DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of a combined bottle and cap showing my new design;

FIG. 2 is a rear elevational view of the bottle shown in FIG. 1;

FIG. 3 is a top plan view of the bottle shown in FIG. 1;

FIG. 4 is a front elevational view of the bottle shown in FIG. 1;

FIG. 5 is a right side elevational view of the bottle shown in FIG. 1;

FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view of the bottle shown in FIG. 1;

FIG. 7 is a left side elevational view of the bottle shown in FIG. 1; and

FIG. 8 is a rear perspective view of the combined bottle and cap shown in an exploded condition.

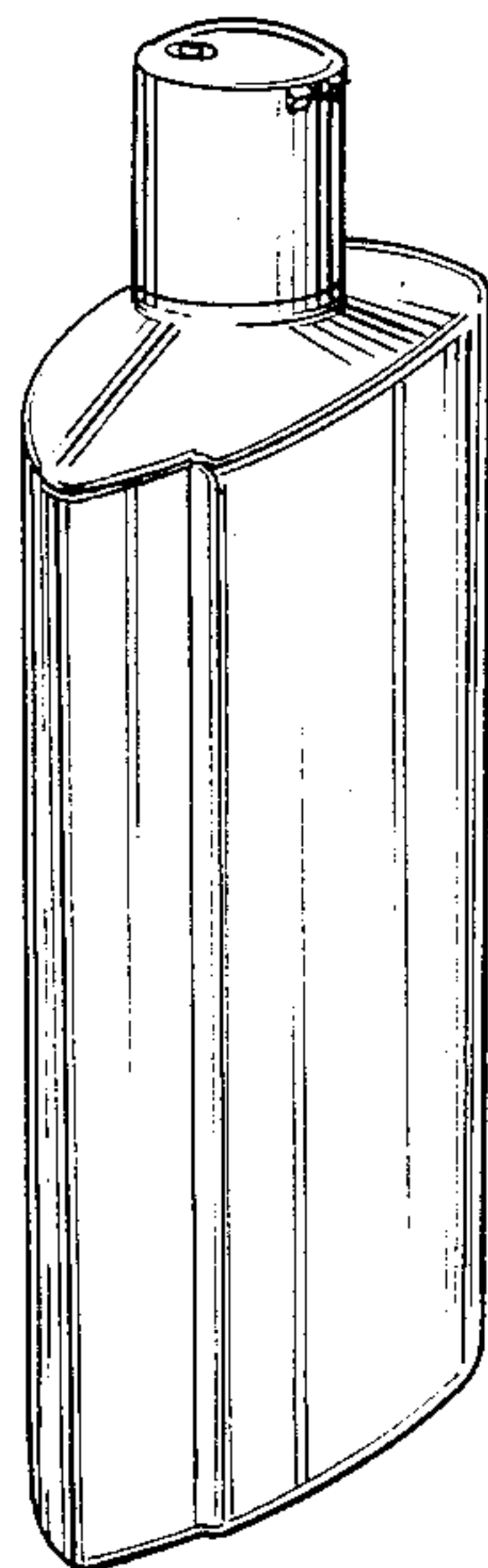

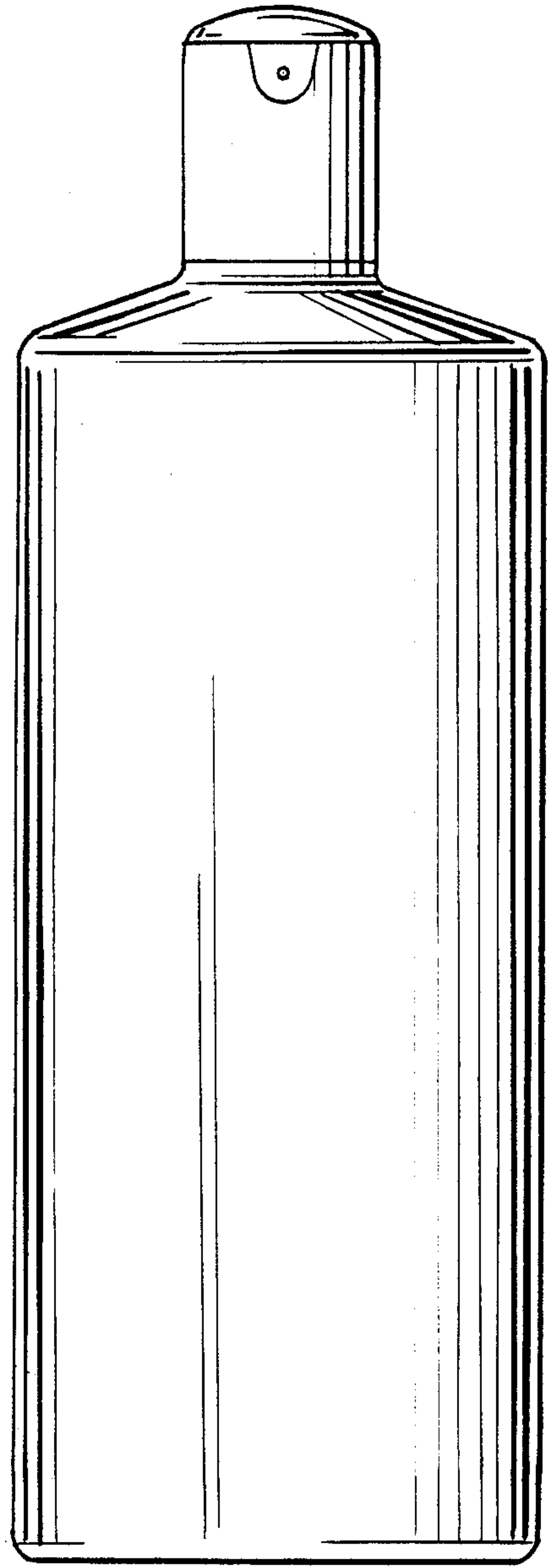
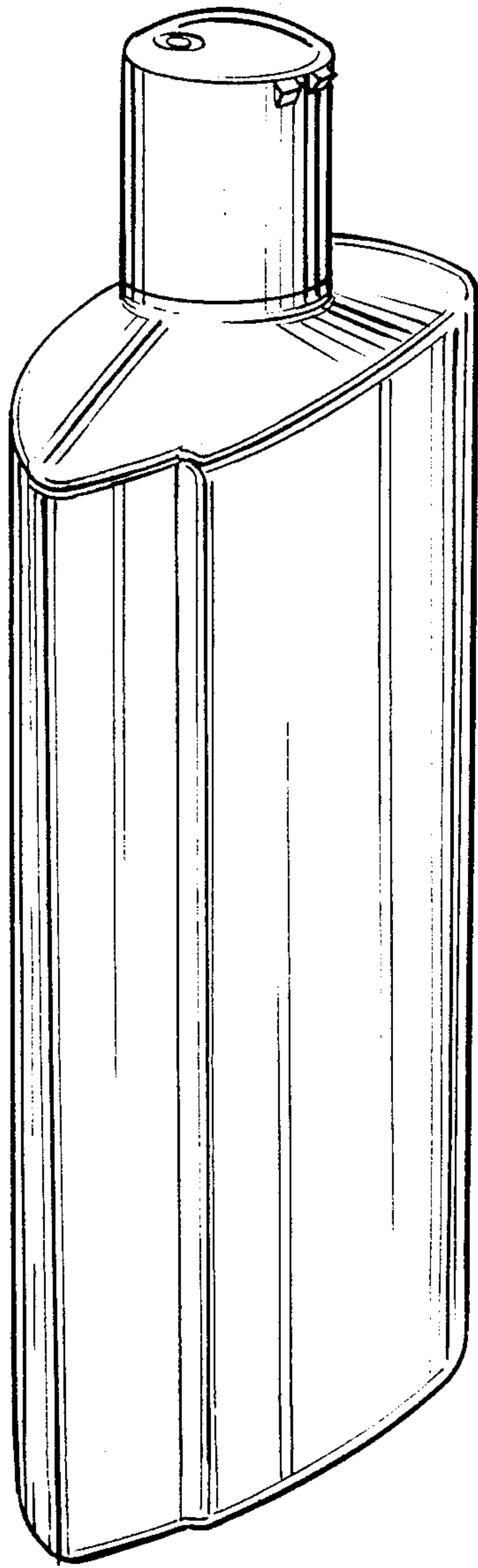

