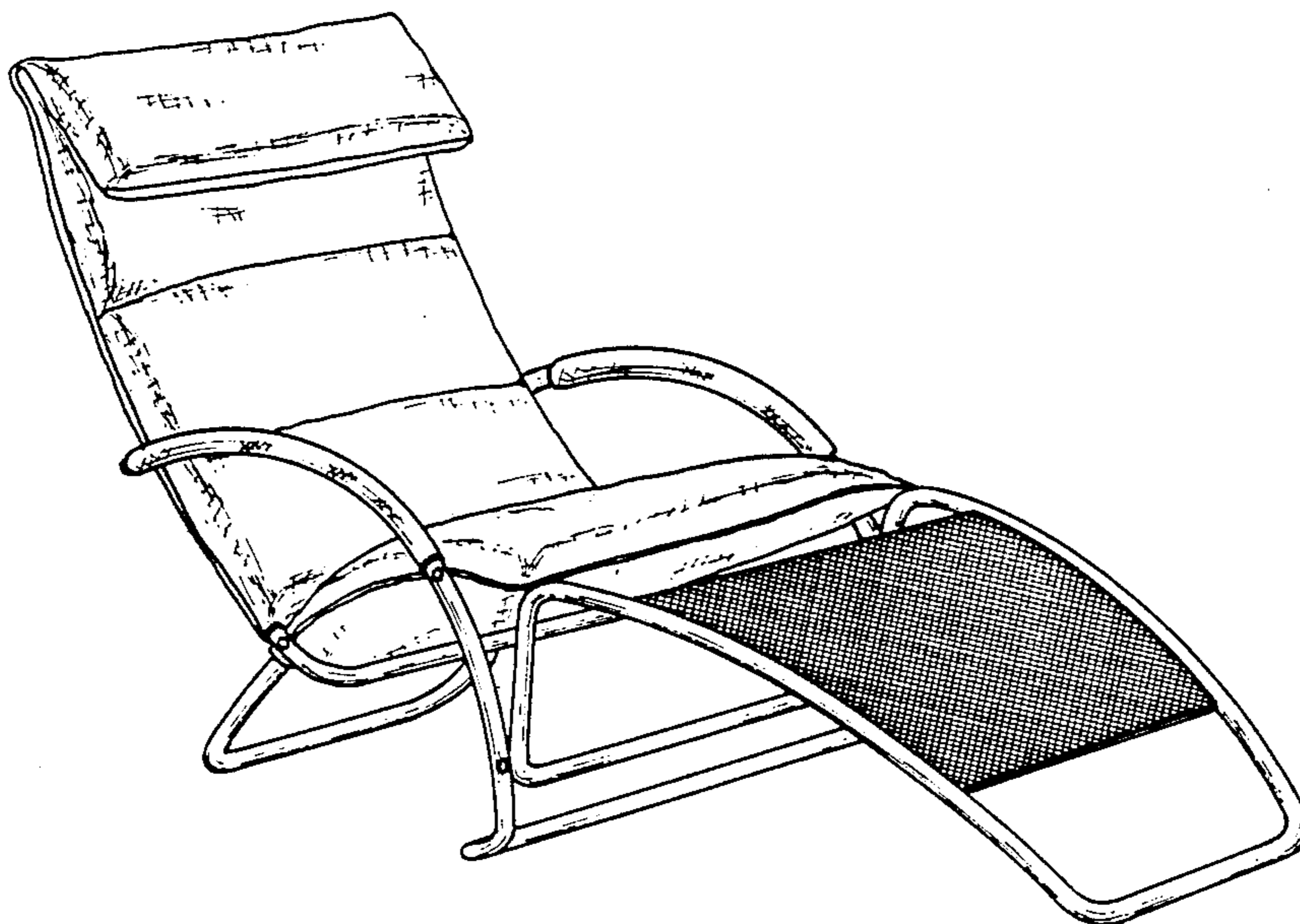

[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a convertible chair, as shown and described.

**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of the convertible chair showing my new design, FIG. 2 is a side elevational view, FIG. 3 is a top plan view, FIG. 4 is a front elevational view thereof; and FIG. 5 is a front perspective view of the convertible chair in an alternate position. The bottom of the chair and the undisclosed rear thereof are conventional in appearance.



