The broken line showings in all figures are environmental only and form no part of the claimed design.

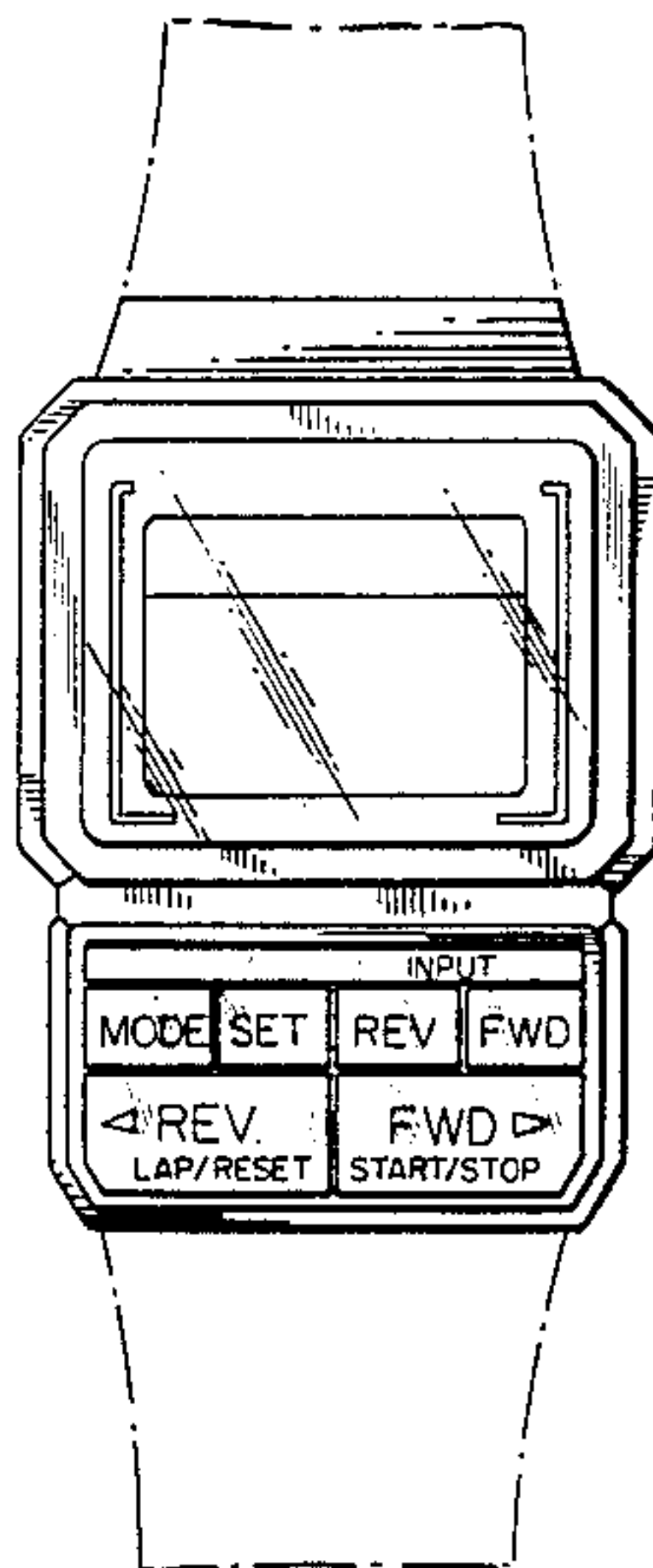

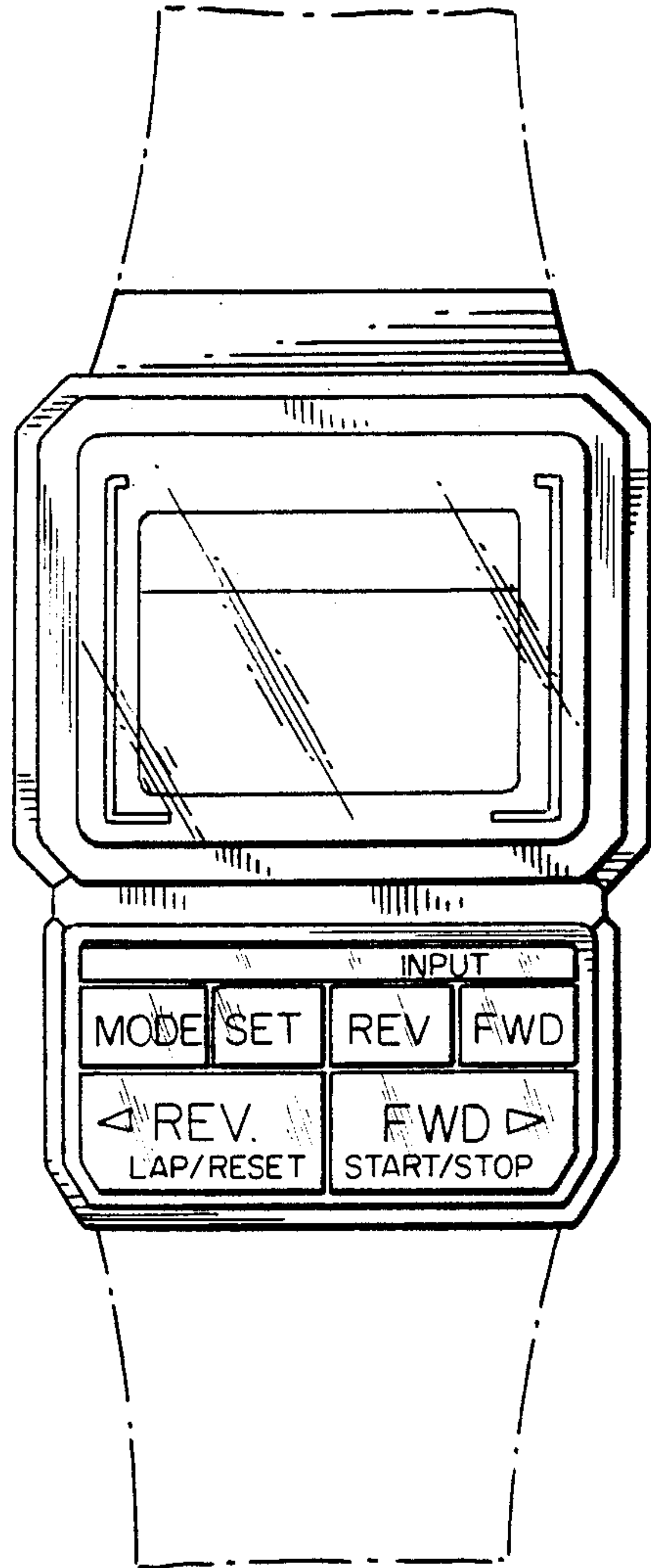