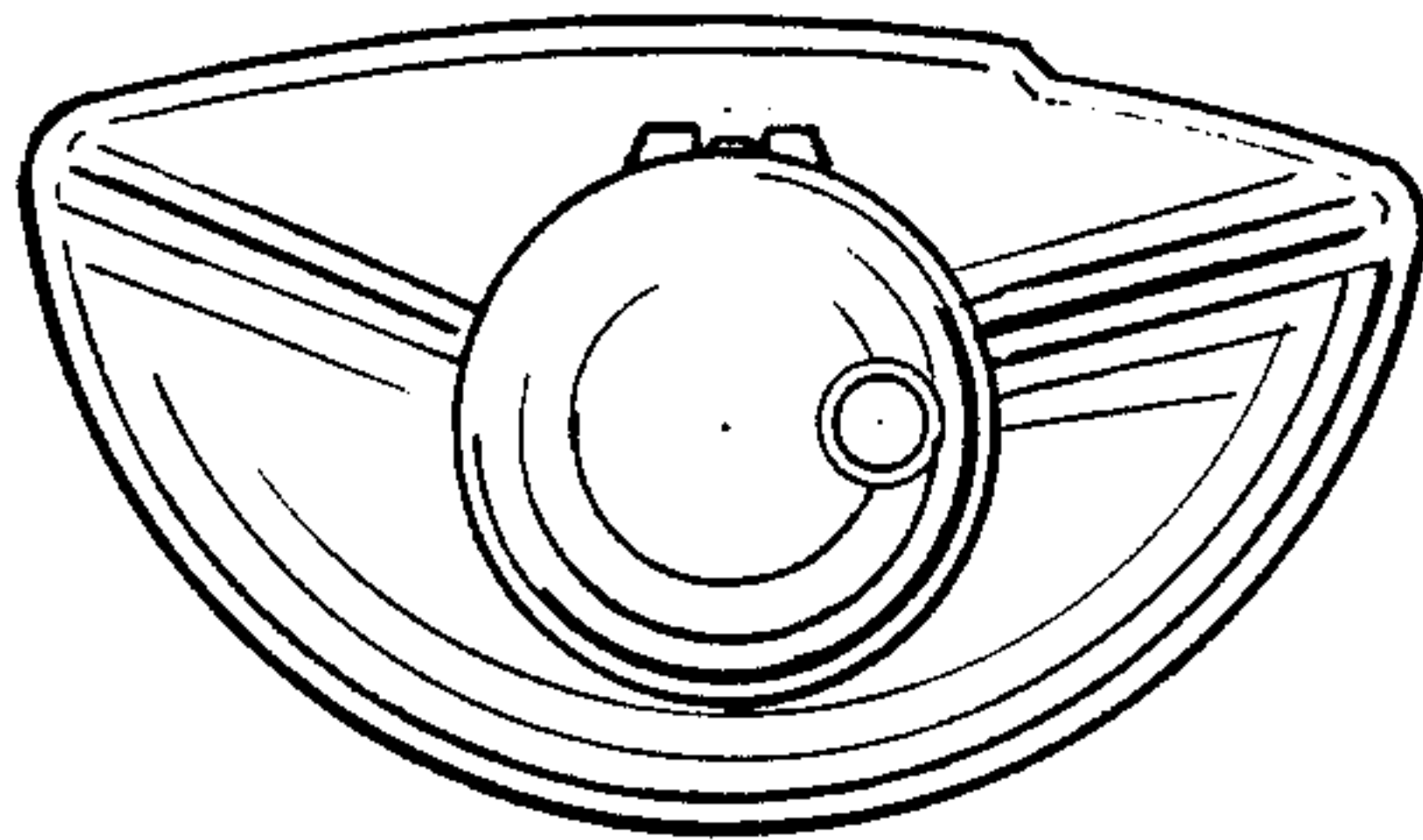

