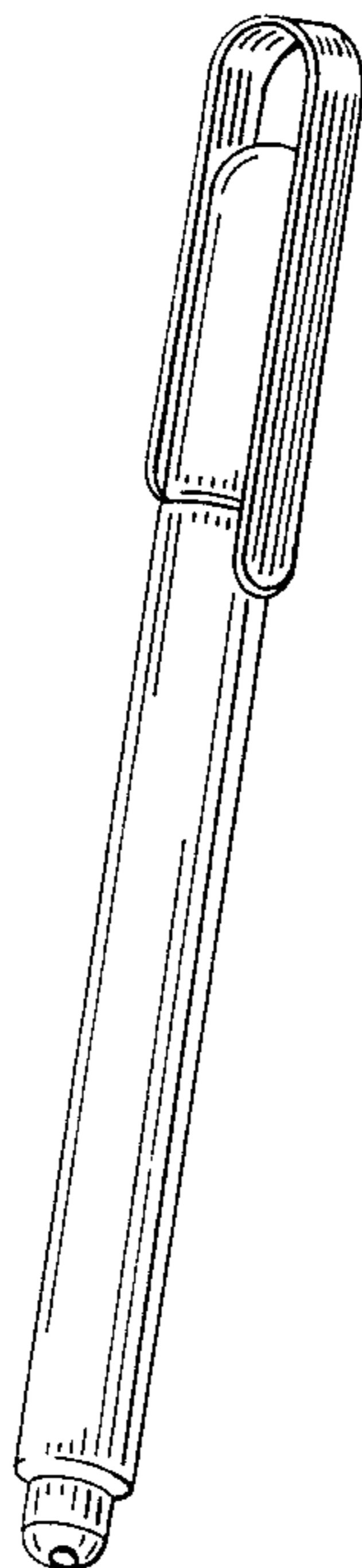

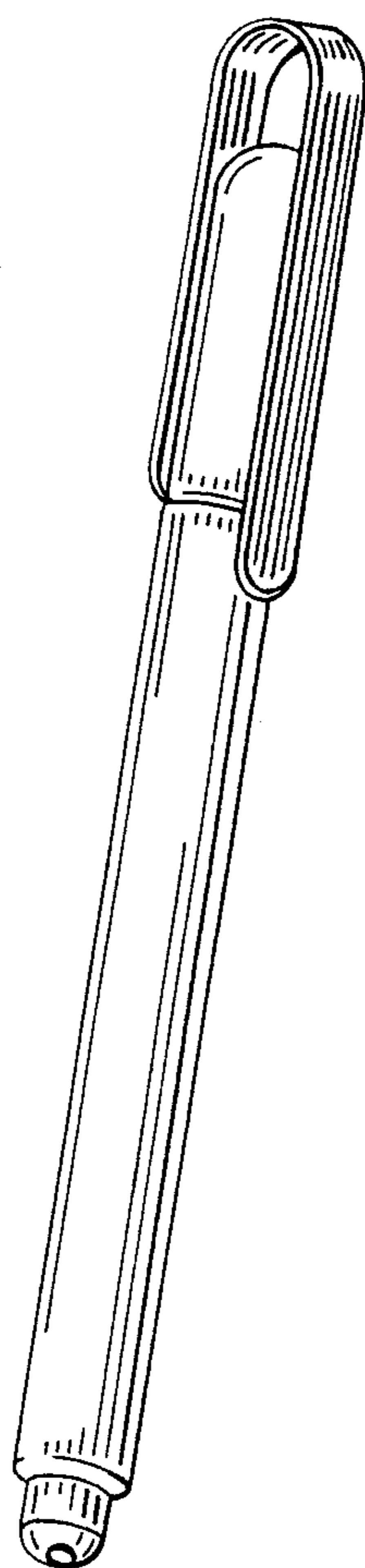
[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a writing instrument, as shown and described.

**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a left front perspective view of a writing instrument showing my new design;