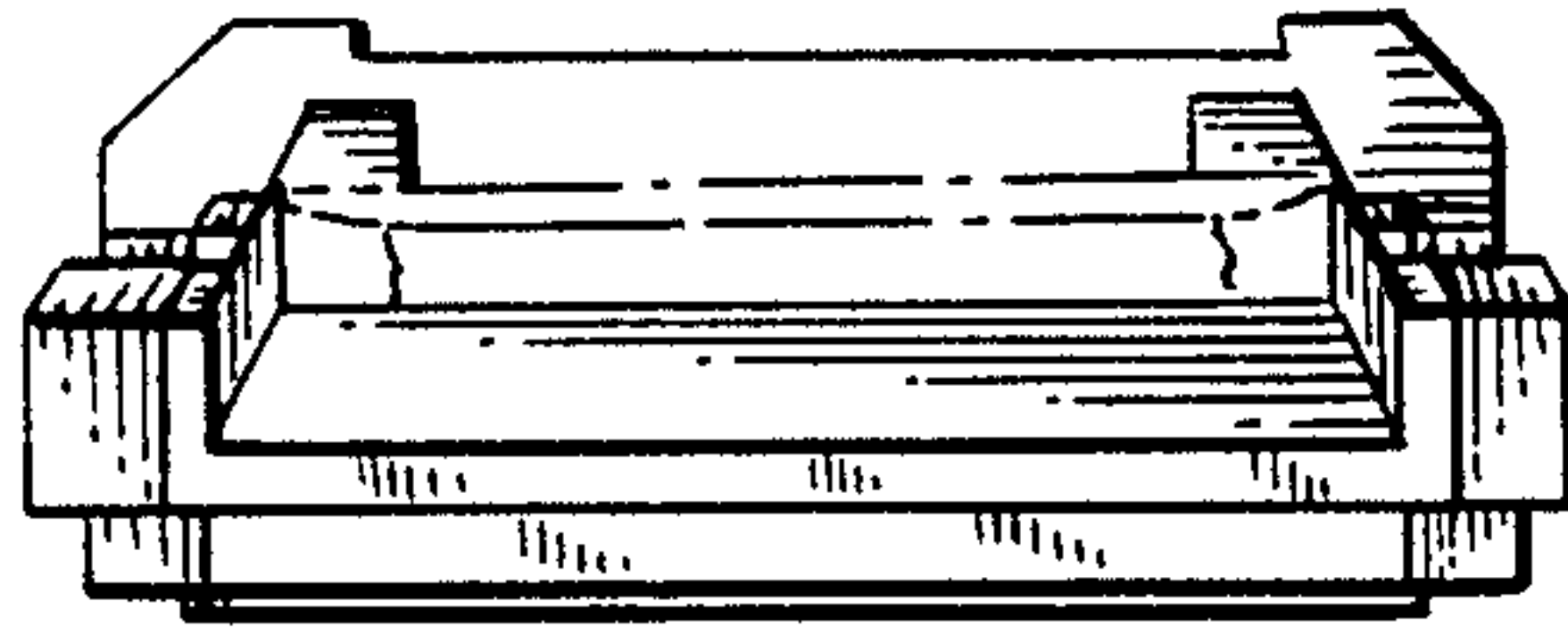

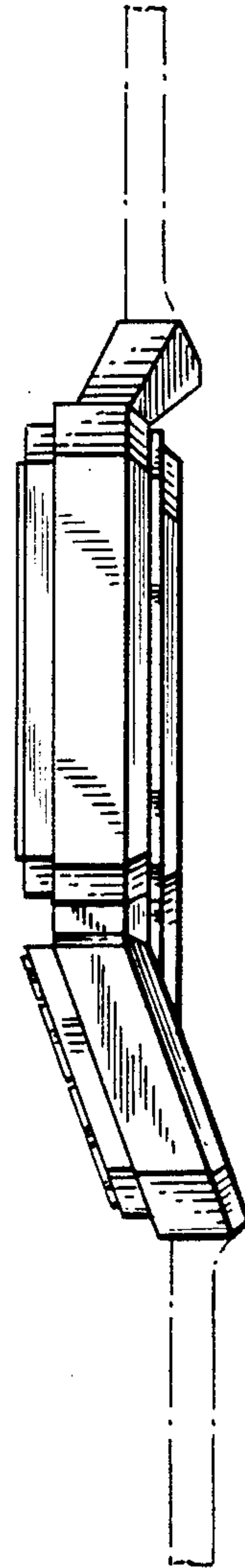

