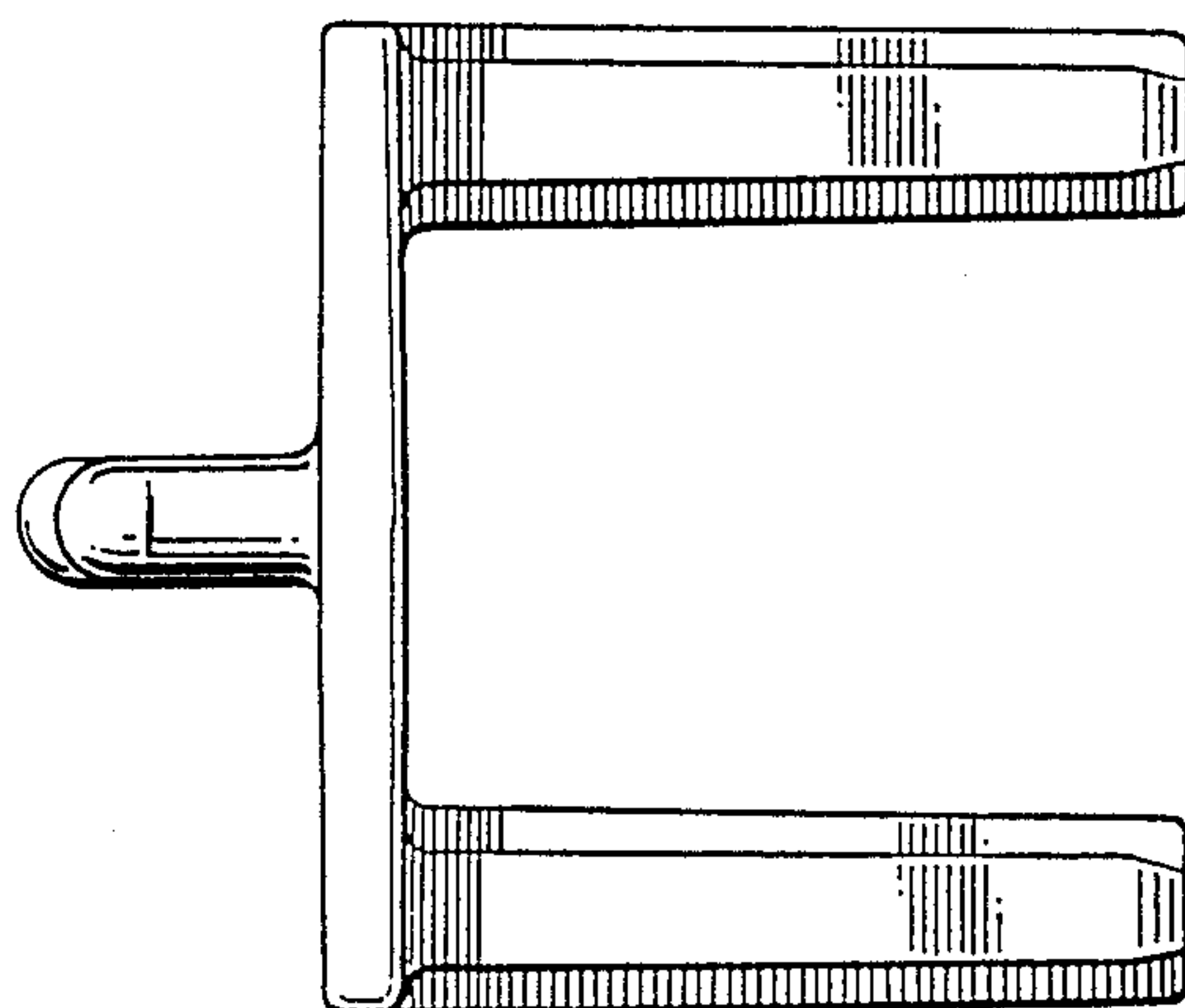