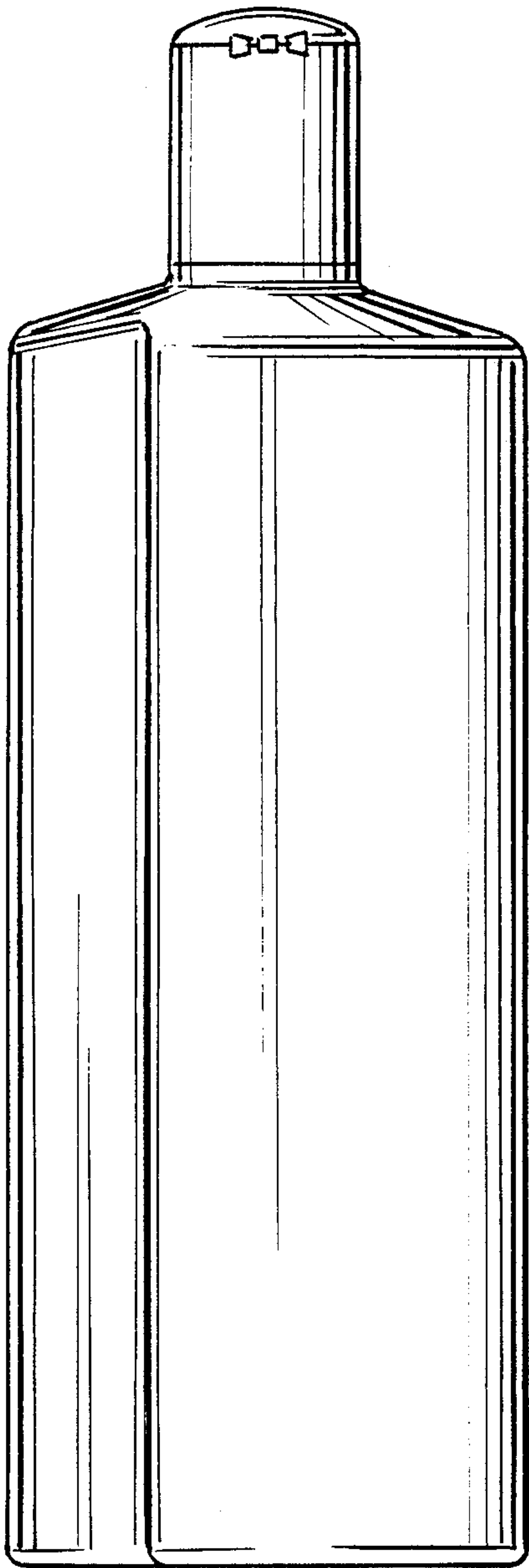

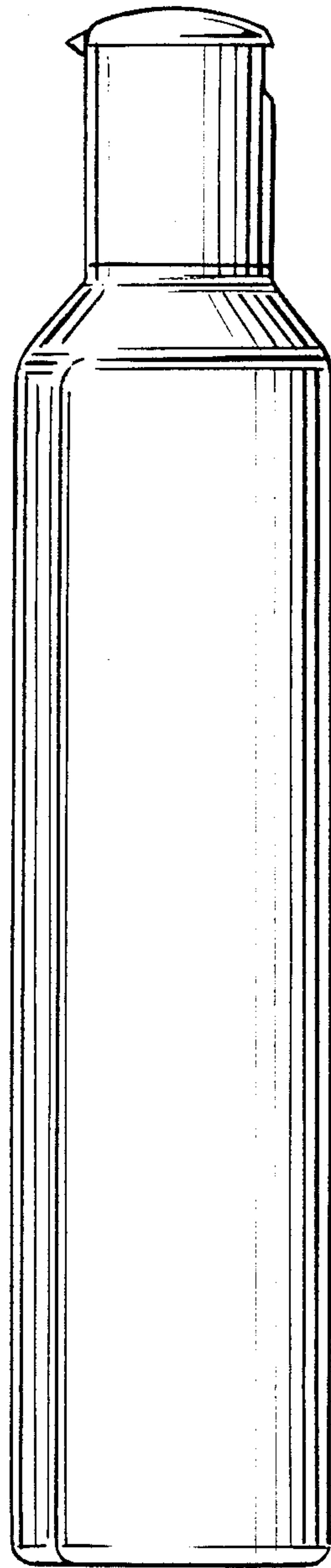
