[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a cassette tape player, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top, front and left-side perspective view of a cassette tape player, showing our new design; FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof; FIG. 3 is a rear elevational view thereof; FIG. 4 is a right-side elevational view thereof; FIG. 5 is a left-side elevational view thereof; FIG. 6 is a top plan view thereof; and FIG. 7 is a bottom plan view thereof.

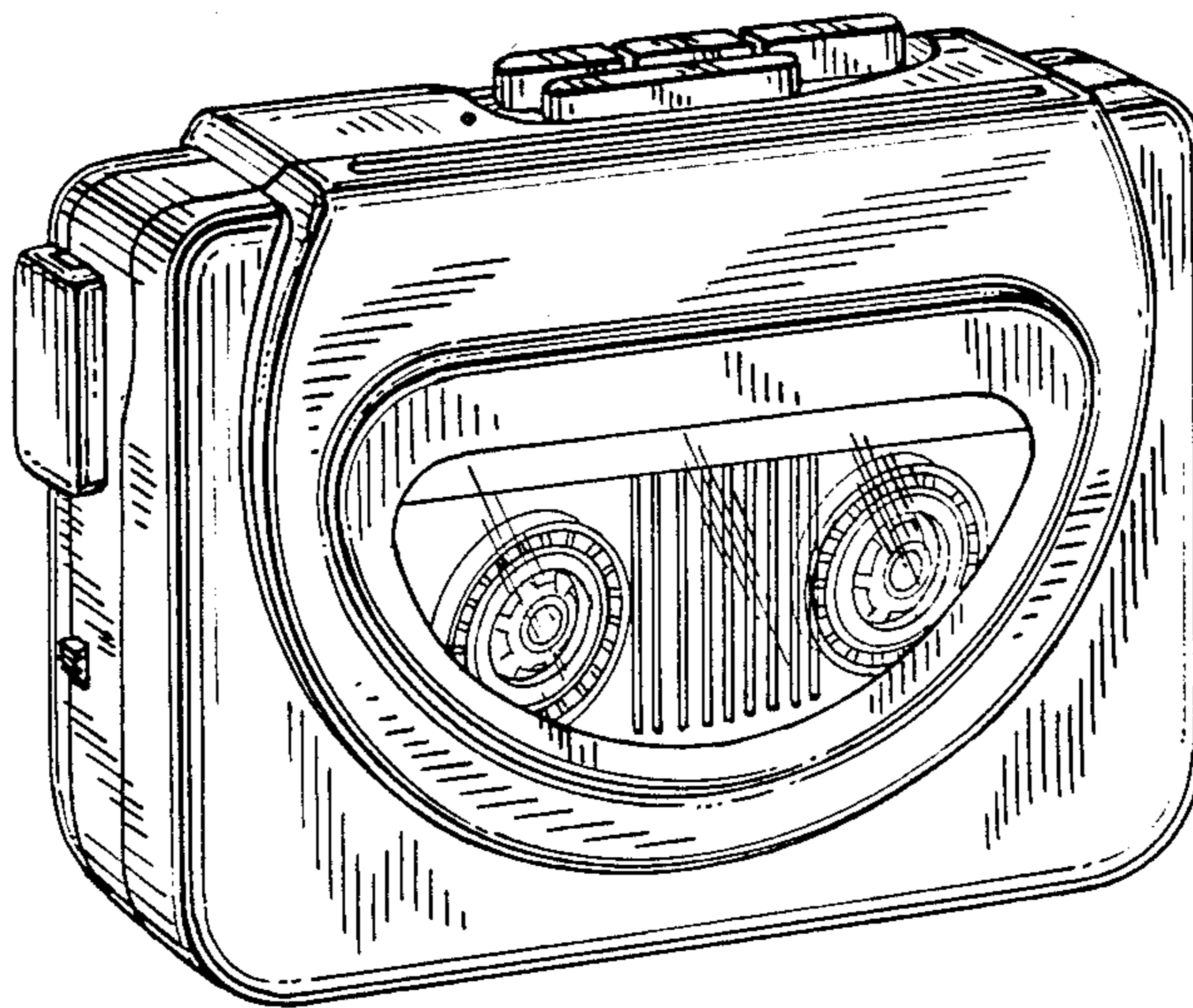

