FIG. 2 is a bottom, rear, and right side perspective view thereof;

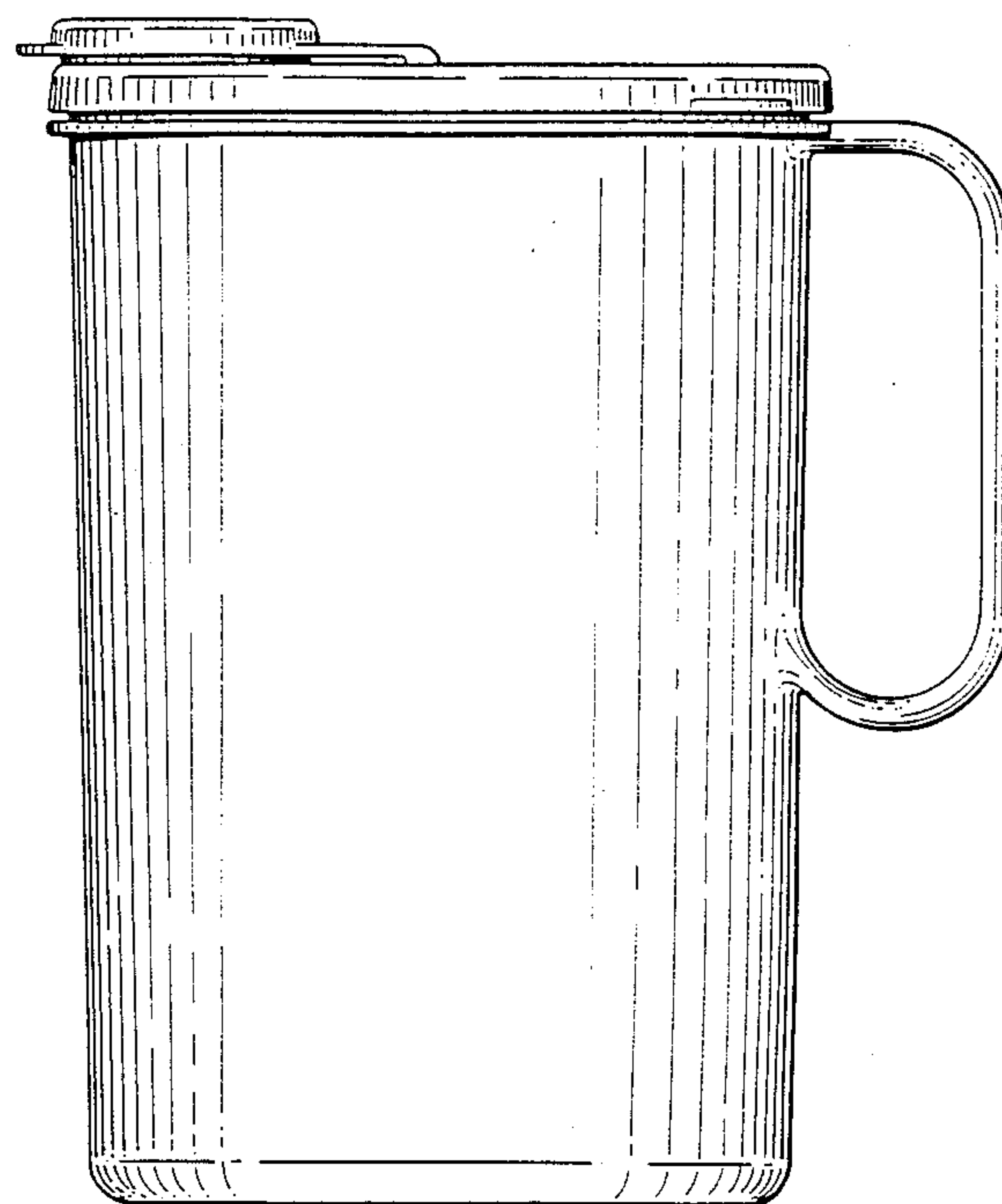