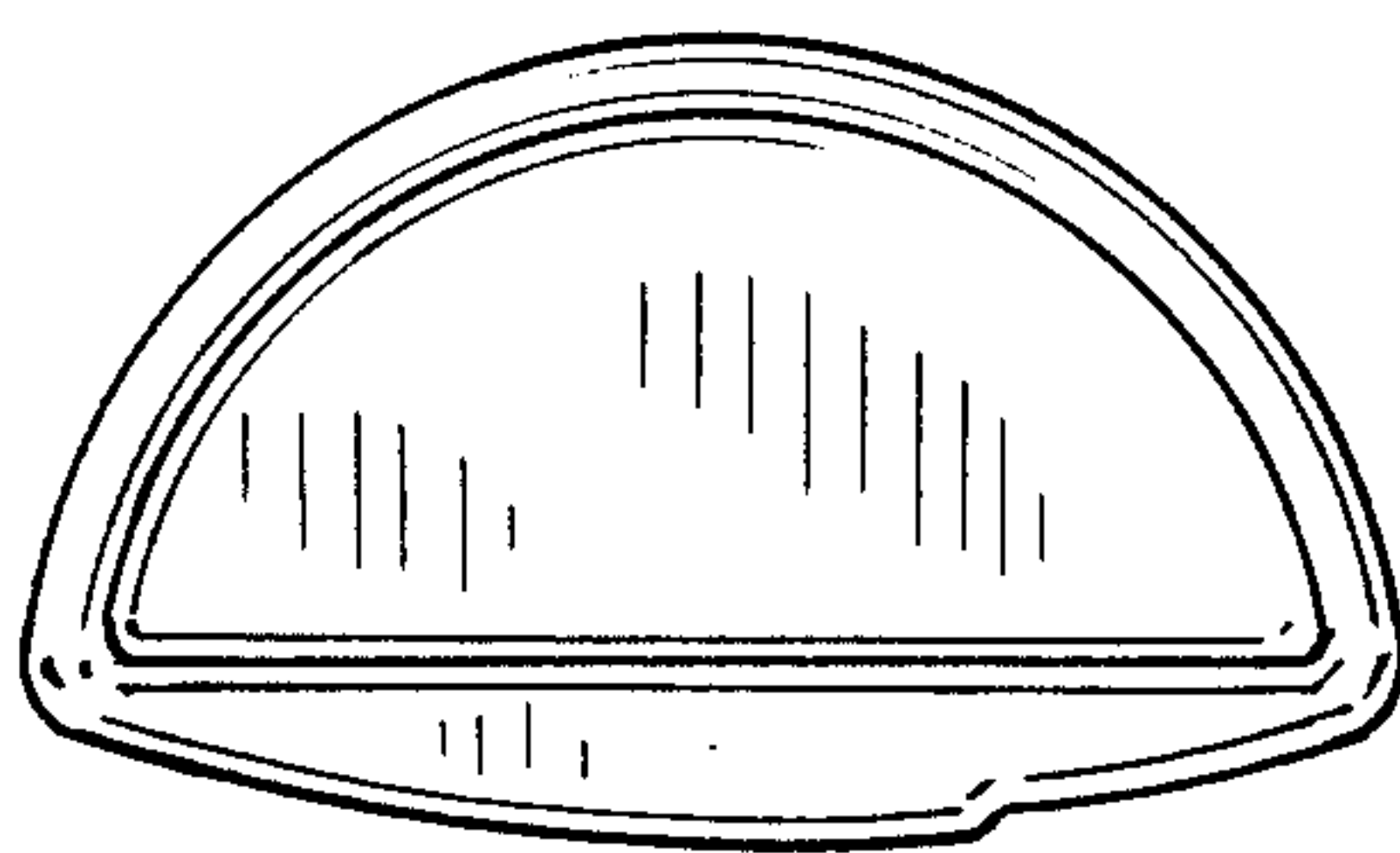