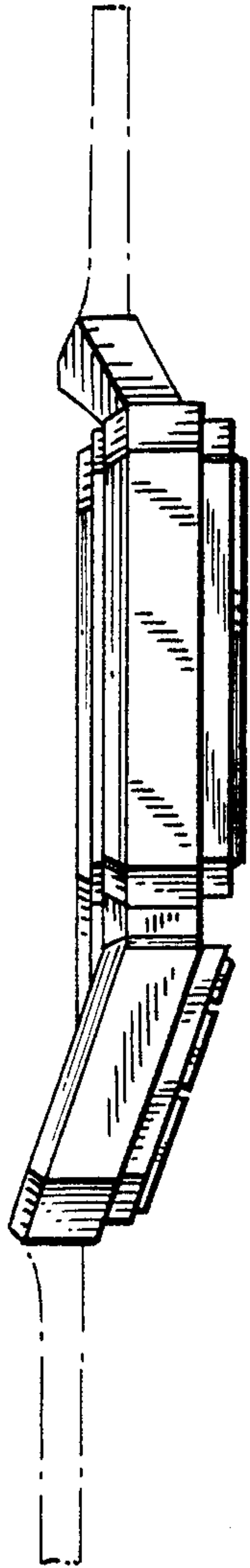

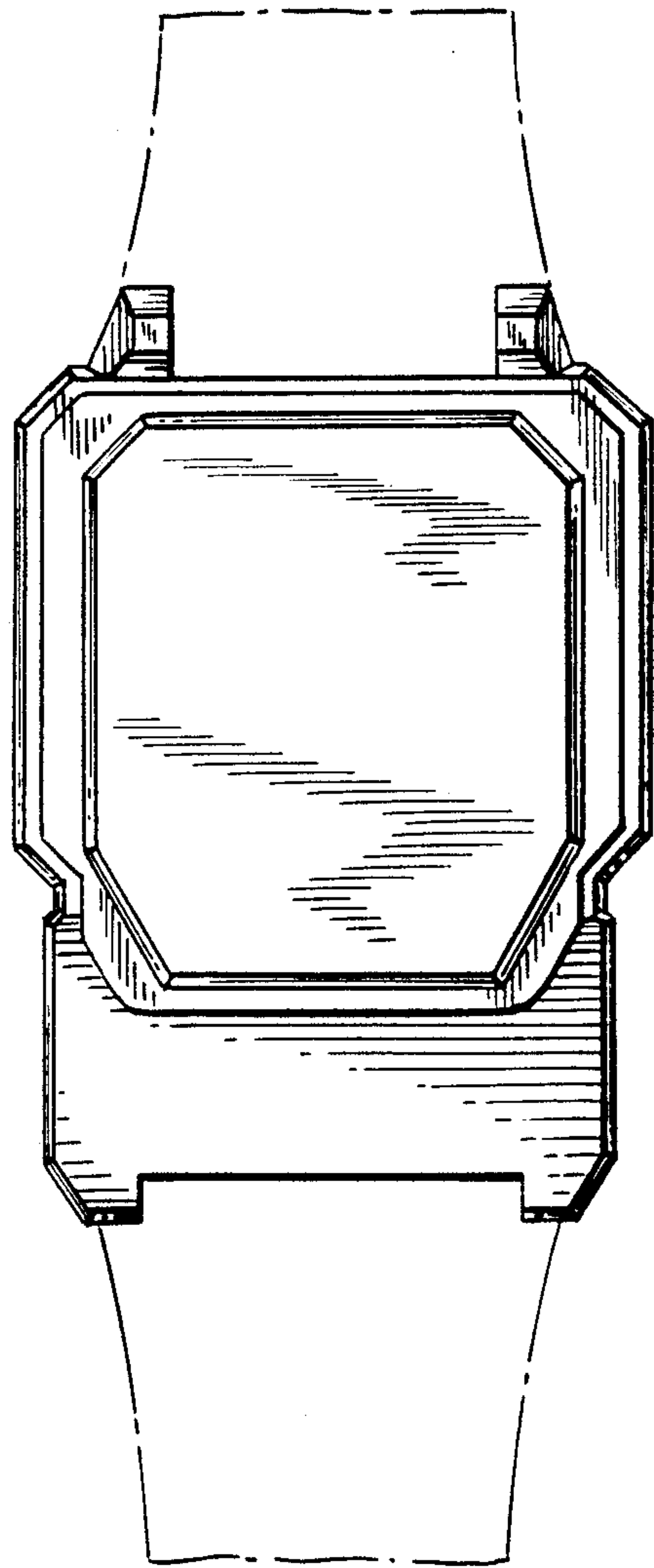
