[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a flashlight, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a side elevational view of a flashlight showing my new design, the opposite side being identical; FIG. 2 is a side elevational view thereof as seen from the left of FIG. 1, the side from the right being identical; FIG. 3 is a front elevational view thereof; FIG. 4 is a rear end elevational view thereof.

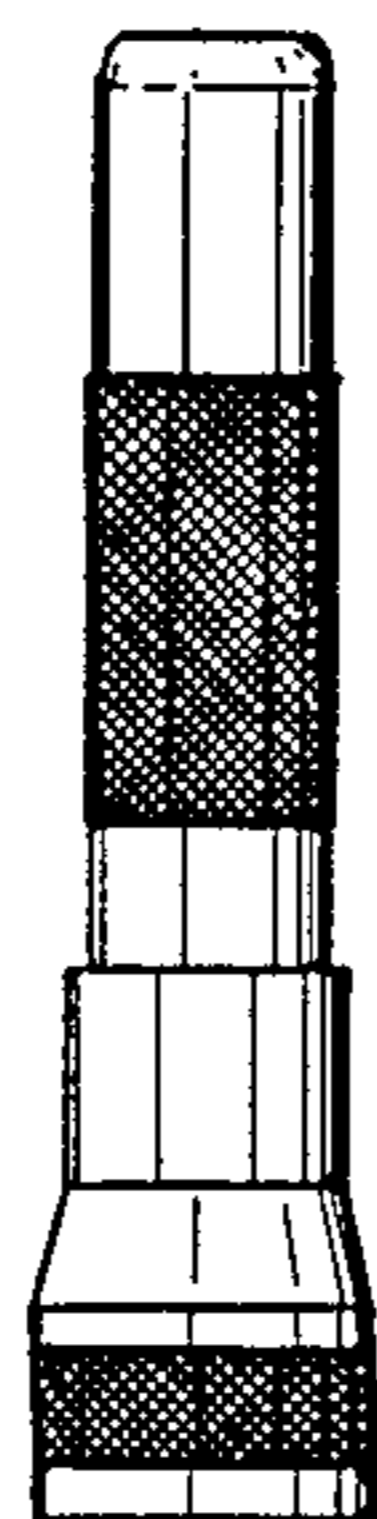

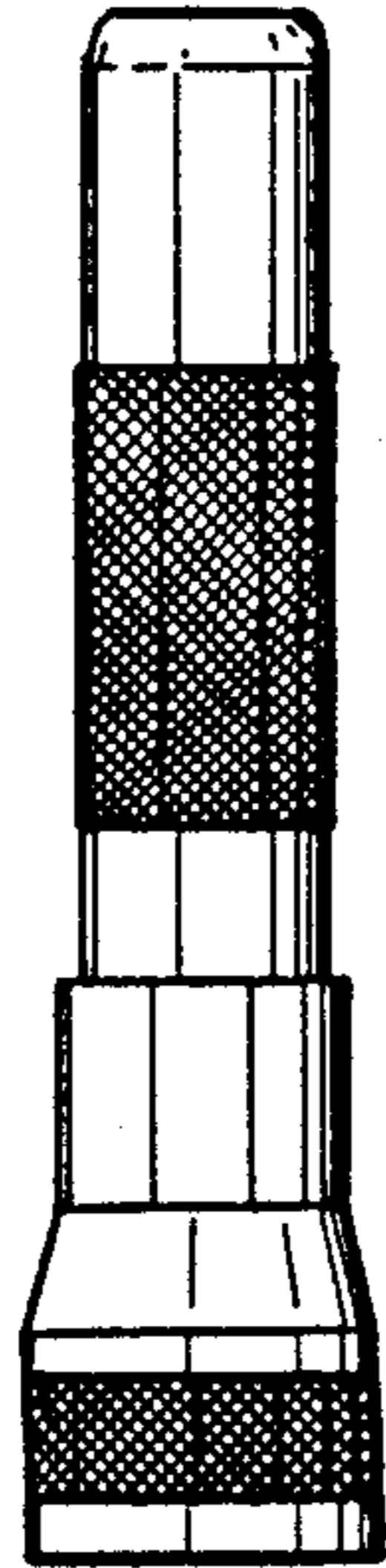

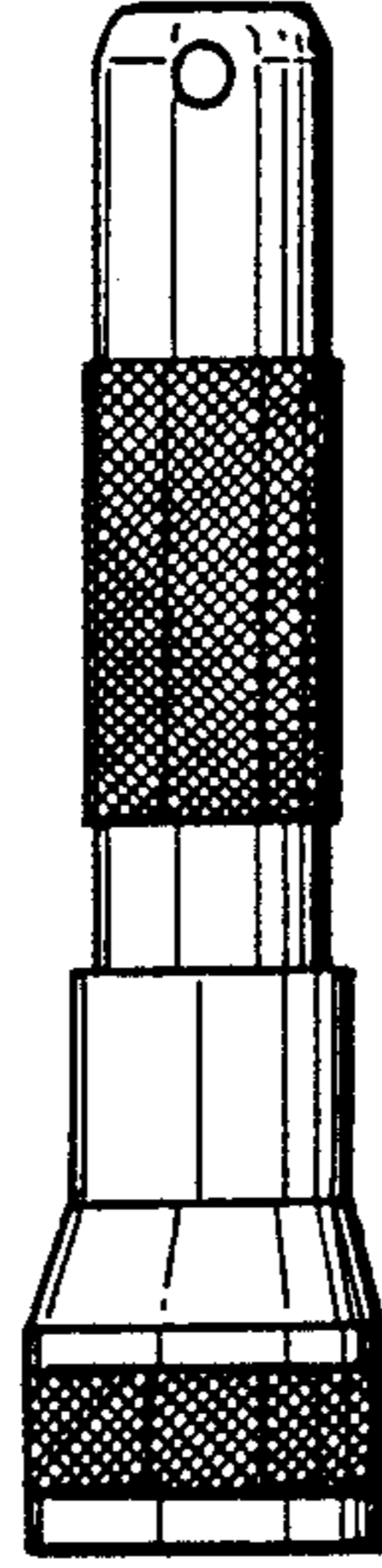

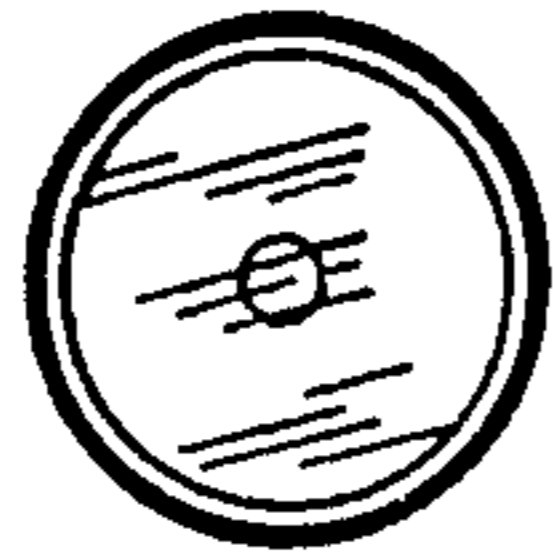