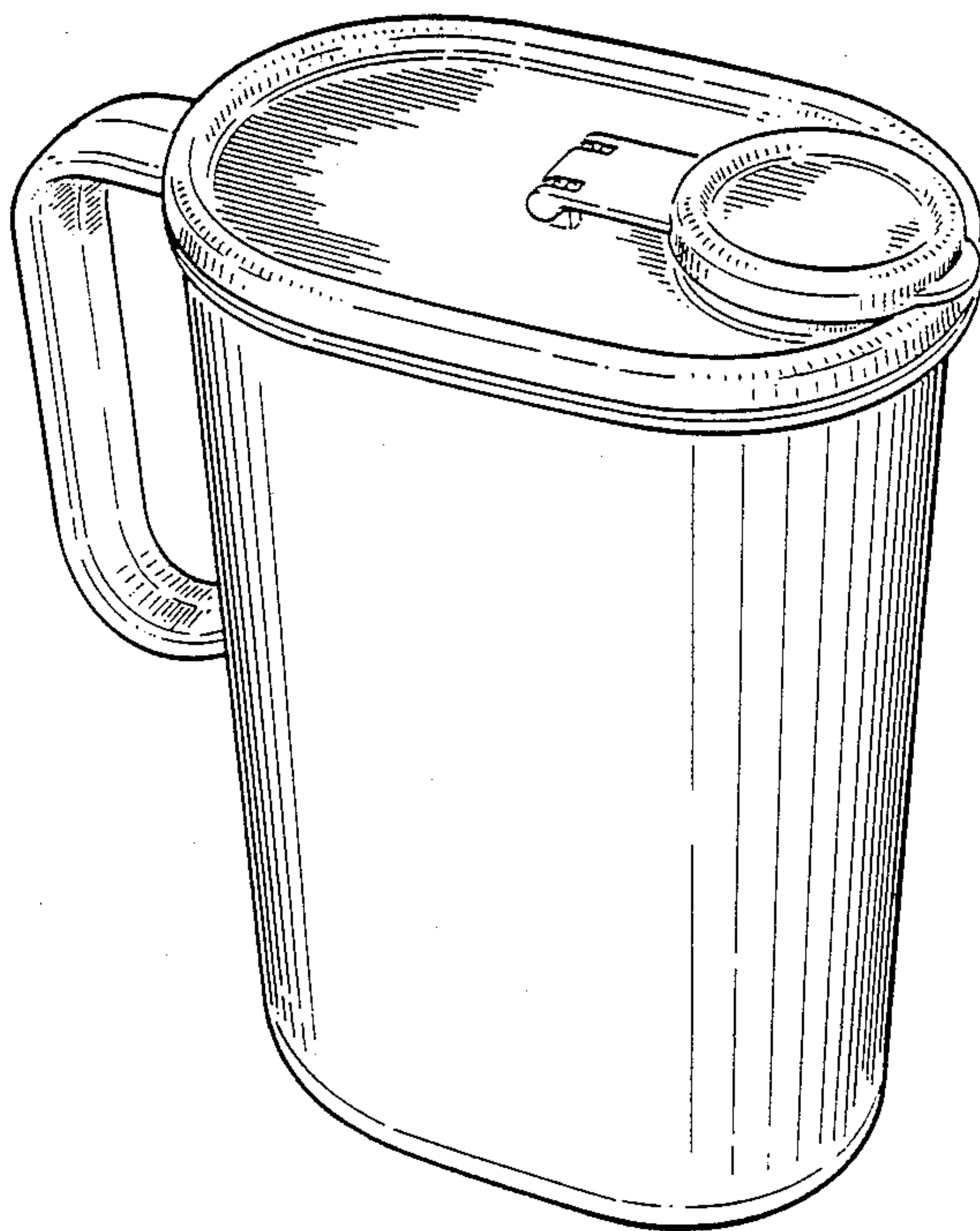
FIG. 3 is a right side elevational view thereof;

FIG. 7 is a bottom plan view thereof.