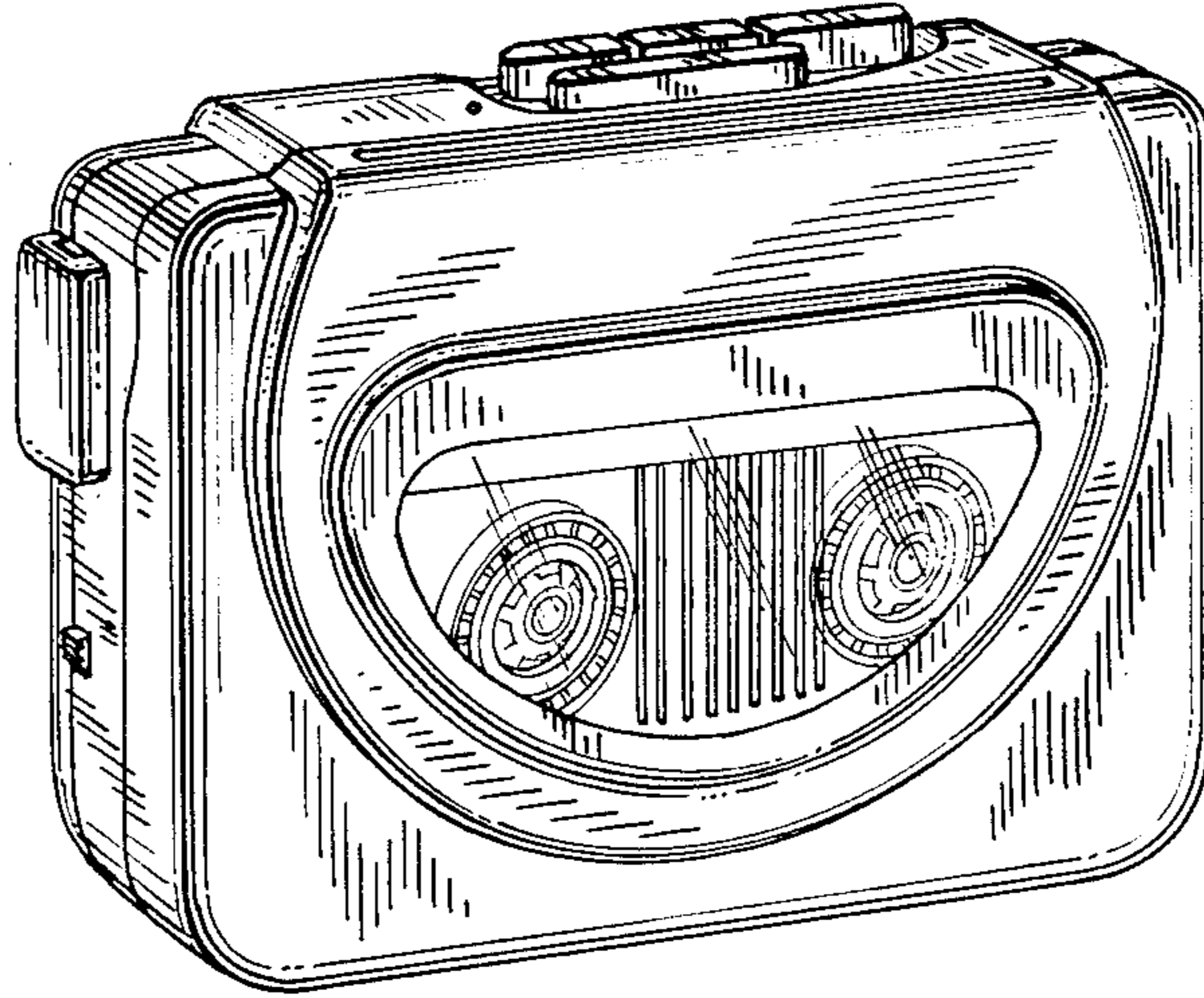

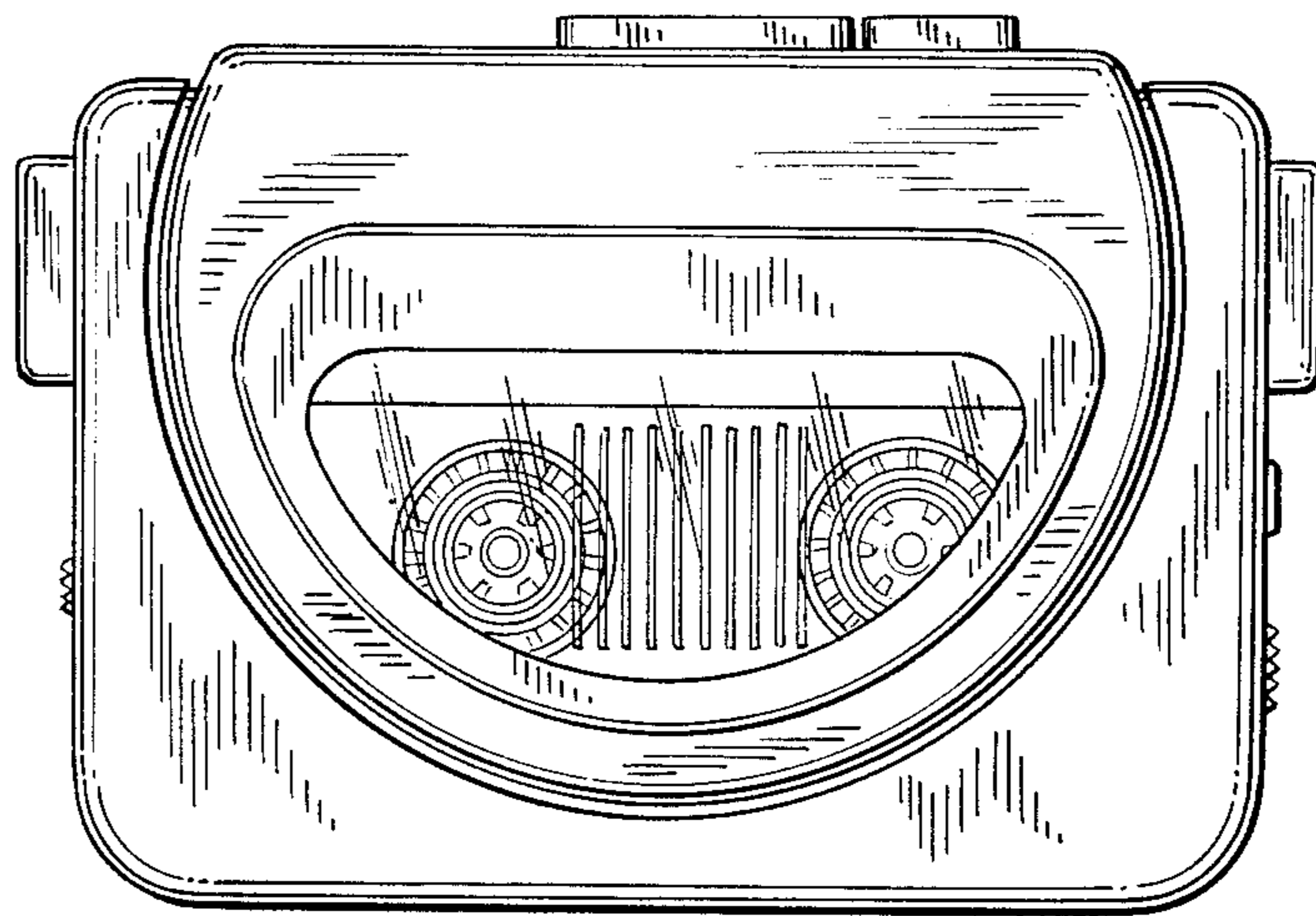

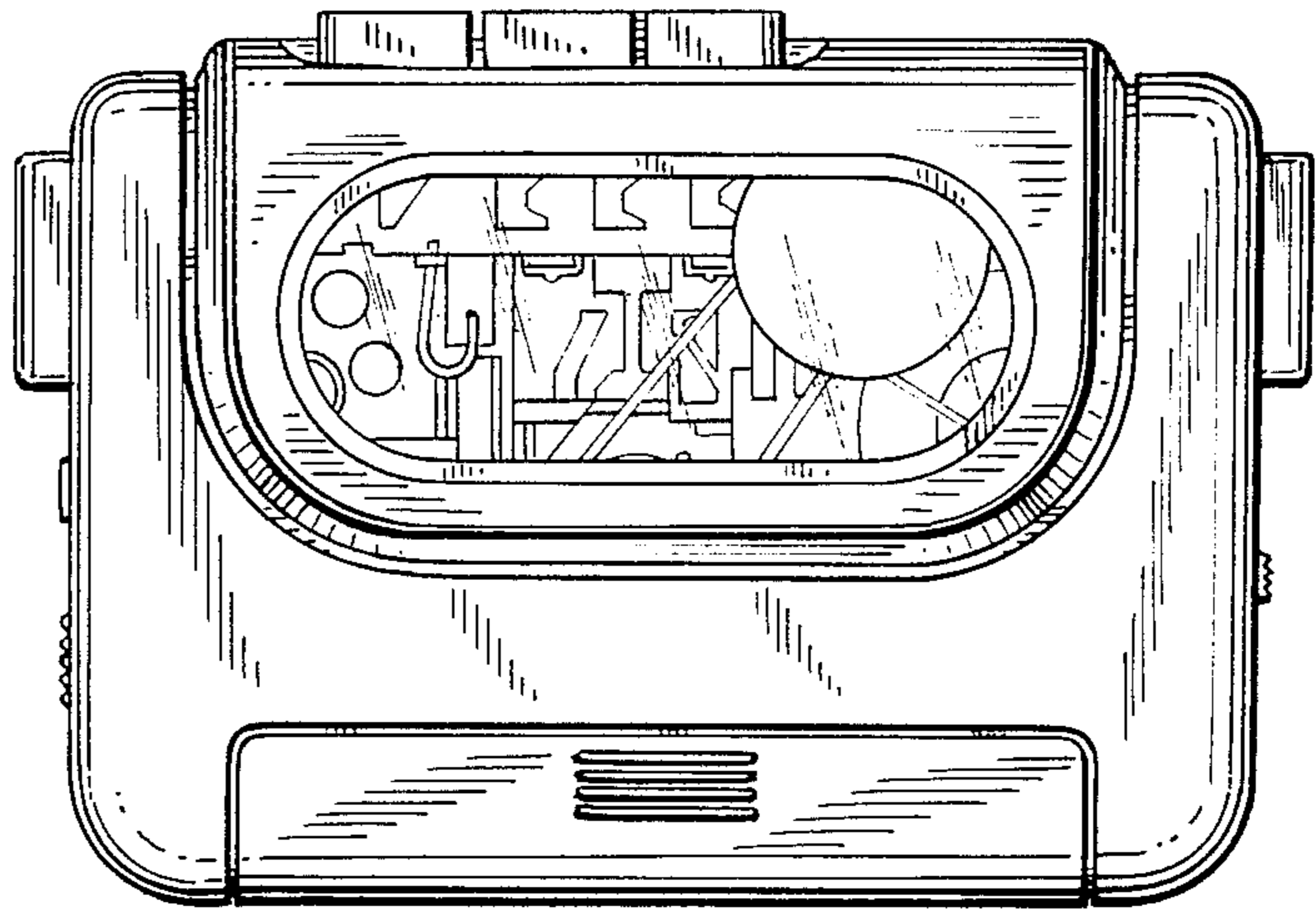
