FIG. 5 is a left side elevational view, with the right side being a mirror image thereof.

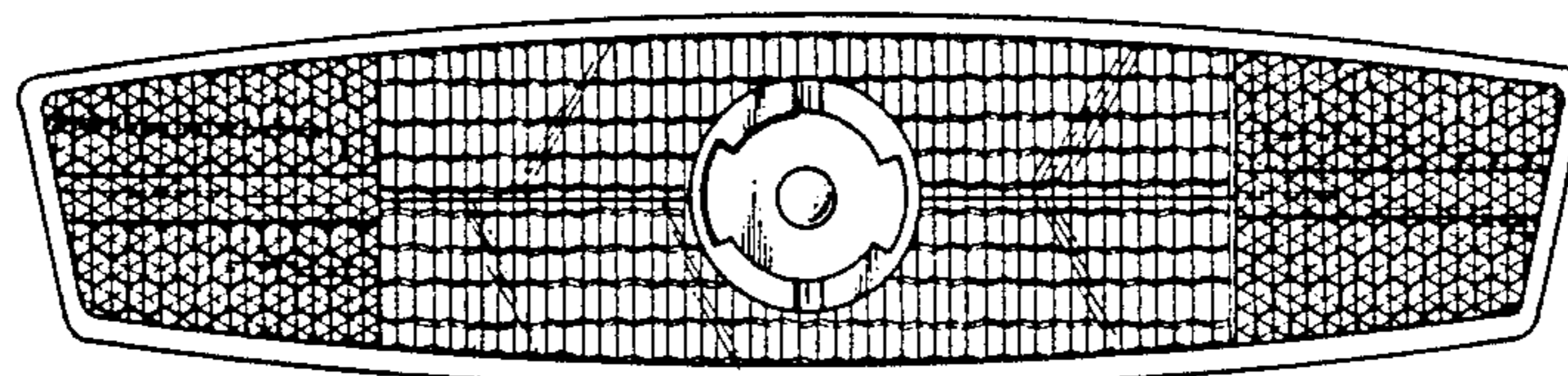
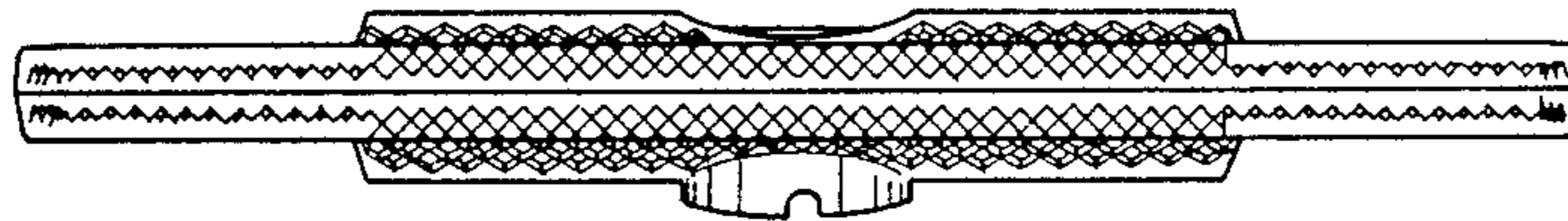