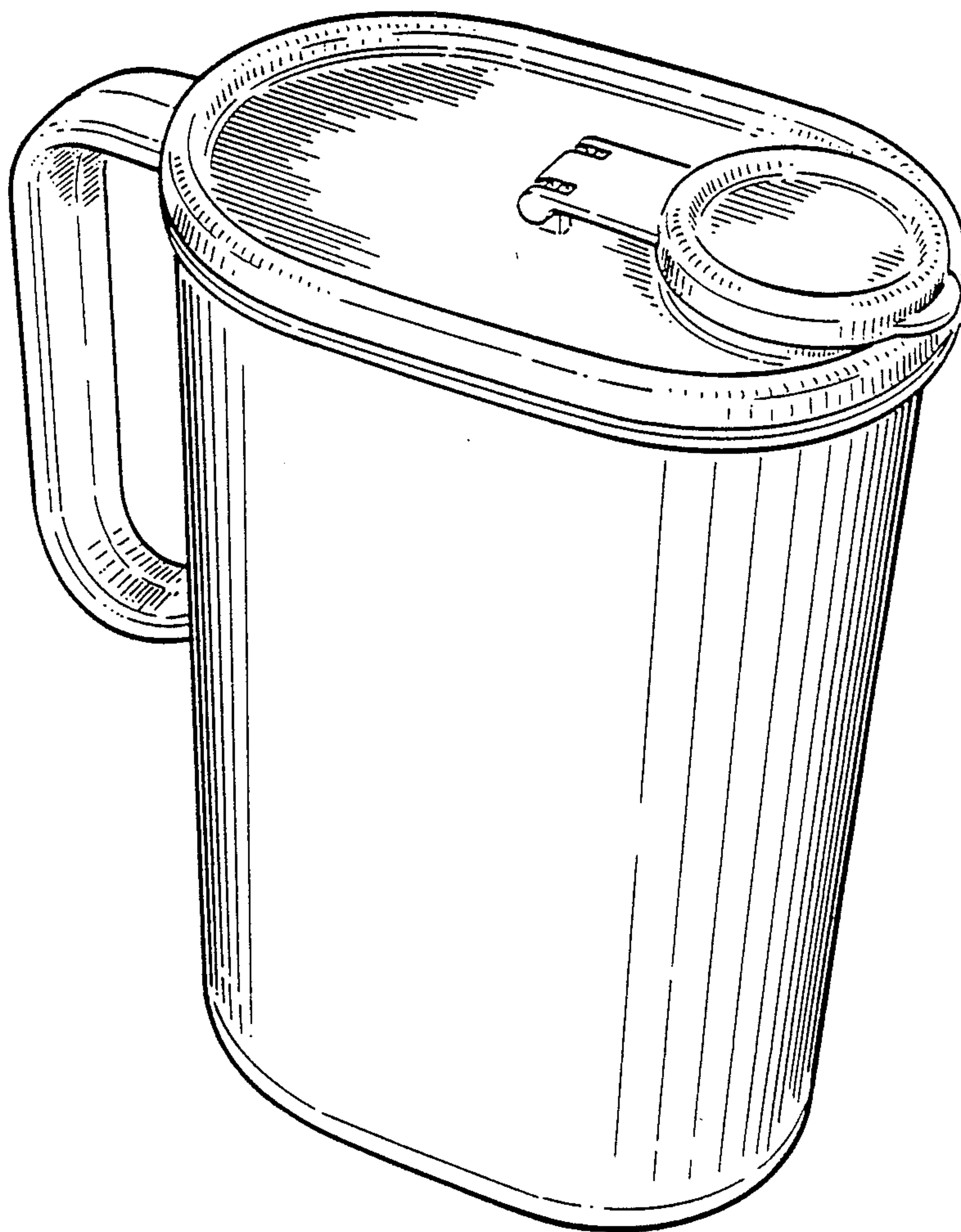