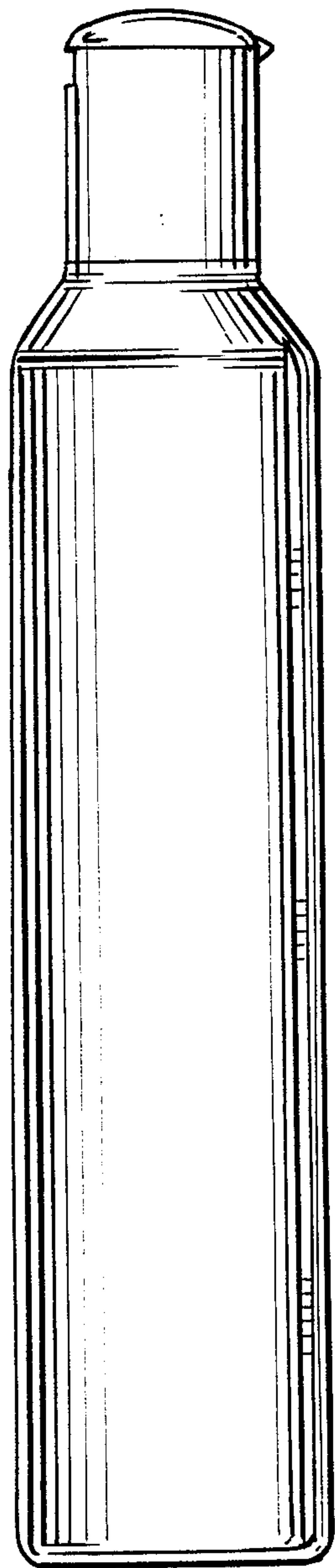

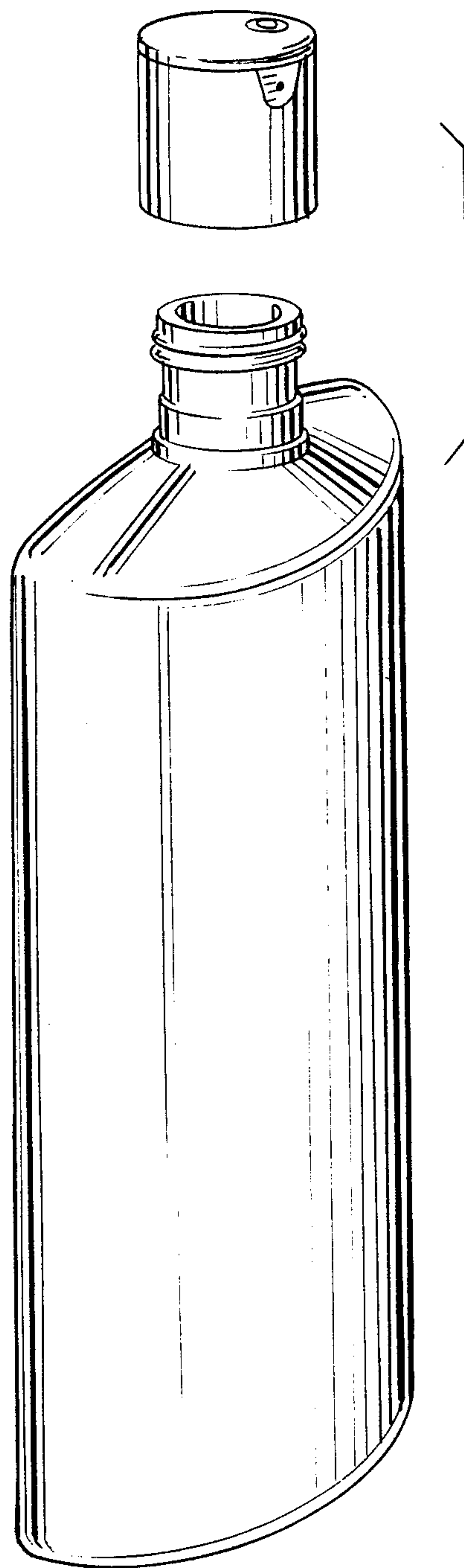