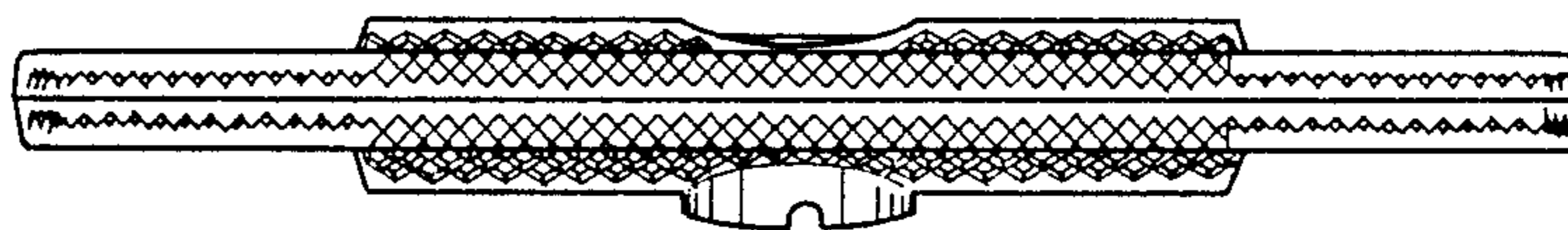

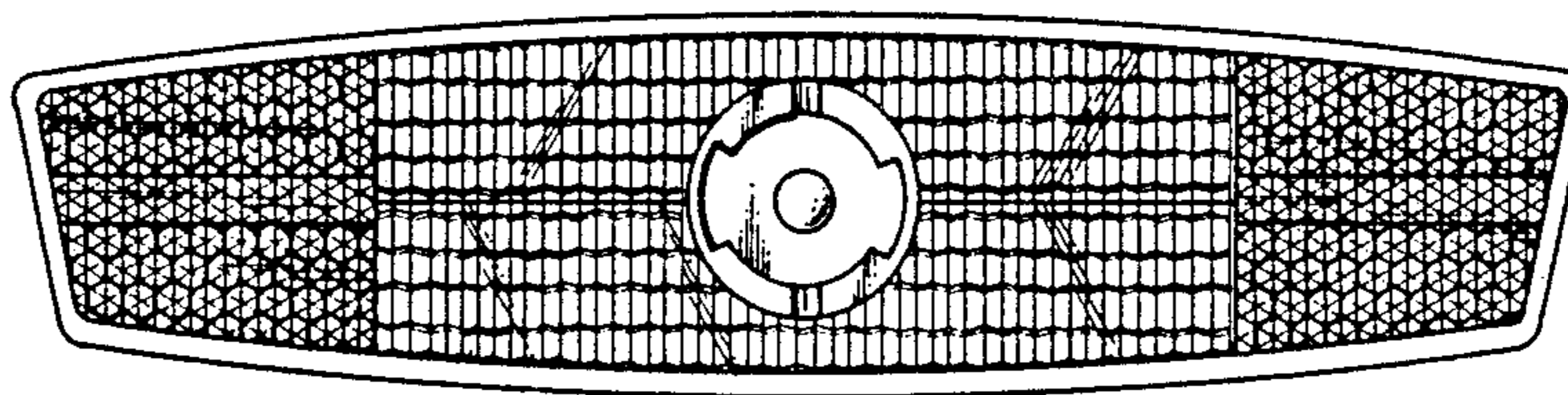

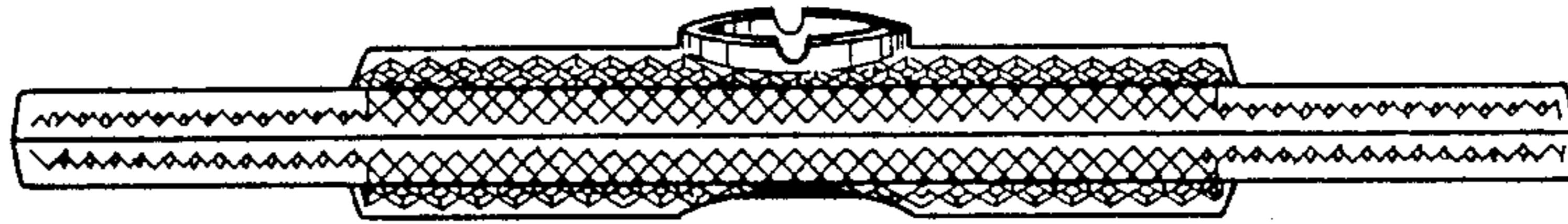

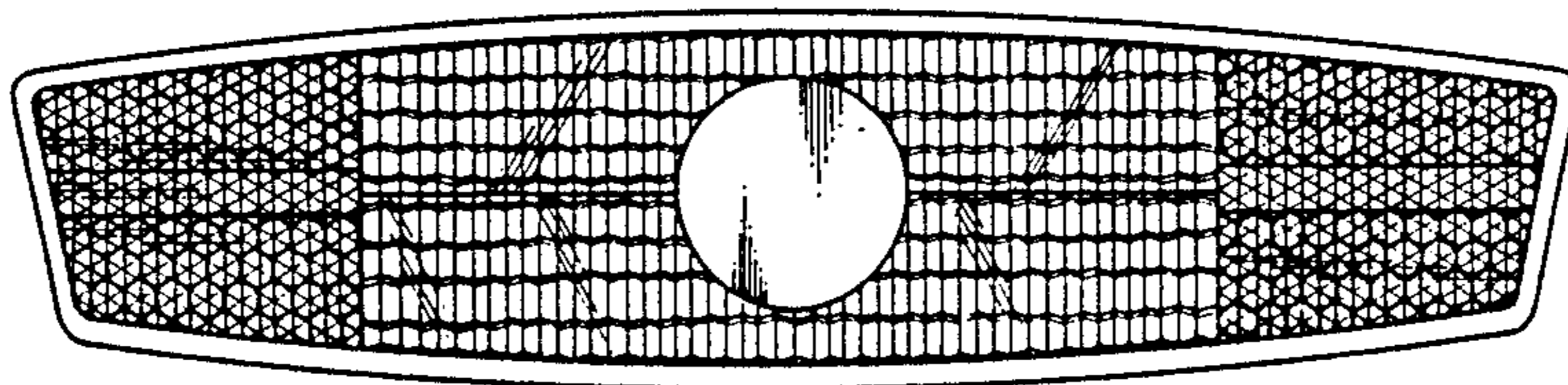