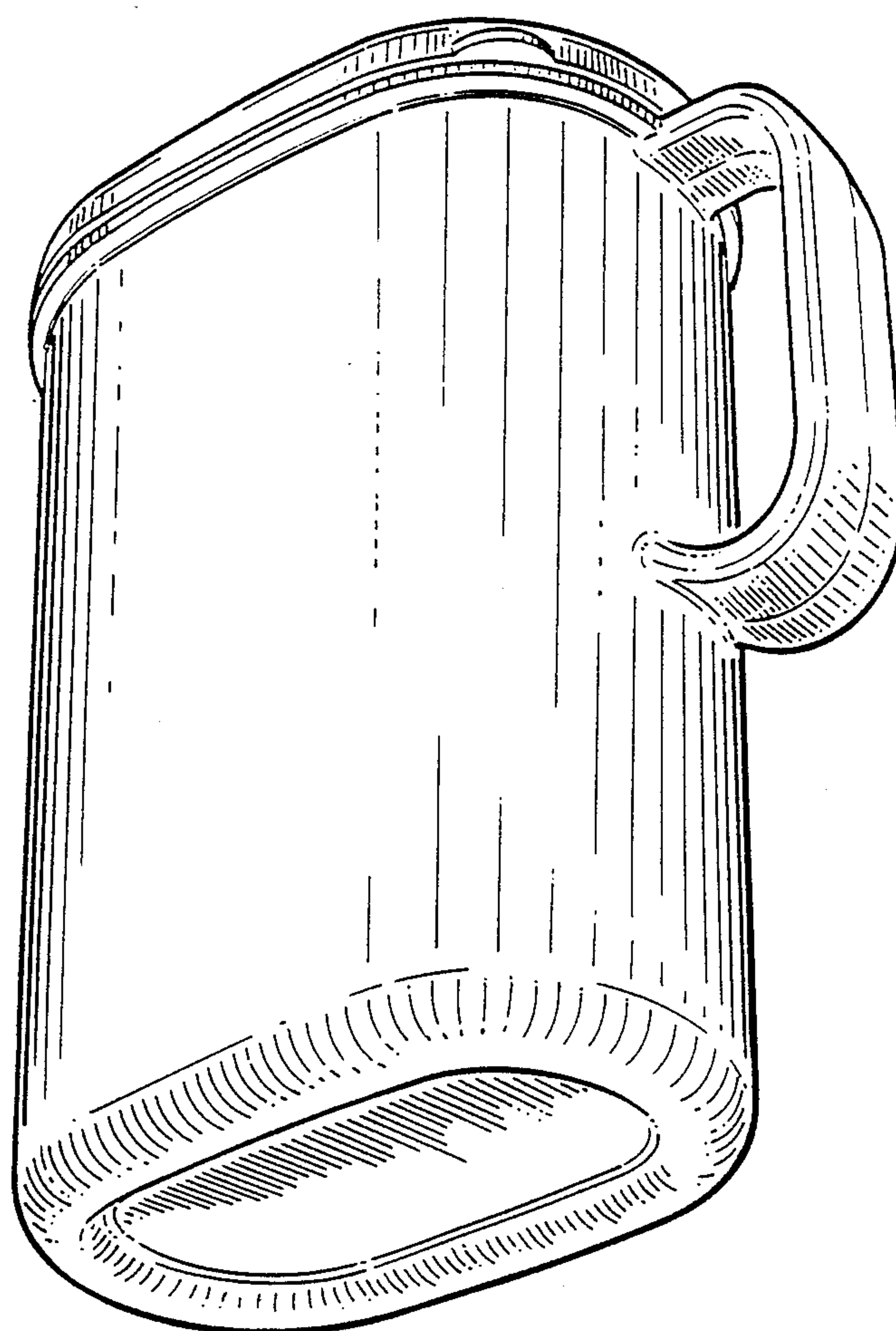

