The ornamental design for an infant seat liner, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top plan view of an infant seat liner showing our new design;

FIG. 2 is an end elevational view thereof;

FIG. 3 is an opposite end elevational view thereof;


FIG. 4 is a side elevational view thereof;

FIG. 5 is an opposite side elevational view thereof;

FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view thereof;

FIG. 7 is a top plan view of an alternative embodiment thereof, the only difference residing in the surface pattern; and

FIG. 8 is an enlarged fragmentary cross-sectional view thereof, taken along line 8—8 of FIG. 1.







