The ornamental design for a faucet set, as shown and described.

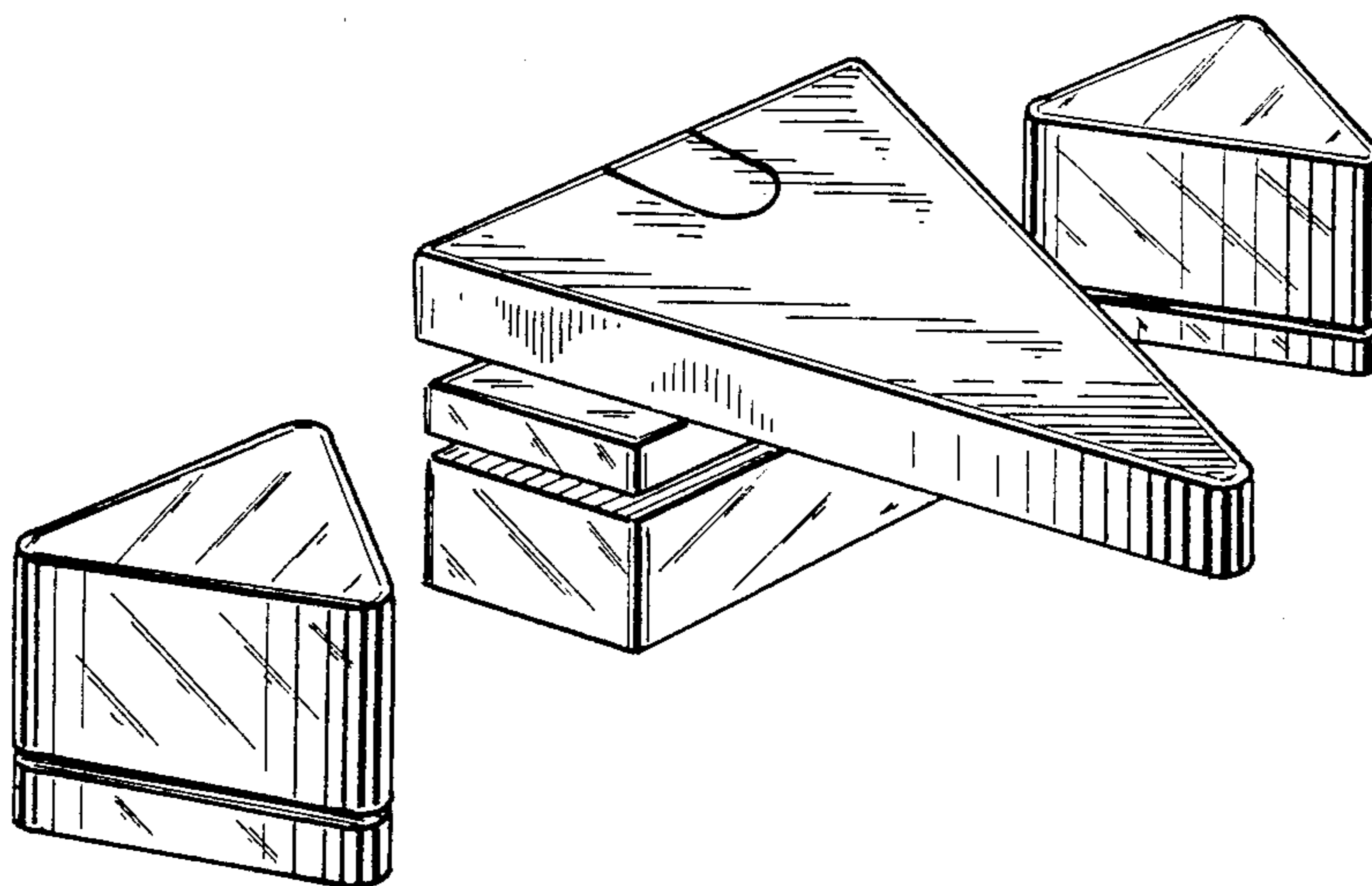
DESCRIPTION

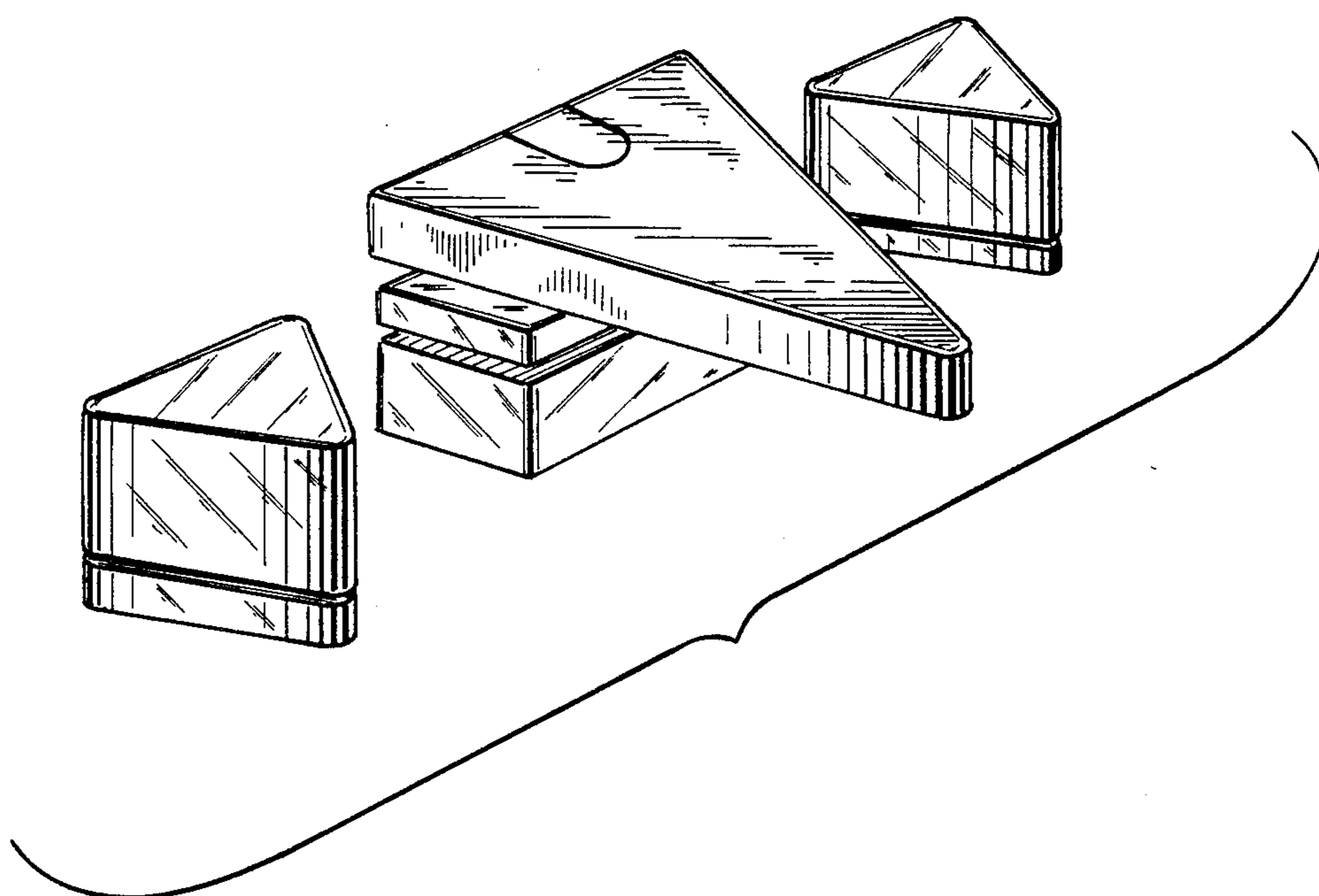