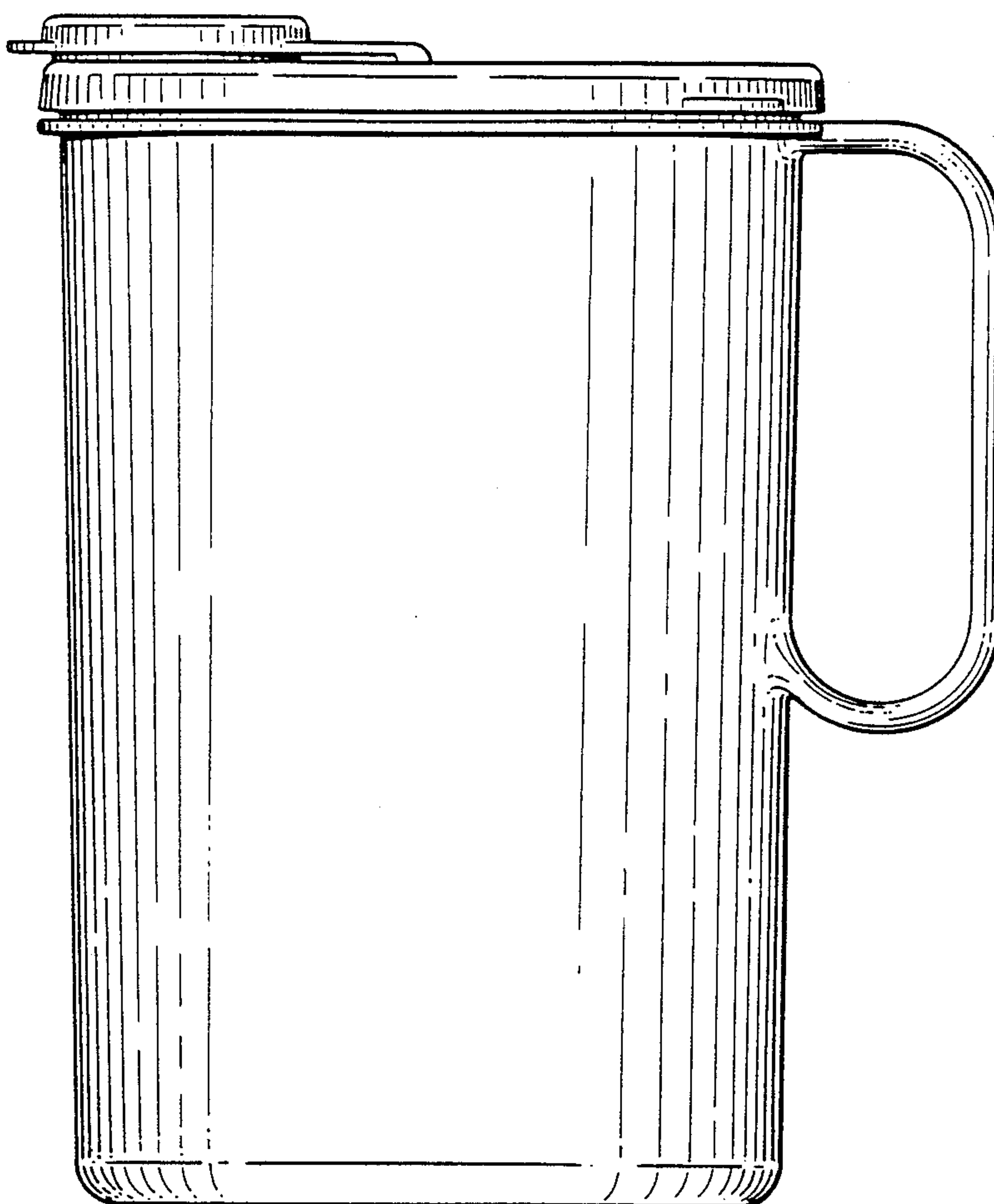