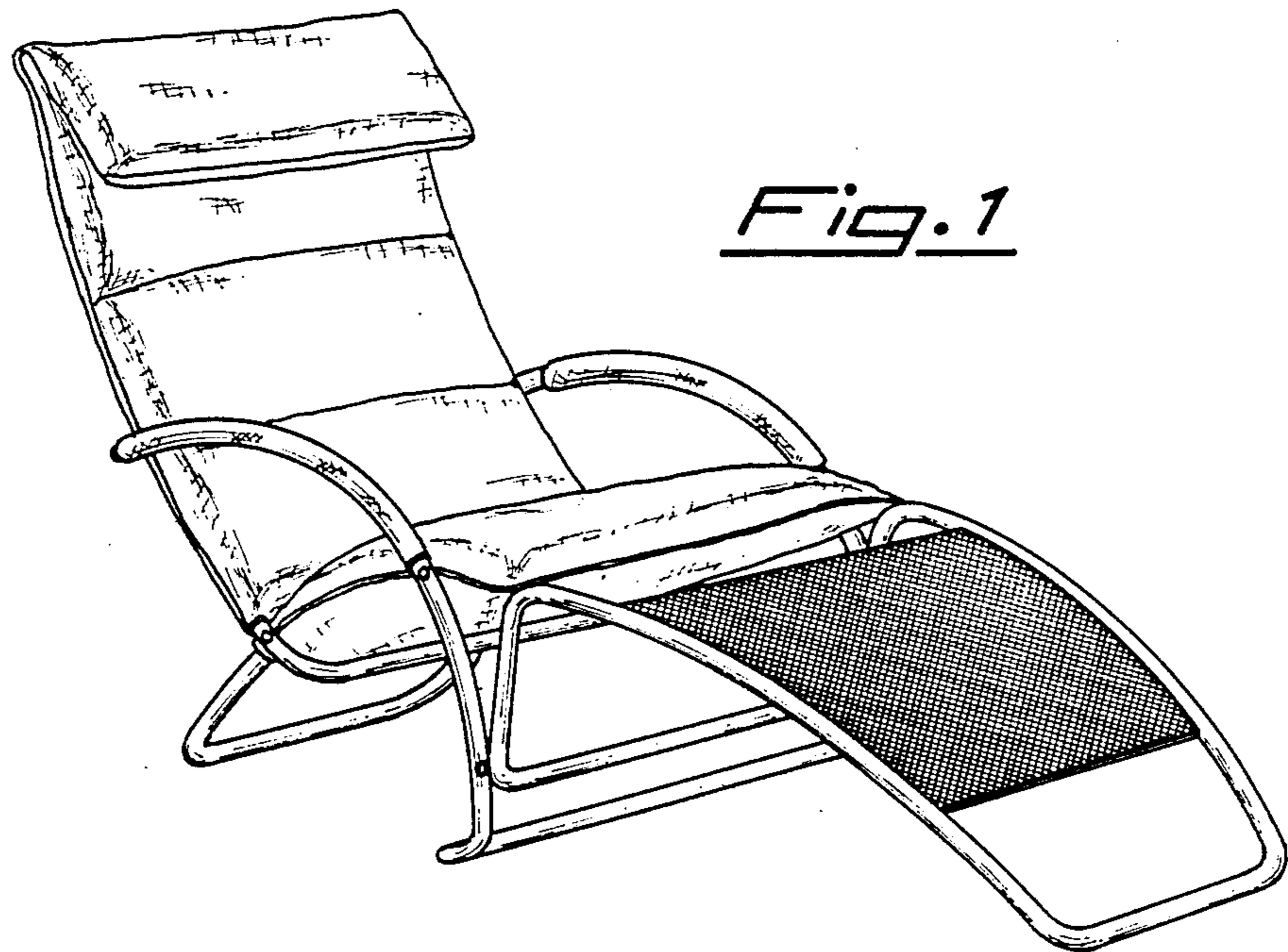