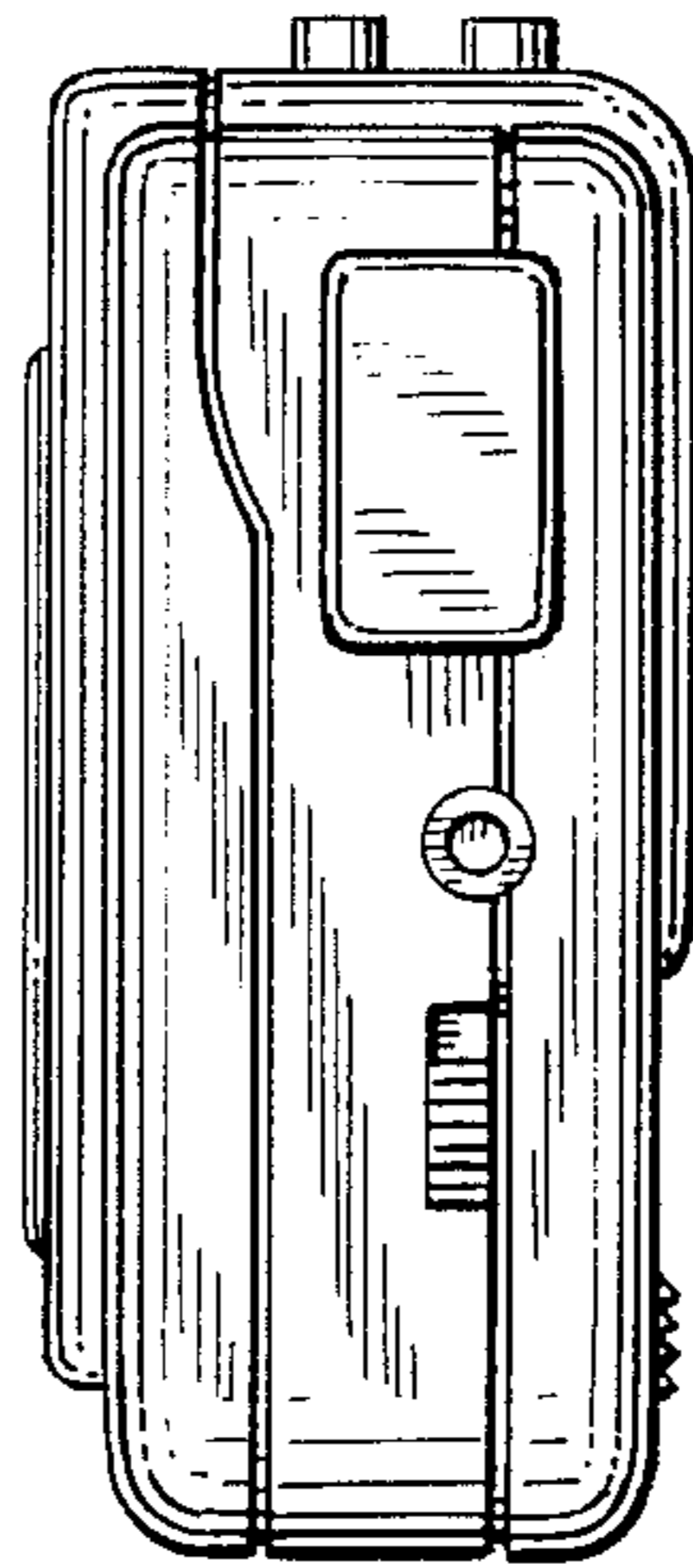

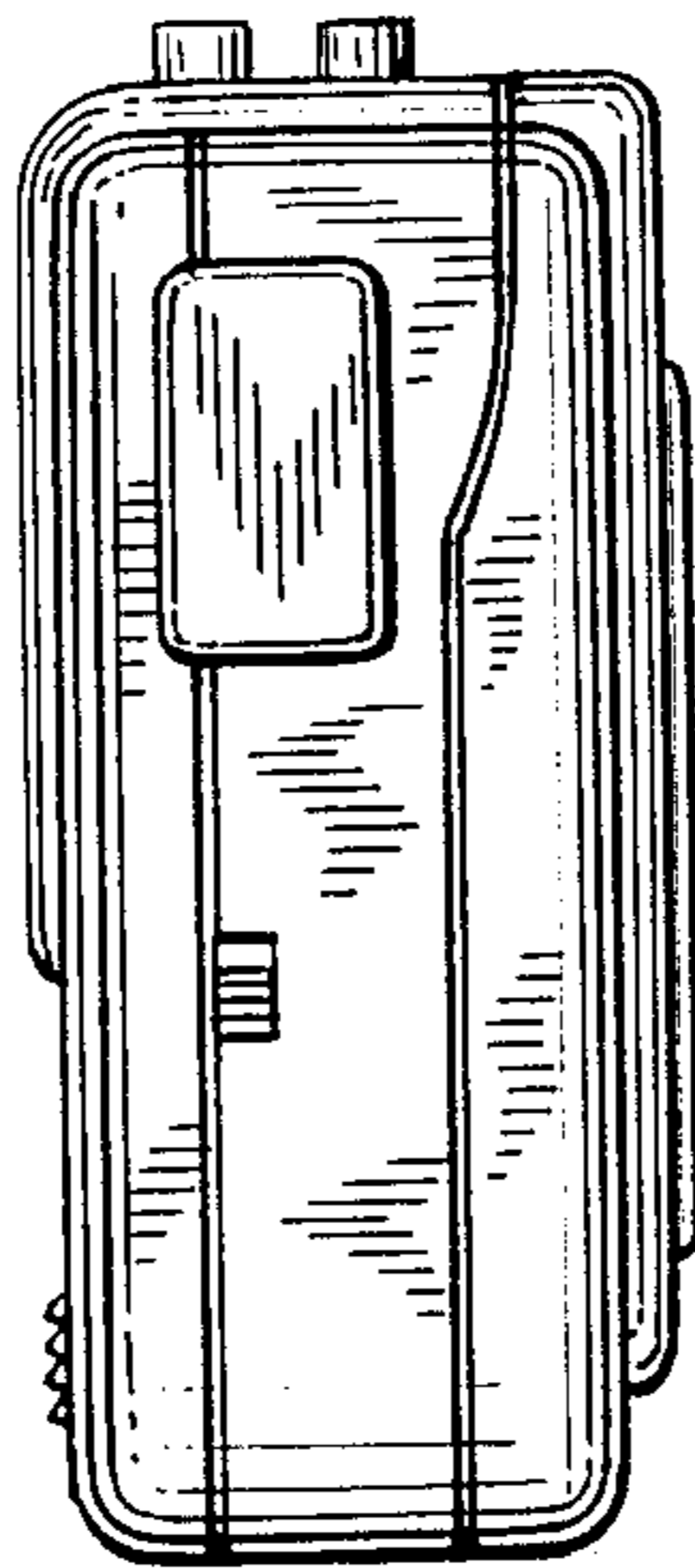

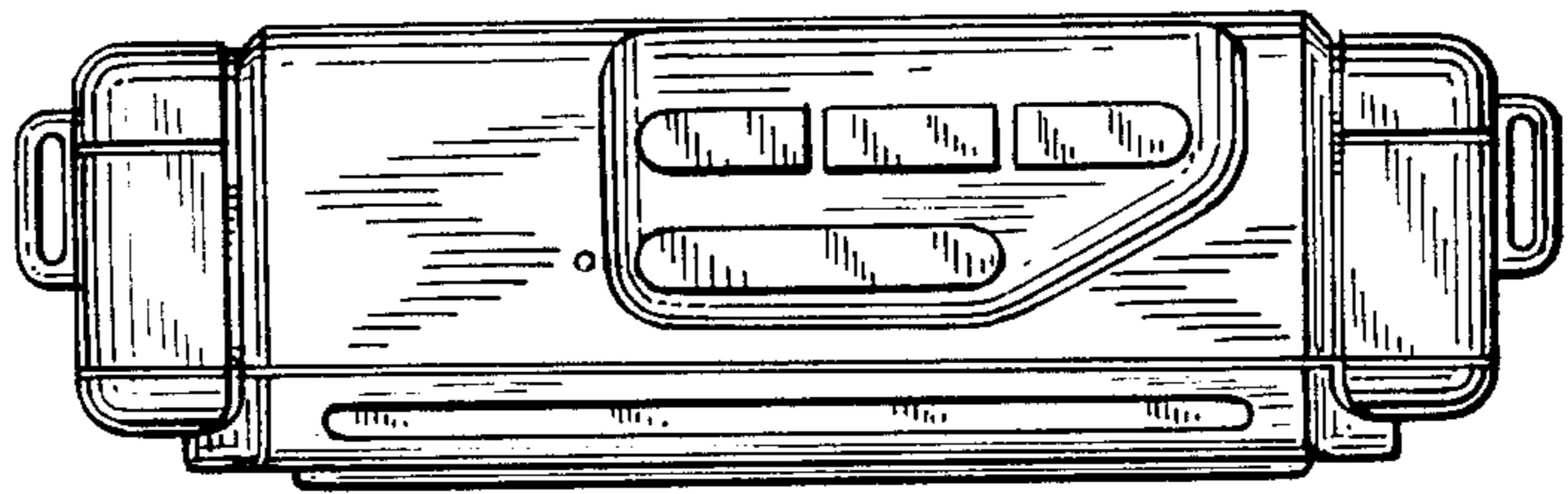