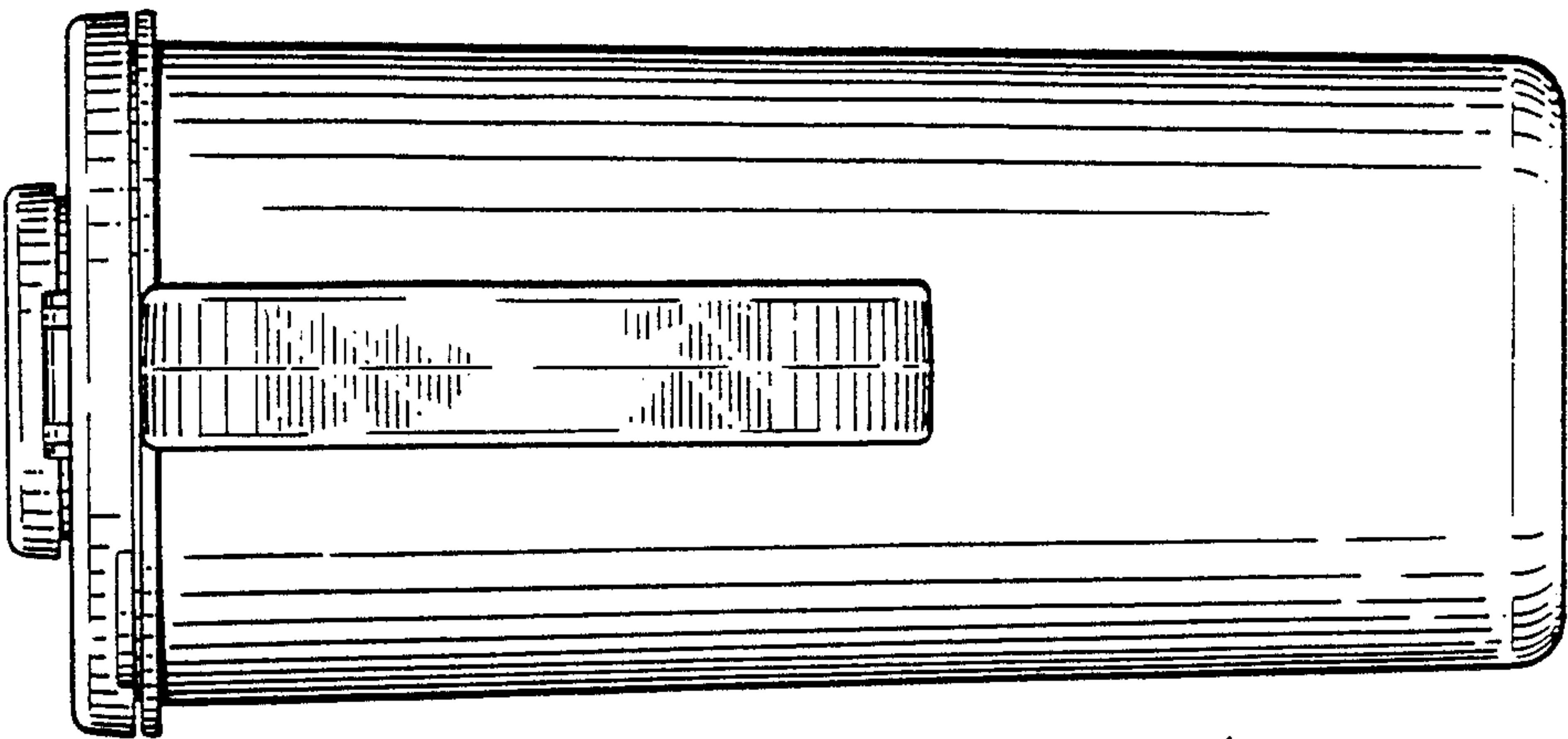
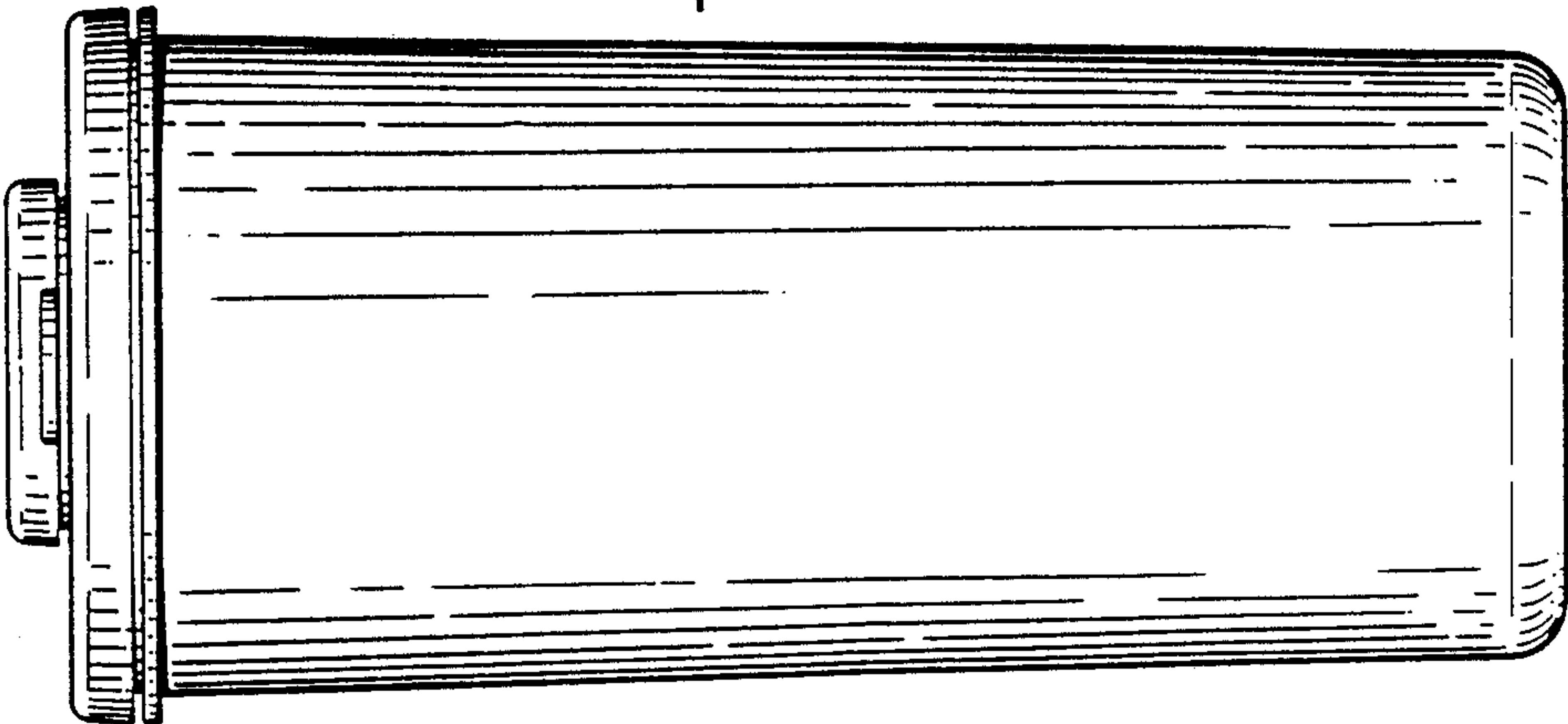