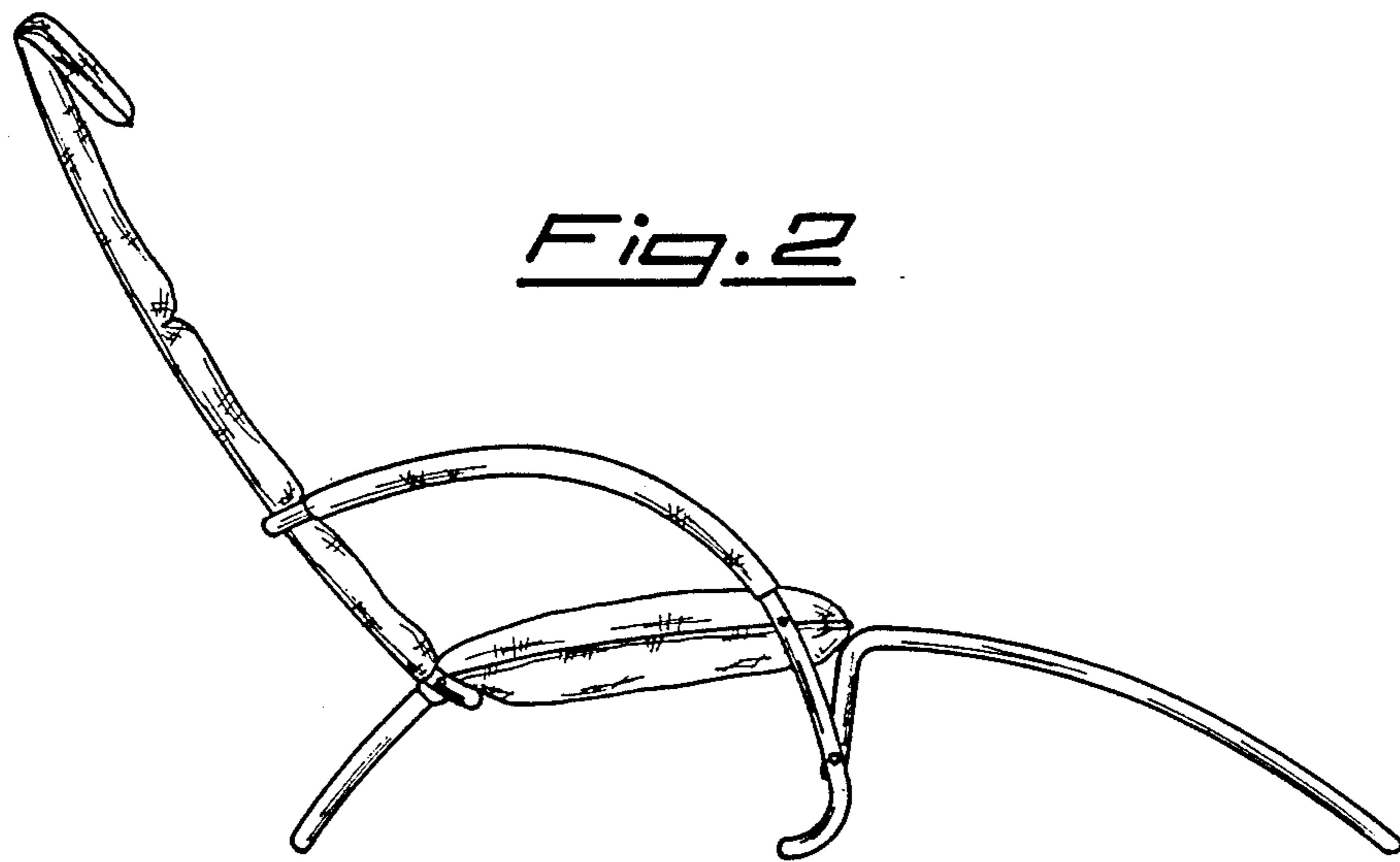

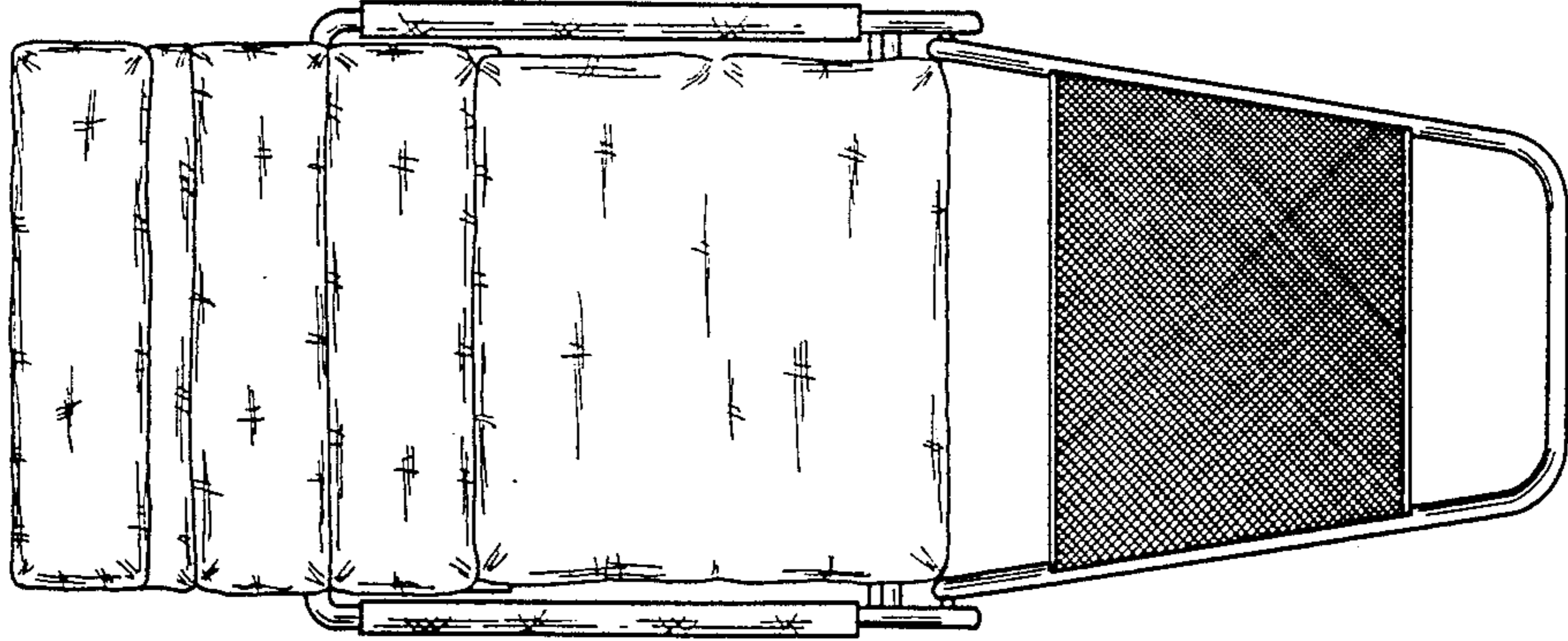