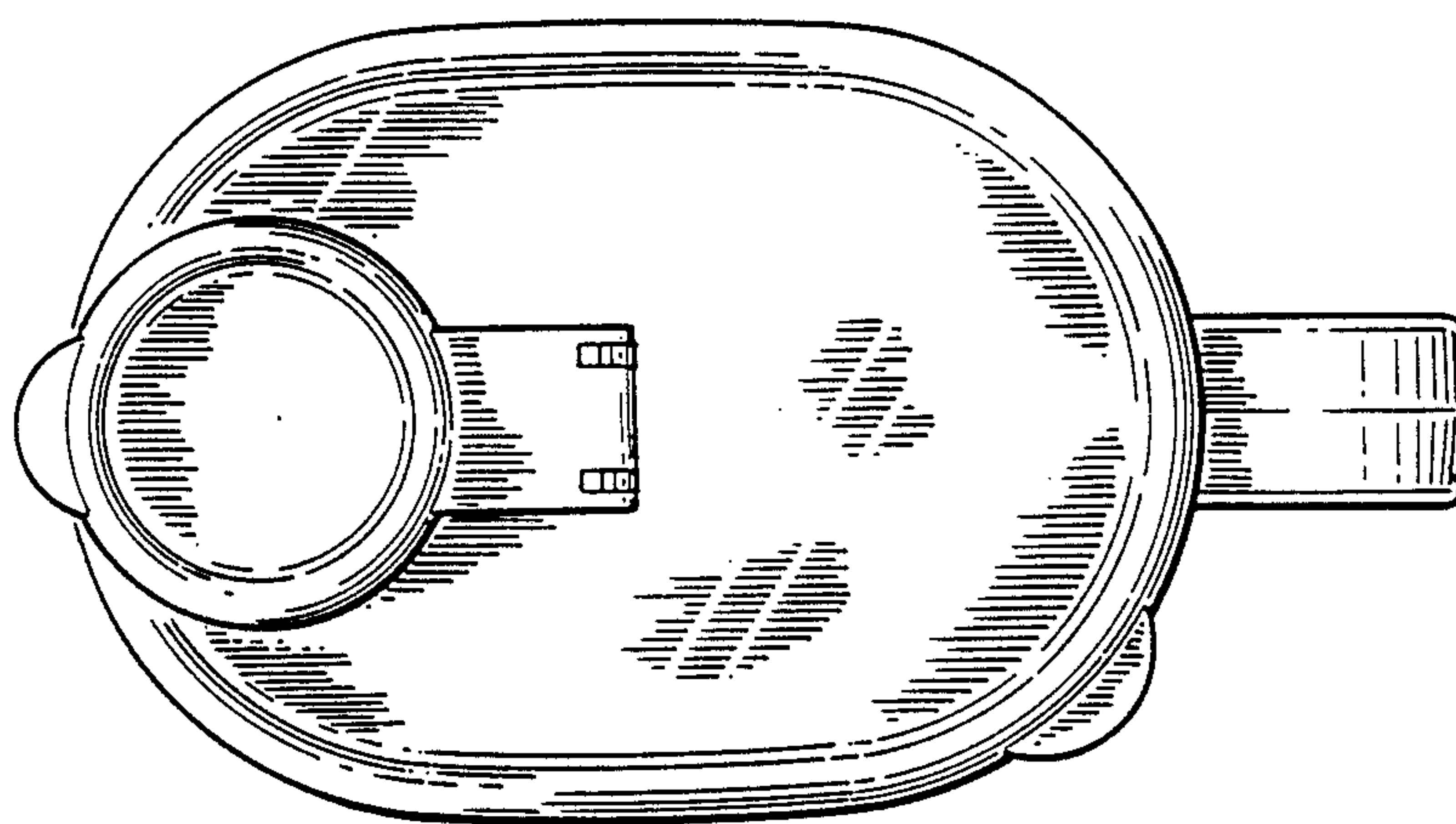