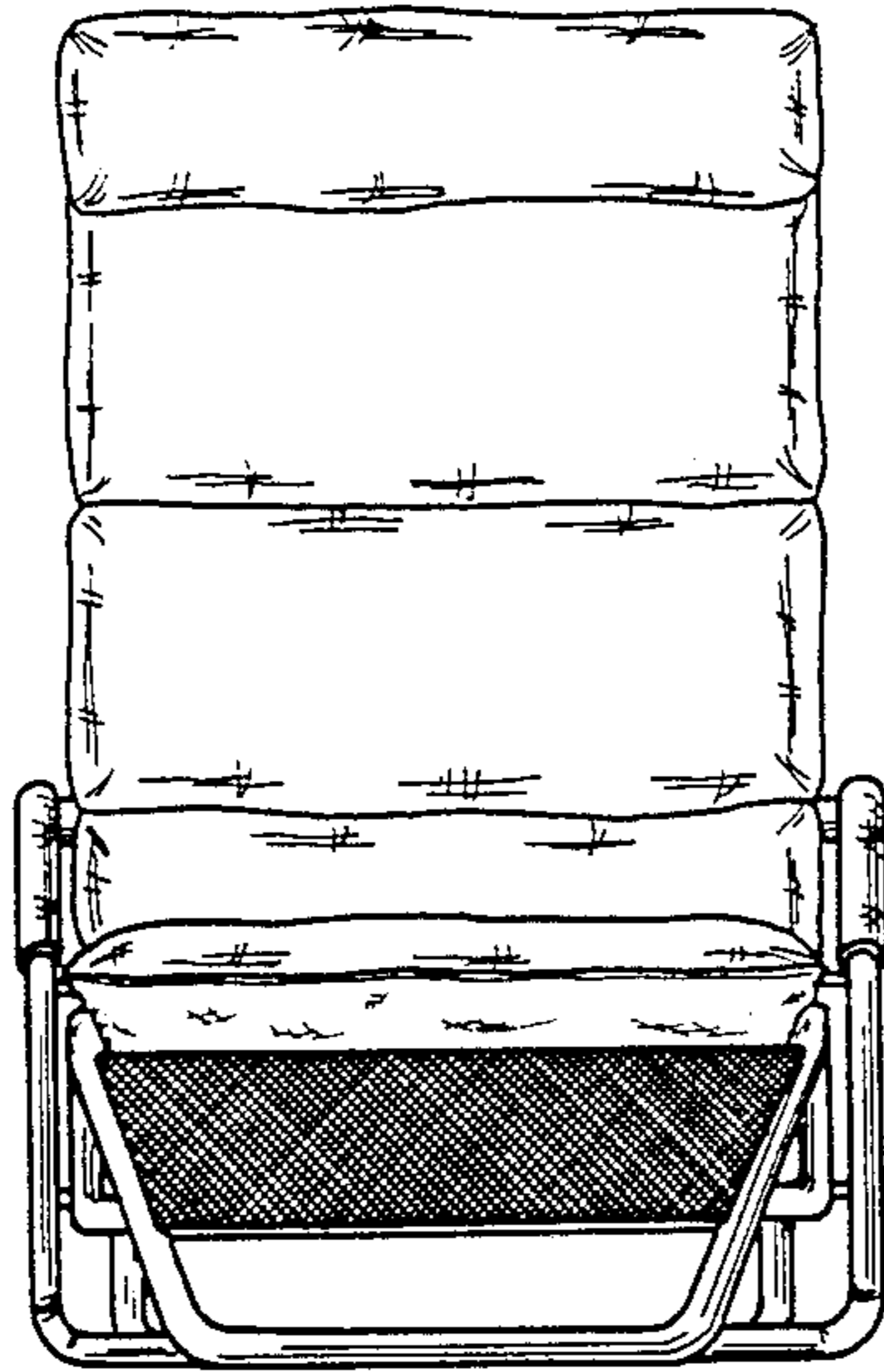