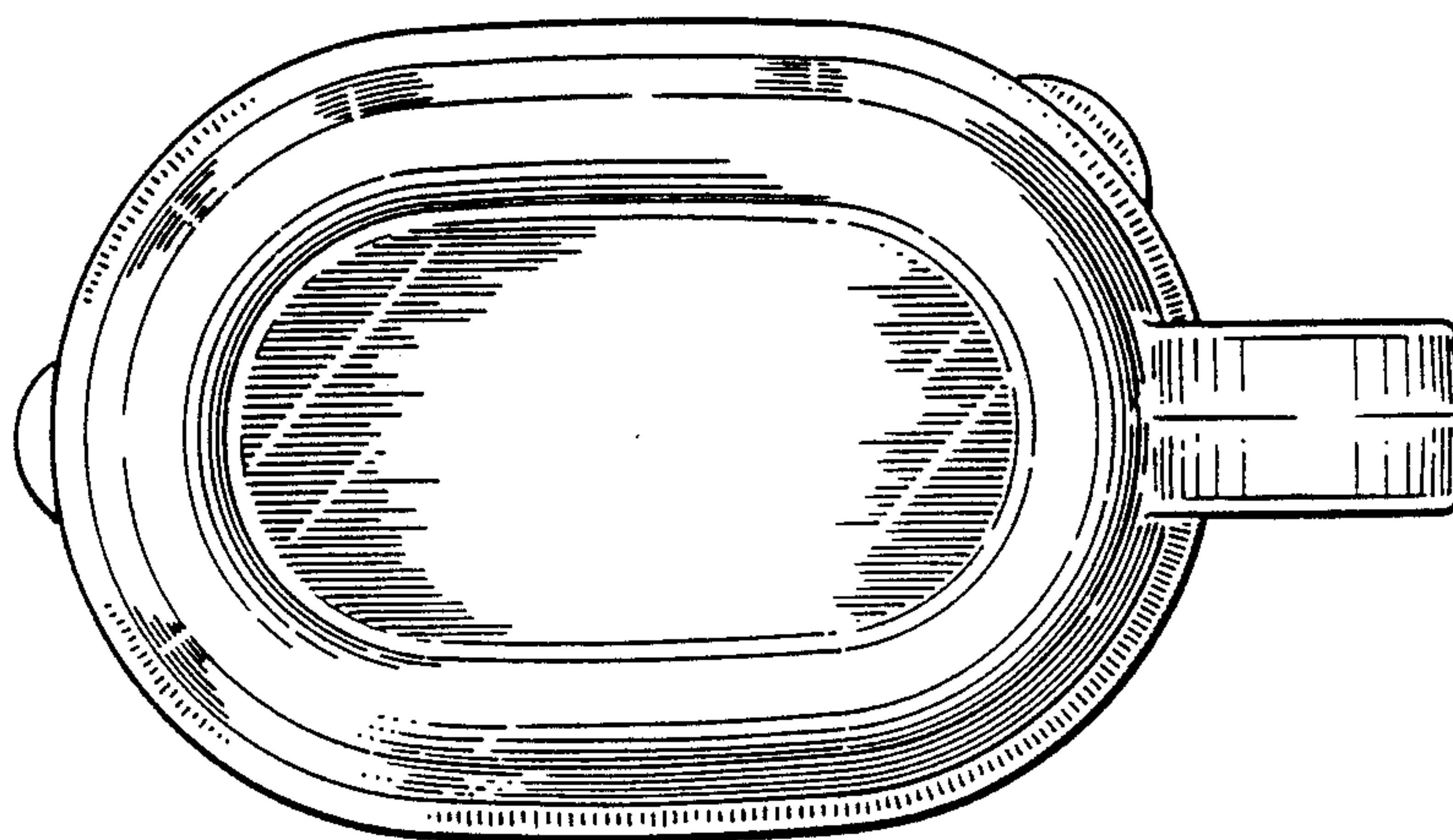
